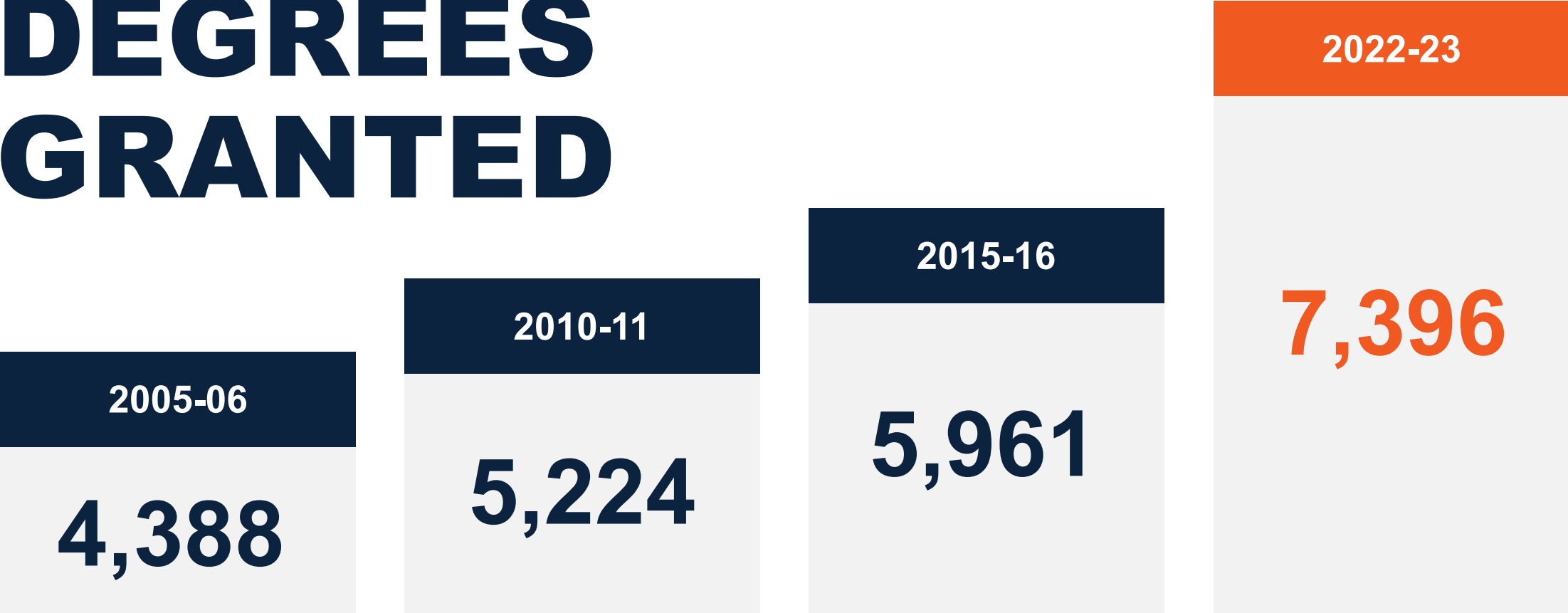

Continued expansion of our downtown educational and research facilities in Downtown San Antonio.

