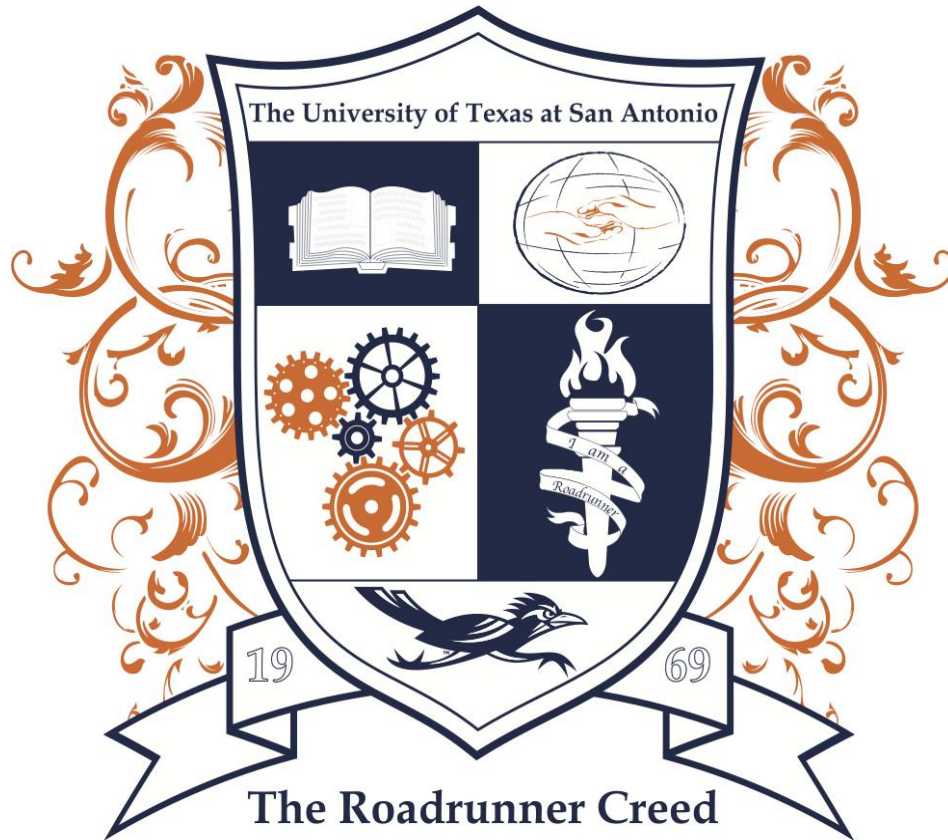

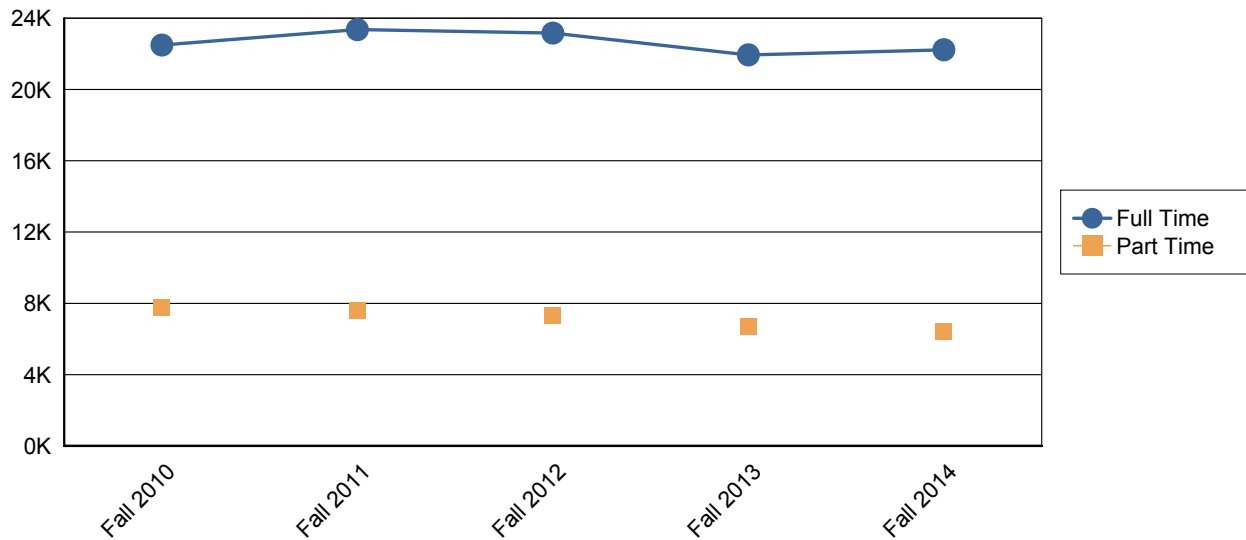

Race/Ethnicity Reporting Changes

As of Summer 2010 a new Race/Ethnicity reporting schema has been adopted based on Federal requirements. Students now have the choice to identify multiple races on the forms collected by the University of Texas at San Antonio. This information is stored as the student has selected, however for reporting purposes a single category has been used. If a student was an International student they would be assigned the International category. If a student is Hispanic, regardless of race indicated, they were assigned to the Hispanic category. Students who chose multiple races were assigned to the Two or more races category. Finally students who chose only one race were assigned to the race category they had chosen. If a student was not International, not Hispanic and did not chose any Race category they were assigned to the Unknown category. In addition to this update the former Asian/Pacific Islander category has now been separated into two categories, one is Asian and the other is Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander.

