

Enrollment by Course Load





Enrollment by Level and Ethnicity






Enrollment by College


Enrollment by Residence





UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Gender (students seeking degrees at UTSA)


UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Gender



UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Ethnicity






UTSA New Transfer Students by Gender


UTSA Transfer Students by Ethnicity



First Time Full Time Undergraduate Cohort by Gender (students seeking degrees at UTSA)



First Time Full Time Undergraduate Cohort by Ethnicity (students seeking degrees at UTSA)


UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Ethnicity







Retention and Graduation in UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort




















