At Del Mar College

- ☞ Only 66 transferable semester credit hours from a community college can be applied to a bachelor's degree at UTSA.

At UTSA

- ☞ Be sure to visit the College of Sciences Undergraduate Advising Center, Room SB 2.01.08; Phone (210) 458-4045 for assistance with course sequencing.
- ☞ Please note that developmental education, orientation, life experience, high school level, mathematics below the College Algebra level, or vocational-technical courses are not acceptable for transfer credit at UTSA.
- ☞ A grade of "C" or better is required for all major, support, and prerequisite work.
- ☞ Students should not take any biology courses that transfer to UTSA as Allied Health Science (AHS) courses as they will not be used in any way towards the Bachelor of Science degree in Biology at UTSA. The exception is BIOL 1322, which transfers as AHS 2043 Nutrition and as a lower-division biology elective.
- ▲ Some community college hours may satisfy the UTSA electives requirement. Check with a College of Sciences advisor upon transferring to UTSA.



It is very important that students pay close attention to course prerequisite sequencing and availability at both the community college and at UTSA as it will affect the time it takes to complete entire degree program.