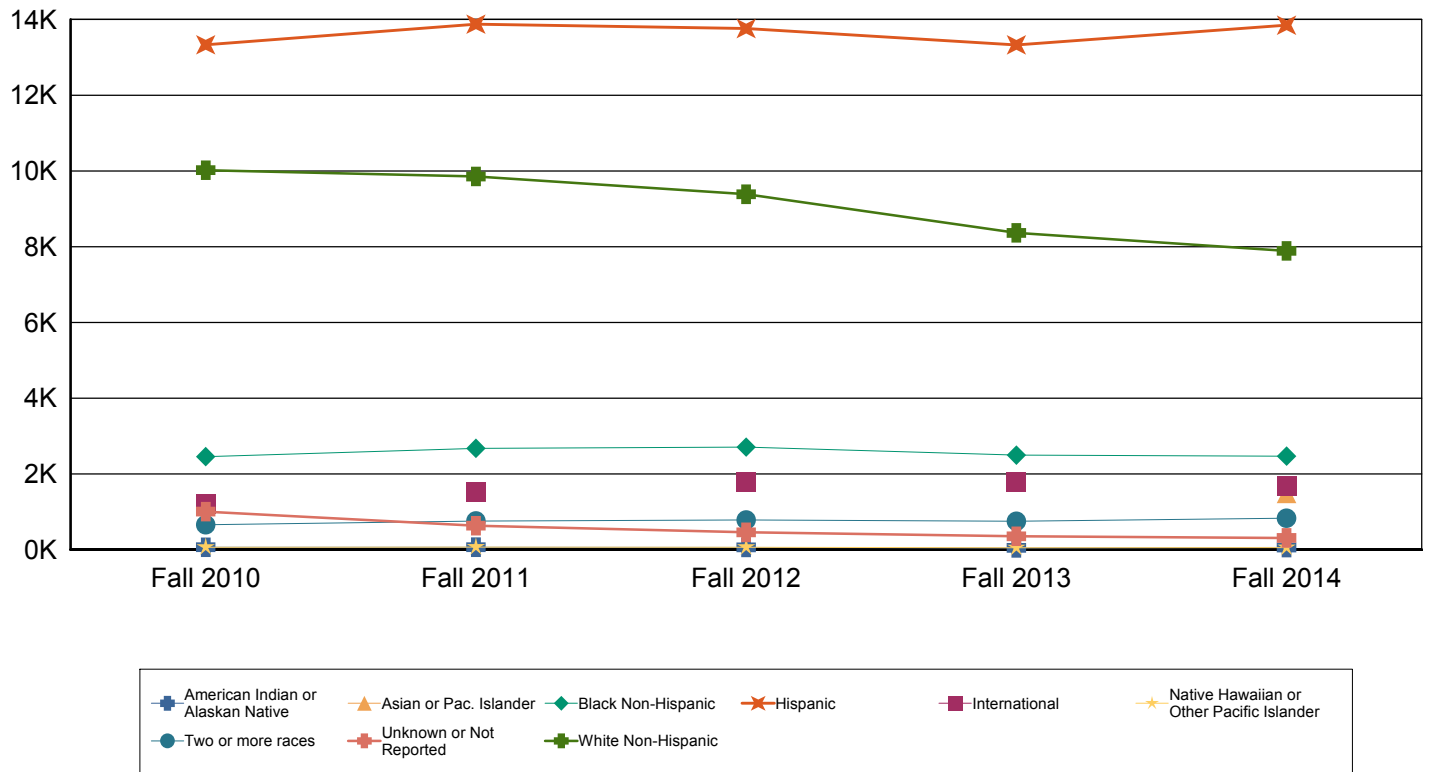

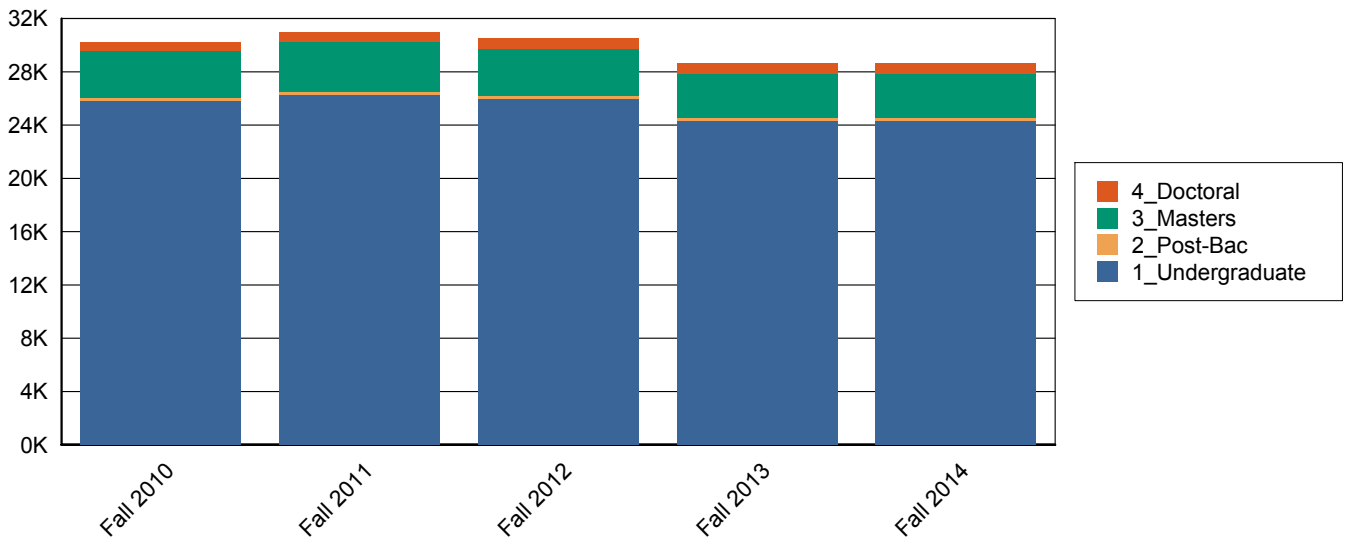

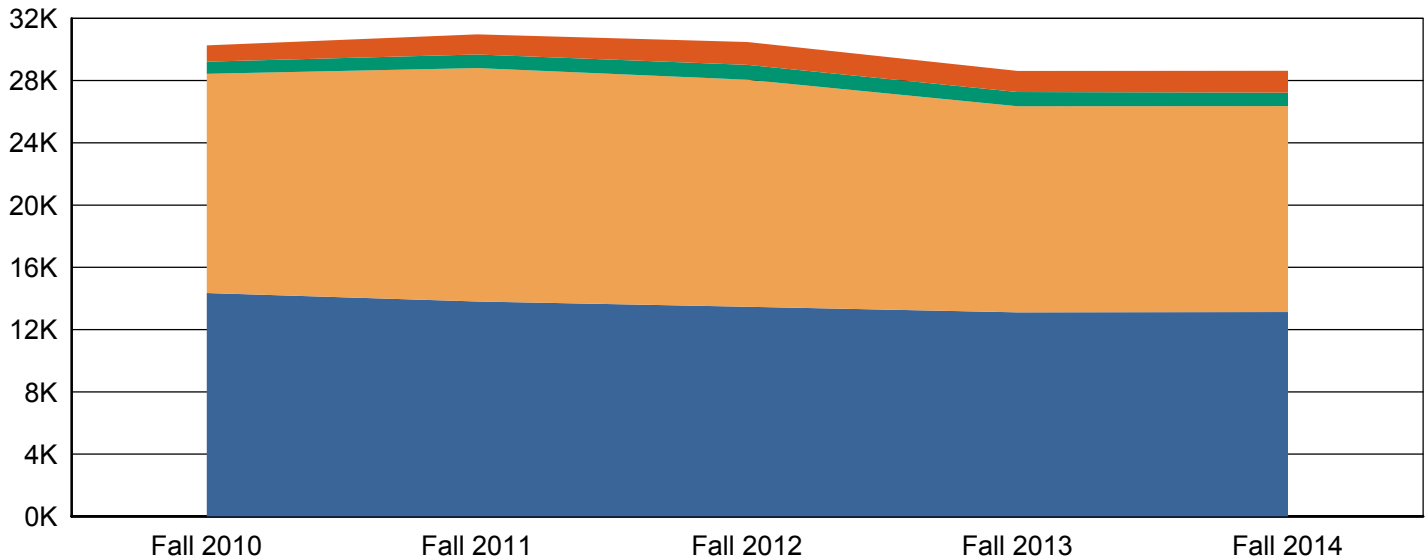

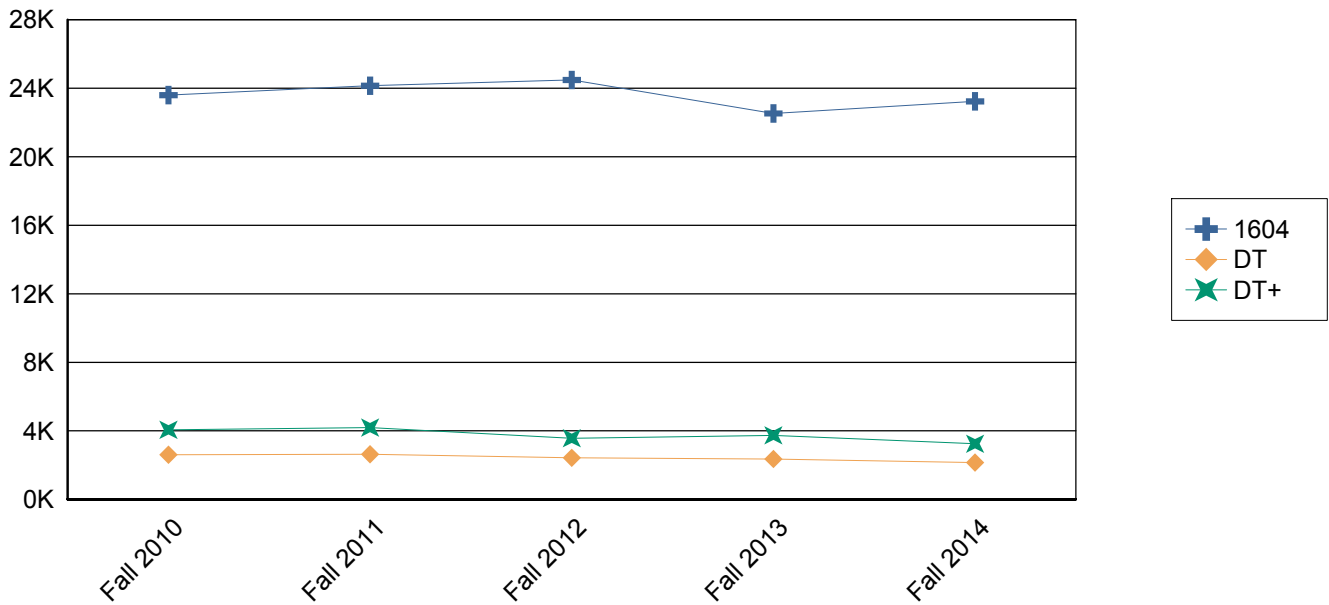

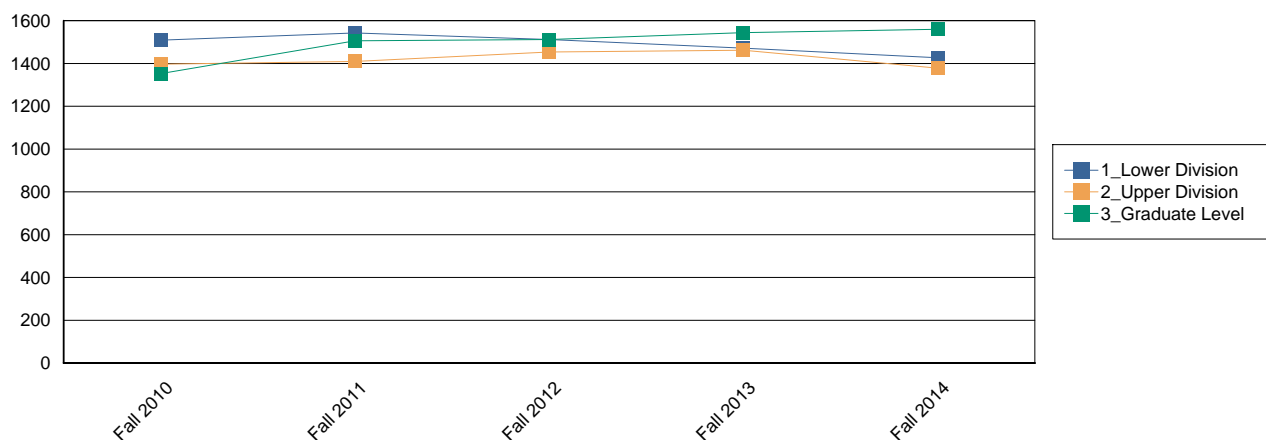

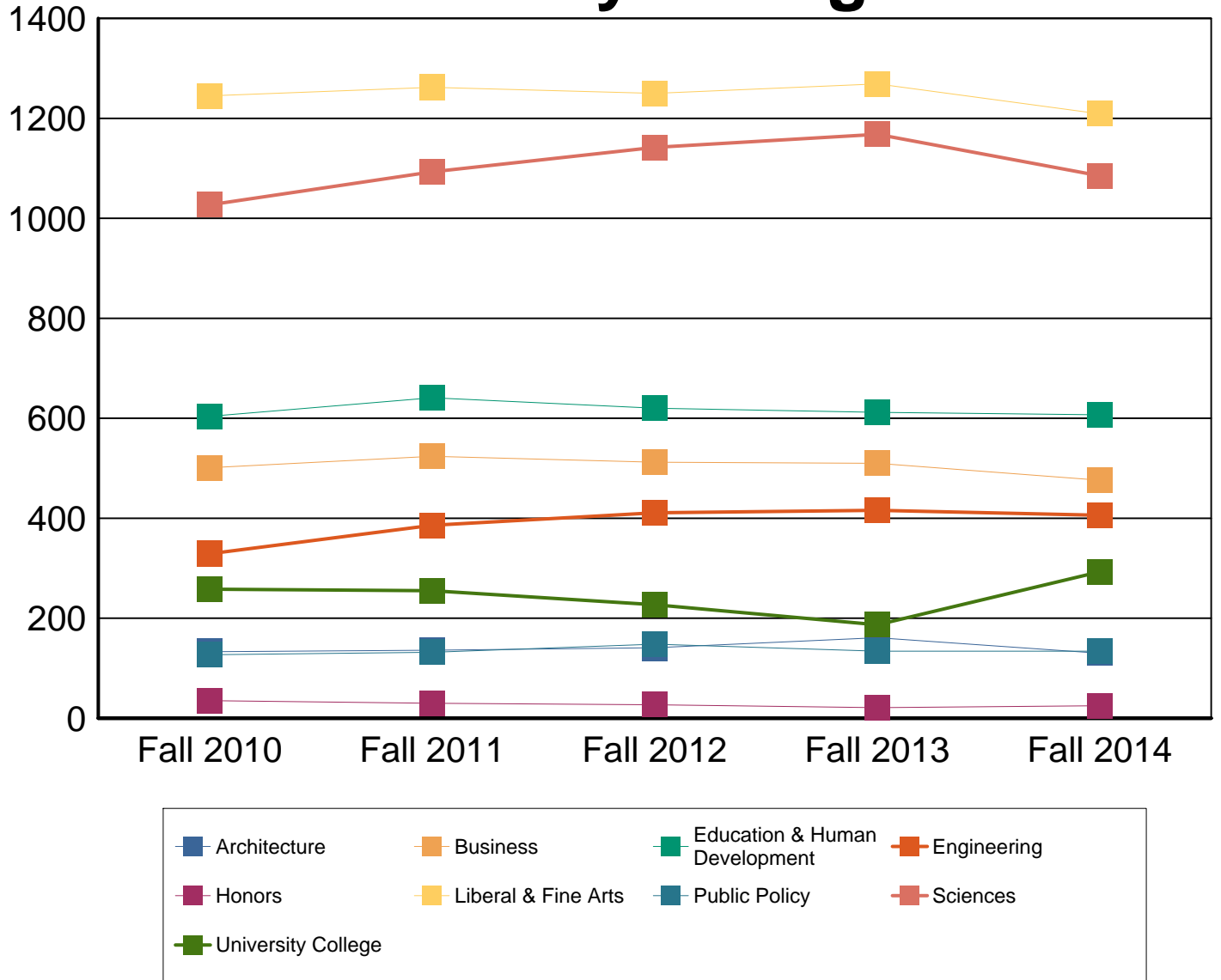

New Student Applications

The Applied, Accepted, and Enrolled information comes from the Coordinating Board Admissions file (CBM00B), this file contains only the Summer and Fall applications for each year. Only students who have never applied at the level are included in this information. Enrollment is based on the fall semester, in prior years it had been based on the student applied for. Note that although many new students enter UTSA each year only students who are first time students seeking a degree at UTSA are included in the Cohort for graduation and retention information. For more information on this topic please contact the Office of Institutional Research at (210) 458-4706.

Race/Ethnicity Reporting Changes

As of Summer 2010 a new Race/Ethnicity reporting schema has been adopted based on Federal requirements. Students now have the choice to identify multiple races on the forms collected by the University of Texas at San Antonio. This information is stored as the student has selected, however for reporting purposes a single category has been used. If a student was an International student they would be assigned the International category. If a student is Hispanic, regardless of race indicated, they were assigned to the Hispanic category. Students who chose multiple races were assigned to the Two or More Races category. Finally students who chose only one race were assigned to the race category they had chosen. If a student was not International, not Hispanic and did not chose any Race category they were assigned to the Unknown category. In addition to this update the former Asian/Pacific Islander category has now been separated into two categories, one is Asian and the other is Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander.

