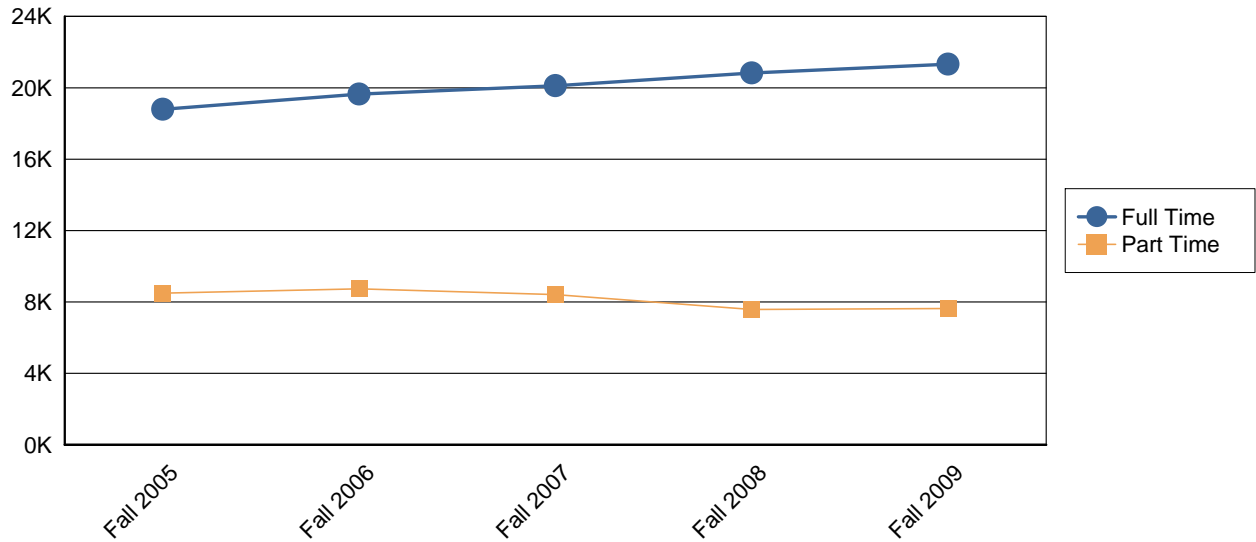

Enrollment by Course Load



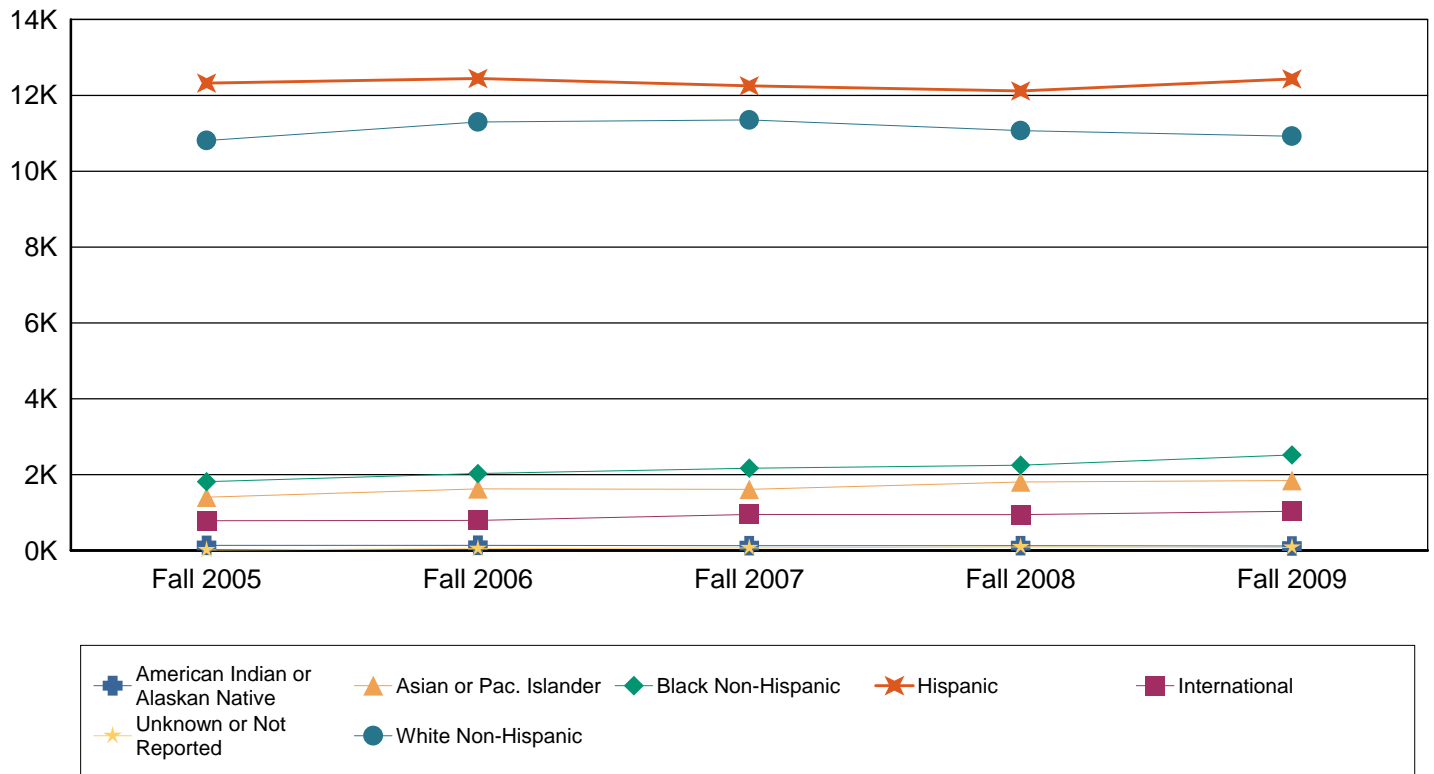

Enrollment by Level and Ethnicity

