The UC provides a Writing Lab, ROTC programs, First-Year Experience courses, such as Academic Introduction & Strategies, and crossuniversity collaborations to promote student success. The college's goal is to positively impact undergraduate students by providing the encouragement and support they need to advance toward their degrees, regardless of their majors.

As a portal to academic and student success for UTSA's undergraduate students, the UC offers a wide variety of academic and experiential learning opportunities to help them realize their own potential. A significant challenge for UTSA is that numerous students arrive at the university unaware of their own capabilities. Many are unprepared for the rigors of university studies and many are first-generation college students who come from underrepresented groups. It is the

responsibility of the UC to provide the innovative programming and student support services that will awaken and nurture the potential in every student. To meet that obligation, the University College plans to create an endowment that will provide ongoing funding for increased specialized training for faculty, enhanced academic programming, and expanded experiential learning opportunities to support students across all disciplines.
