

How to calculate your CRJ GPA:

You will have to count up all of the hours you have taken for CJ courses only. (For example, if you've taken 4 three hour courses you have taken a total of 12 hours.)

Next to those classes on your transcripts you will see points assigned to you. (For a 3 hour course the max amount of points you could receive is 12 making an A worth 12 points, a B worth 9 points, a C worth 6 points and D worth 3 points. Since the class is a 3 hour class, the points are increasing in 3 point increments.)

Then you take the total number of points received and divide by the total number of hours of those courses.

For example, if you receive 2 A's and 2 B's. The A's would be 12 points x 2 = 24 points and the B's would be 9 points x 2 = 18 points. The combined total would be 42 points which you would then divide by the total hours, which in this case would be 12. 42 points divided by 12 hours would make your GPA a 3.5.

Example with both 3 and 4 hour courses combined:

3 hour class:

A = 12
B = 9
C = 6
D = 3

4 hour class:

A = 16
B = 12
C = 8
D = 4

Example:

You took 2 – three hour courses and 2 - four hour courses. The total number of hours taken would be...

$$4 + 4 + 3 + 3 = 14 \text{ hours}$$

You received an A and a C in the three hour courses and 2 B's in the four hour courses. You add up the corresponding points...

3 hour courses:	4 hour courses:
A = 12	B = 12
C = 6	B = 12

To figure the GPA:

The total number of points therefore is $12 + 6 + 12 + 12 = 42$ points.

42 total points / 14 total hours give a GPA of: 3.0.
