#### B. 12 semester credit hours of elective coursework

Elective coursework may also be determined based on the student's program of study and in consultation with assigned advisor. Students may elect to take courses from relevant departments throughout COEHD (i.e., Bilingual Bicultural Studies, Counseling, Educational Leadership and Policy Studies, Educational Psychology, Interdisciplinary Learning and Teaching, and/or Race, Ethnicity, Gender, and Sexuality Studies) and UTSA (e.g., including but not limited to Psychology, Sociology, and Public Policy). While students may add the ABA certificate to their program, they may not use their master's degree electives to obtain the certificate. Students may opt to do a master's thesis and earn credits as part of their elective options. EDP 6983 Master's Thesis (Permission of the Graduate Advisor of Record and thesis director required. Thesis research and

preparation. 6 SCH required. May be repeated for credit, but no more than 6 hours will apply to the Master's degree. Credit will be awarded upon completion of the thesis. Enrollment is required each term in which the thesis is in progress.)