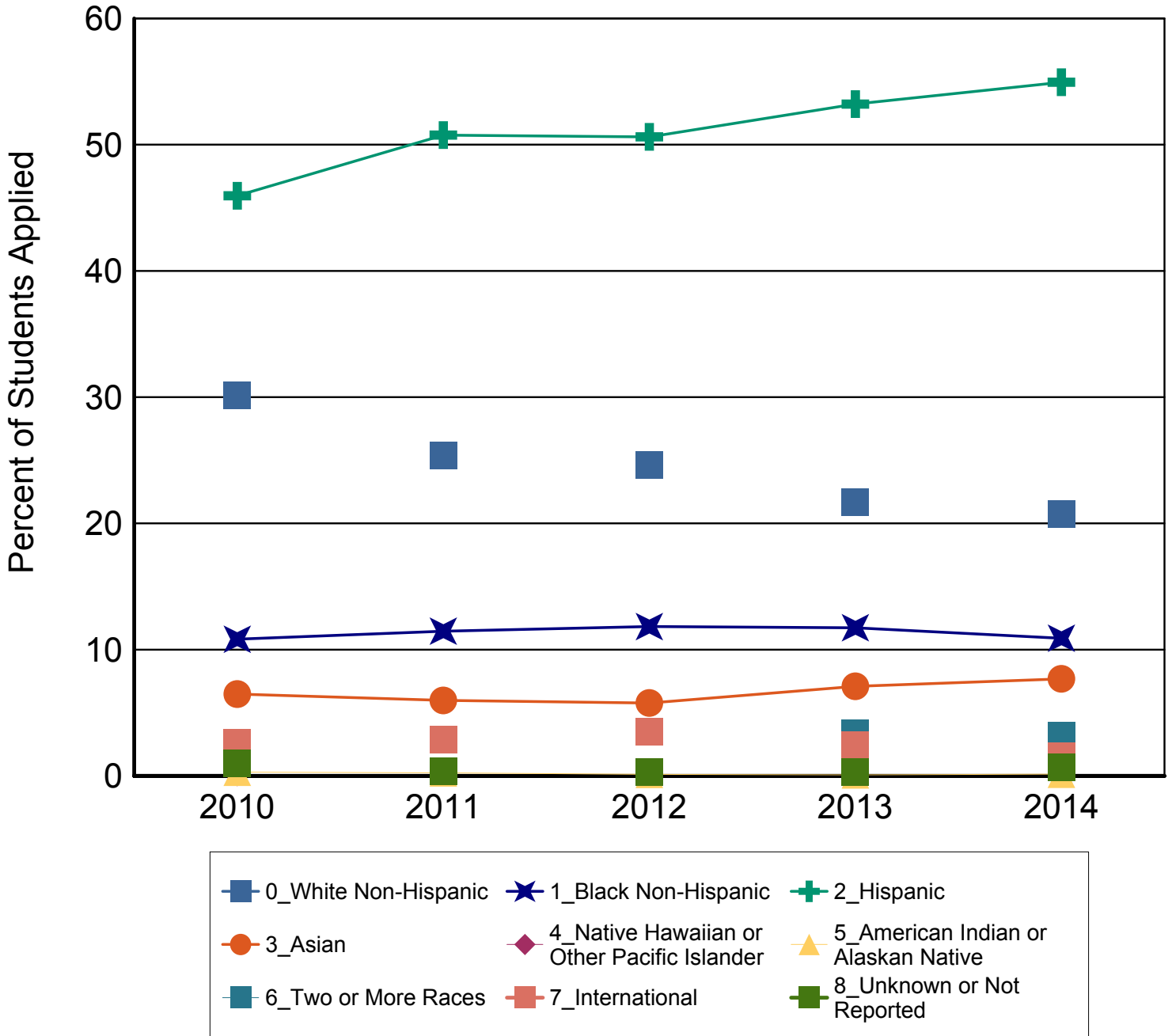

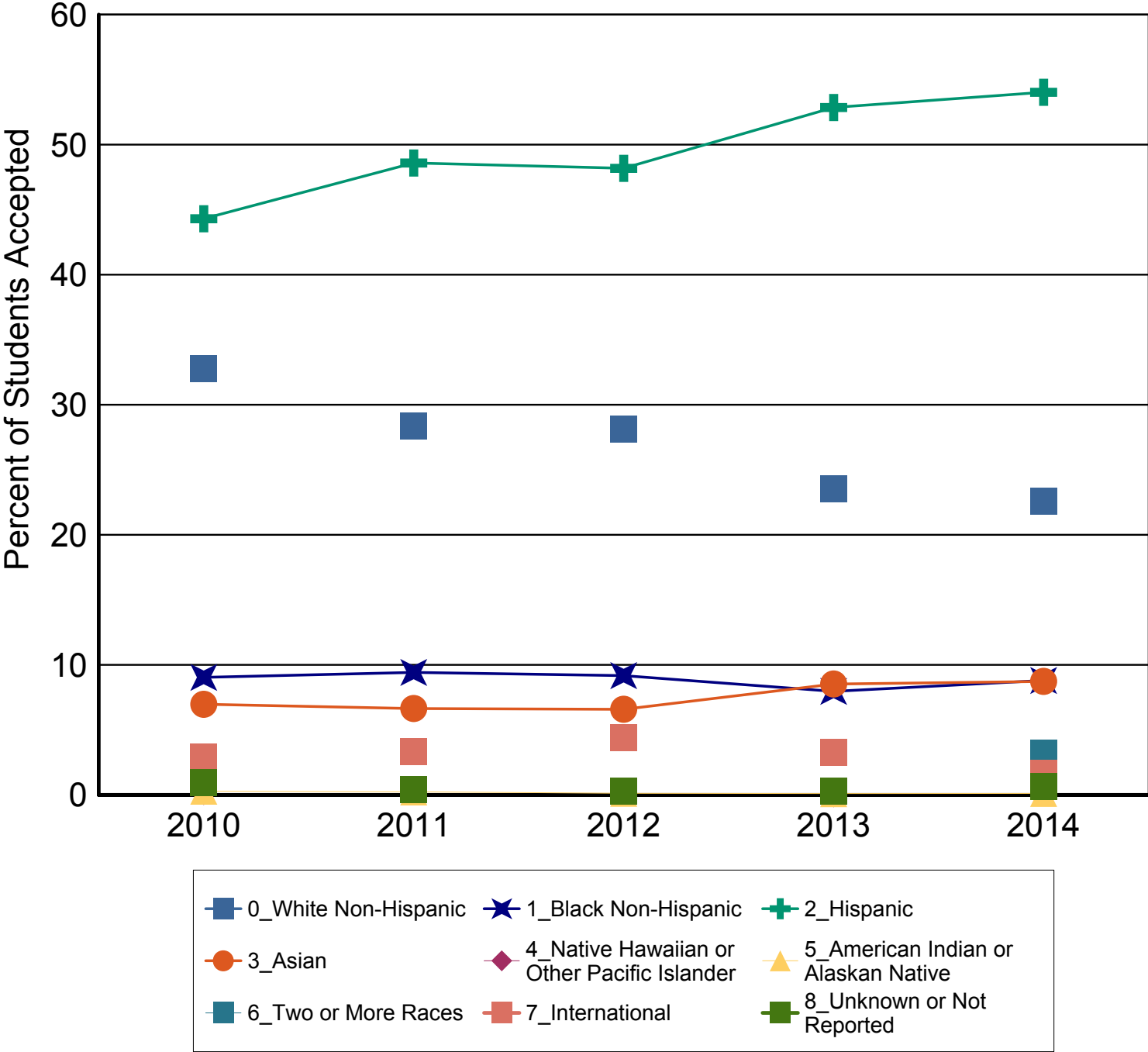

Percent of First Time Undergraduates Applied by Ethnicity



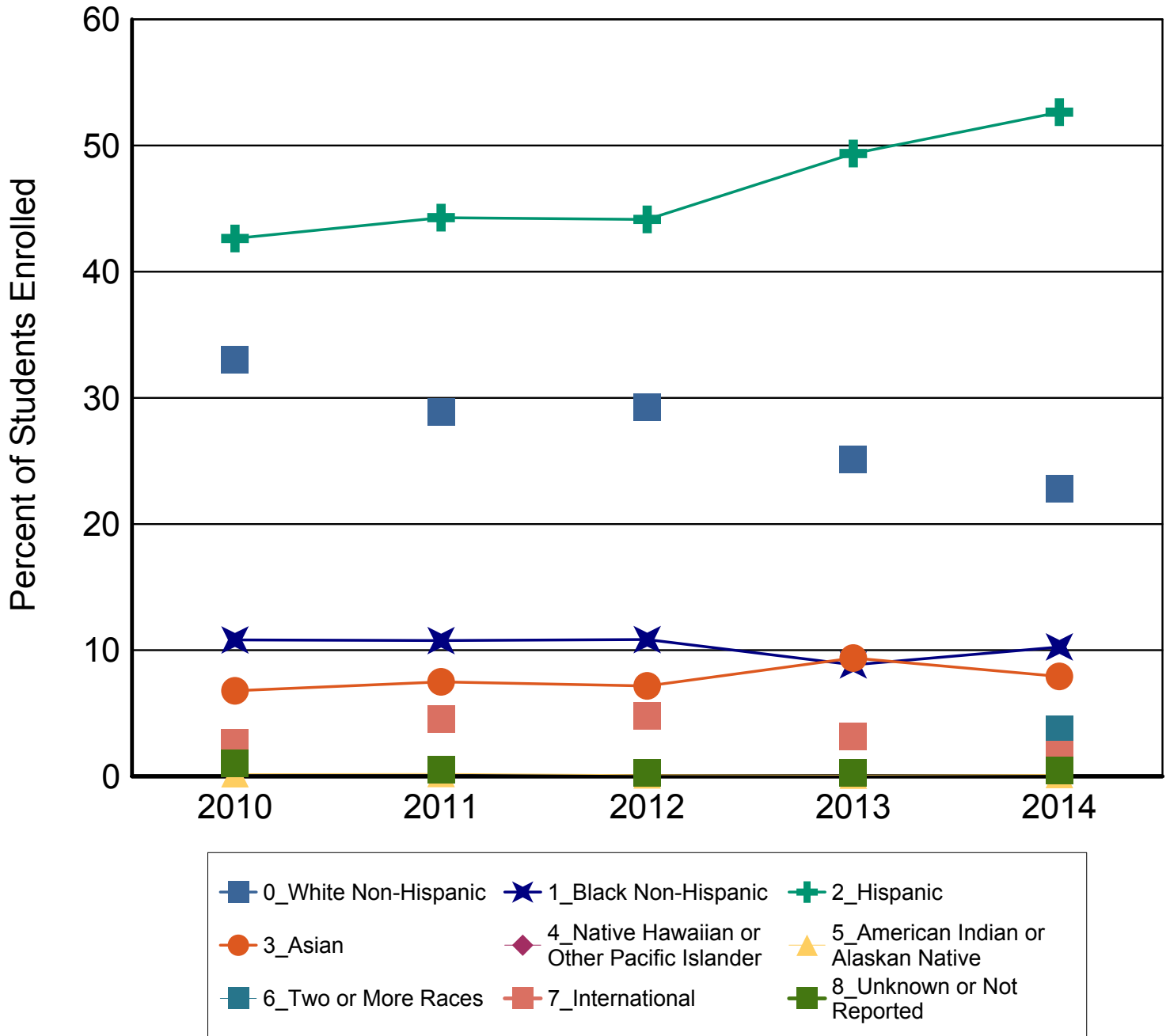

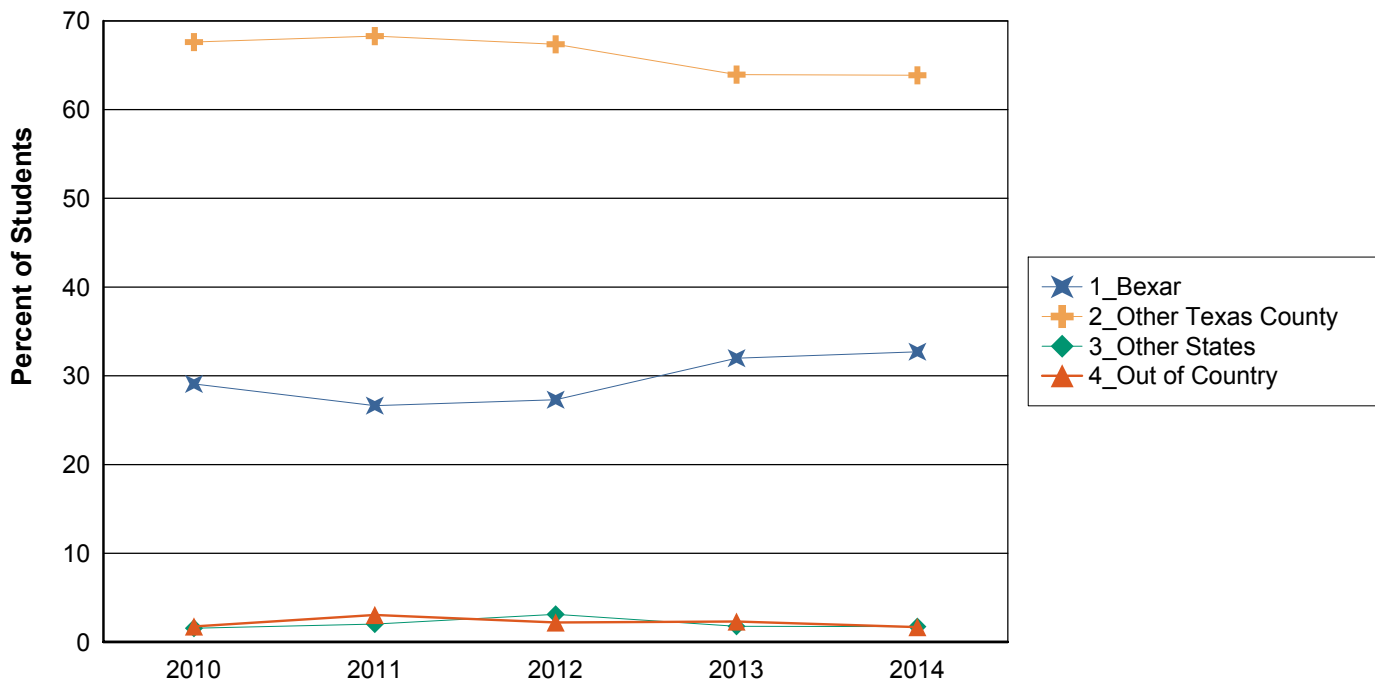

As of Summer 2010 a new Race/Ethnicity reporting schema has been adopted based on Federal requirements. Students now have the choice to identify multiple races on the forms collected by the University of Texas at San Antonio. This information is stored as the student has selected, however for reporting purposes a single category has been used. If a student was an International student they would be assigned the International category. If a student is Hispanic, regardless of race indicated, they were assigned to the Hispanic category. Students who chose multiple races were assigned to the Two or More Races category. Finally students who chose only one race were assigned to the race category they had chosen. If a student was not International, not Hispanic and did not chose any Race category they were assigned to the Unknown category. In addition to this update the former Asian/Pacific Islander category has now been separated into two categories, one is Asian and the other is Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander.

