Why:

1. To Raise awareness of HIV/AIDS and other STDs
  2. To Raise awareness about Alcohol/Substance Abuse
  3. To Raise awareness about Hepatitis
- According the MADD, Mothers Against Drunk Driving:
    - Young adults aged 18 to 22 enrolled full-time in college were more likely than their peers not enrolled full time to use alcohol in the past month, binge drink, and drink heavily.
  - Young adults make up the largest number of HIV cases reported in recent years. (March 2007). The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) estimate that there are at least 15,000 HIV+ young people between the ages of 13 to 24 years old living in the U.S. Yet, most HIV+ teens and young adults remain unaware of their infection, or that they were even at risk for HIV.
