PREPARATION ACADEMY (SLSPA) 2014

Aimed to help students successfully apply to and excel in law school

- The SLSPA is designed to hone the analytical, reading, and writing skills needed to succeed in legal education. It includes 12 credit hours of coursework that count towards your GPA and legal studies minor.
- SLSPA students receive LSAT preparatory training and attend plenary sessions featuring law school professors, judges, and practicing attorneys. Plenary sessions also include law school admission reps on topics such as how to finance a legal education, prepare an admission portfolio, write personal statements, and others.
- Students completing the SLSPA and attending at least 70% of plenary sessions earn the *Certificate in Legal Reasoning*. Deadline to apply for early admission is March 15, 2014, for regular admission is April 15, 2014.
