UT San Antonio School of Nursing Pre-requisite courses

Math

① **MAT 1023 or higher**
① **STA 1053 or PSY 2073**

Biology

**(UTSA pre-requisite of BIO 1233 or BIO 1203 required before you can begin below courses)

① **BIO 2053 + BIO 2051** (Anatomy & Physiology I w/lab)
① **BIO 2063 + BIO 2061** (Anatomy & Physiology II w/ lab)
① **MMI 1053 + MMI 1061** (Microbiology w/ lab)
① **NDT 2043** (Nutrition)

Chemistry (1 semester)

Allied Science Chemistry (non-science major): ① **CHE 1004** --- OR ---

Chemistry from Sciences Majors: ① **CHE 1103*** (CHE 1121 *lab not required by UTHSA*)

*must have passed Basic Chemistry (CHE 1073) or met minimum exam score in ALEKS Chemistry Placement

Note: Other nursing schools may require a 1-hour chemistry laboratory pre-requisite for application.

Social and Behavioral Sciences

① **PSY 1013** (Applied toward Social and Behavioral Science Core)
① **PSY 2503** (Developmental/Lifespan Psychology)
① **SOC 1013** (Applied toward Component area option Core)

UTHSA Nursing General Education Pre-Requisite Requirements (Texas Core)

AIS 12x3 (First-Year Experience) ***UTSA required course for all incoming freshman***

① **WRC 1013** (Composition I)
① **WRC 1023** (Composition II)
① **HIS 1043** (U.S. History I)
① **HIS 1053** (U.S. History II)
① **POL 1013** (American Govt)
① **POL 1133** (Texas Govt)
① Art Core (Any UTSA approved Art Core xxx3)
① **PHI 2013** or any school-approved course from the Language, Philosophy & Culture Core in your Degreeworks
① General Elective: any UTSA college level course will apply (e.g., AIS 12x3, BIO 1203/1233, CHE 1073 etc.)

All pre-requisites must be completed with grade C or better

Opt-in MDST-BSN Pathway Degree Plan Requirements^a (12 credit hours)

- **HTH 2413 or UCS 2033**
- **MDS 4983**
- **IS 1413 or 2053; CS 1063 or 1083 or 1173; DS 4003 or 4113 (choose one). IS 1413 recommended**
- **COM 1043 or 1053 or 2113 or 2343 or 2733; or ENG 2413 (choose one)**

^a These courses are required in addition to the nursing prerequisite coursework. Students who opt in to the MDST-BSN pathway must complete all nursing prerequisites and MDST courses at the UT San Antonio Main Campus. Any credit already earned through AP or dual credit coursework prior to enrollment at UT San Antonio is permitted.

MDST-BSN Eligibility Must have by time of application

- Min. 3.5 Pre-Requisite GPA
- Earn a minimum score of 84 on TEAS
- All **bolded** Math/Science courses completed prior to application
- By time of application, have completed 51 of 60 pre-requisite hours (this includes the math & science hours).
- **no more than 9 hours from non-math/science pre-requisites may be in-progress or planned at time of application.**

Application Deadlines *Fall entry: Feb 1*
Spring entry: Aug 1

NOTE: The courses on this handout align specifically to UT San Antonio School of Nursing BSN program, however students are encouraged to consider applying to multiple nursing school programs.

If you plan to apply to other BSN programs please know that some pre-requisites courses and application requirements referred to on this handout may change as each school determines their own pre-requisite courses and application requirements (including minimum GPA's; Entrance Exam required, etc.)

The MDST-BSN pathway allows students to earn a second bachelor's degree after the completion of their BSN at UT San Antonio School of Nursing. Students who have completed the optional 12 hours of MDST courses at UT San Antonio main campus before starting nursing school and meet the MDST-BSN eligibility requirements, will earn a B.S. in Multidisciplinary Studies once the School of Nursing transcript confirms that the BSN degree has been awarded.

^① courses indicated will count toward the minimum 3.0 UTHSA BSN pre-requisite GPA required to apply to the traditional track BSN program.
