

HEERF Student Funds Reporting from January 1, 2021, to March 31, 2021

The University of Texas at San Antonio acknowledges that it has signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that it will use the applicable amounts of Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) I, II, and III designated under the CARES Act, Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act, and American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, signed into law by Presidents Donald Trump and Joe Biden, to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

The total amount of HEERF I, II, The University of Texas at San Antonio will allocate for distributions to students is \$29,656,888.00 The total student portion of each individual HEERF allocation is listed below:

- HEERF I - \$14,828,444
- HEERF II - \$14,828,444

As of March 31, 2021, The University of Texas at San Antonio has distributed \$14,828,444 For the quarter ranging January 1, 2021, to March 31, 2021, the total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed \$2,353,882.00 to 1458 students out 28,877 eligible students

HEERF Student Portion Method of Award

Students in need of funds were asked to complete an institutional application. All eligible applicants were awarded funds. Applicants were prioritized for awards based on:

- Must be enrolled for Spring 2021
- Must have a good FAFSA on file
- Must be Financial Aid eligible
- Must be degree seeking
- Must be in good Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Cannot be in default
- Must not have any outstanding Financial Aid C-Flags
- Must not have any Financial Aid holds
- Cannot be solely in an online program
- Award amounts for spring 2021 up to \$1500.