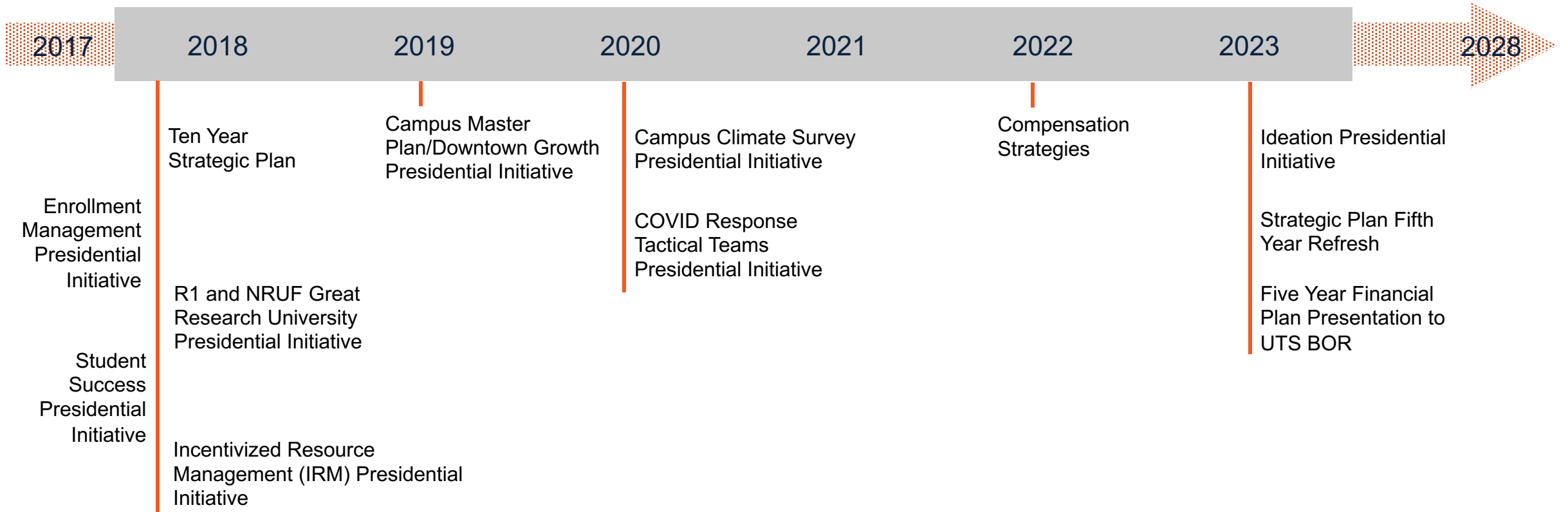

