Who is eligible?

Undergraduate and graduate students whose studies relate to the mission of the donor organization, which is to promote the use of the Spanish language and literatures and an understanding of Mexican and Hispanic-American culture.

Eligible for the award will be:

- Spanish and Mexican-American studies majors
- History majors who manifest an interest in Texas & the Borderlands
- Music majors who manifest an interest in the music of Latin America
- Other majors, if the applicant can demonstrate that the focus of his/her studies relates to the Spanish language and literatures and/or Mexican and Hispanic-American culture

Criteria

- Undergraduate recipients must have completed at least 45 undergraduate semester hours at the time of application with an overall GPA of 2.5 or better, and be enrolled full-time (at least 12 hours per semester) while holding the scholarship. Each semester's award is contingent upon the student maintaining a minimum overall GPA of 2.5.
- Graduate recipients must have, and maintain, an overall GPA of 3.0 or better, and be enrolled for at least 6 hours per semester while holding the scholarship. Each semester's award is contingent upon the student maintaining a minimum overall GPA of 3.0.
- Applicants must complete an application form and provide a maximum 500-word essay explaining why they should be selected for the scholarship by addressing their interest in promoting the use of Spanish language and literatures and an understanding of Mexican and Hispanic-American culture.
