How Does It Work?

1. Eligible person requests ride by calling 210-362-5254 or 1-800-960-5201, email <u>vetrides@askasc.org</u> or is referred by a social worker, case manager or other advocate.

2. Rider completes intake & assessment process:

- Provide basic information via phone interview
- Provides supporting information via fax / email to include:
 - a) DD214 b) Photo ID c) other documents as requested
- 3. Rider is approved and provided contact number for transportation provider in their area or assistance in scheduling a ride

(must be at least 7 to 10 days prior to ride request)

4. If eligible, ride is provided FREE of charge (*Riders can use for up to 3 trips based on funding*)

Who is Eligible?

- 1. Veterans, immediate family (spouse, under 18, or disabled adult living with the Veteran) Caregivers, & Surviving Spouses
- 2. Have no means of transportation, OR have medical needs that require you to have a driver



Our primary goal is to help those needing medical care or services first, but you can use the program to do almost anything (not all inclusive):

- 1. Doctor Visits (not just to the V.A.)
- 2. Grocery Needs
- 3. Places of Worship
- 4. Paying Bills
- 5. Trips to a senior center or community agency
