The Dietitians Today & Tomorrow Scholarship was funded by a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture for UTSA to award one outstanding Health student with a sincere interest in a nutrition career to continue studies in an accredited Dietetics program of his/her choice.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

- Enrolled at UTSA as an undergraduate with a declared major in Health;
- Enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours);
- At the time of application, have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours at UTSA;
- At the time of application, have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale;
- Provide 3 letters of recommendation with at least one related to your community involvement; and
- Submit a completed application and required essay by the application deadline date.
- Priority consideration will be given to traditionally underrepresented populations in the field of dietetics and/or demonstrated need for financial assistance as determined by UTSA's Office of Student Financial Aid.*

***The UTSA Financial Aid Office will determine your financial need based on a completed FAFSA. FAFSA applications for an academic year can be submitted starting January 1. If you have not submitted a FAFSA, please do so as early as possible.**
