ON-CAMPUS

FERPA: Federal law protecting the privacy of students' education records.

- Prohibits Financial Aid, Registrar, Fiscal Services, & other UTSA departments from releasing any specific student education information without the student's written permission.
- Individuals other than the student cannot access the student's education records, unless the student has granted authorization through a FERPA/Proxy account in ASAP.

OFF-CAMPUS

Senate Bill 4: Allows local law enforcement to inquire about immigration status. You do not have to respond about your immigration status. Be aware of TX counties that have signed 287(g) memorandums of agreement: www.ice.gov/287g

- You have the right to remain silent
- You have the right to talk to an attorney
- You have the right against illegal inspection
- You do not have to sign any document(s)
- You are protected from unreasonable search & seizure

REDUCING RISK

- Stay calm
- Do not run, argue, resist or obstruct
- Keep hands visible at all times
- Do not provide false documentation
- Do not lie

- Obey all state & federal laws
- Do not drive without a license
- Follow all traffic laws
- Drive carefully
- Conduct regular checks of your vehicle

BYSTANDER INTERVENTION

- Assert your rights and the rights of the individual being questioned
- Obtain information: agent/officer name, badge number, details about the incident
- Video the incident but do not escalate the situation
- For an off-campus incident, you can get in contact with a local nonprofit (RAICES, AmericanGateways, etc.)