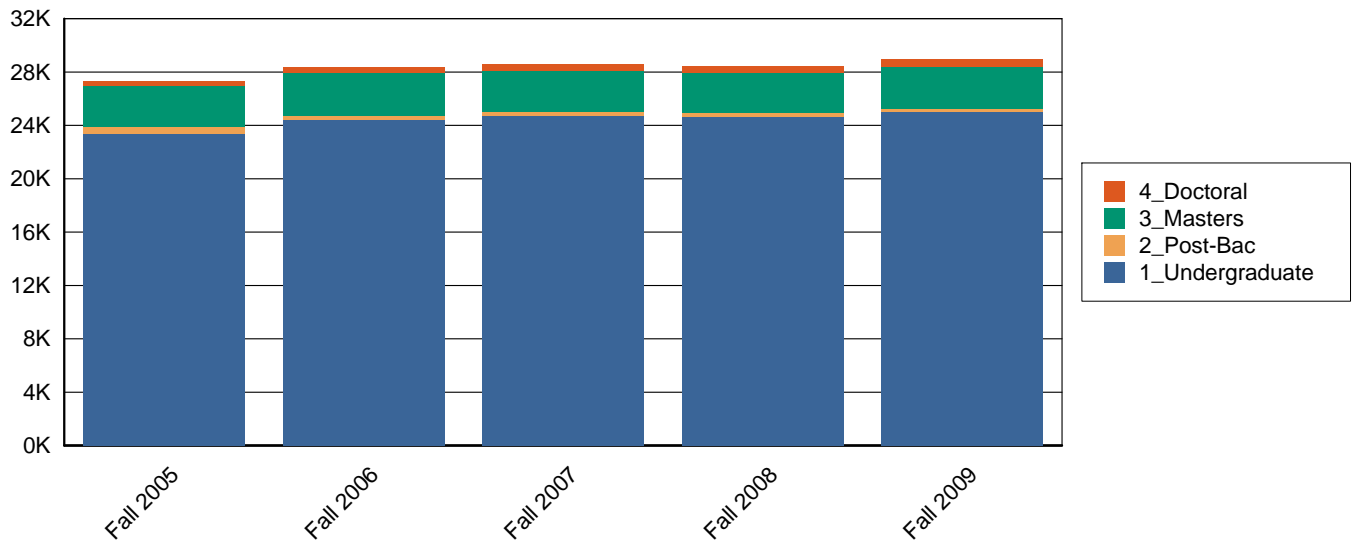

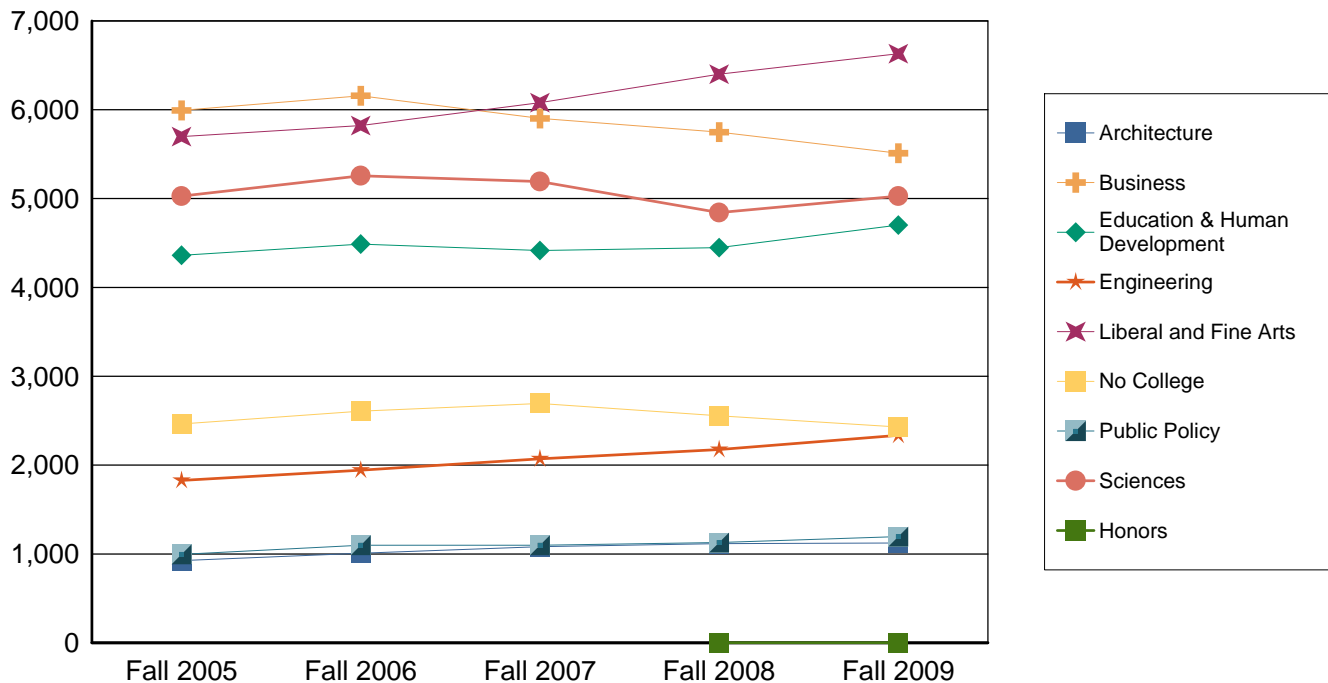

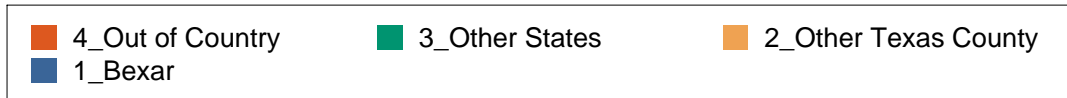
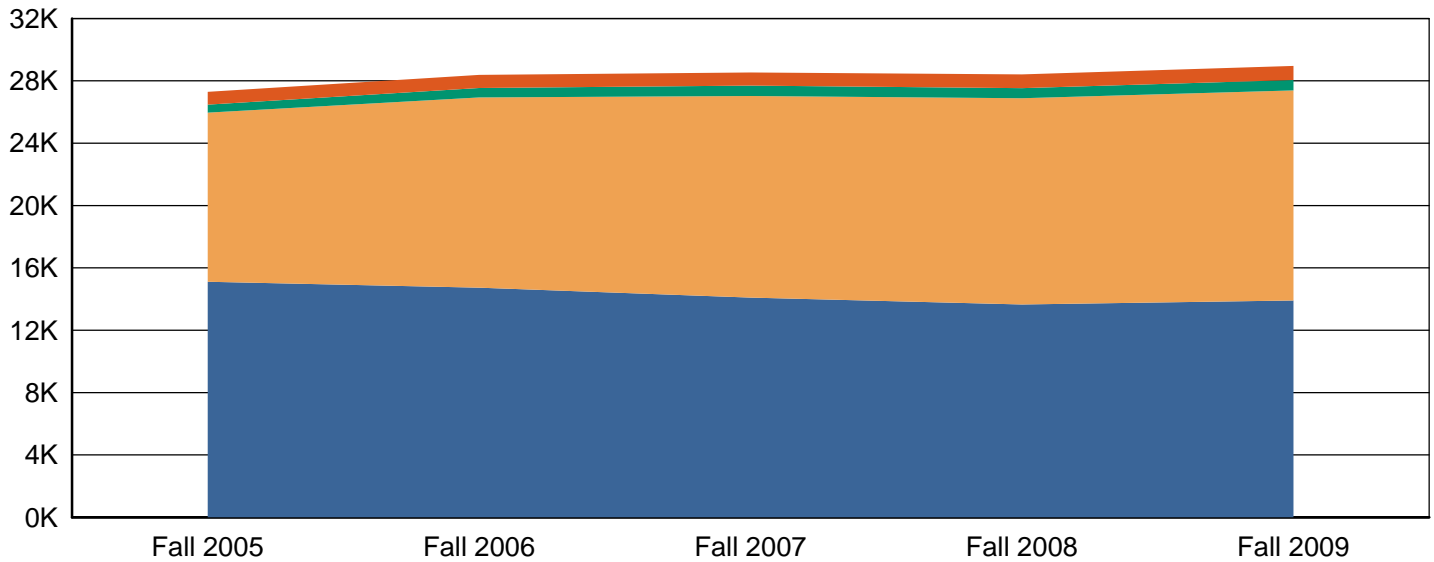
Enrollment by College

