Leader Summit is seeking educational session proposals for the 2008 conference to be held on Saturday, September 27th from 8:15 AM until 5:00 PM in the UTSA University Center. The theme of this conference will explore the endless possibilities of leadership.

What is Leader Summit?

Leader Summit is an all day leadership conference for student leaders at UTSA. Last year over 150 individuals participated. Leader Summit's purpose is to:

- Provide opportunities for student leaders to learn from each other
- Provide participants the opportunity to learn practical leadership skills
- Invigorate our organization leaders as they begin a new academic year
- Strengthen the connection between our student organization leaders and the Student Activities office

What topics will sessions cover?

Leader Summit will encompass four key areas:

- **Foundations, Blueprints, and Planning:** Foundational leadership skills and theory
- **Tools, Teamwork, and Building:** Practical, hands-on leadership skills for use in organizational settings
- **Neighbors, Community, and Sharing:** Broadening awareness of current community and global issues.
- **Maintenance, Additions, and Cleaning:** Challenging held beliefs and ways of thinking through simulations, activities, and discussions.

- What kind of expertise do I have?
- What am I most passionate about?
- What questions do student leaders want me to answer?