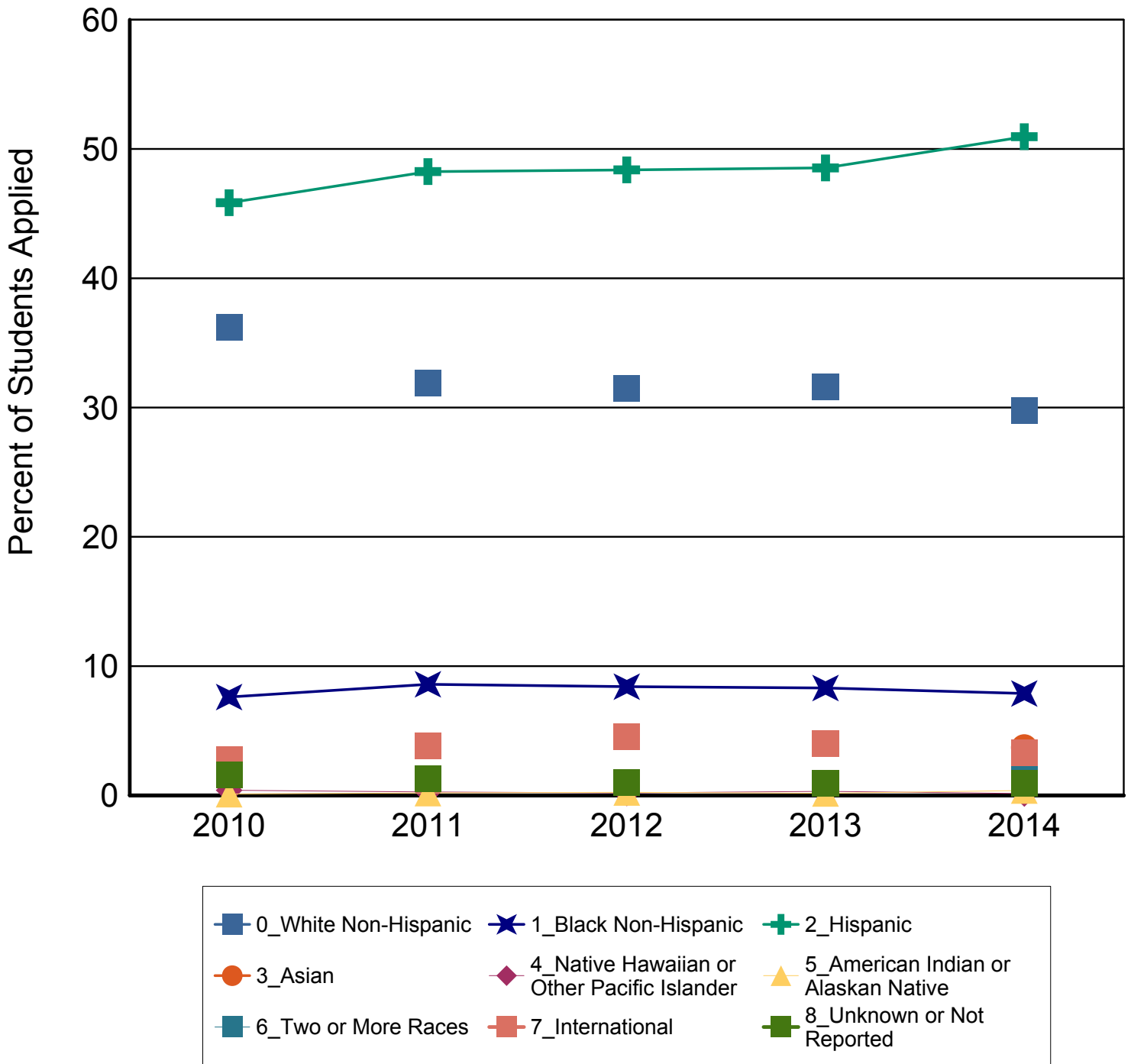

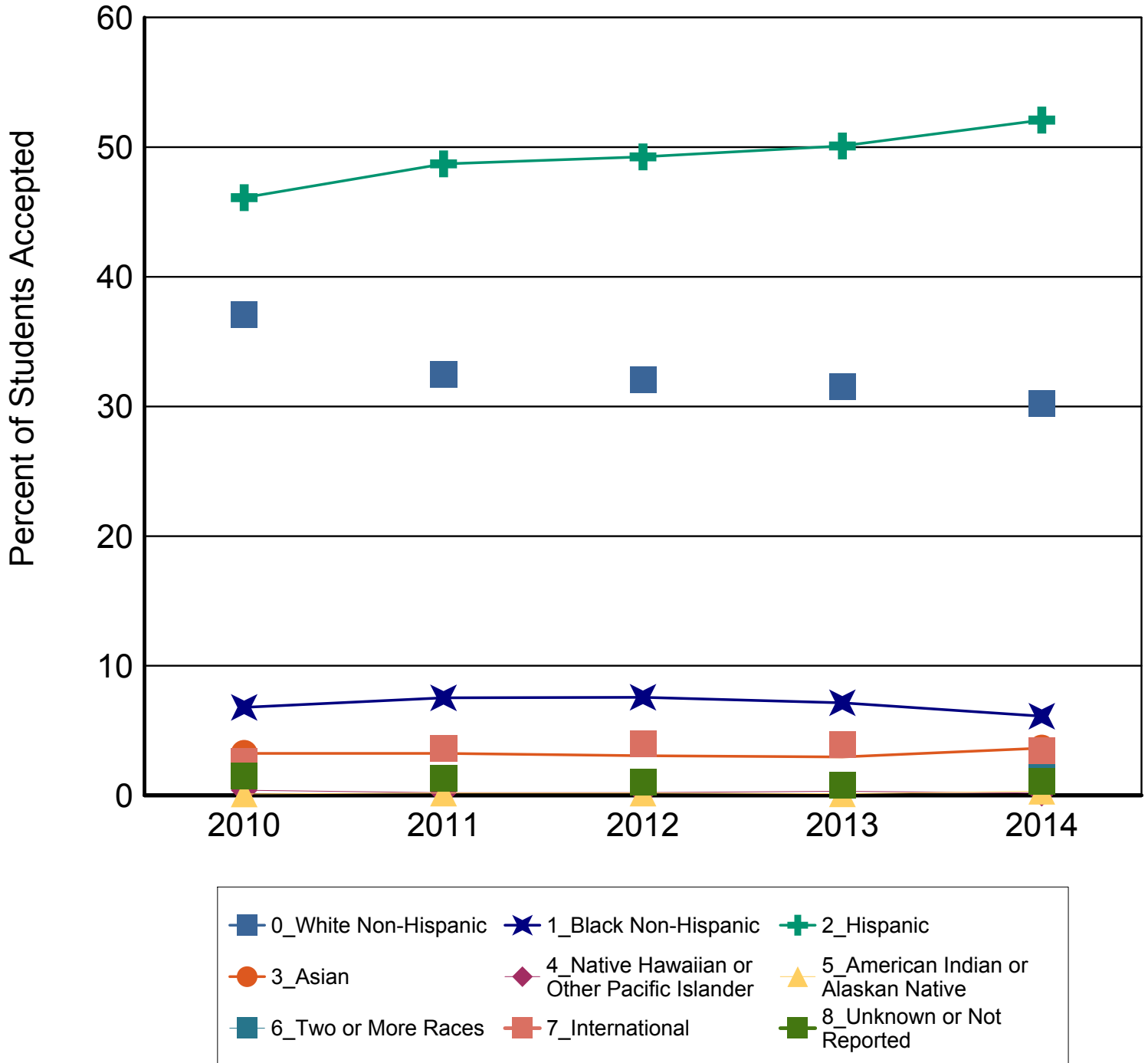

Transfer Students Applied by Ethnicity



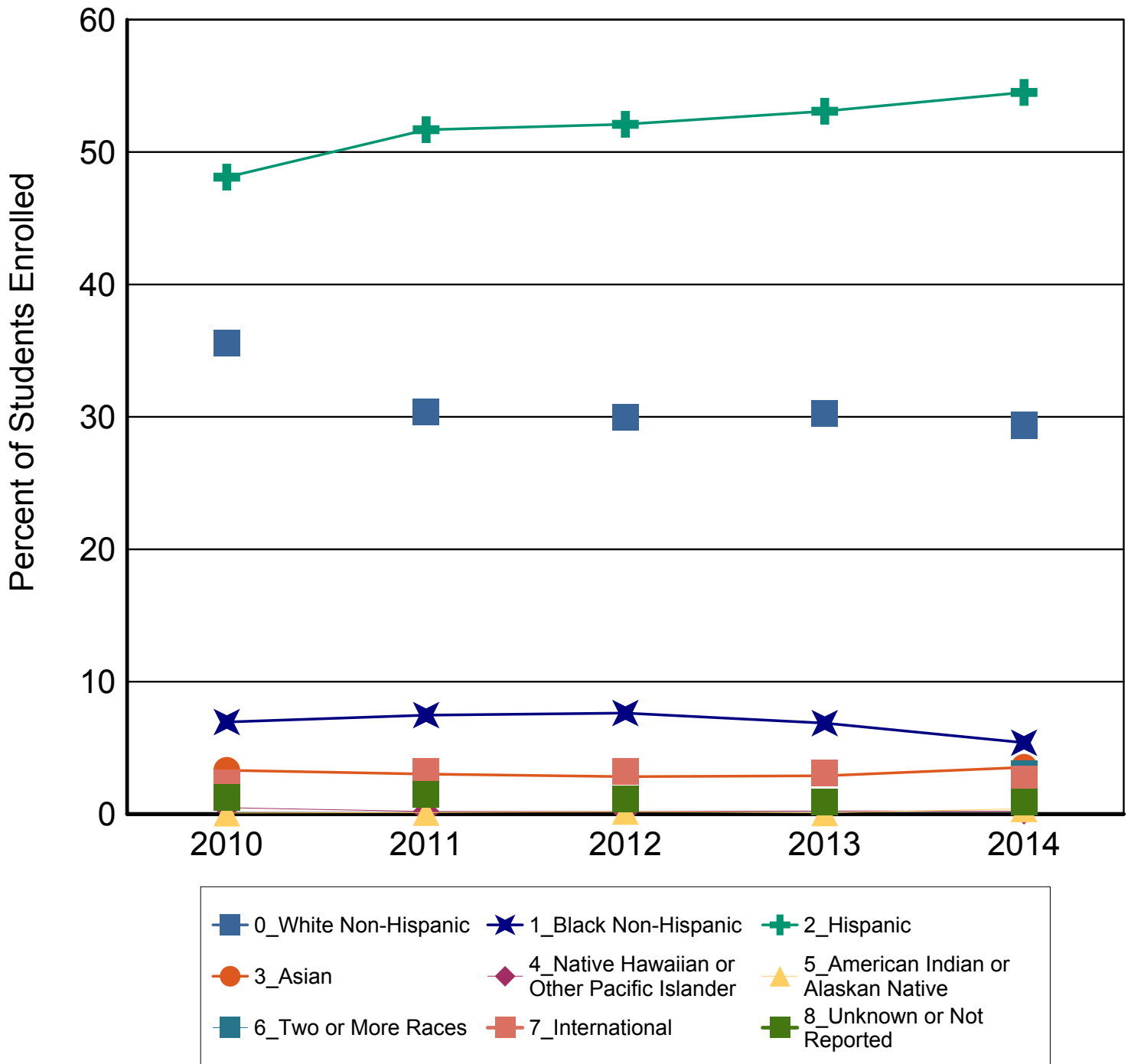

Transfer Students Enrolled by Ethnicity



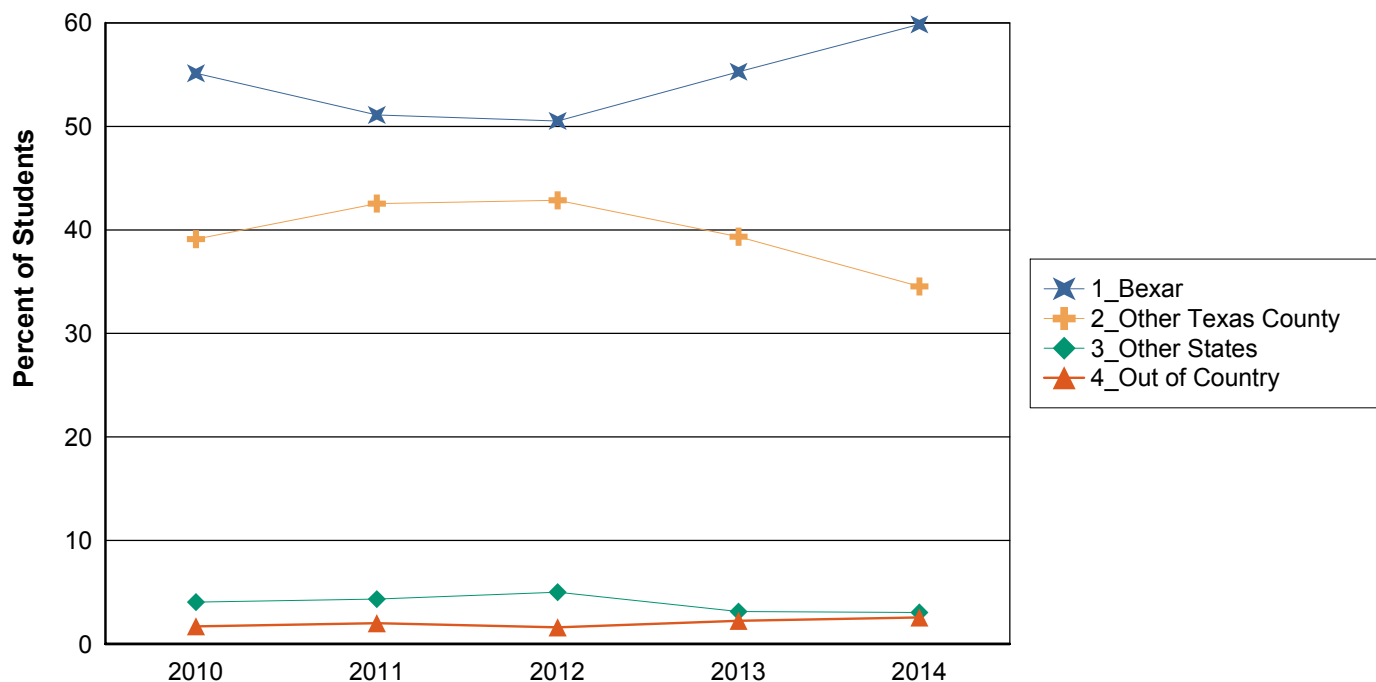

First Time Undergraduate Enrollment by Residence



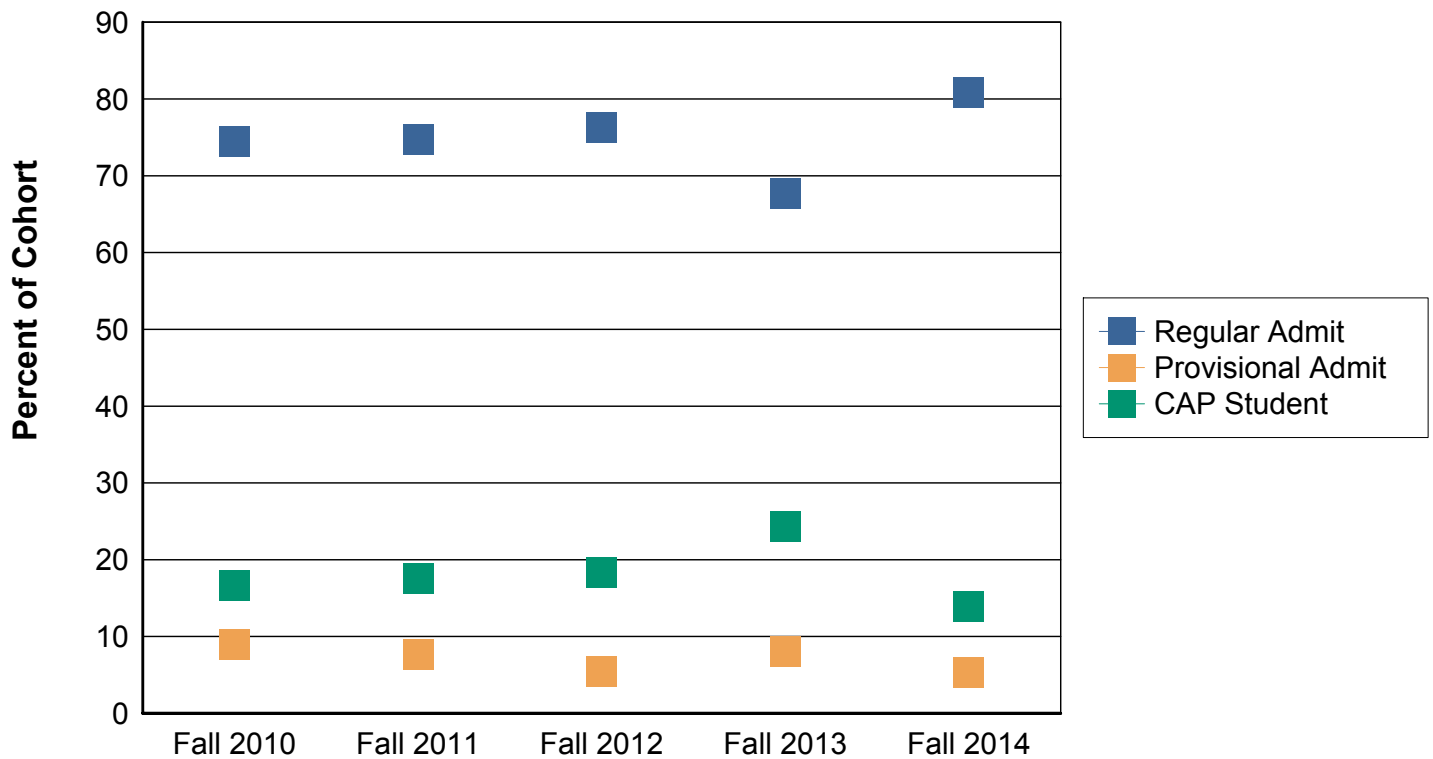

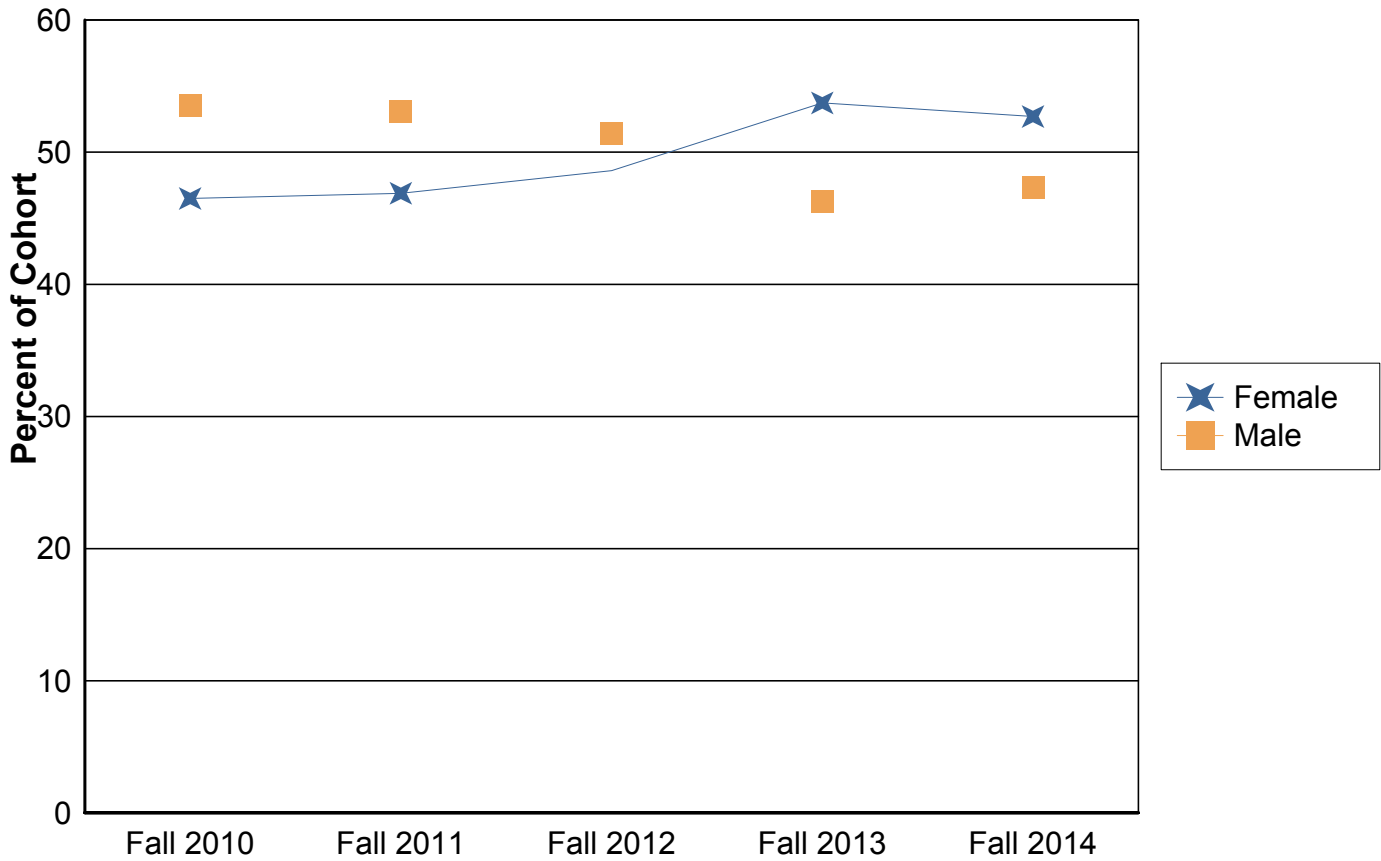
UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Admission Type

UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Gender

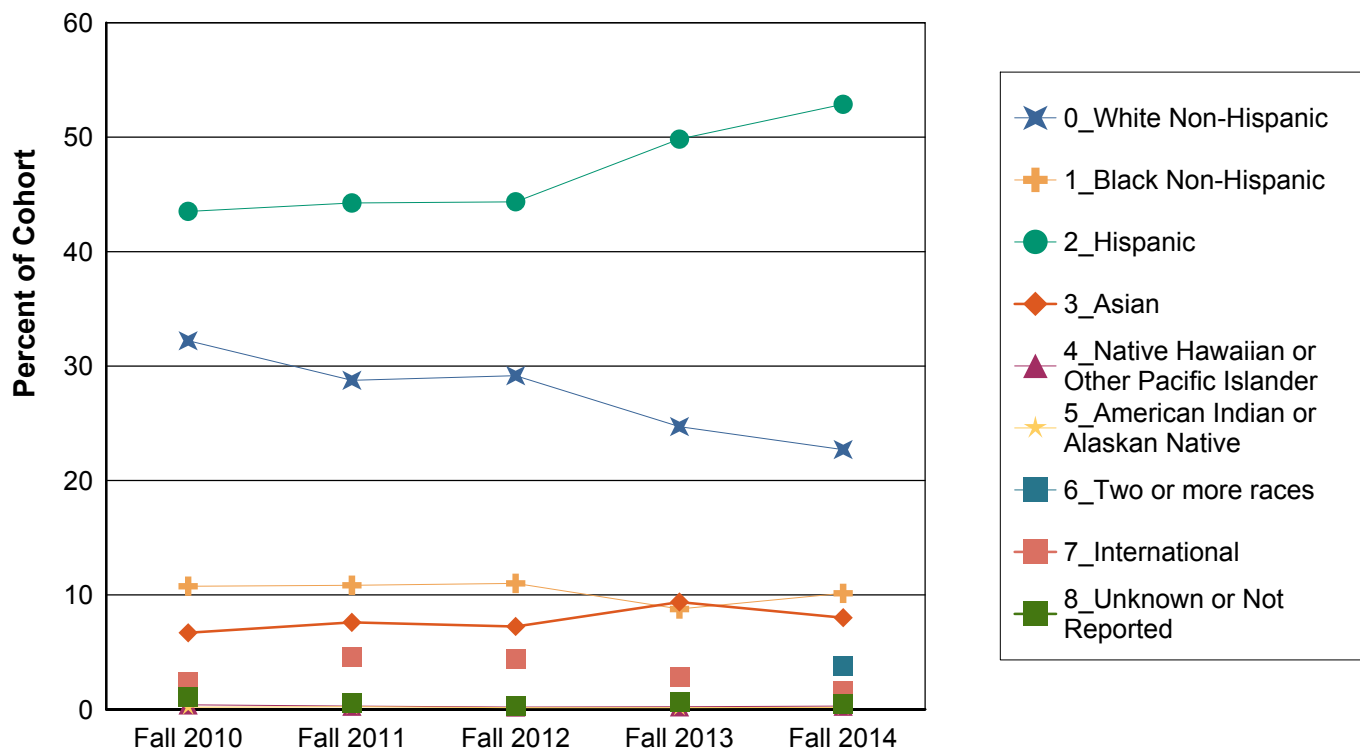

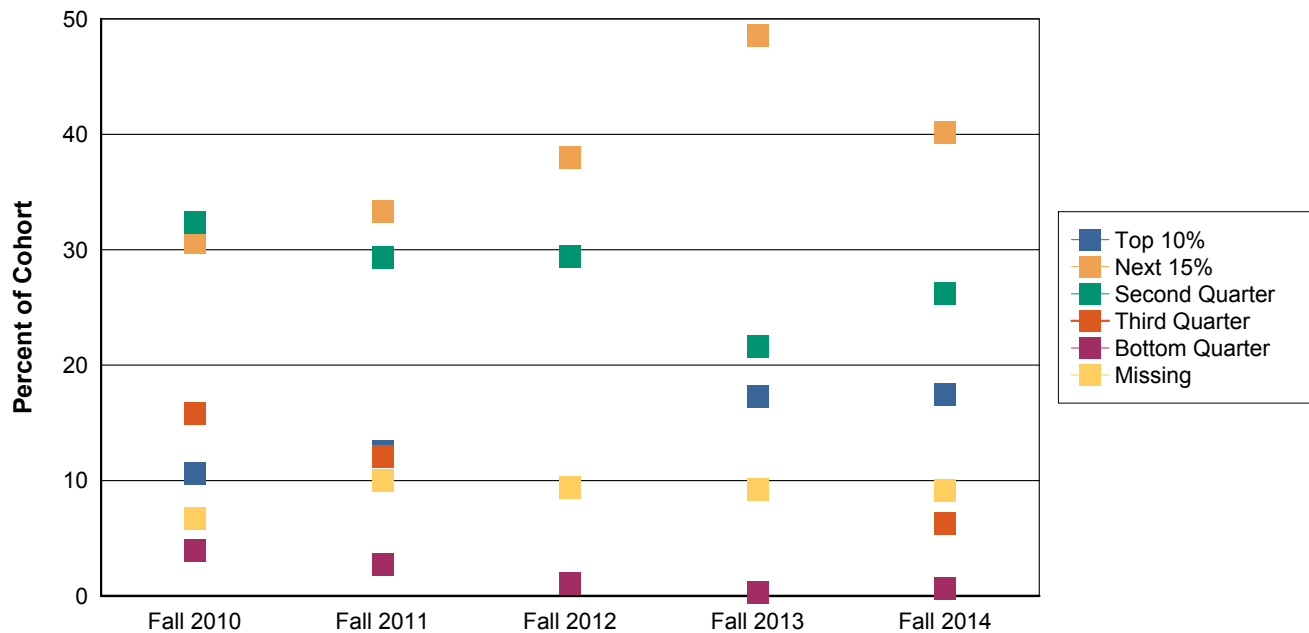

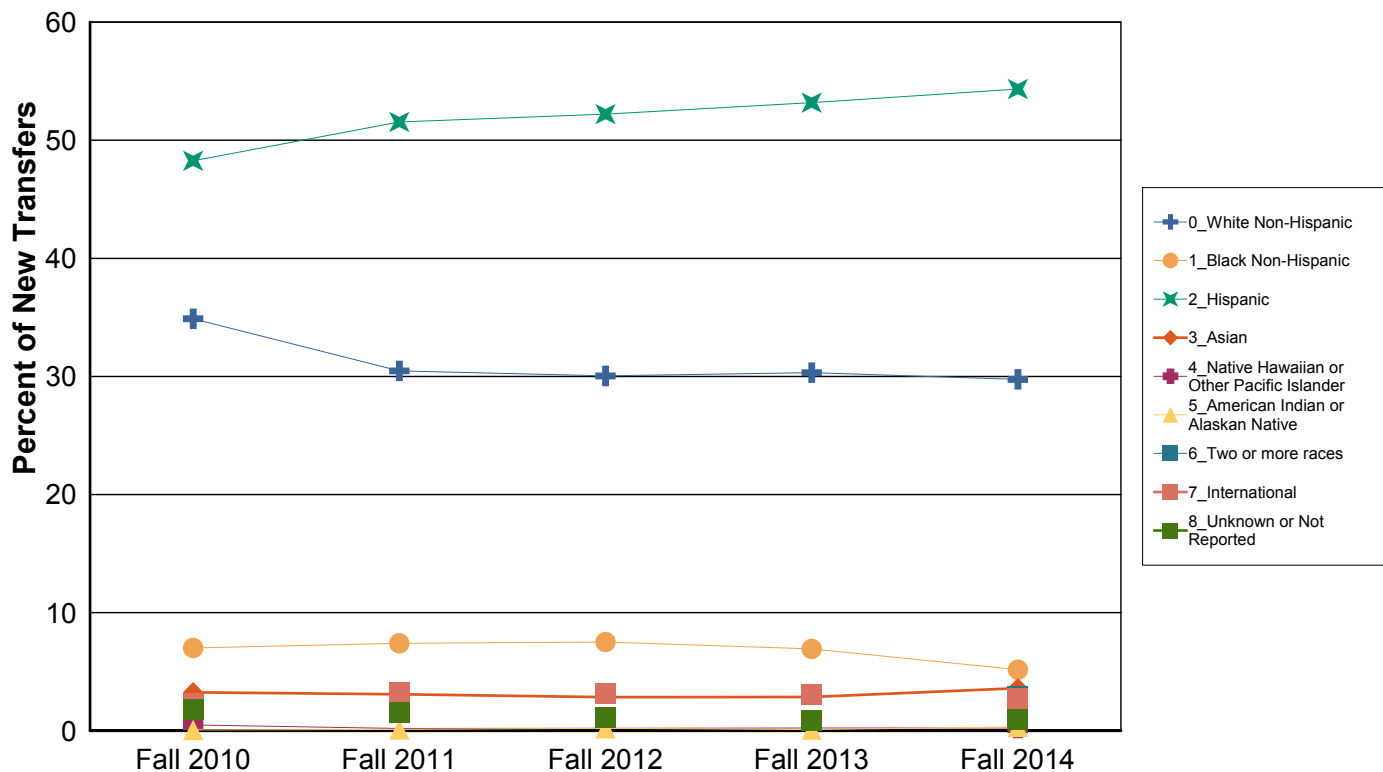

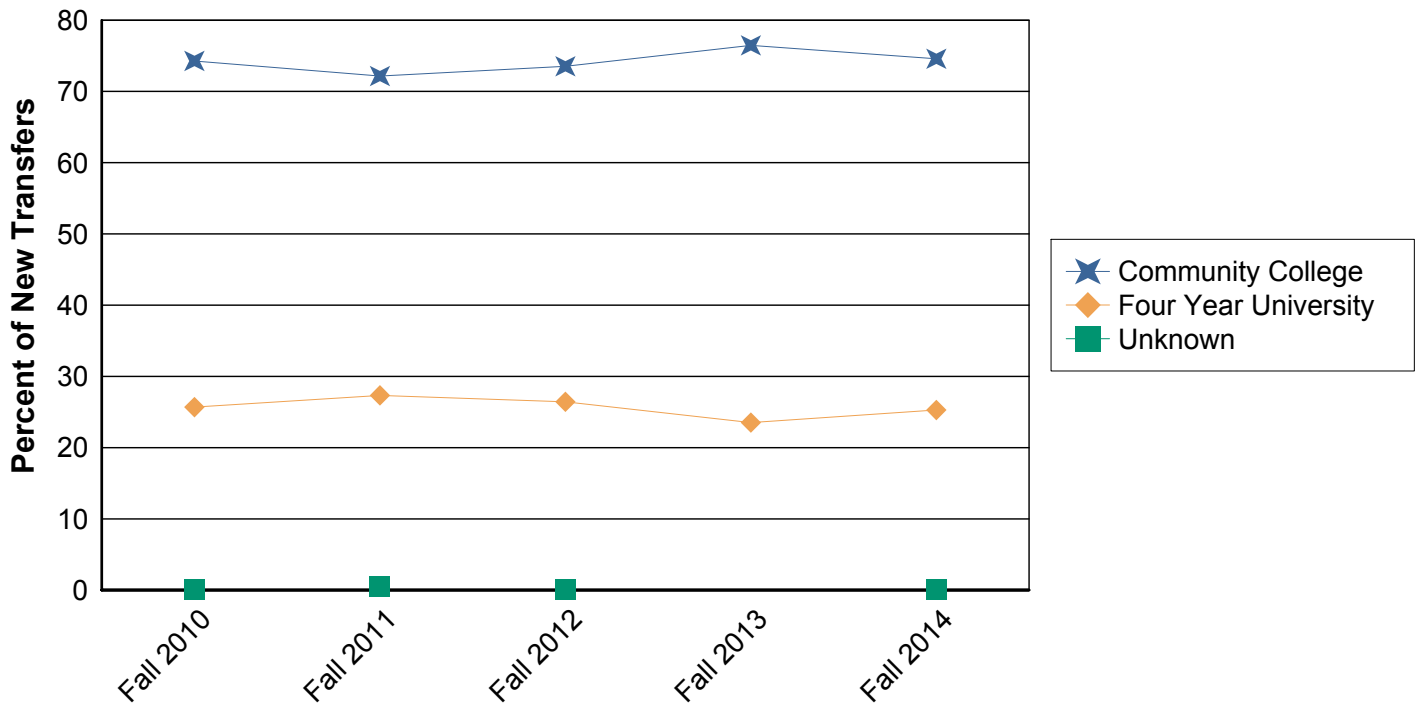
UTSA Transfer Students by Ethnicity

New Transfer Students By College Type



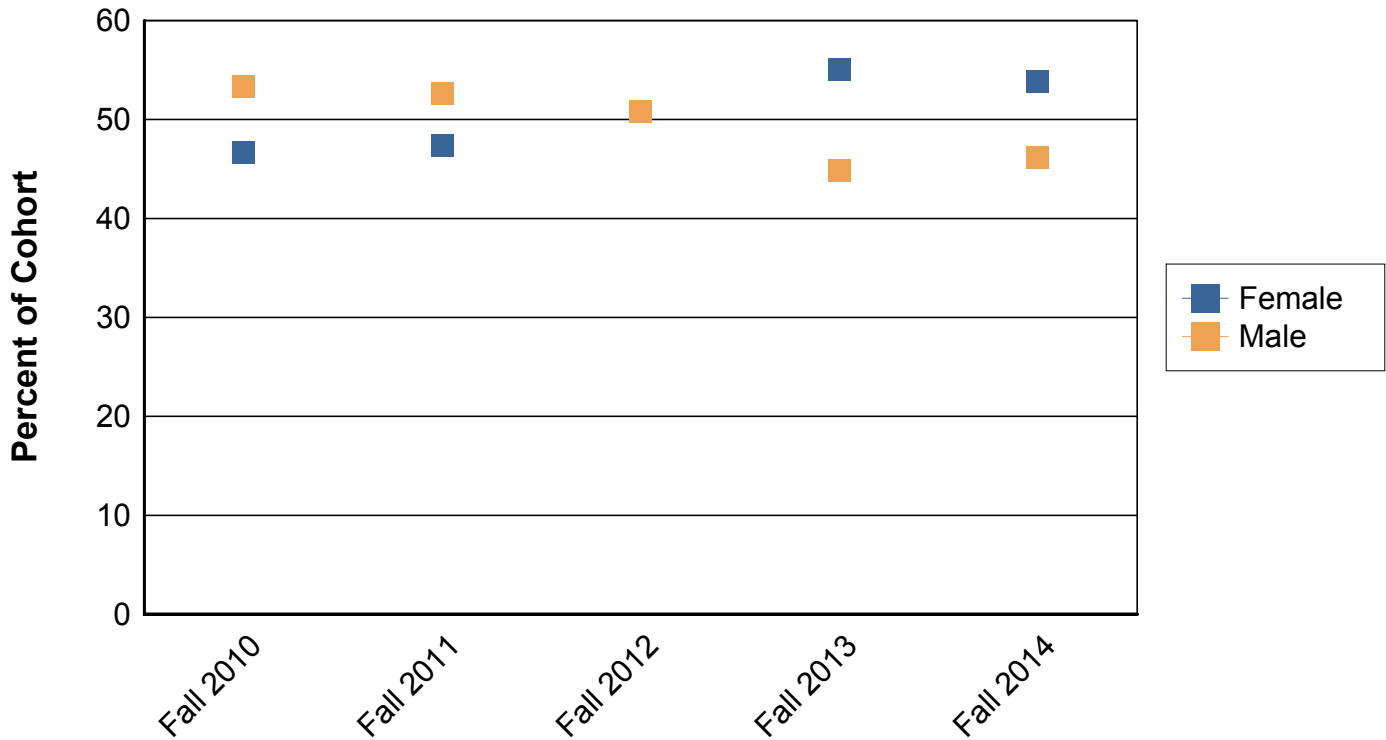

UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Gender

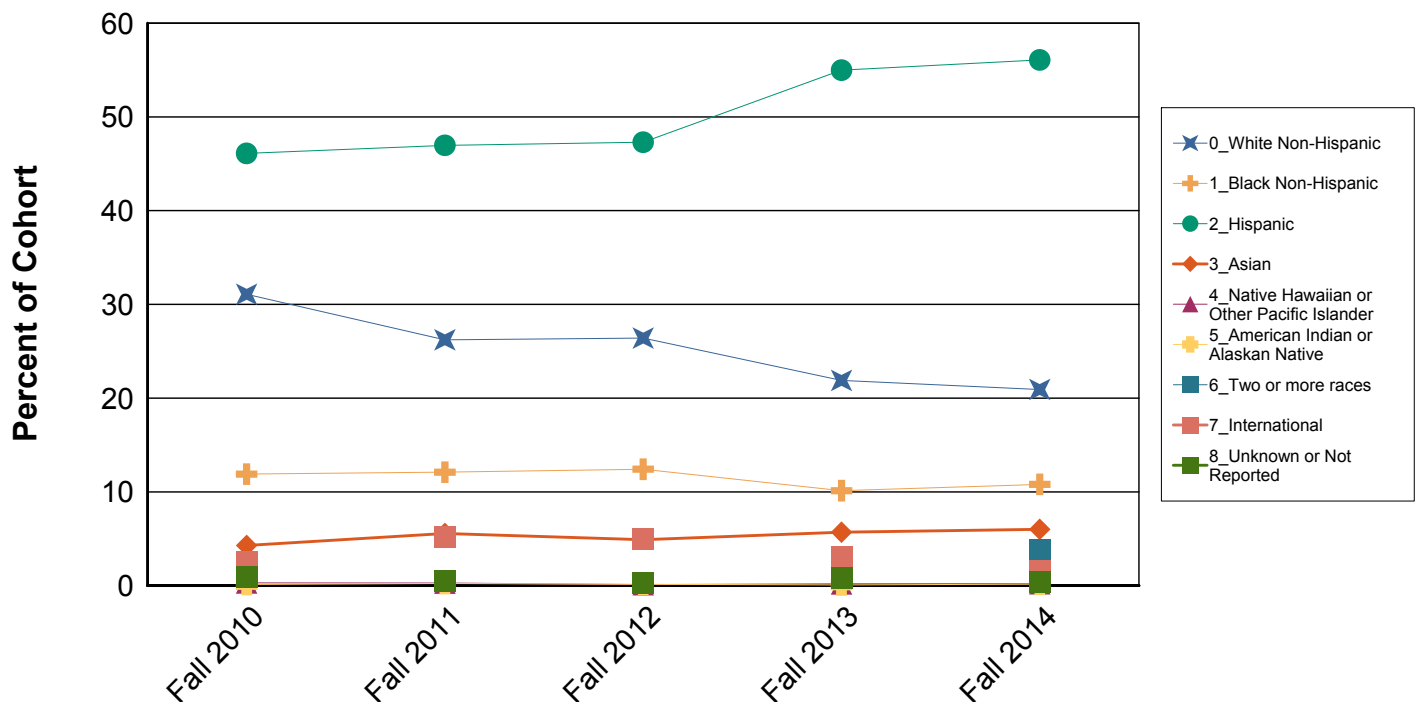

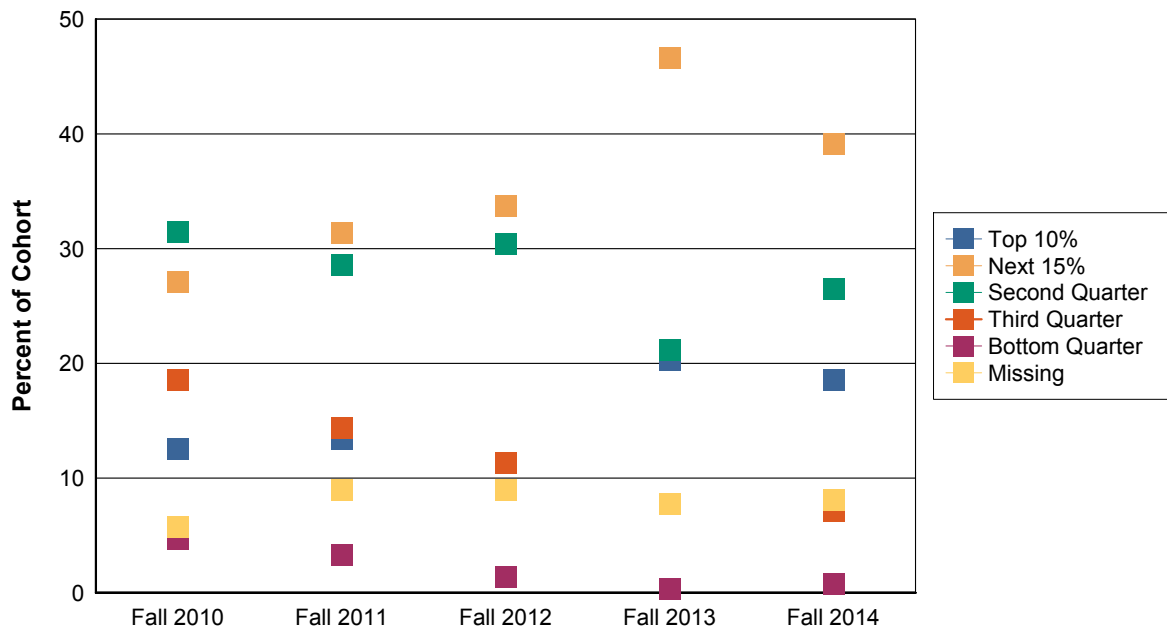
UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Ethnicity

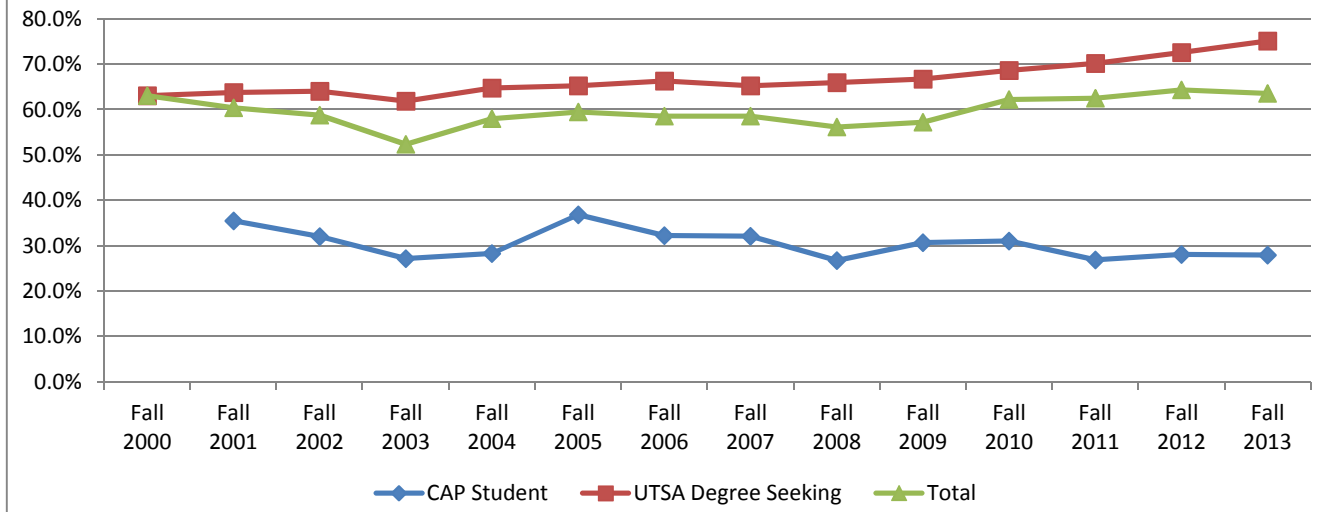

Race/Ethnicity Reporting Changes

As of Summer 2010 a new Race/Ethnicity reporting schema has been adopted based on Federal requirements. Students now have the choice to identify multiple races on the forms collected by the University of Texas at San Antonio. This information is stored as the student has selected, however for reporting purposes a single category has been used. If a student was an International student they would be assigned the International category. If a student is Hispanic, regardless of race indicated, they were assigned to the Hispanic category. Students who chose multiple races were assigned to the Two or more races category. Finally students who chose only one race were assigned to the race category they had chosen. If a student was not International, not Hispanic and did not chose any Race category they were assigned to the Unknown category. In addition to this update the former Asian/Pacific Islander category has now been separated into two categories, one is Asian and the other is Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander.