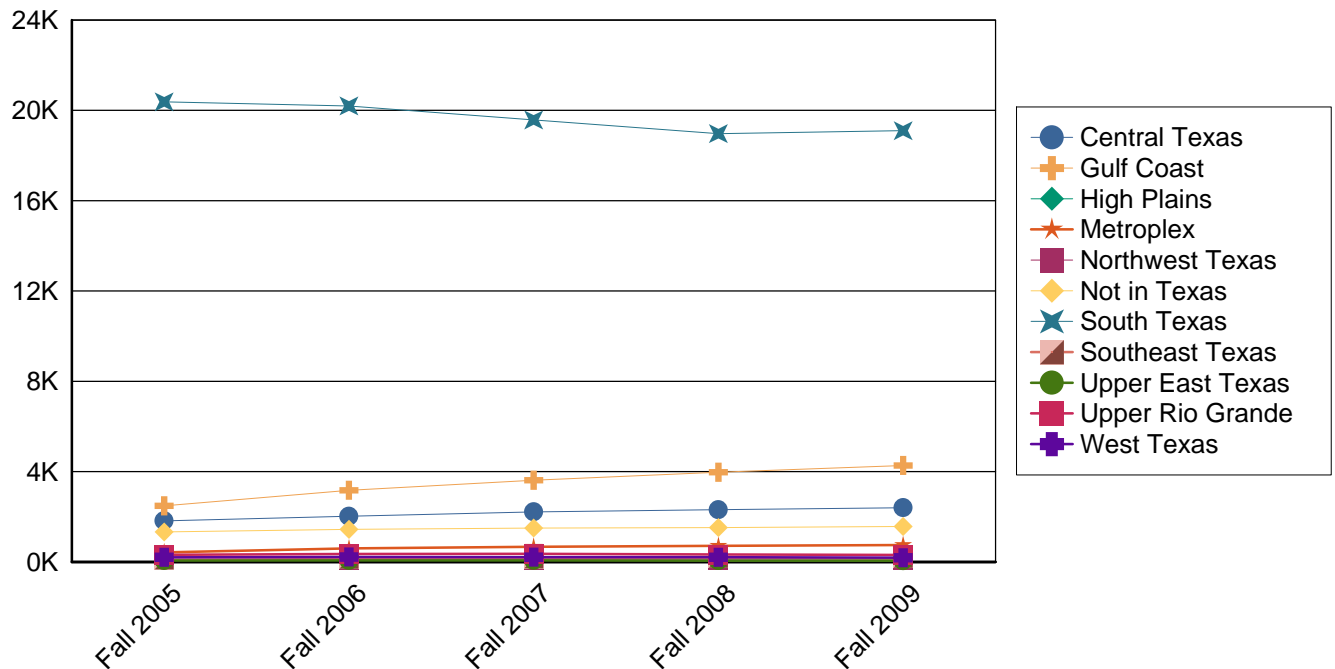
Enrollment by Residence

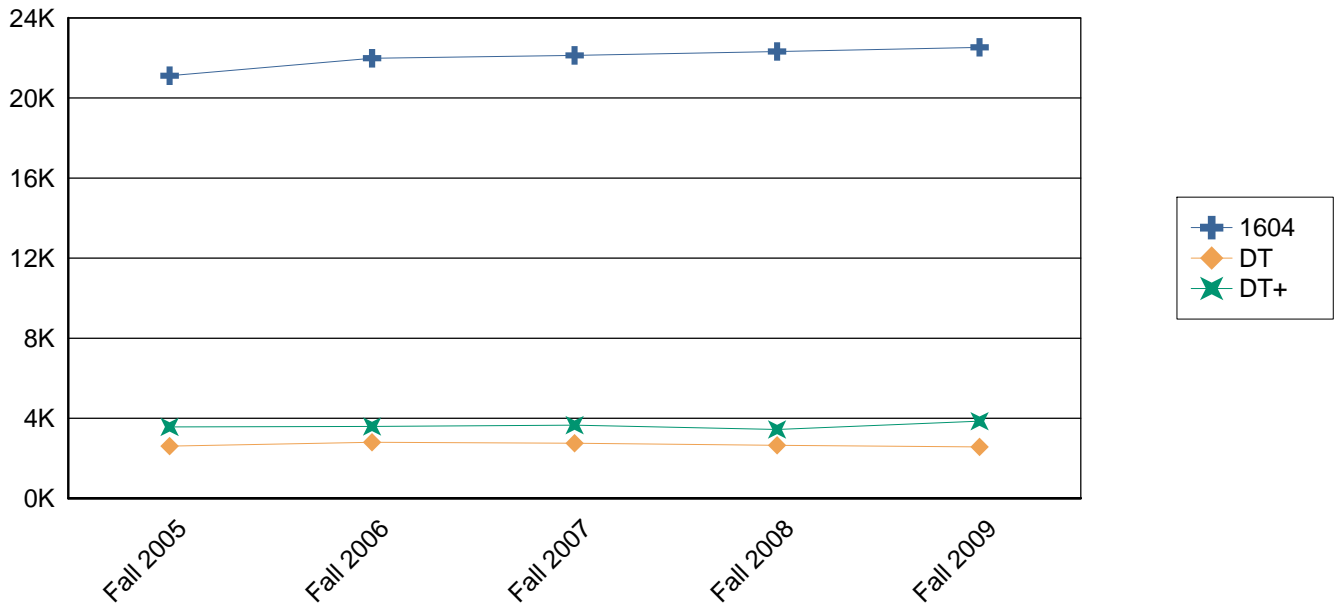
Enrollment by Economic Region

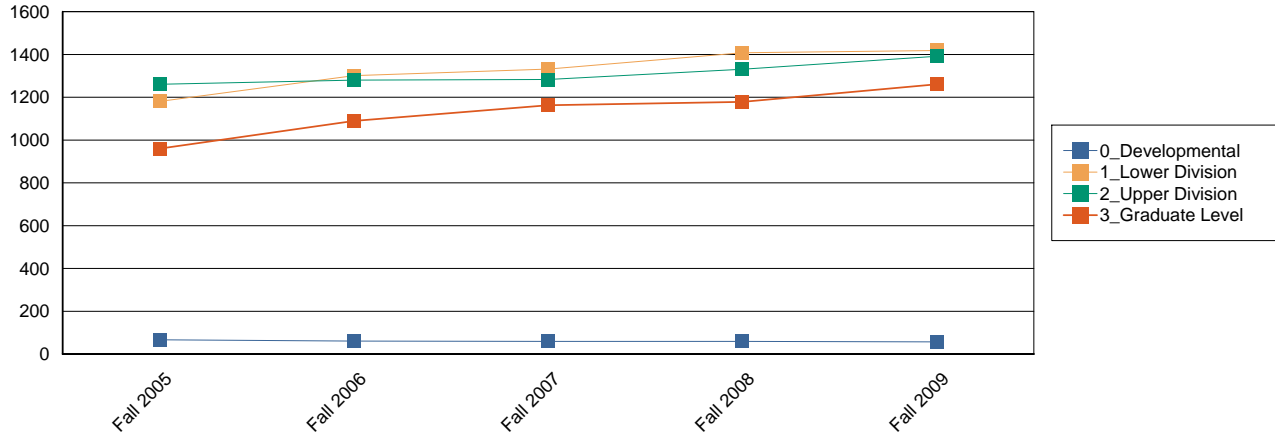

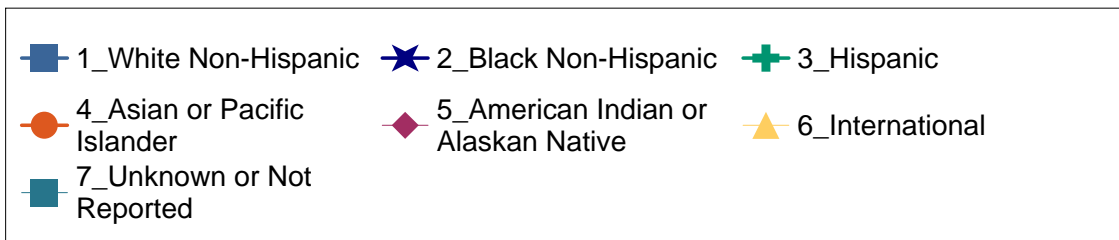
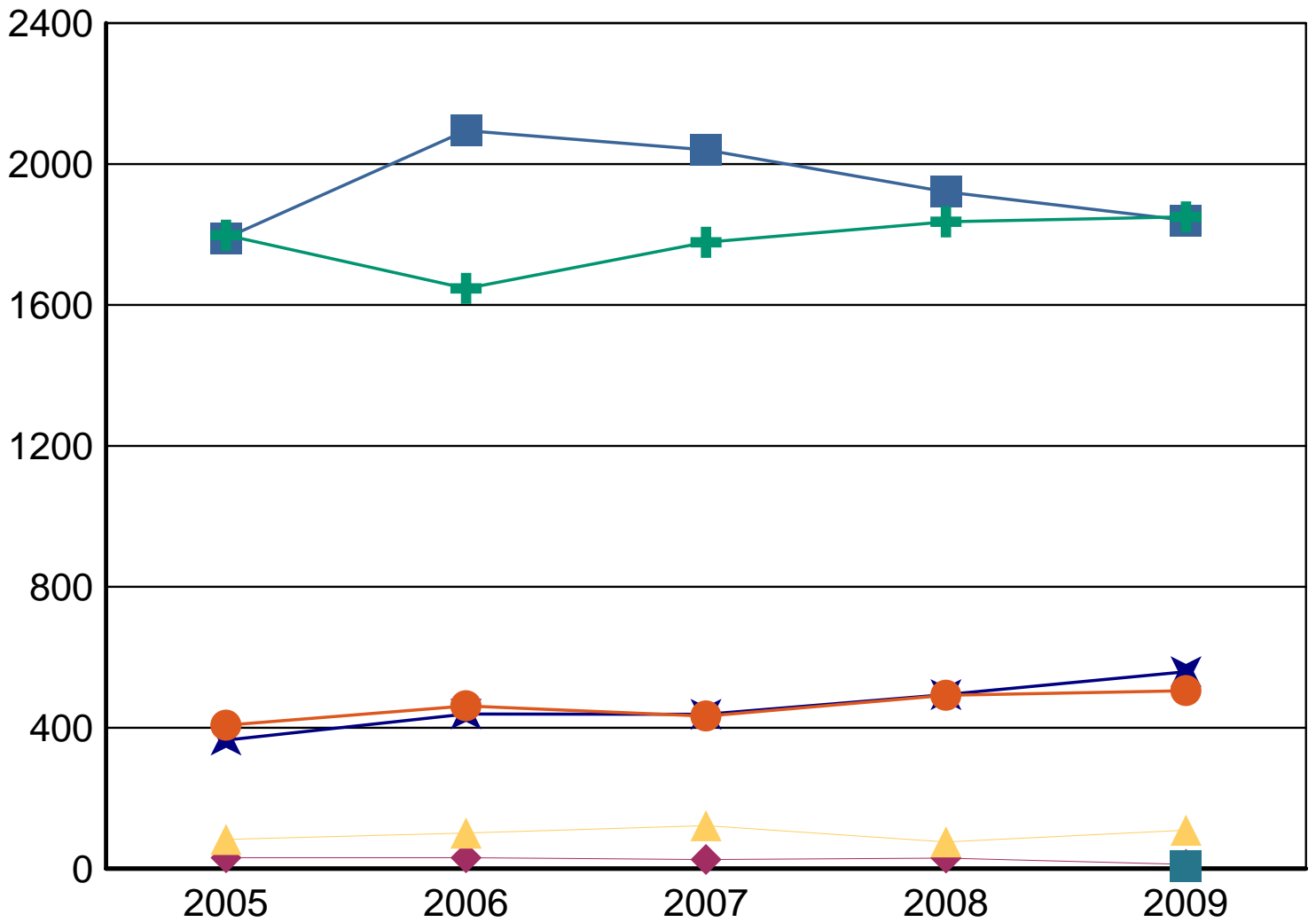
Number of New First Time Undergraduates Applied

