

Health Insurance Information

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TEACHING ASSISTANTS AND RESEARCH ASSISTANTS

If you have been approved for a Teaching Assistant or Research Assistant position, the UTSA employee insurance plan does not include coverage for Medical Evacuation and Repatriation of Remains coverage. In order to be eligible for the health insurance waiver it is mandatory that you have Medical Evacuation **and** Repatriation of Remains coverage. It is your responsibility to find supplemental coverage for these two policies.

When shopping for Medical Evacuation and Repatriation of Remains supplemental insurance you must have coverage dates that include the first day of classes through the end of the last date on the health insurance waiver.

If you do not provide proof of Medical Evacuation and Repatriation of Remains with your health insurance waiver – your request for a waiver will be denied regardless of if your medical coverage meets the requirement. To be approved for the waiver you must meet ALL requirements listed on the health insurance waiver application.