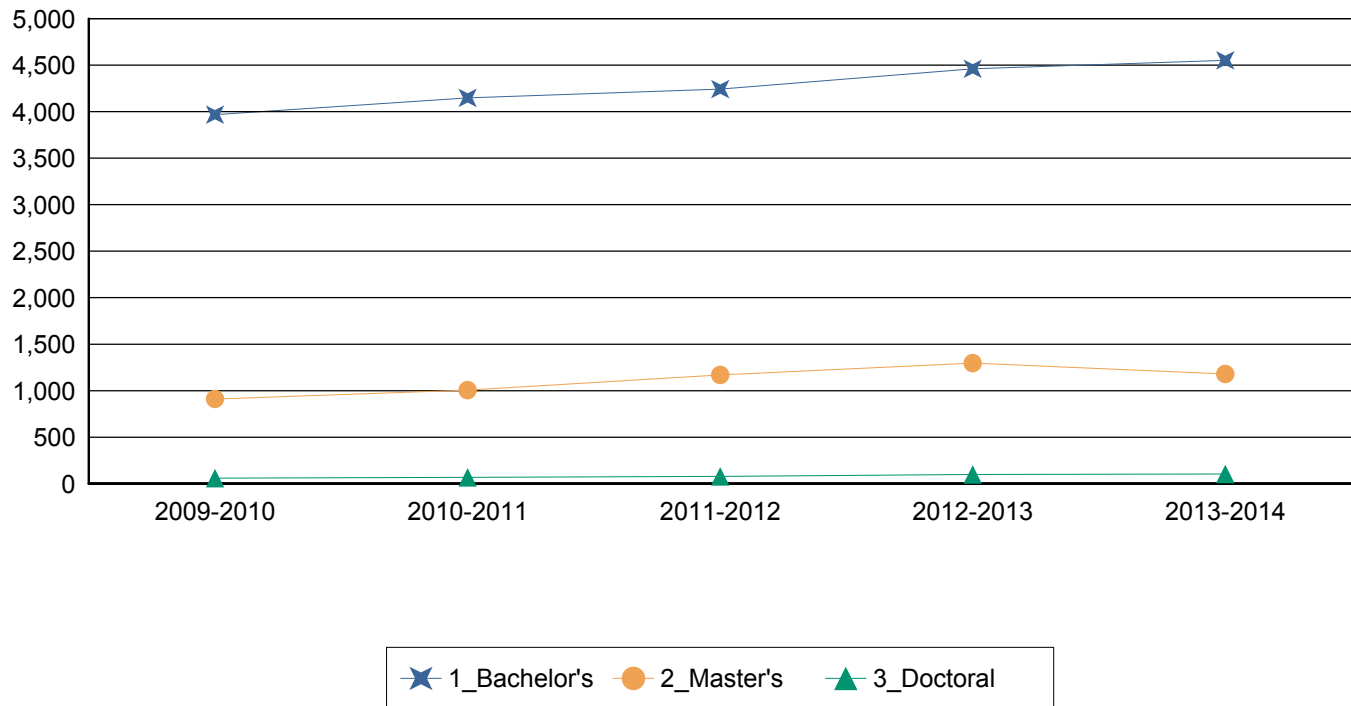

Degrees Awarded by Level

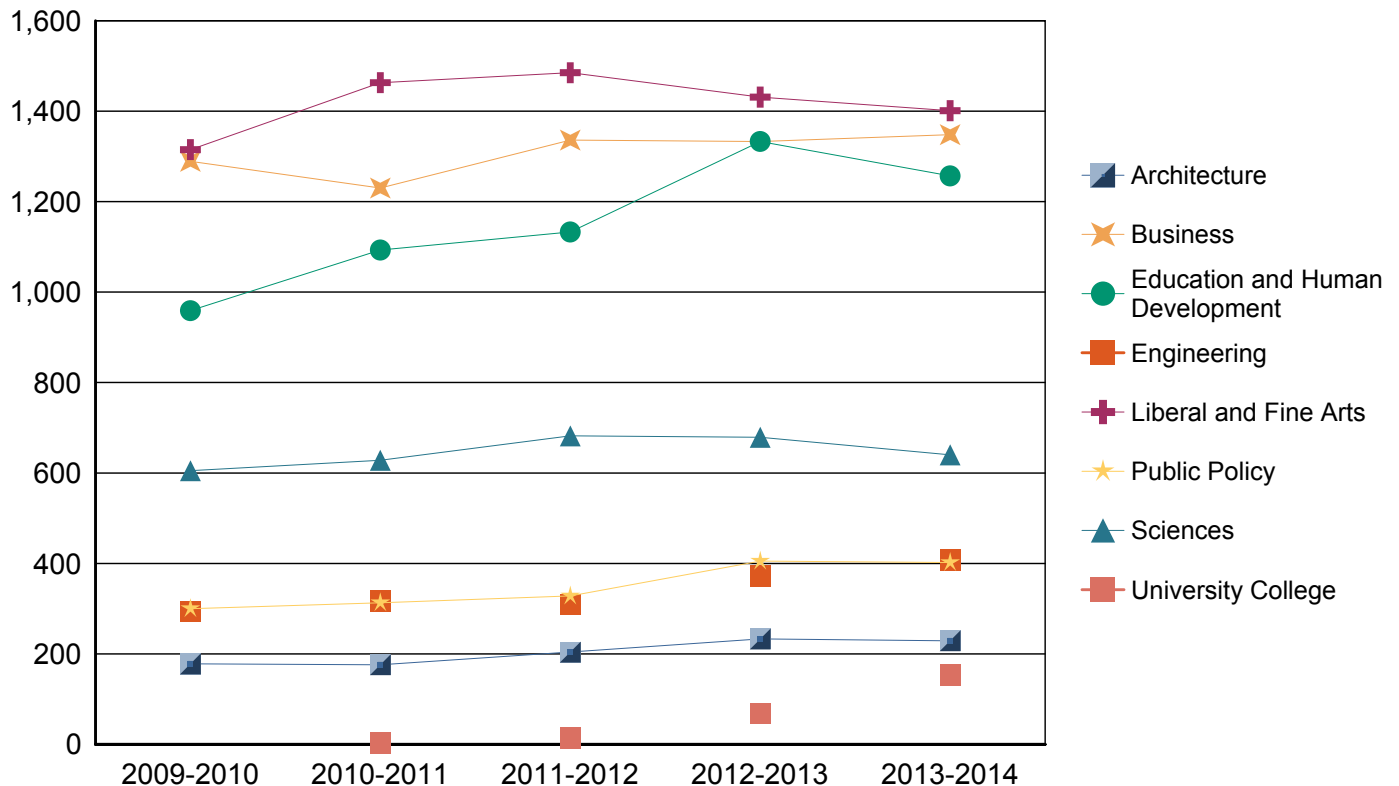

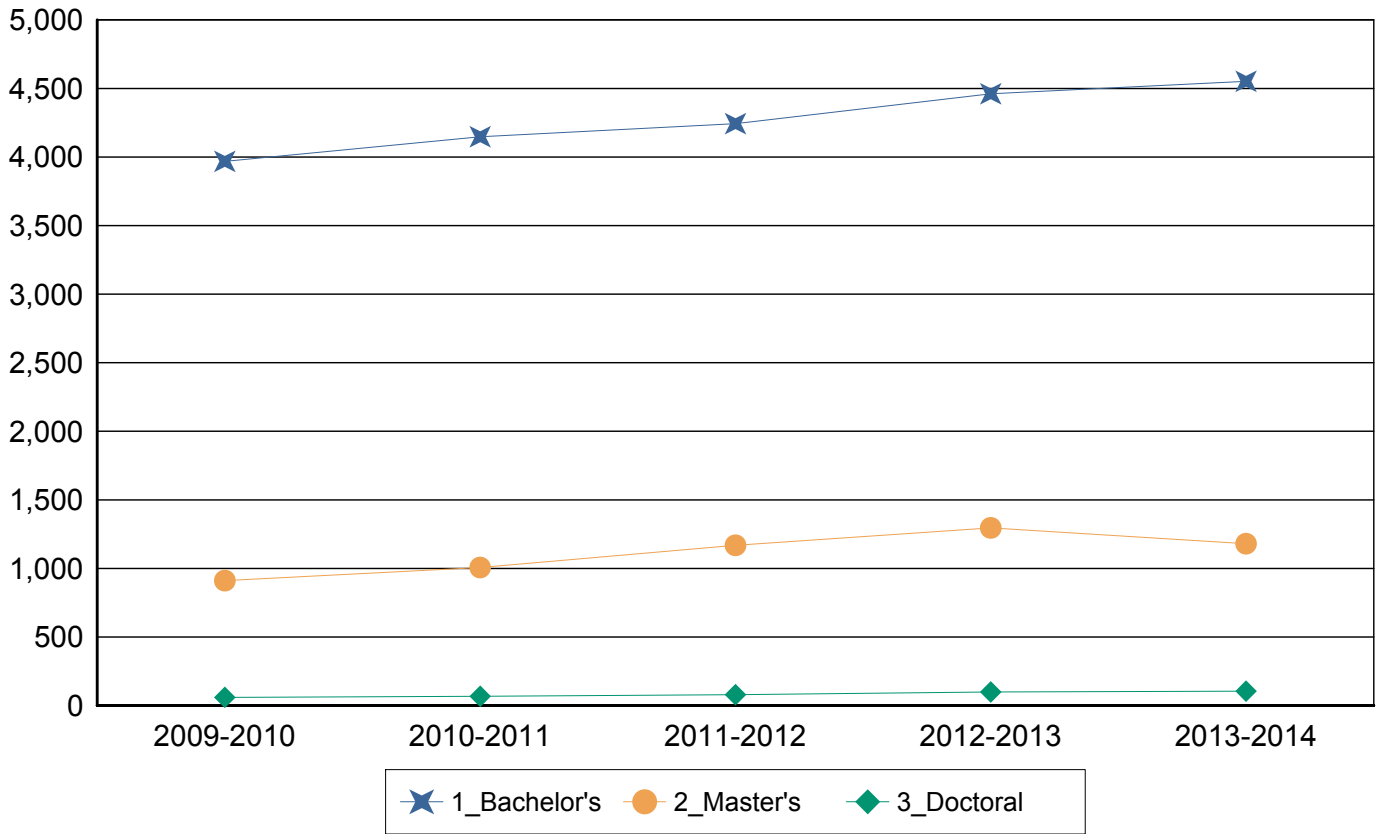

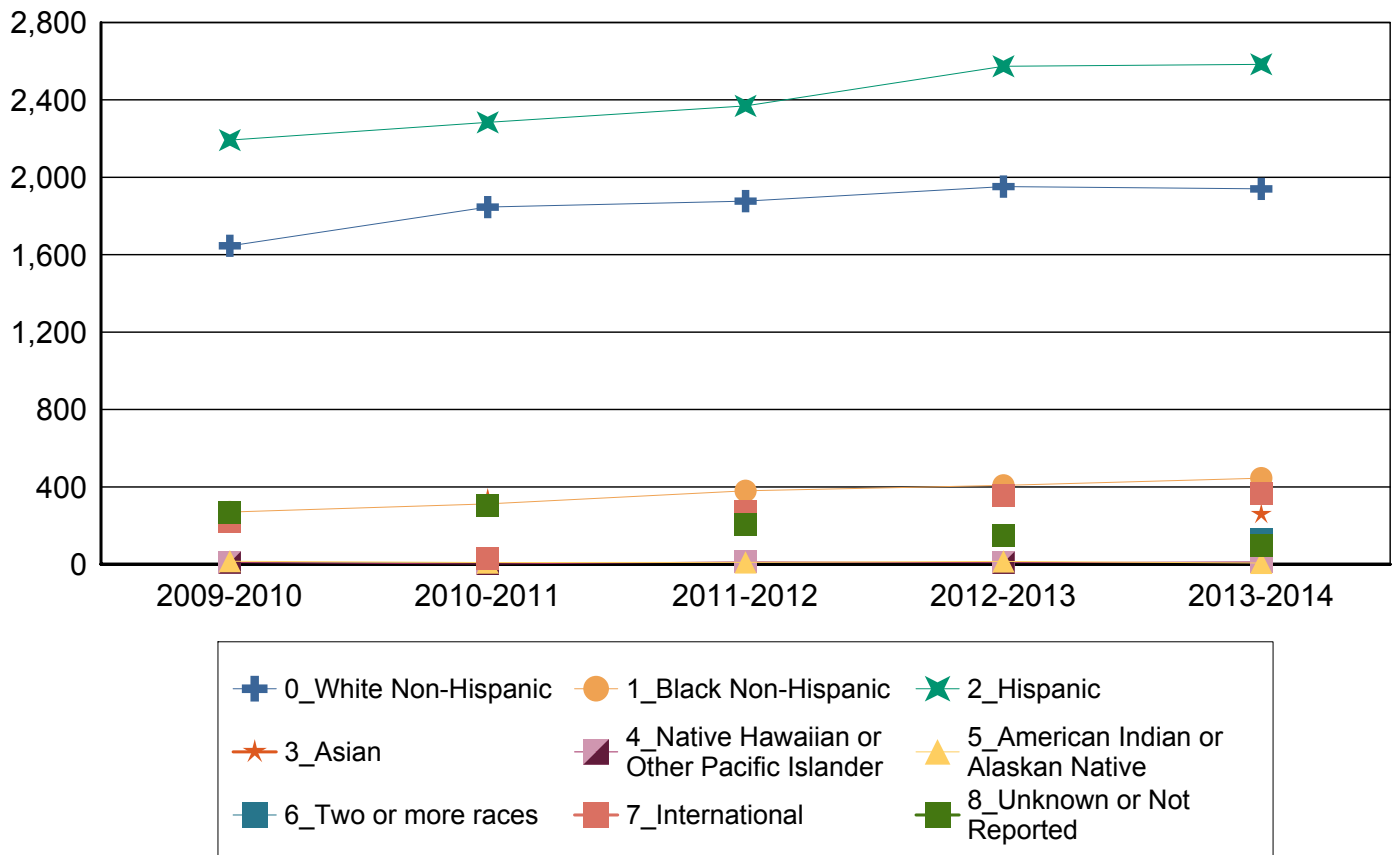

Degrees Awarded by Level



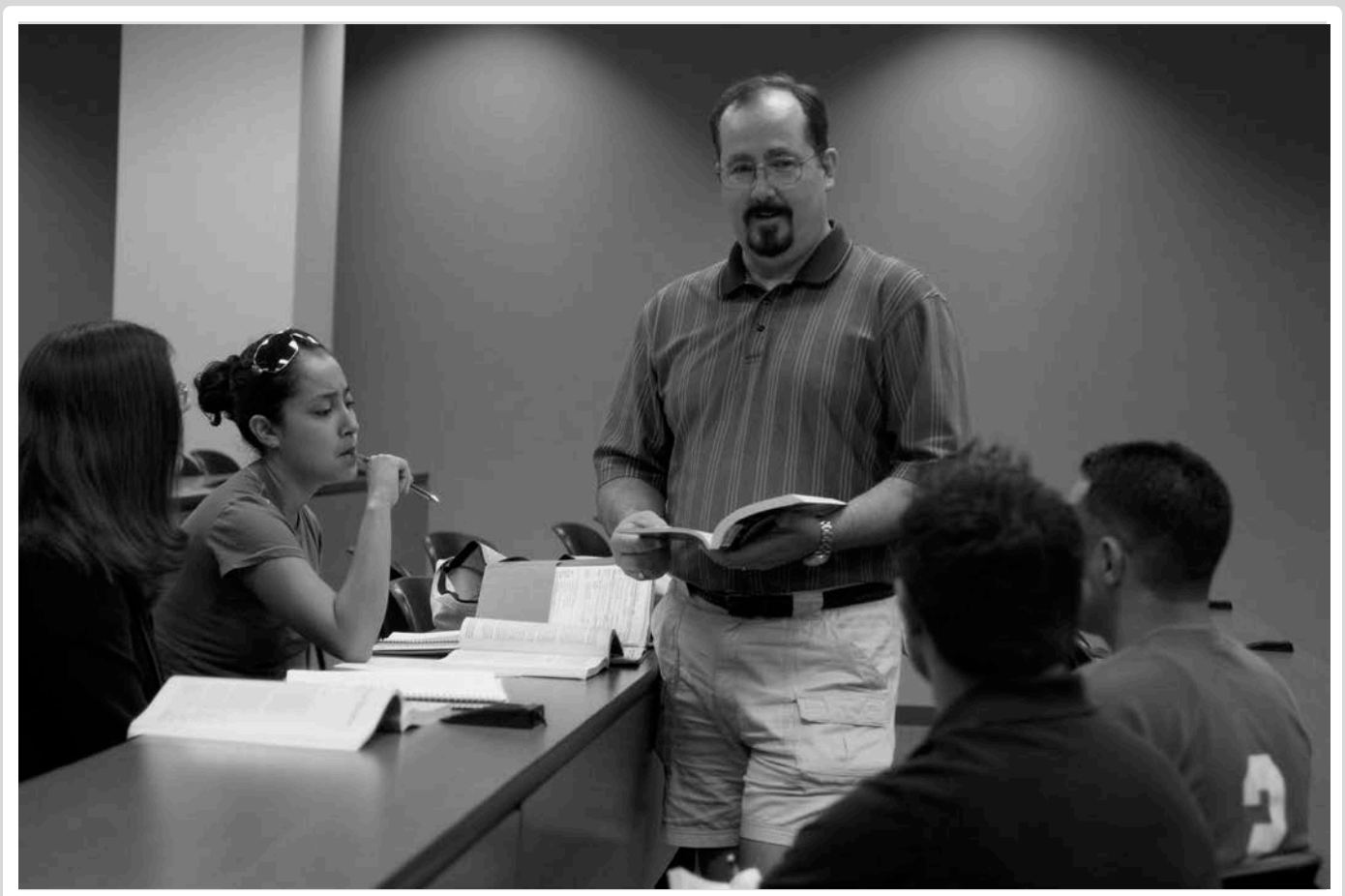
Degrees Awarded by Ethnicity

Race/Ethnicity Reporting Changes

As of Summer 2010 a new Race/Ethnicity reporting schema has been adopted based on Federal requirements. Faculty now have the choice to identify multiple races on the forms collected by the University of Texas at San Antonio. This information is stored as the faculty member has selected, however for reporting purposes a single category has been used. If a faculty member was an International faculty member they would be assigned the International category. If a faculty member is Hispanic, regardless of race indicated, they were assigned to the Hispanic category. Faculty members who chose multiple races were assigned to the Two or more races category. Finally faculty members who chose only one race were assigned to the race category they had chosen. If a faculty member was not International, not Hispanic and did not chose any Race category they were assigned to the Unknown category. In addition to this update the former Asian/Pacific Islander category has now been separated into two categories, one is Asian and the other is Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander.