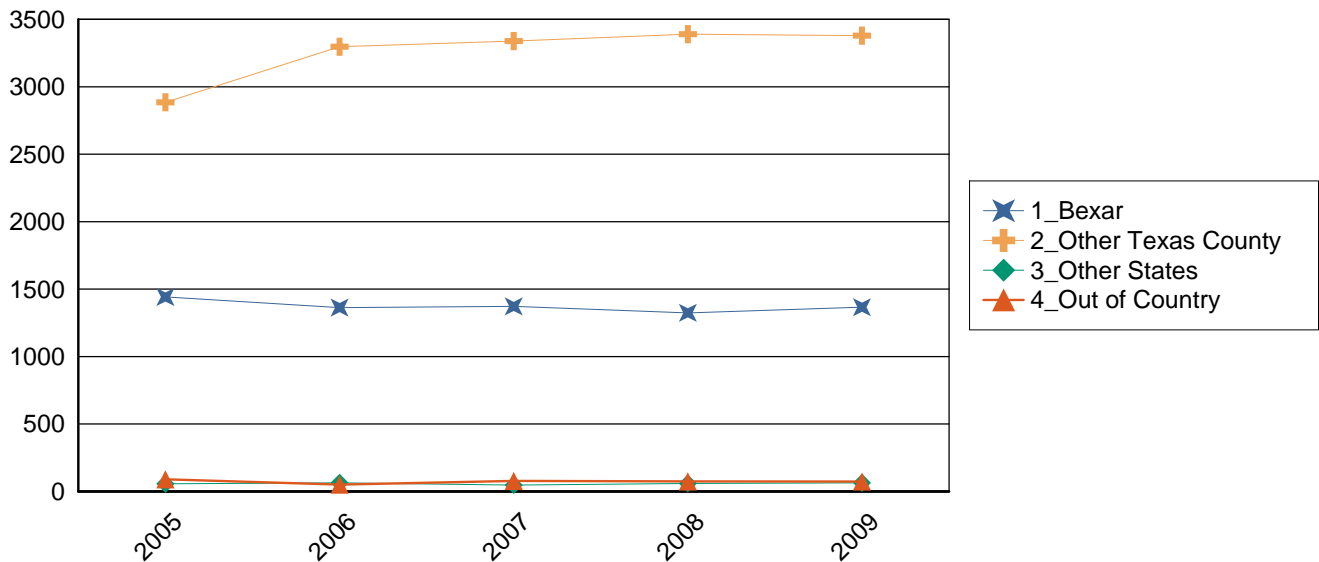

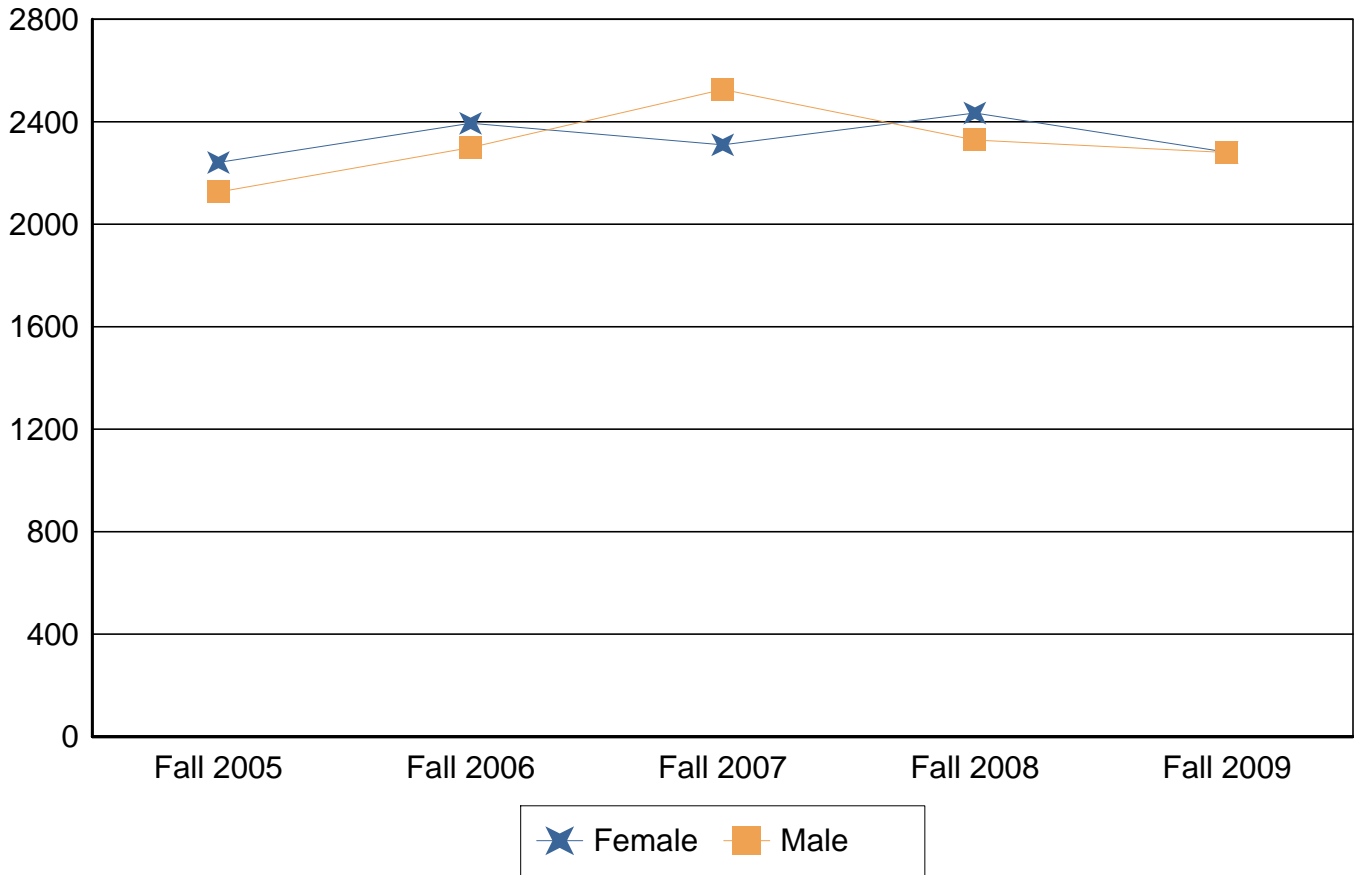

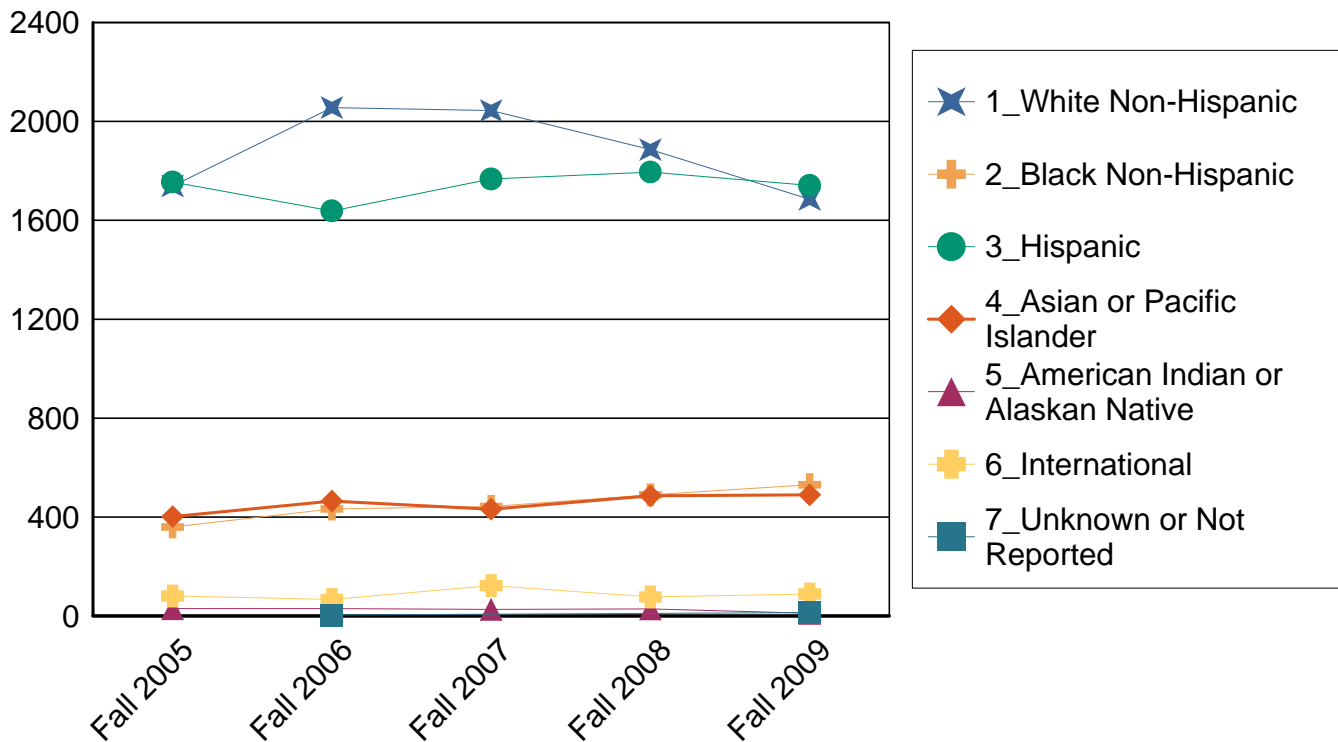
UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Gender

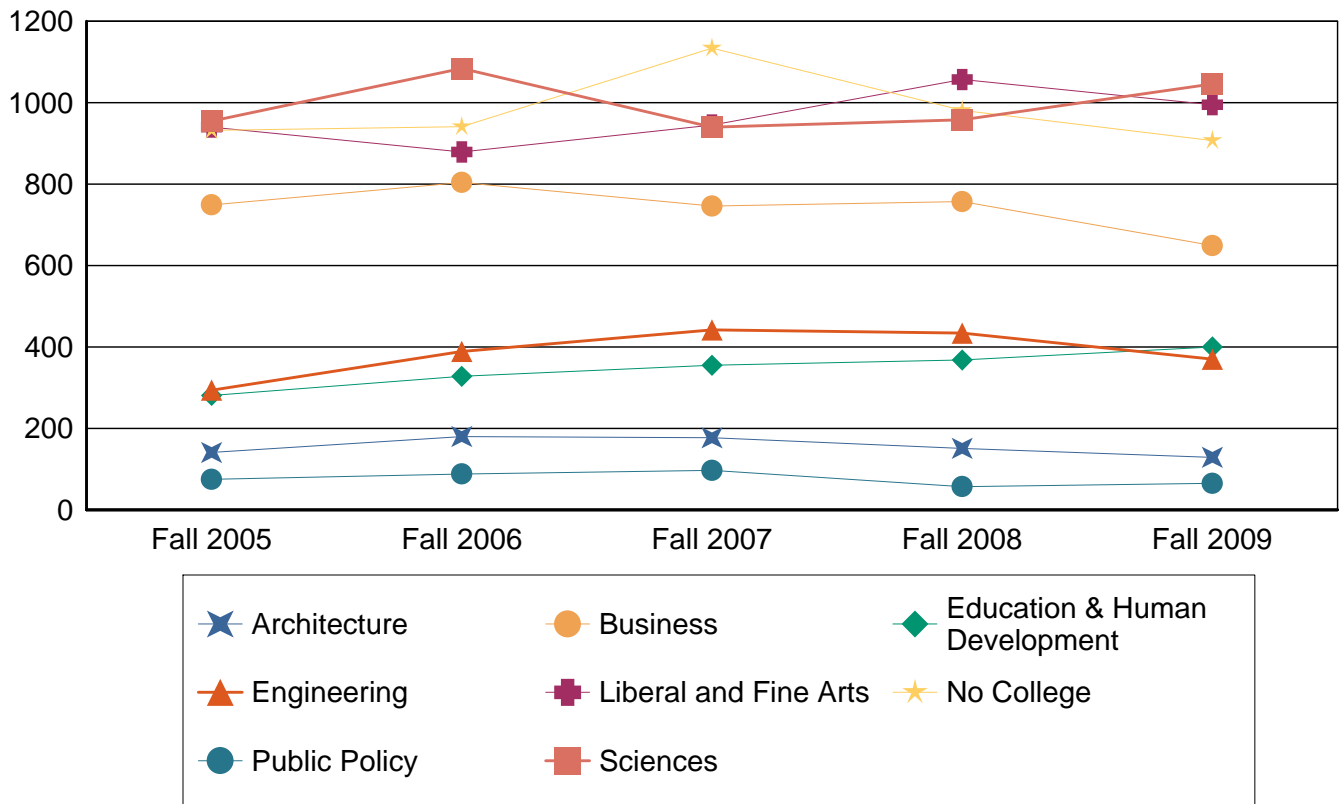
UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Ethnicity

