Students experiencing the Student Conduct process through Housing and Residence Life, Campus Living Villages, and Student Conduct and Community Standards after a violation are often connected with an E.P.I.C. Journey. The E.P.I.C. Journey is part of their sanction and is designed to improve individual skill sets needed for academic and personal success.

Educational sanctions that require participation or action on the part of the student are referred to as active sanctions. Effective sanctioning or “designing the journey” employs the use of combining active and inactive sanctions. Collaboration across UTSA and the community is vital to the success of the E.P.I.C.
