Student Services Fee	All students	All students	\$15.40/SCH maximum \$184.80/sem	A compulsory fee to fund student-related services such as intramural activities; student government and organizations; student financial aid; career services; counseling services; others
Athletics Fee	All Students	All Students	\$20/SCH maximum \$240/sem	To provide partial funding for UTSA athletic programs, expand scholarships to athletes, increase the number of sports offered, and expand indoor and outdoor athletic facilities; allows UTSA students free admittance to all UTSA regular season conference and non-conference sporting events held on campus.
Library Resources Charge	All Students	All students	\$14/SCH	To defray costs of providing increased direct and indirect services & supplies to include online access to full-text data bases, academic indexes, print journals & monographs. Defray costs for providing extended library hours & increased access based on student demand. To provide for growth in library staffing & associated service costs. To defray costs of approved library renovations when available funding at year end permits.

University Center Fee	All students	All students	\$10/SCH \$40 min \$120 max	Fee may be used for finance, construction, operation, and maintenance of a university center and its programs
Medical Services Fee	All students	All students	\$32.70/sem	For medical services provided at Health Services
International Education Fee	All students	All students	\$2/semester	For funding an international education financial aid fund
Recreation Center Fee	All students	All students	\$120/semester	Fee may be used for finance, construction, operation, and maintenance of student recreation center
Automated Services Charge	All students	All students	\$25/SCH \$100 min \$300 max	An incidental charge that provides for campus computer and network facilities for administrative, library, and academic programs
ID Card Fee	All students	All students	\$3/semester	To defray costs of producing and distributing student ID cards
Teaching & Learning Center Charge	All students	All students	\$5/semester	To defray costs associated with support of center operation and learning needs of students
Student Data Management Fee	All students	All students	\$10/semester	To defray costs associated with adding & dropping classes, administrative processing of applications for graduation, late registration, processing transcripts, updating student records, and preparing enrollment certifications