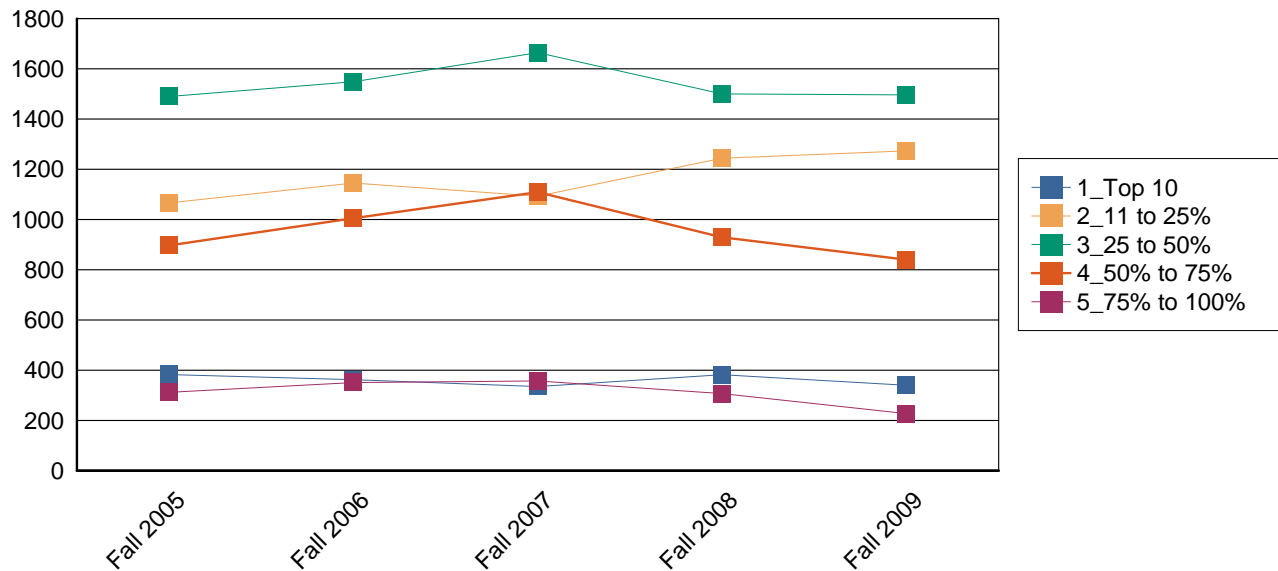

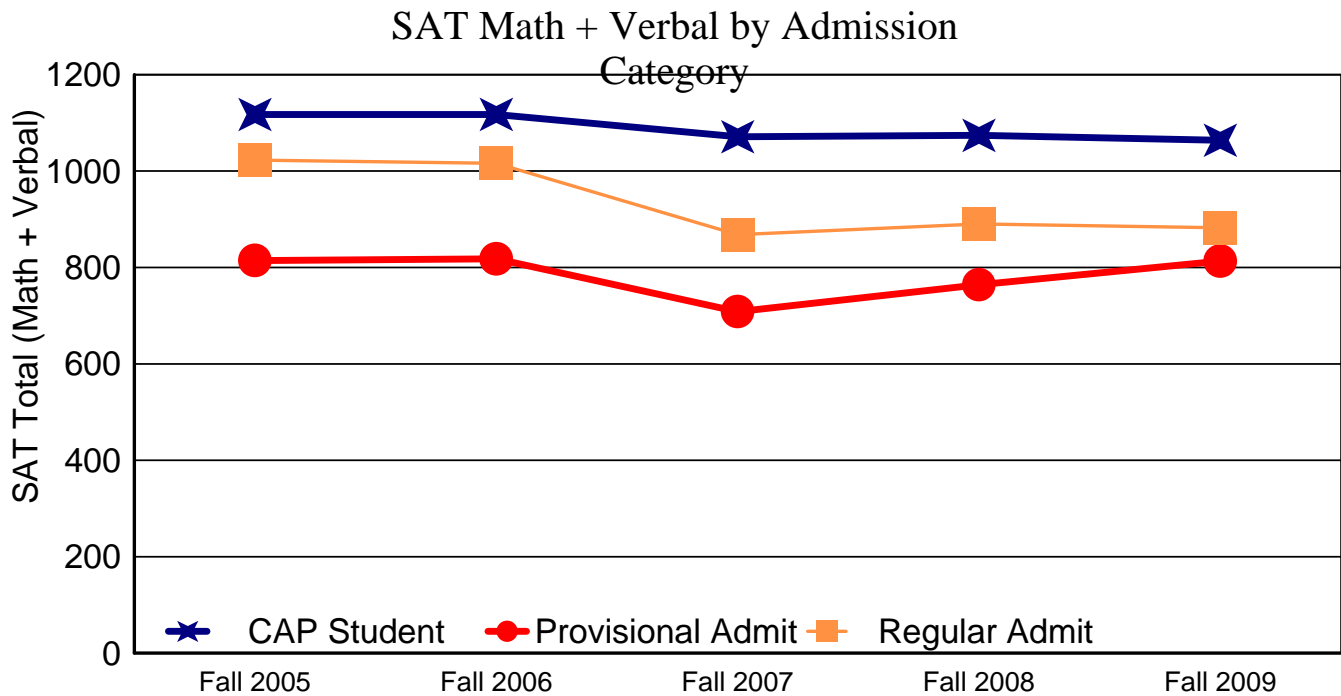

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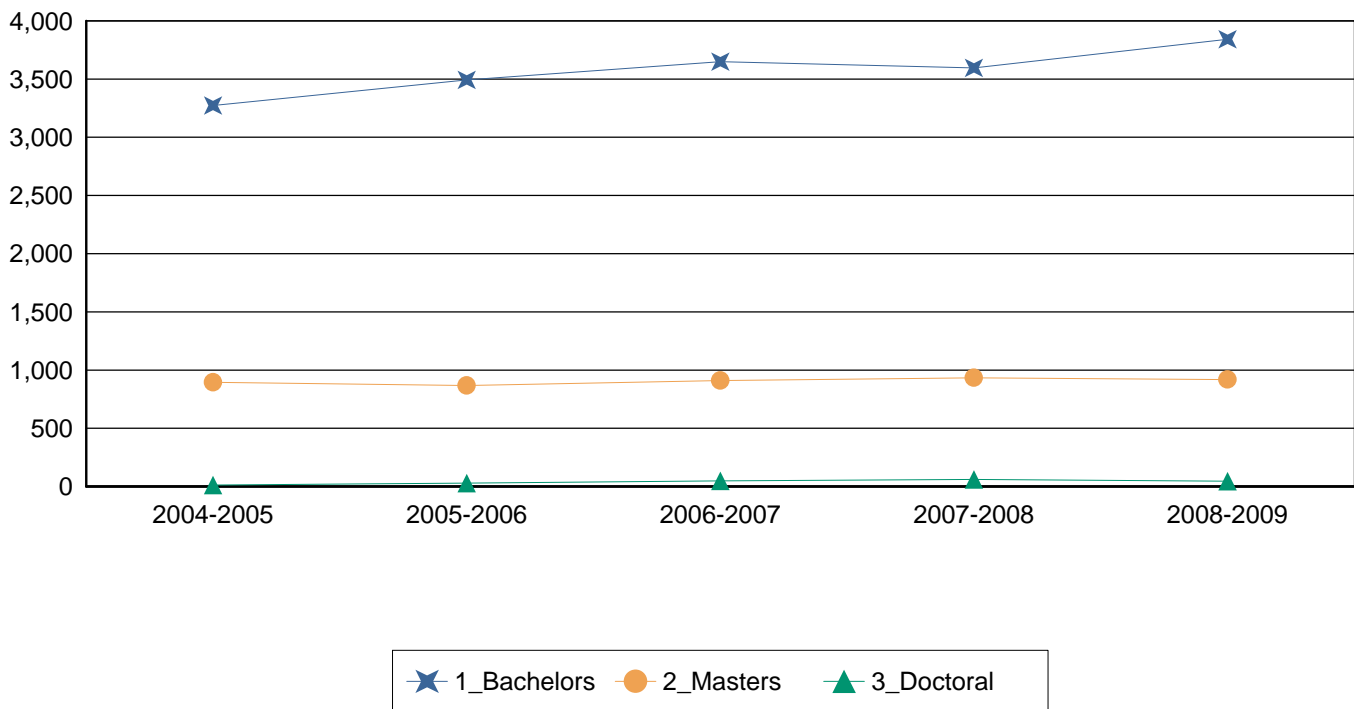