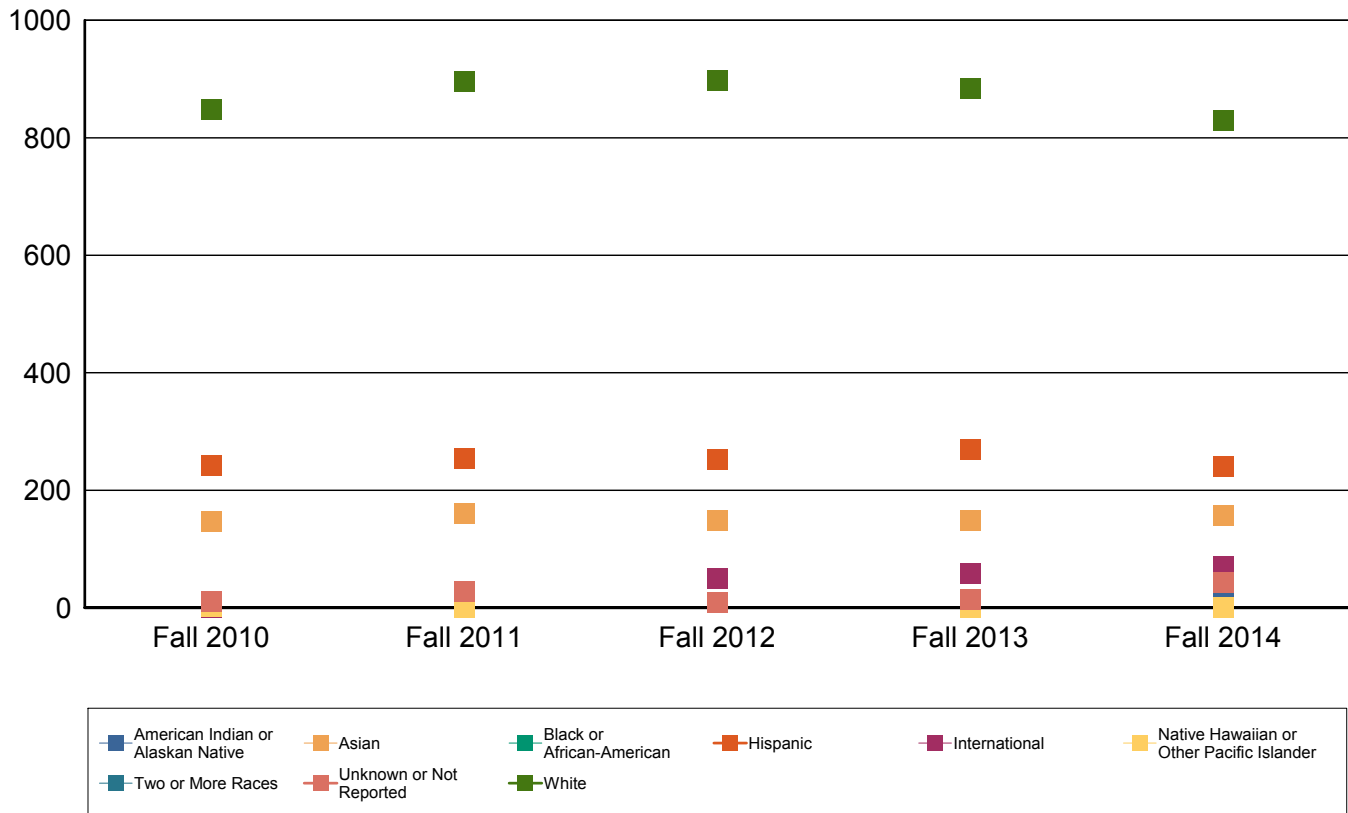

Faculty Members by Ethnicity

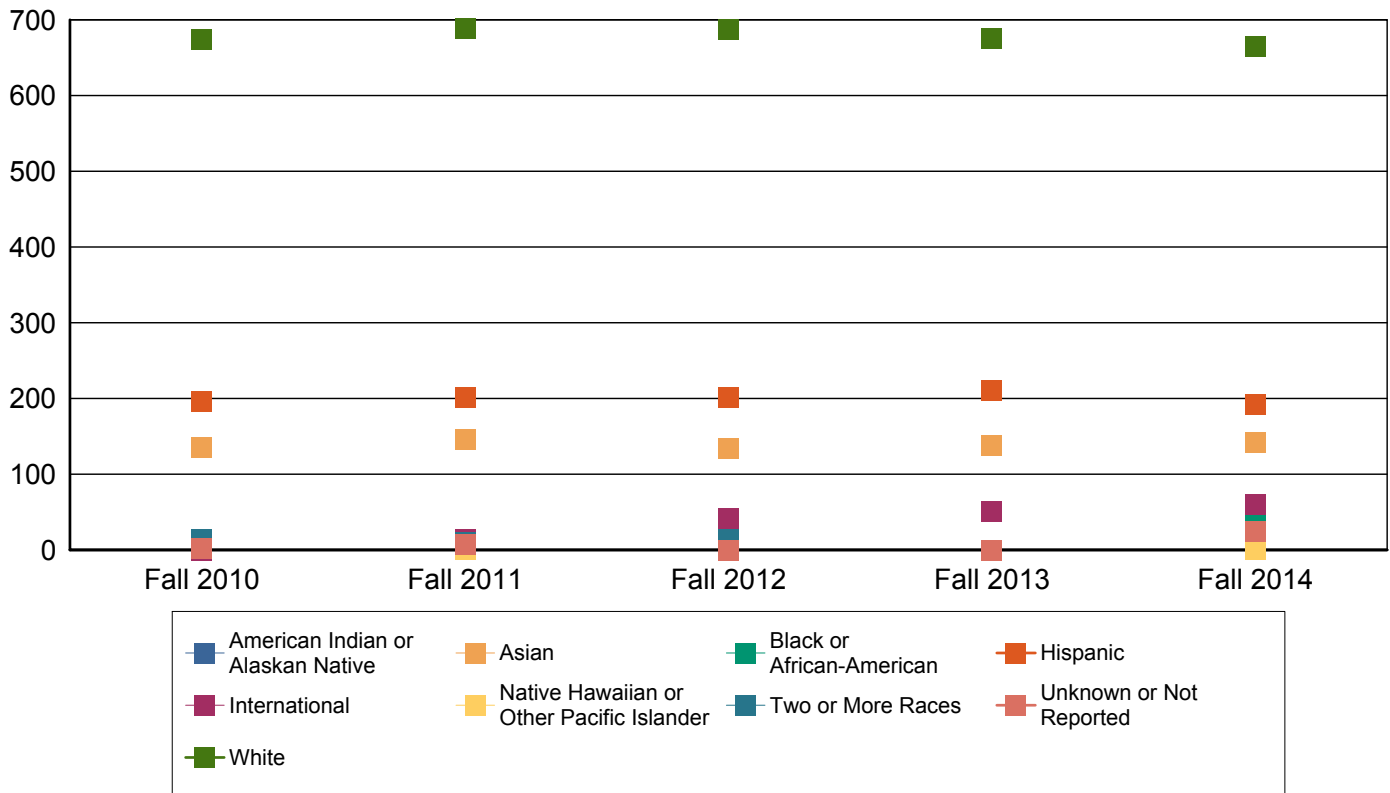

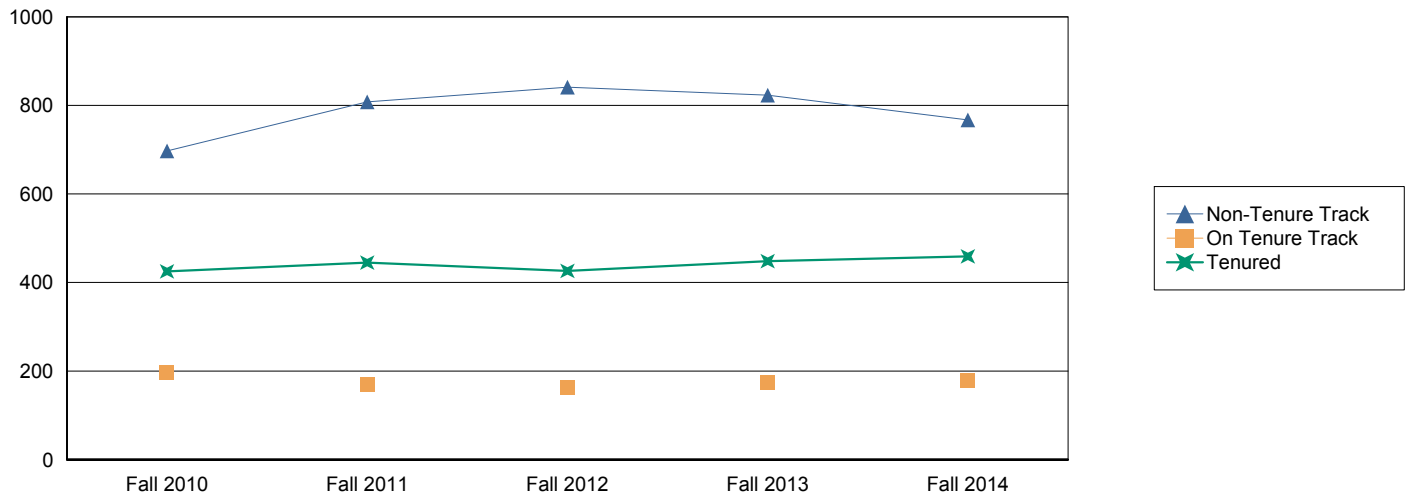

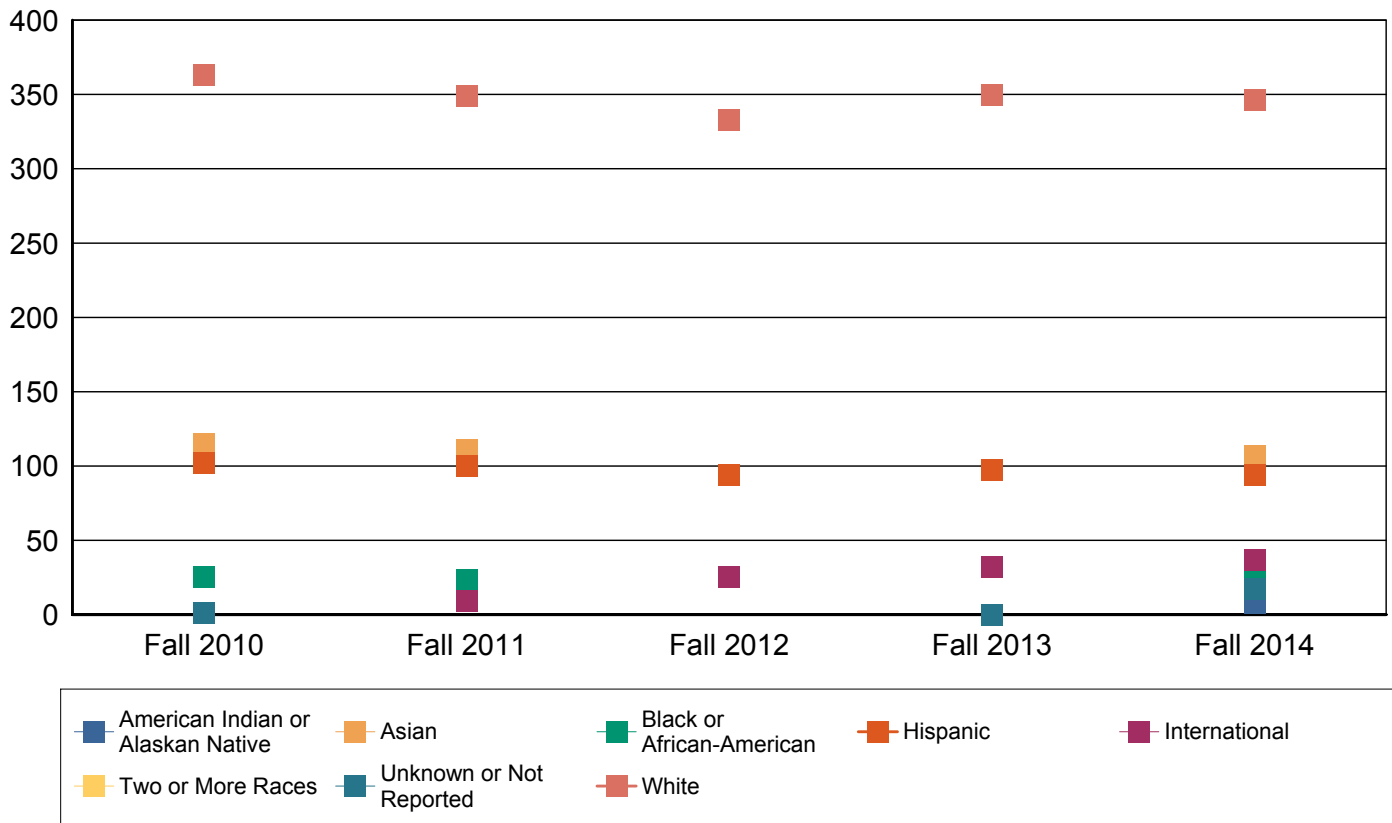

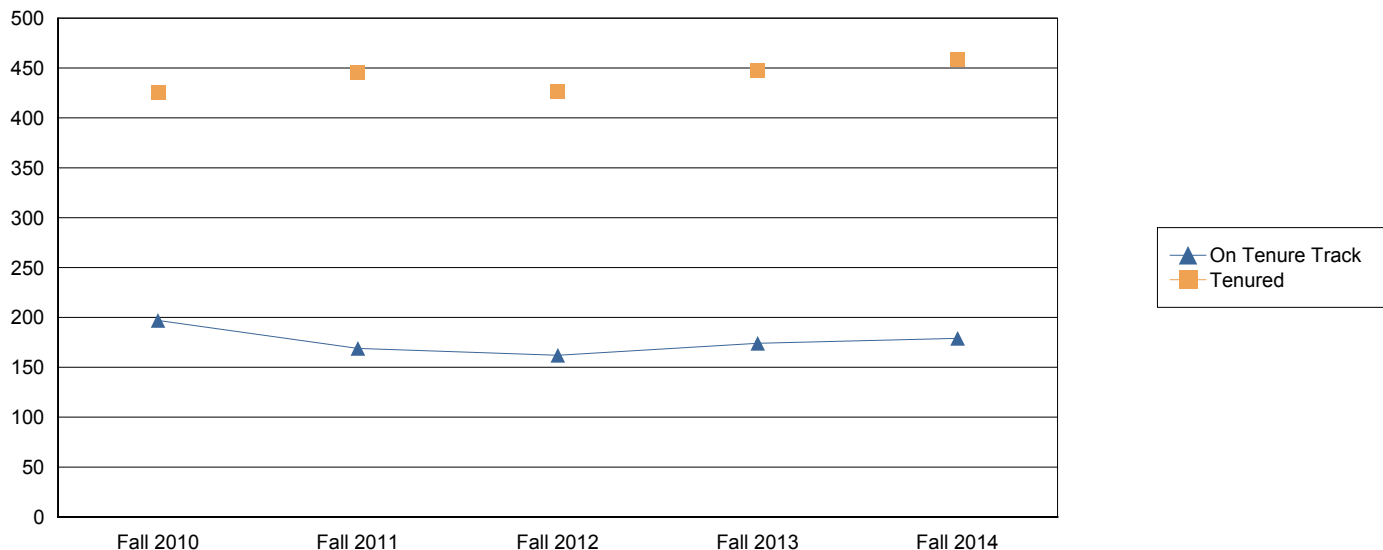

Tenured/Tenure Track Faculty Members by Tenure Status



