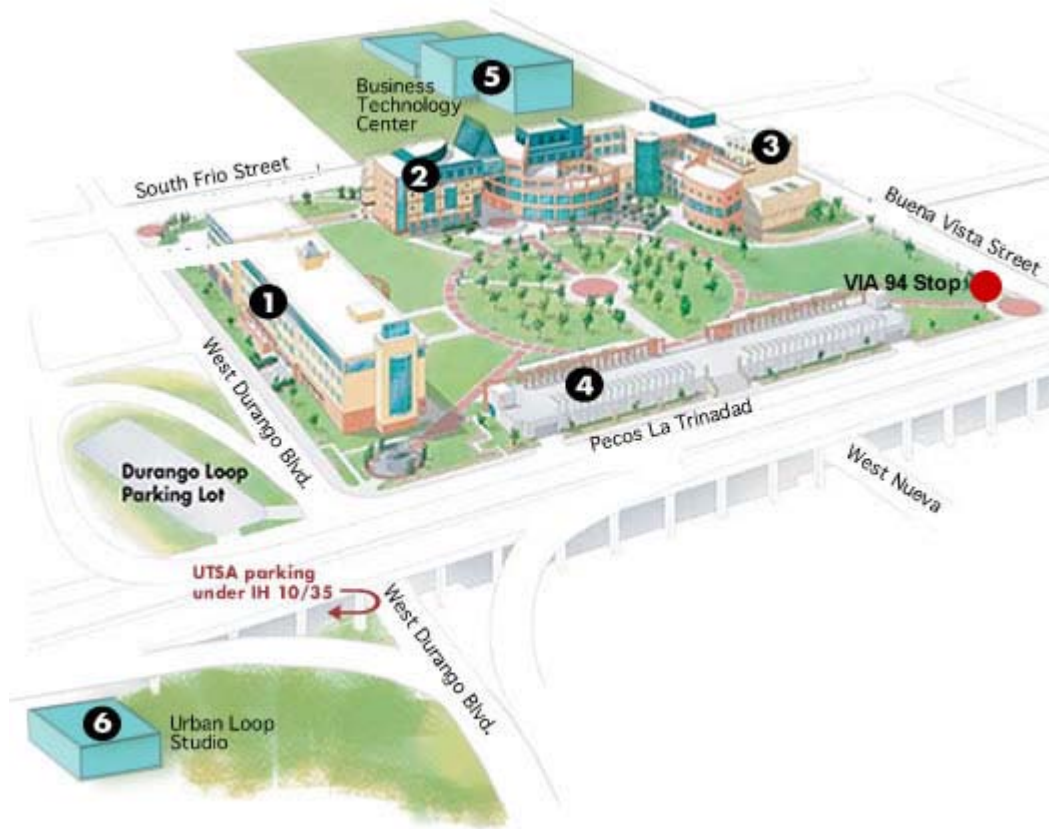

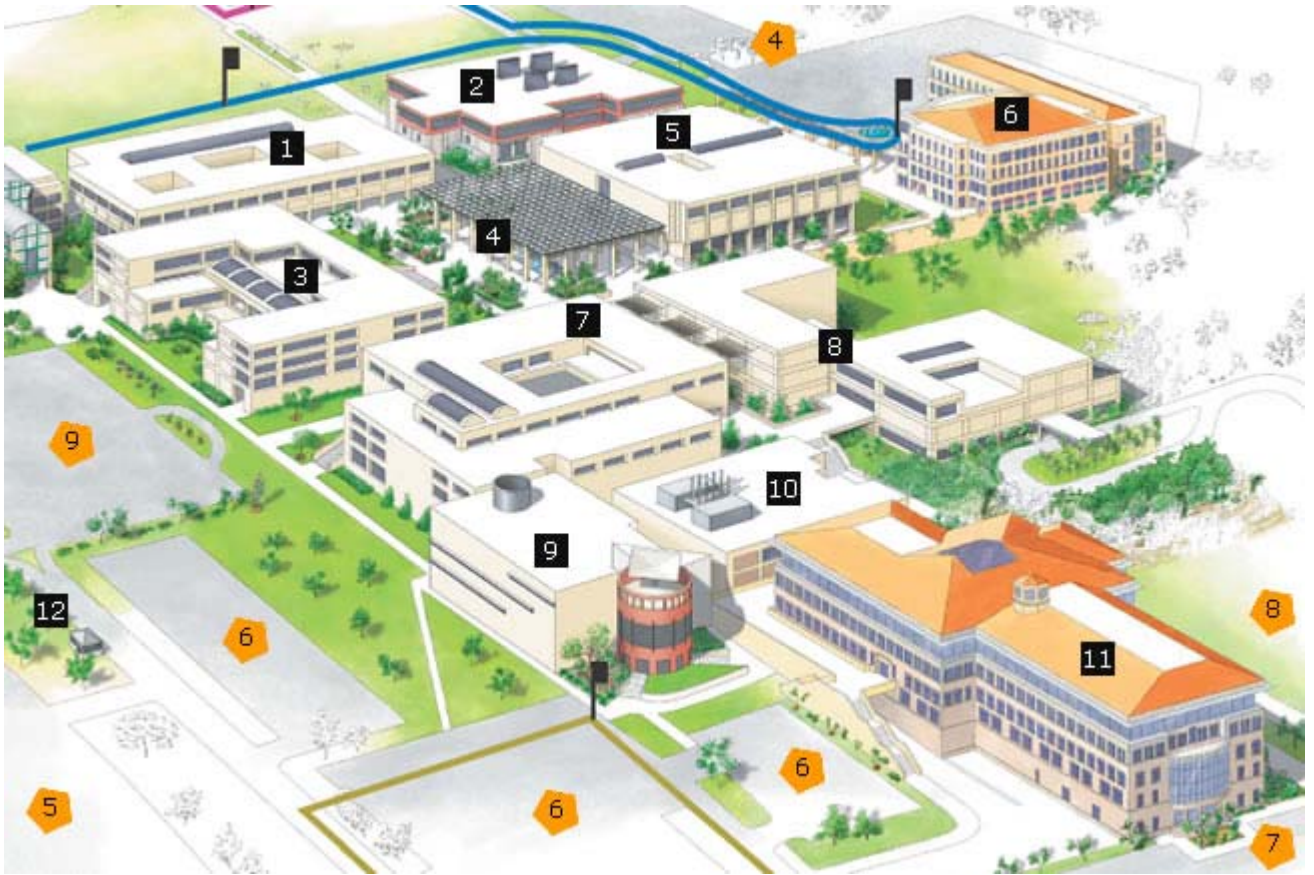
Buildings
