UTSA Institute for Law and Public Affairs 2017 Summer Law School Preparation Academy Application for Admission

The Summer Law School Preparation Academy is designed for current undergraduates who are considering law school. Students will take 23-credit hour courses during each of the two phases and participate in plenary sessions with law school professors, admissions professionals, and practicing attorneys. Students have the option of completing the SLSPA over two summers, or enrolling in both phases during the same summer. Students completing the SLSPA (*earning 12 credit hours and attending at least 70% of plenary sessions*) will be awarded the Certificate of Legal Reasoning.

In order to be considered for admission to the SLSPA, applicants must submit:

- the completed application form
- a statement of purpose describing your interests and goals in regards to the SLSPA, your background, and other relevant information
- a resume (describing work experience, extracurricular activities, community involvement, honors/awards)
- at least one letter of recommendation from someone who knows you well and can describe your qualifications for participation in the SLSPA
- Non-UTSA students should include their most recent transcript (unofficial is acceptable).

Priority Deadline: March 1Regular Deadline: April 15Applications received after April 15 will be considered on a space-available basis.