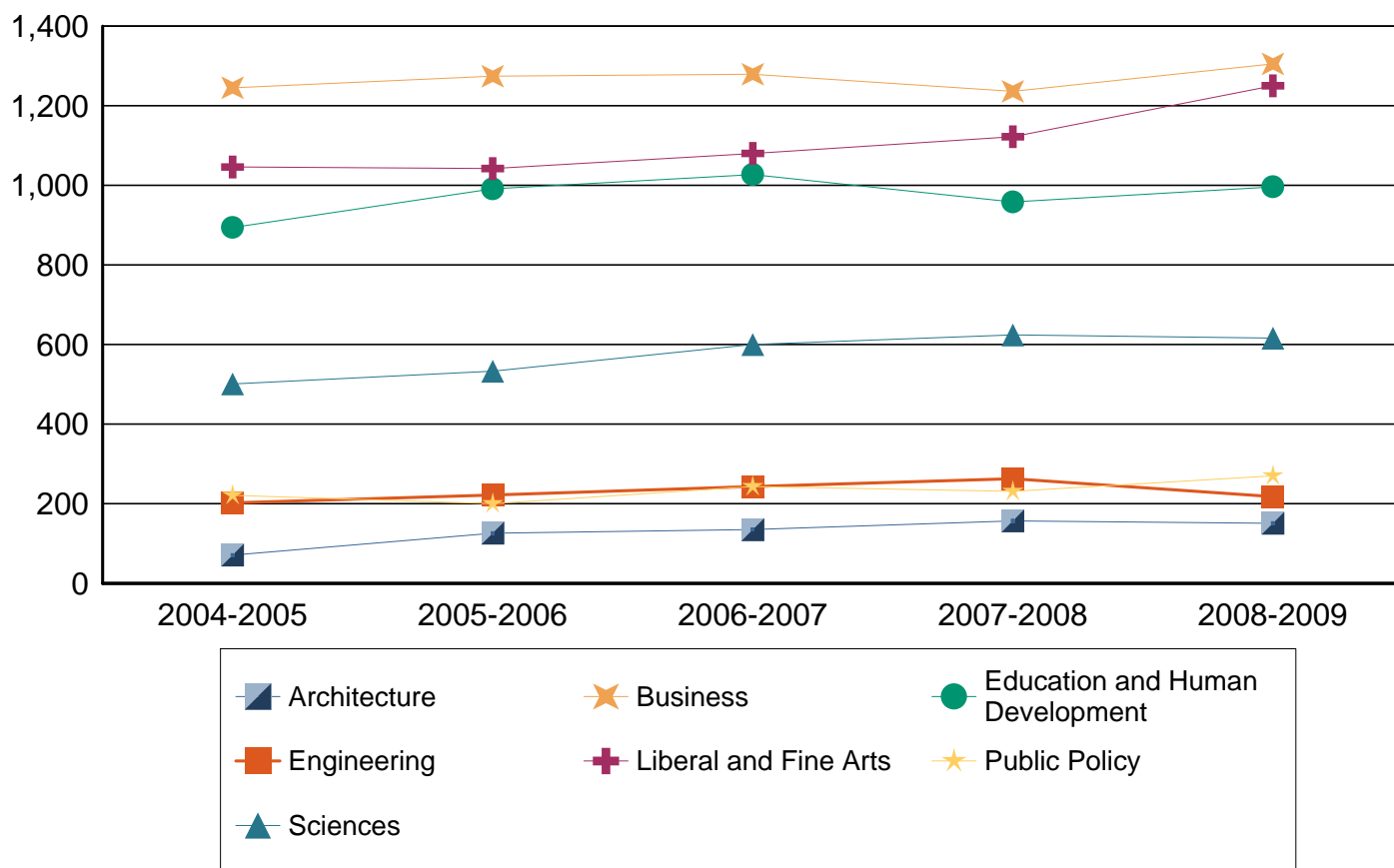

Degrees Awarded by College Based on the Fall 2009 College Structure

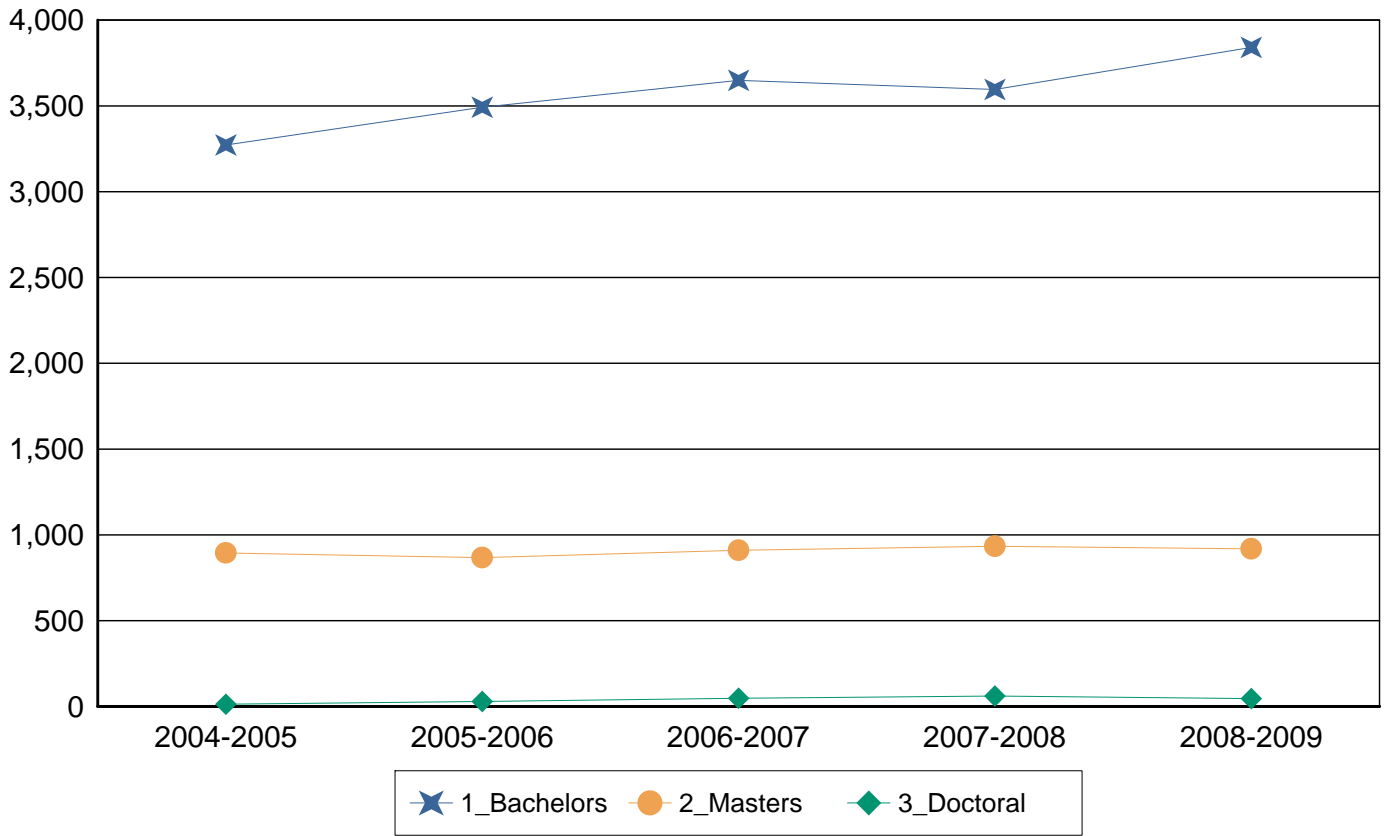

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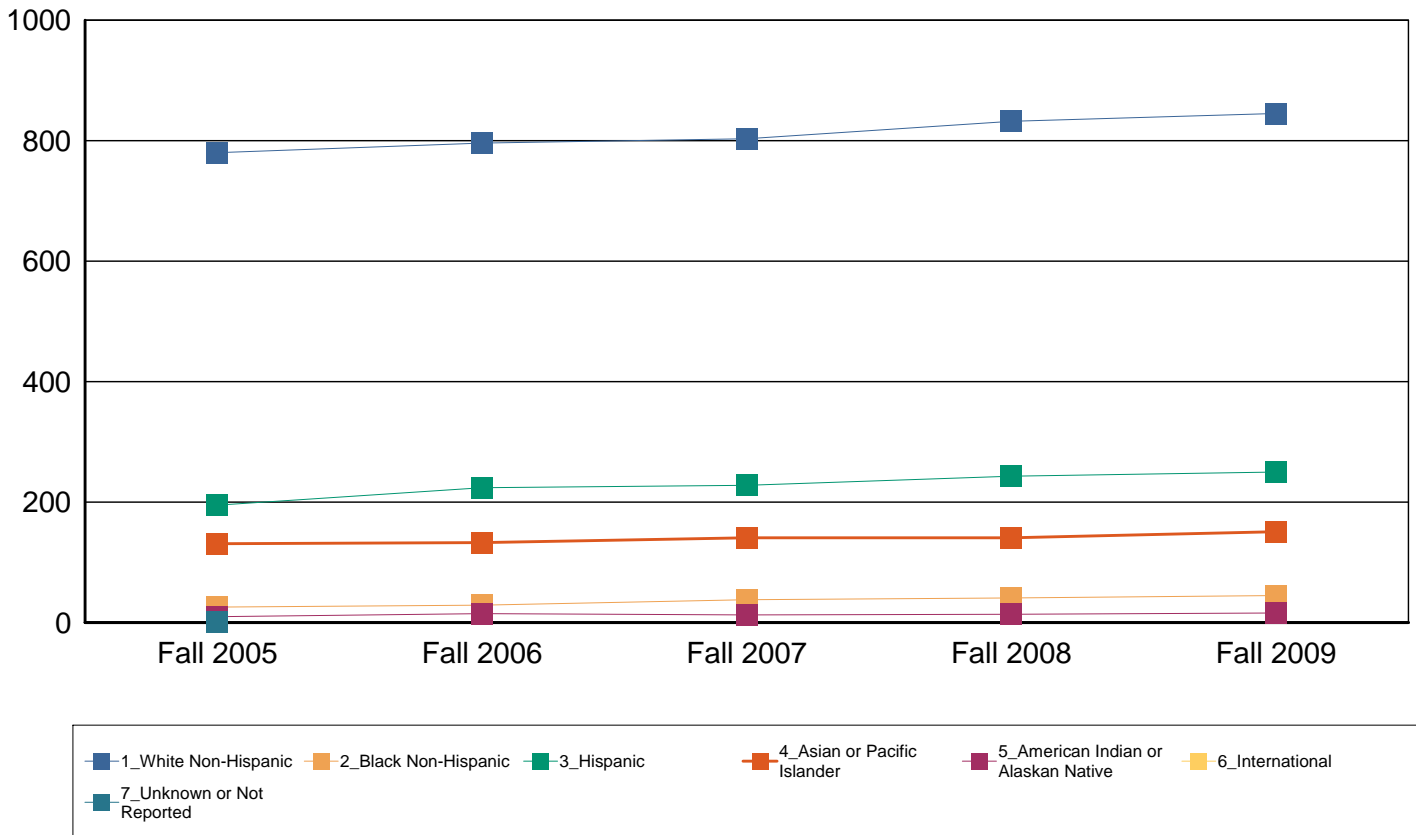

