Leader Summit is an all day leadership conference for student leaders at UTSA. Last year over 150 individuals participated. Leader Summit's purpose is to:

- Provide participants INTERACTIVE opportunities to learn how to be effective leaders
- Provide participants INTERACTIVE opportunities to learn practical leadership skills
- Invigorate our organization leaders as they begin a new academic year
- Strengthen the connection between our student organization leaders, the Student Activities office, and the UTSA Community

What topics will sessions cover?

Leader Summit will encompass four key areas and below you will find some example topics for each area:

- **Communicating:** Conflict Management, Delegating, Communication Etiquette, Facilitating and Listening, Advertising, Member Recruitment
- **Connecting:** Networking, Icebreakers, Team Building Exercises, Organizational Retention, Organizational Apathy
- **Collaborating:** Co-Sponsorships, Community Engagement, Organizational Resource, Organizational Dynamics
- **Creating:** Event Programming, Marketing, Policies/Standards, Scholastic Plans, Innovation, Change Agents