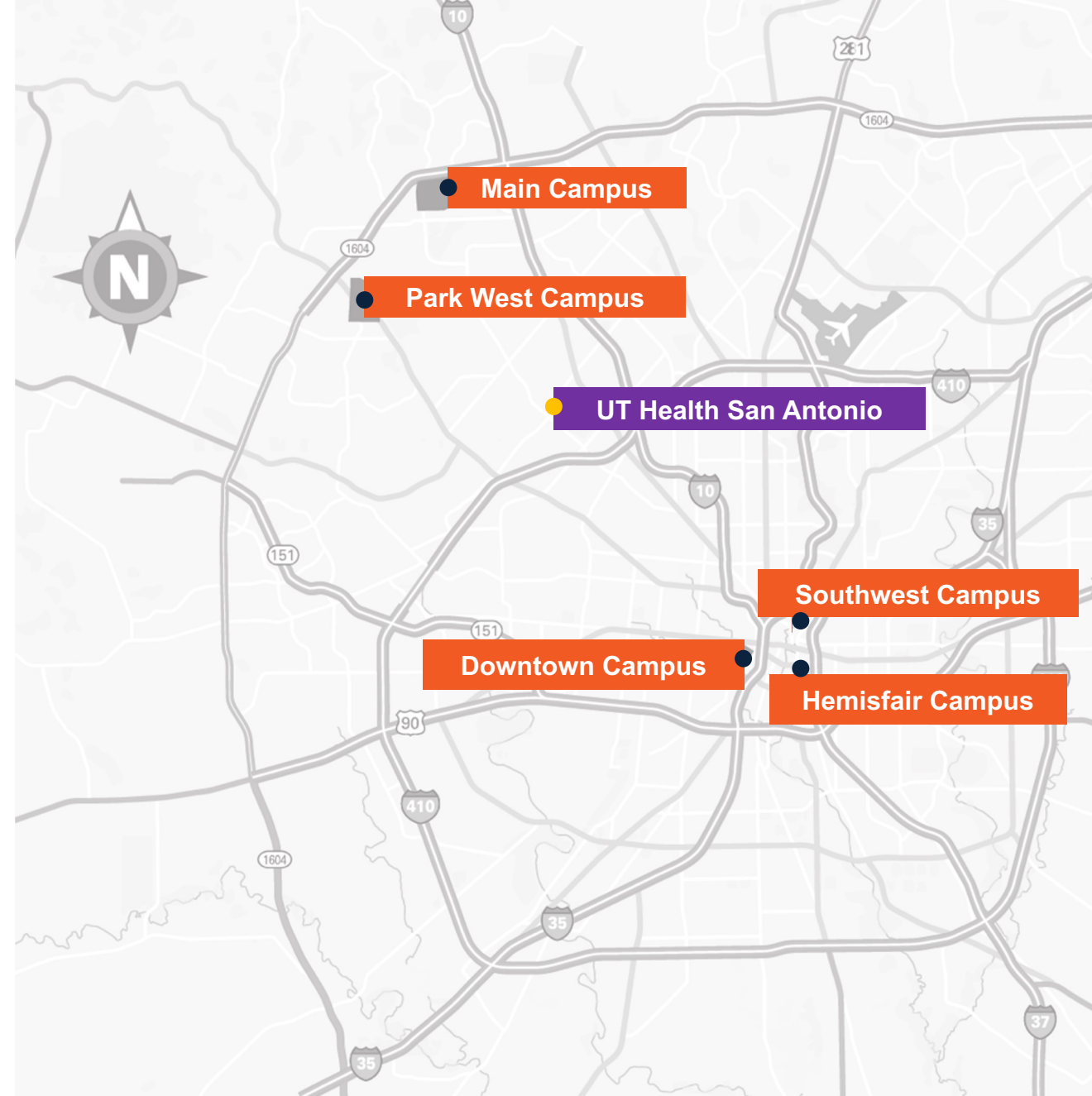

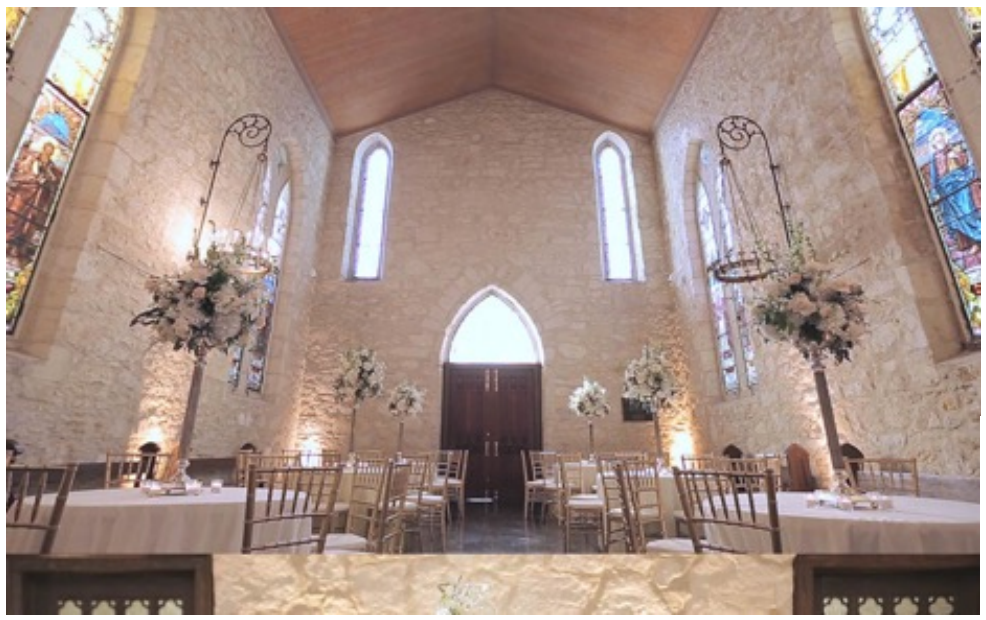
