



To help make higher education affordable, accessible and provide financial support to students and their families, The University of Texas at San Antonio has established a new financial aid program—UTSAccess (Undergraduate Tuition, Support, and Access).

For the 2011-12 school year, UTSA students who are first-time Freshmen as well as Texas residents with a family adjusted gross income and wage earnings of \$30,000 or less and assets less than \$50,000 will be provided grants and/or scholarships to cover tuition and mandatory fees for four years under the UTSAccess program.*

The UTSAccess program will also set aside work-study funds for students to help cover the cost of room and board and other educational expenses. Students may work on-campus for approximately 10-12 hours per week to help support their additional costs and will gain work experience in a variety of departments while becoming involved in campus life. Students will also be provided low interest loans to assist with additional education expenses over and above tuition and fees.

Undergraduate Tuition Support & Access

Along with Financial Aid Resources, UTSAccess will also provide support to students that help them continue at UTSA and graduate on time. Support programs include assistance with increased advising, financial aid counseling, money management programs, and tutoring.

To qualify for the UTSAccess program, students must:

- ◆ Have a family adjusted gross income and wage earnings of \$30,000 or less
- ◆ Have assets less than \$50,000
- ◆ Apply and be admitted to UTSA by **March 15th, 2011**
- ◆ Apply for financial aid using the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by the priority deadline of **March 15th, 2011**
- ◆ Be registered for at least 12 credit hours each semester and complete 24 credit hours each year at UTSA
- ◆ Maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher