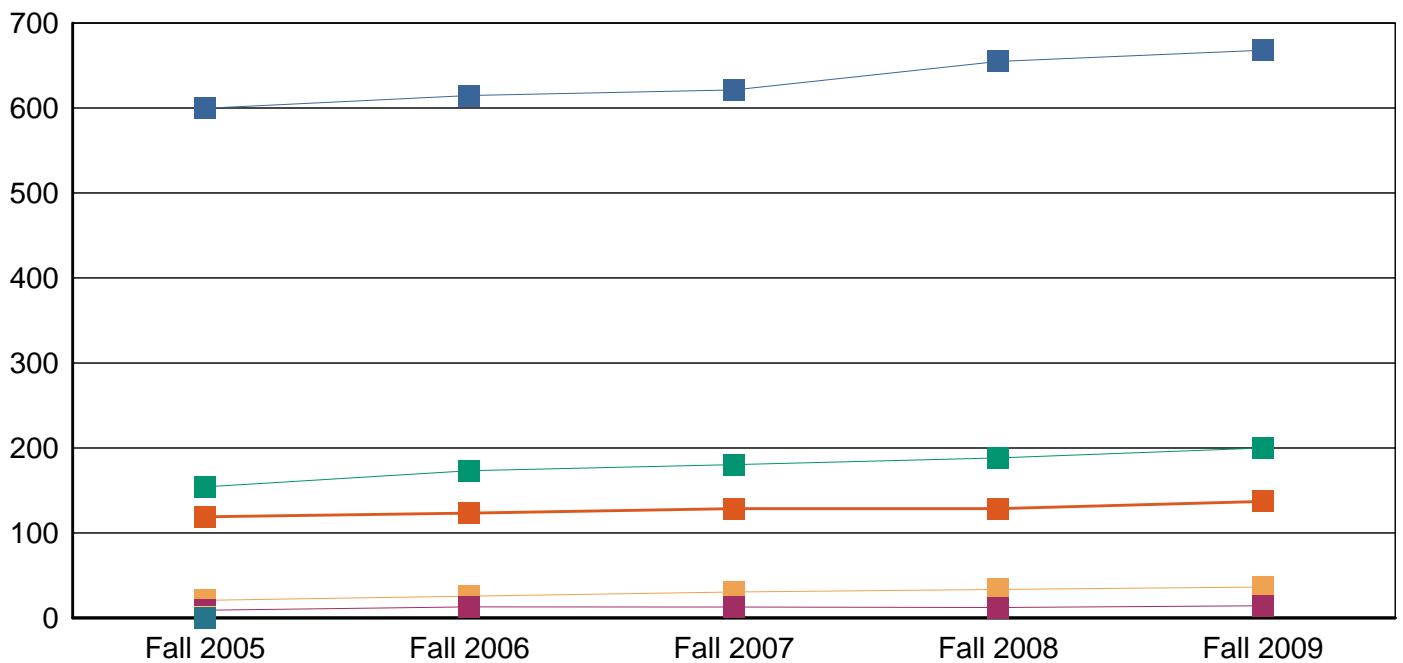

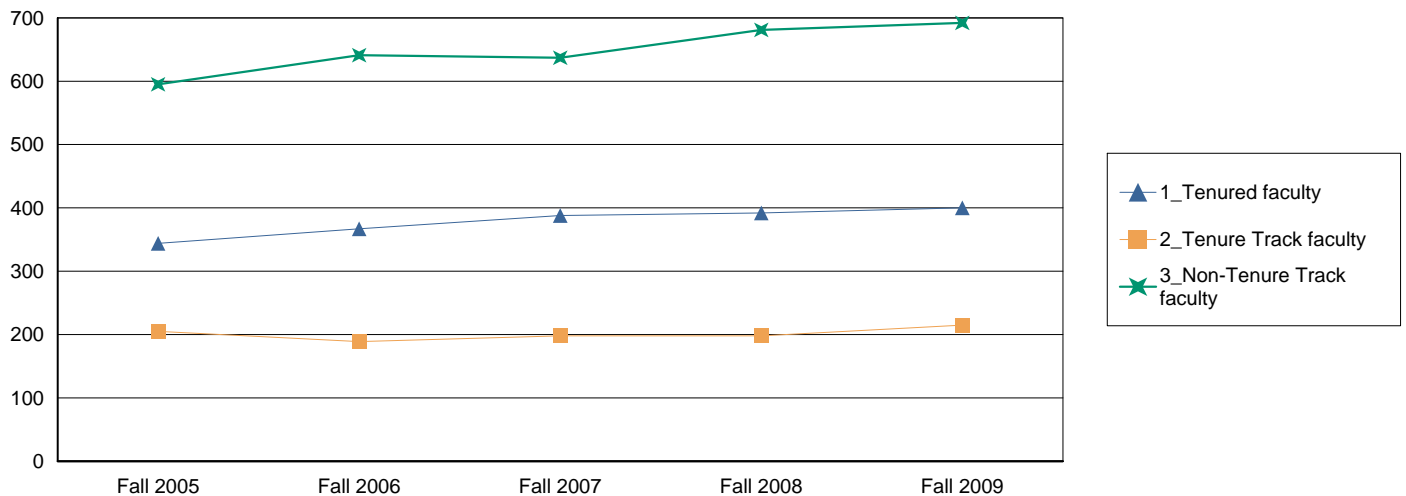

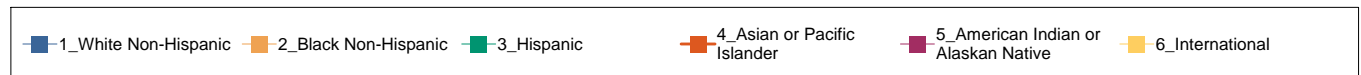

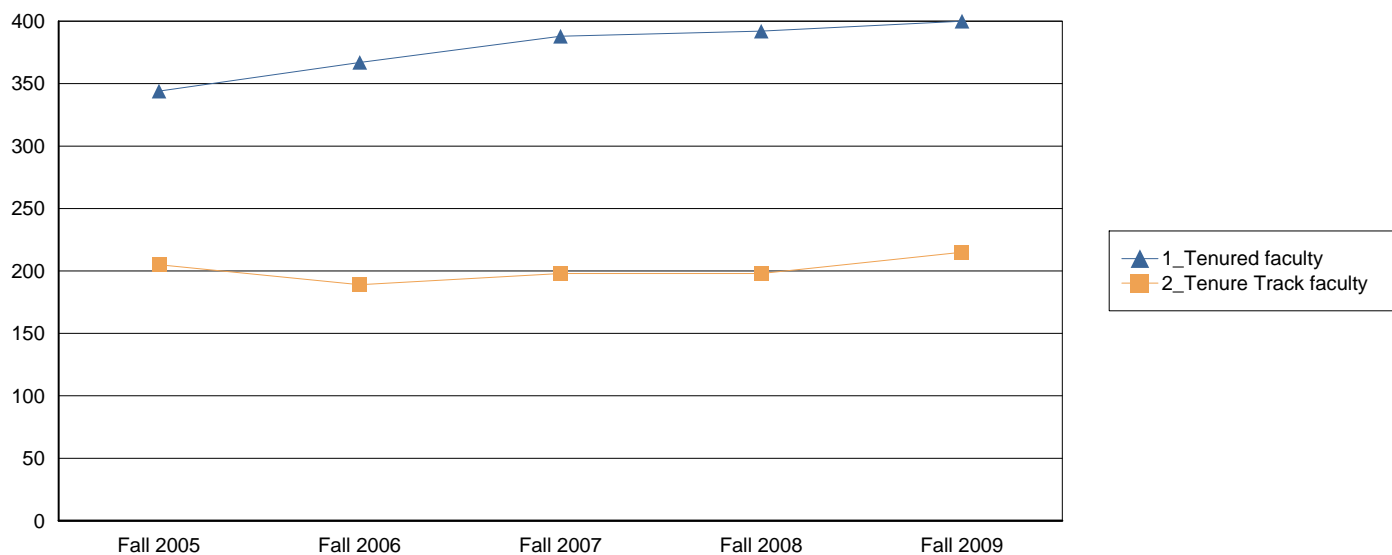

