Motivations of the Color Styles

BLUES

are motivated by connection and personal relationships. They seek meaning in their work and opportunities to help develop potential in themselves and others. They need a sense of "higher" purpose and will put their all-out efforts towards someone or something they believe in. GOLDS

They don't like to sit through drawn out speeches and award presentations. Instead they prefer it when things are kept light and moving along with humor and colorful stories. They don't like to be told they "have to" do something.
