



What is EDUCATIONAL TALENT SEARCH?

The Educational Talent Search (ETS) Project of the University of Texas at San Antonio provides **free** college, career, and financial aid information to over 600 students each year. ETS identifies and selects students who demonstrate the potential for postsecondary enrollment and provides them with the motivation and support to enroll in a program of postsecondary education (college, university, technical or vocational school) after high school graduation.

How Does ETS Work?

Educational Talent Search encourages and prepares students for postsecondary enrollment by providing assigned students in grades 6-12 with the following services and activities through group workshops and individual appointments held at designated target schools:

- **Academic Advisement**
- **Financial Aid & College Awareness Activities**
- **Career Exploration Activities**
- **Tutoring**
- **Scholarship Information**
- **College, Career & Cultural Field Trips**
- **Individual Assistance with College Admissions, Scholarship Applications & Financial Aid Forms**

Who Can Join ETS?

In order to be eligible for selection as ETS participants, students must meet the following criterion:

- ★ Be a U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident Alien;
- ★ Currently enrolled in grades 6-12;
- ★ Qualify as Low Income and/or Potential First Generation College Graduate (neither parent has received a 4-year degree);
- ★ Commit to remain in the ETS Project until HS graduation;
- ★ Demonstrate **Potential for Postsecondary Enrollment** as defined by:
 - Expressing a desire to go to college;
 - Maintaining a GPA of 2.5 or higher;
 - Level of maturity/integrity;
 - Initiative /Willingness to learn new things;
 - Exhibiting good citizenship and leadership skills.