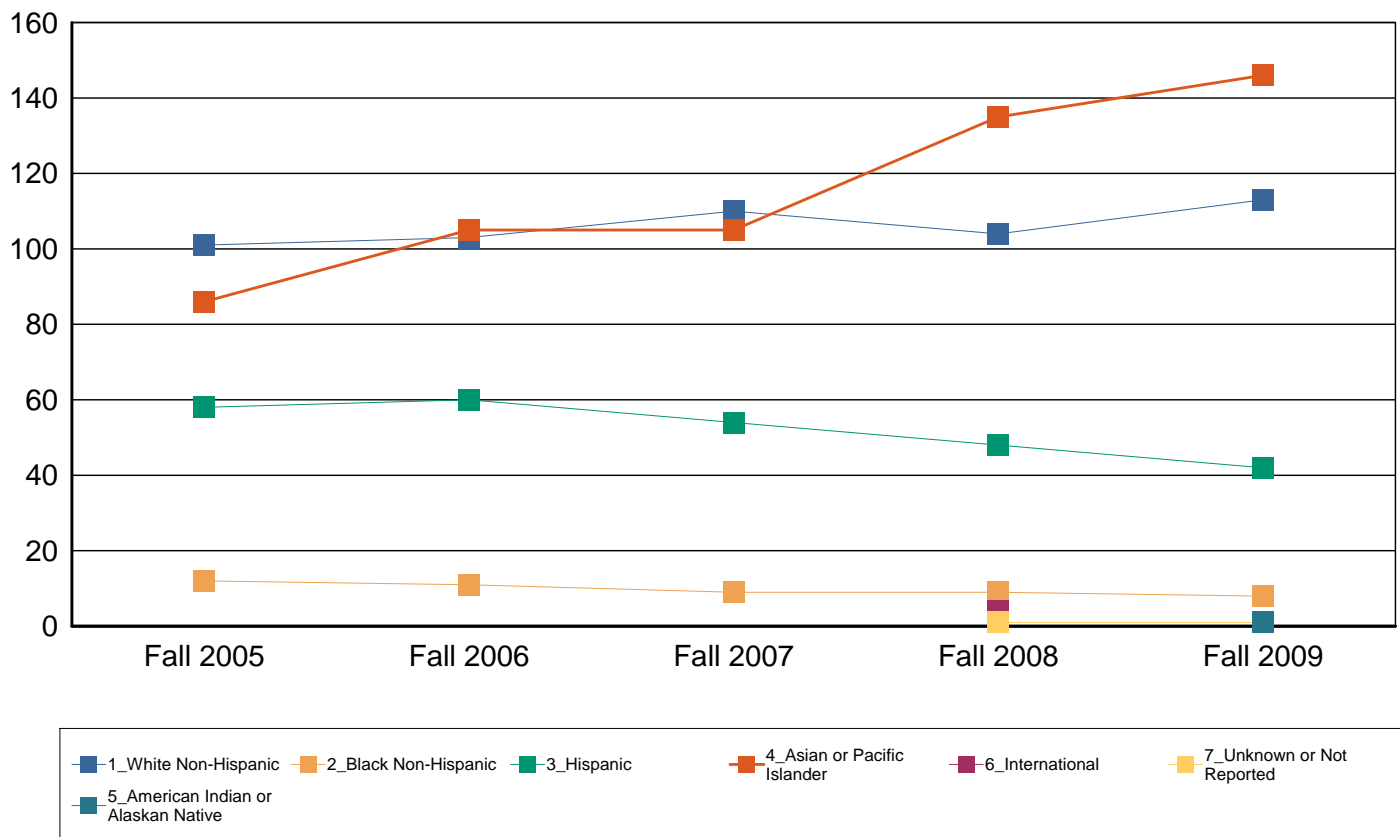

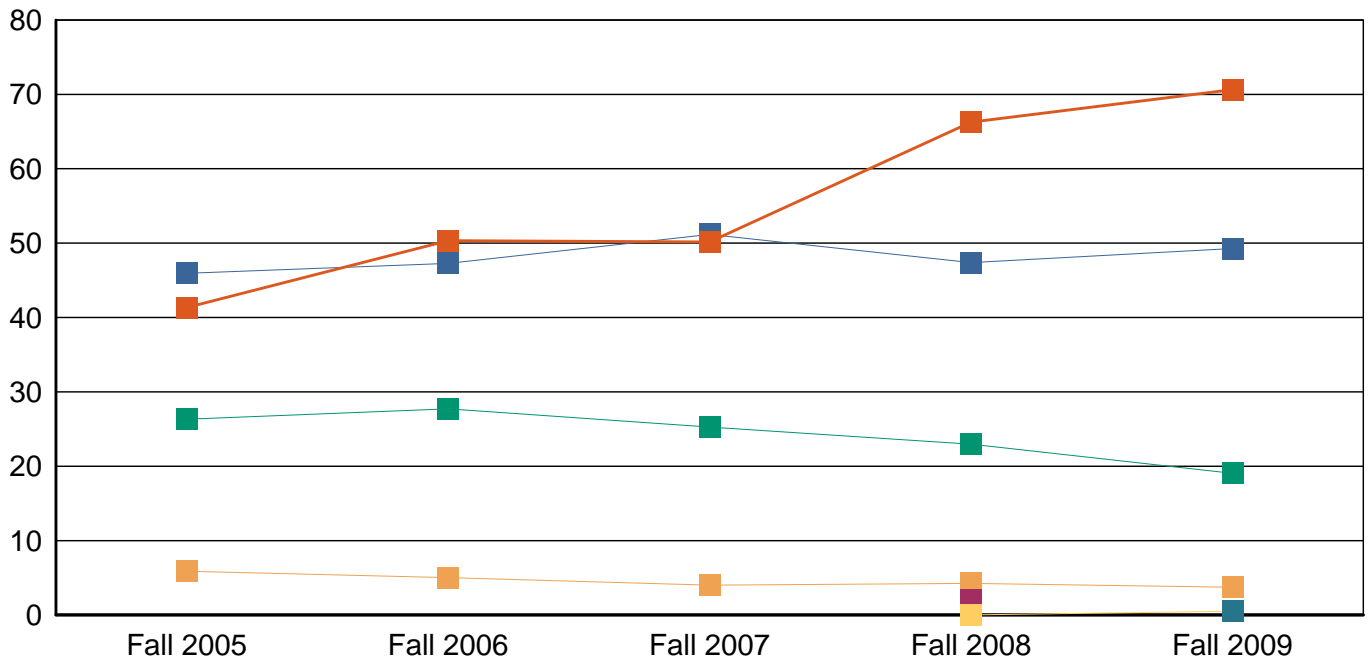

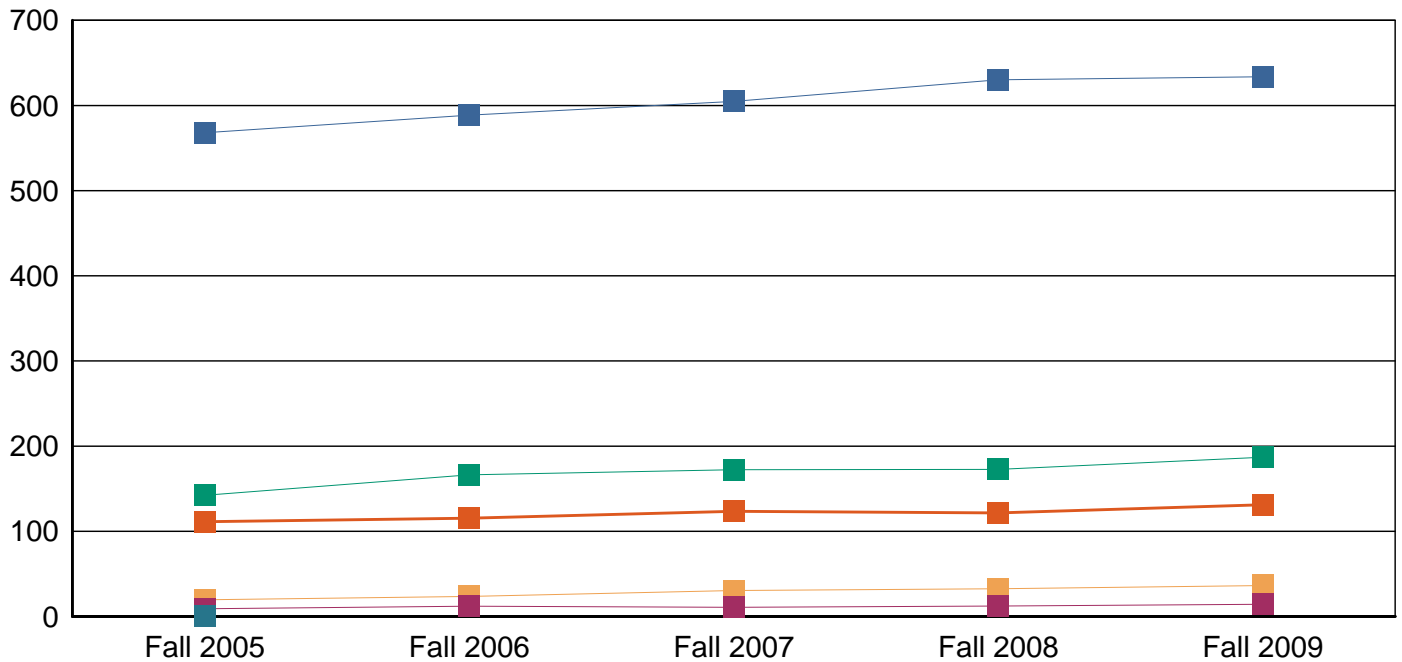

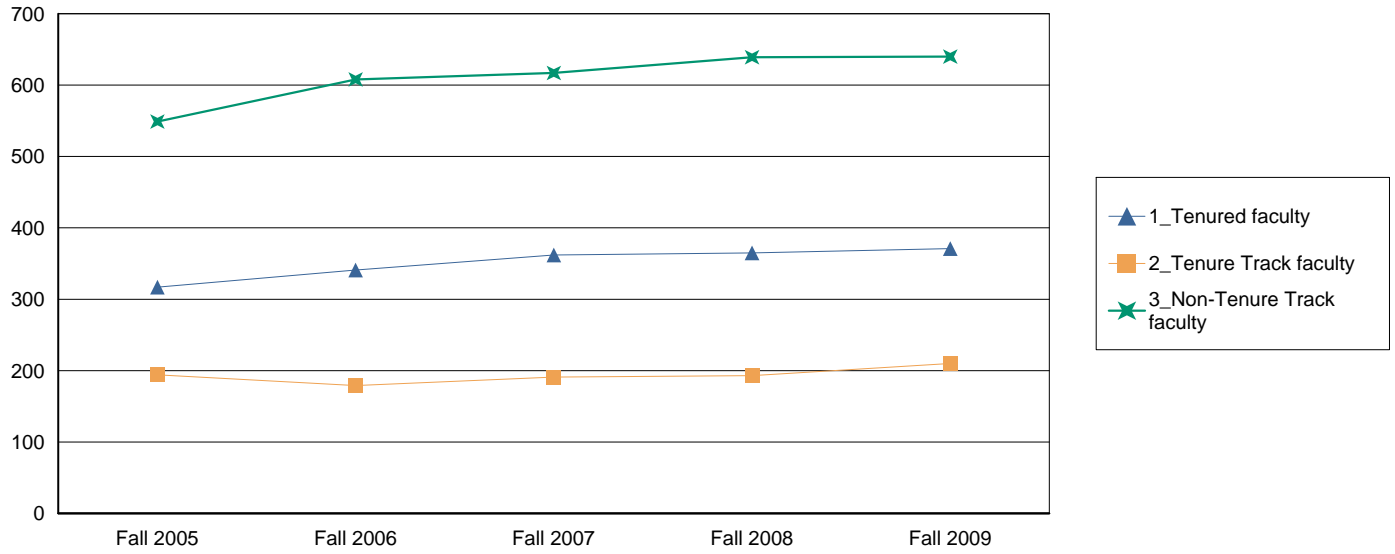