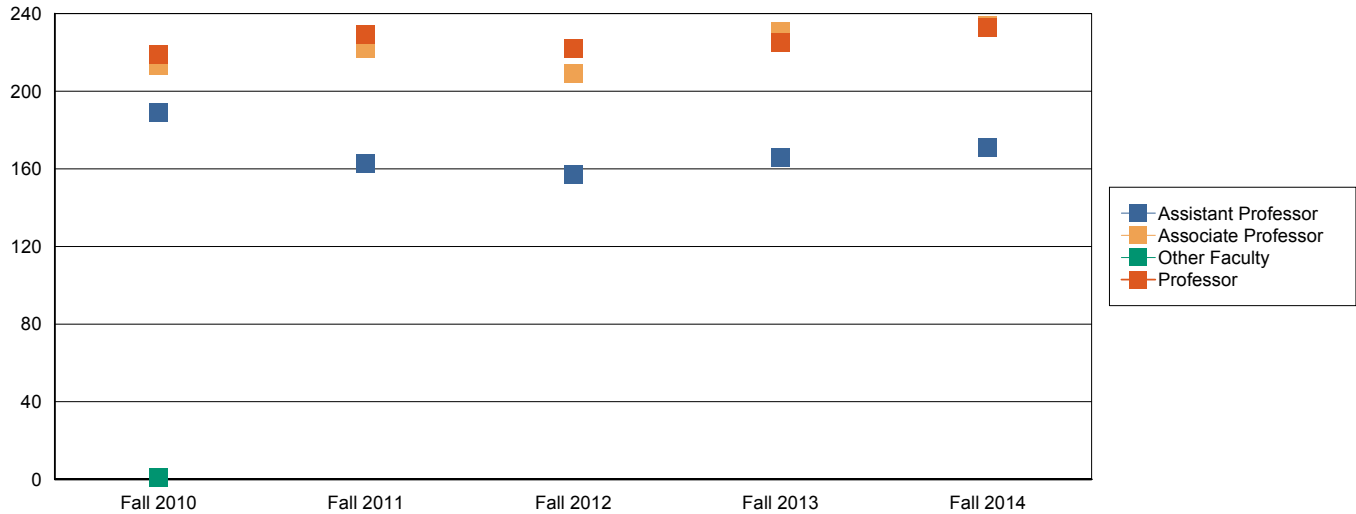

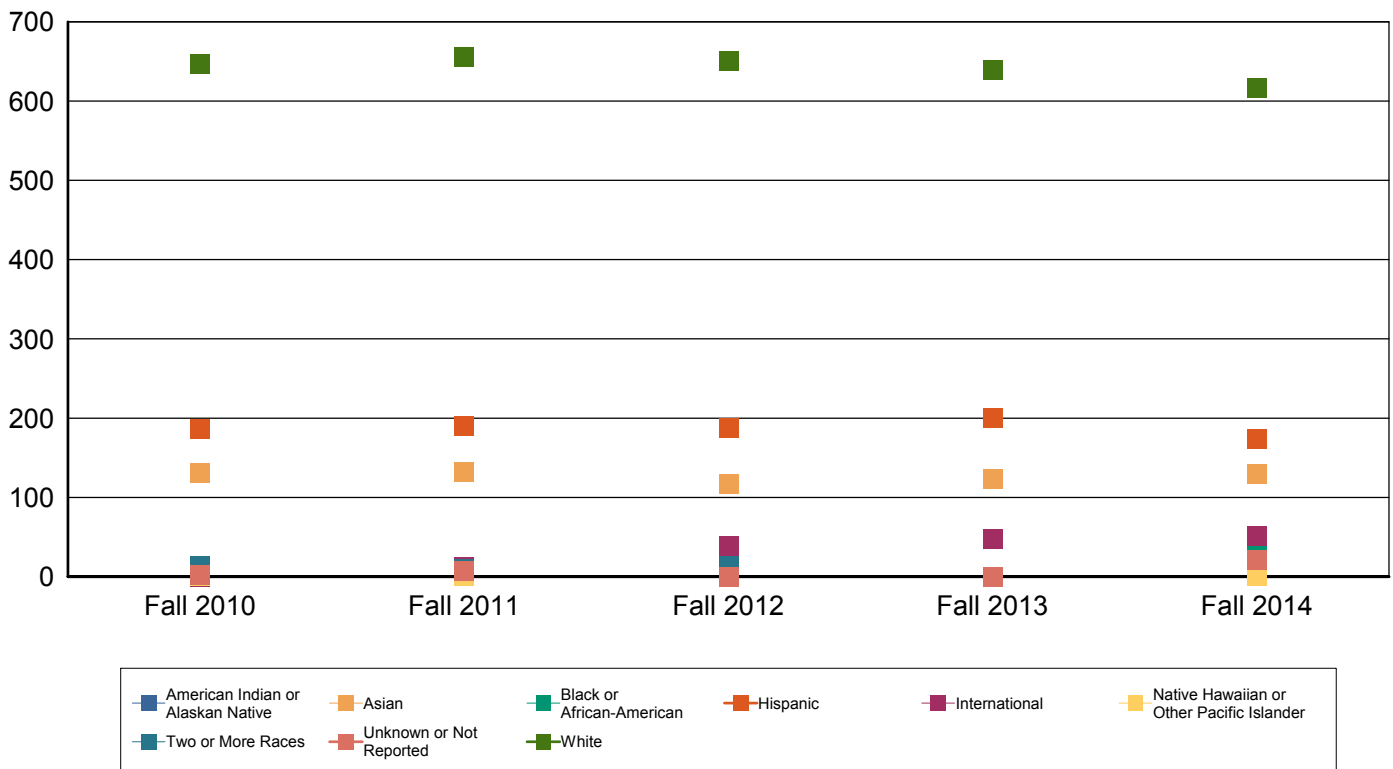

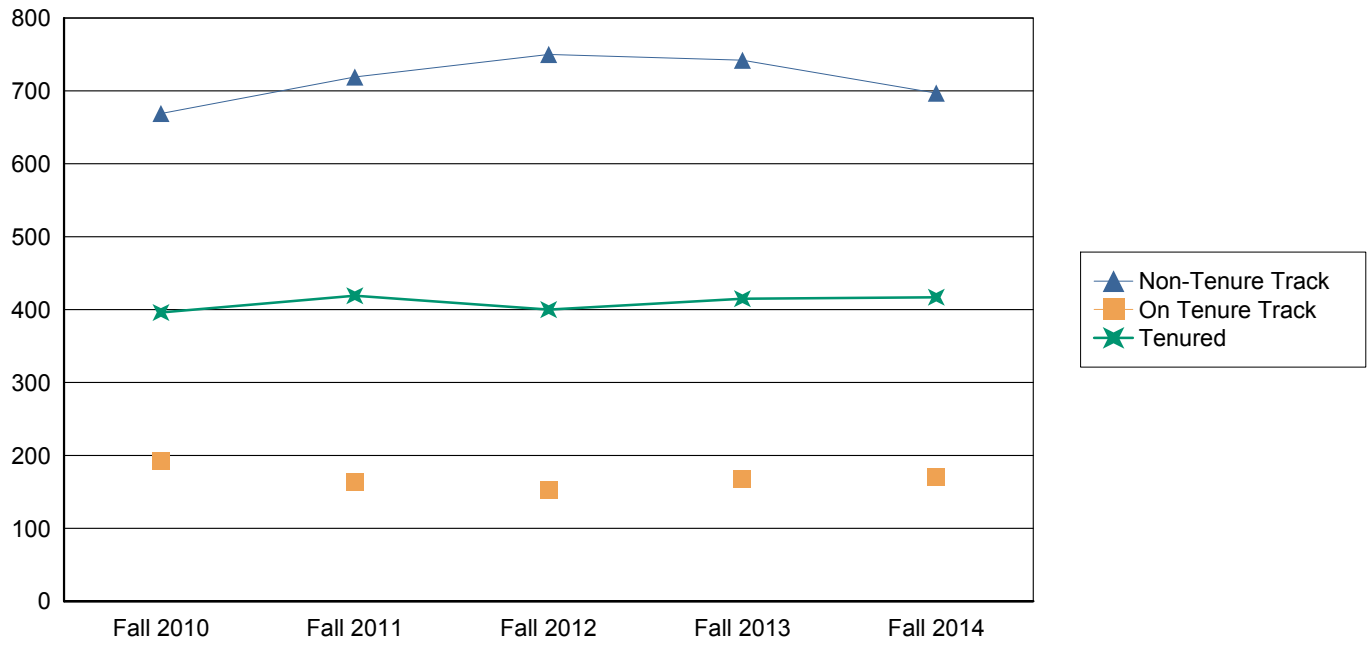

Teaching Assistants by Ethnicity

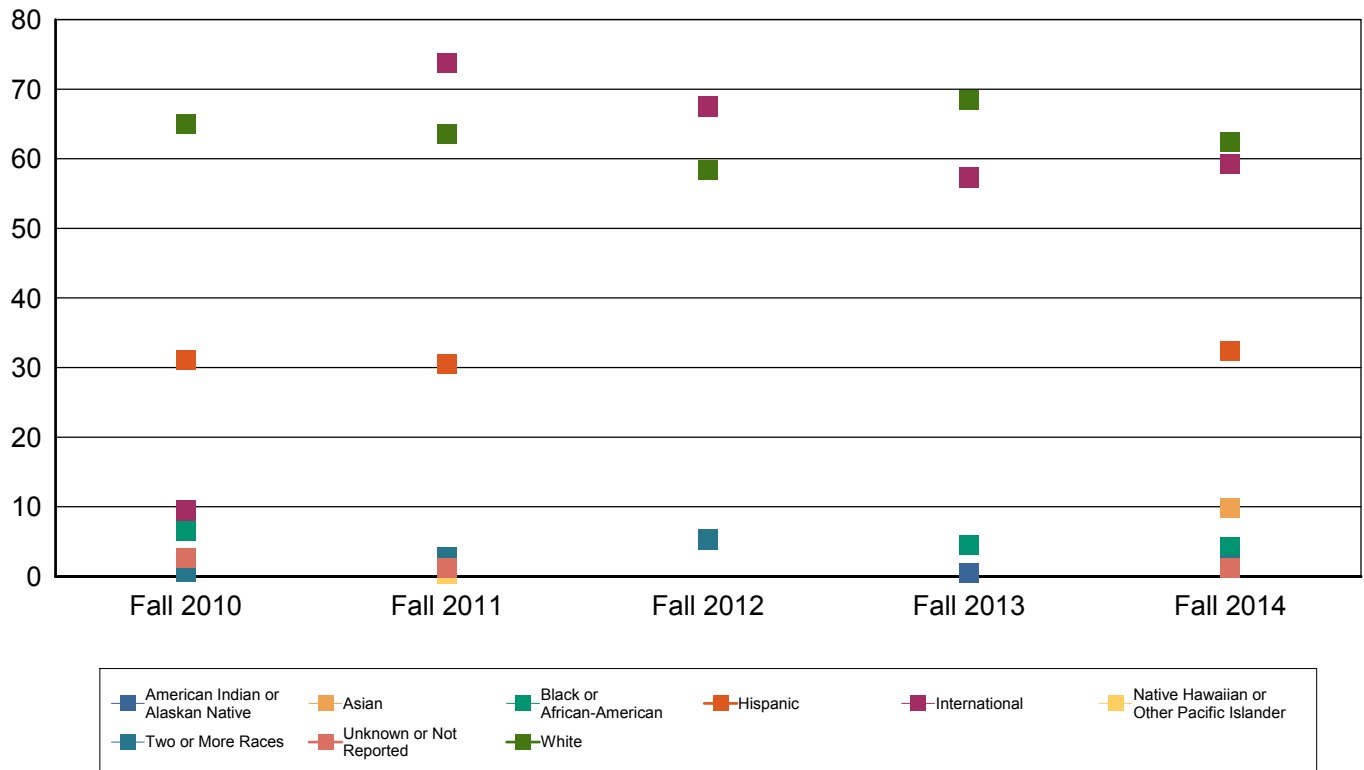

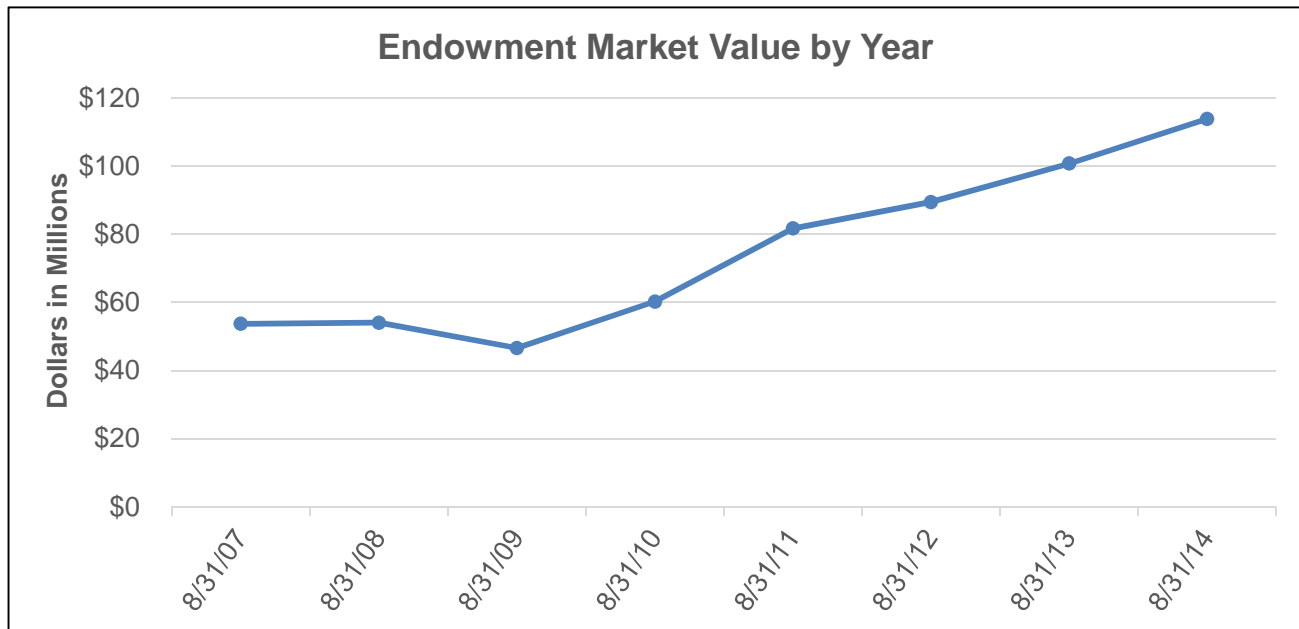

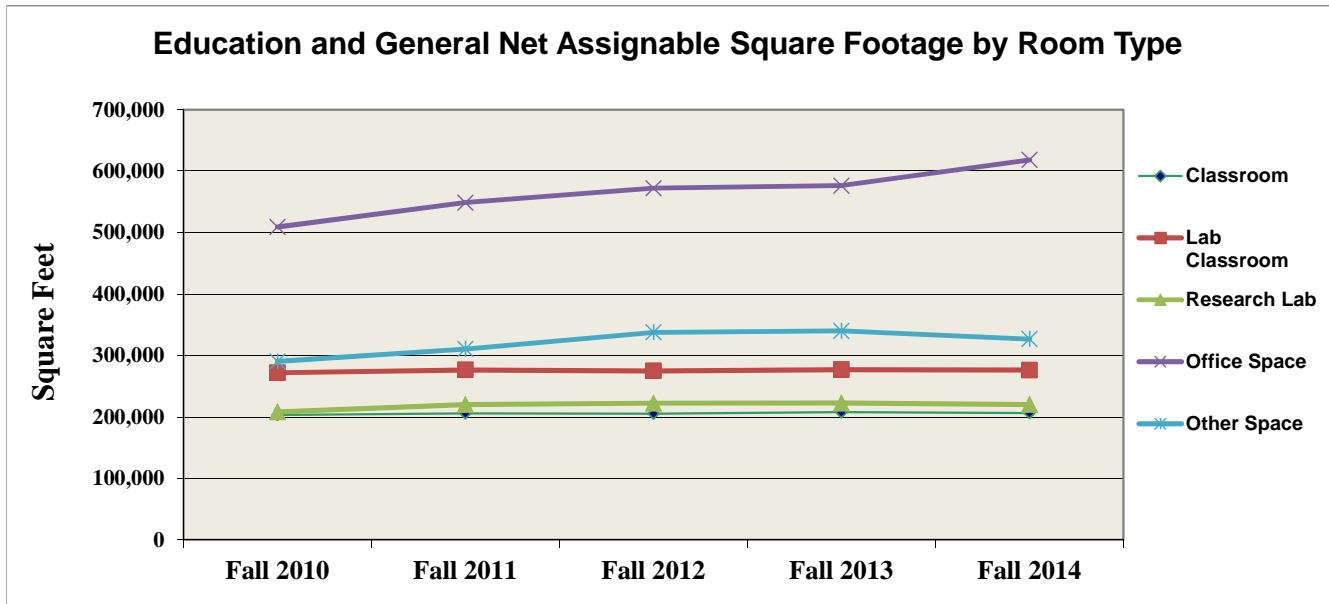
