- Representative of the institution in Conference and NCAA affairs.

#### Role of the FAR is to:

- Ensure that the academic institution establishes and maintains the appropriate balance between academics and intercollegiate athletics.
- Ensure academic integrity of the athletics program
- Ensure personal well-being of student-athletes
- Promote institutional control of intercollegiate athletics by monitoring and assessing rules compliance
- Enhance the student-athlete experience

## INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS COUNCIL

- Advises UTSA President on all matters of policy and procedures for Intercollegiate Athletics program
- Meets at least three times each academic semester
- FAR serves as the Chair



# BASKETBALL & VOLLEYBALL TRAINING FACILITY



- Cost: \$35 million
- Breaking Ground: Early 2025
- Site Area: 1.83 acres
- Building Area: 49,774 sf
- 2 full-size NCAA practice courts with 8 goals on each court.
- 3,000-square-foot weight room with dedicated cardio
- 1,000-square-foot athletic training room for sports medicine
- Coaches offices on second level with bridge connector to the RACE facility.
