- Applicants must be enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester for undergraduate students and 9 credit hours for graduate students) at the time of the award.
- Applicants must document community involvement by attaching a short essay explaining their participation in chapter-related functions, their participation in at least one extra-curricular activity at UTSA, and at least one community service program in San Antonio
- Applicants must submit a letter of endorsement from an alumni member of Lambda Chi Alpha and/or an endorsement from Lambda Chi Alpha Alumni Association, including the San Antonio Alumni Association, as evidence by a letter signed by both the President and the Secretary of the Board of Directors of the respective Alumni Association.
