Note on Reporting of SAT Scores:

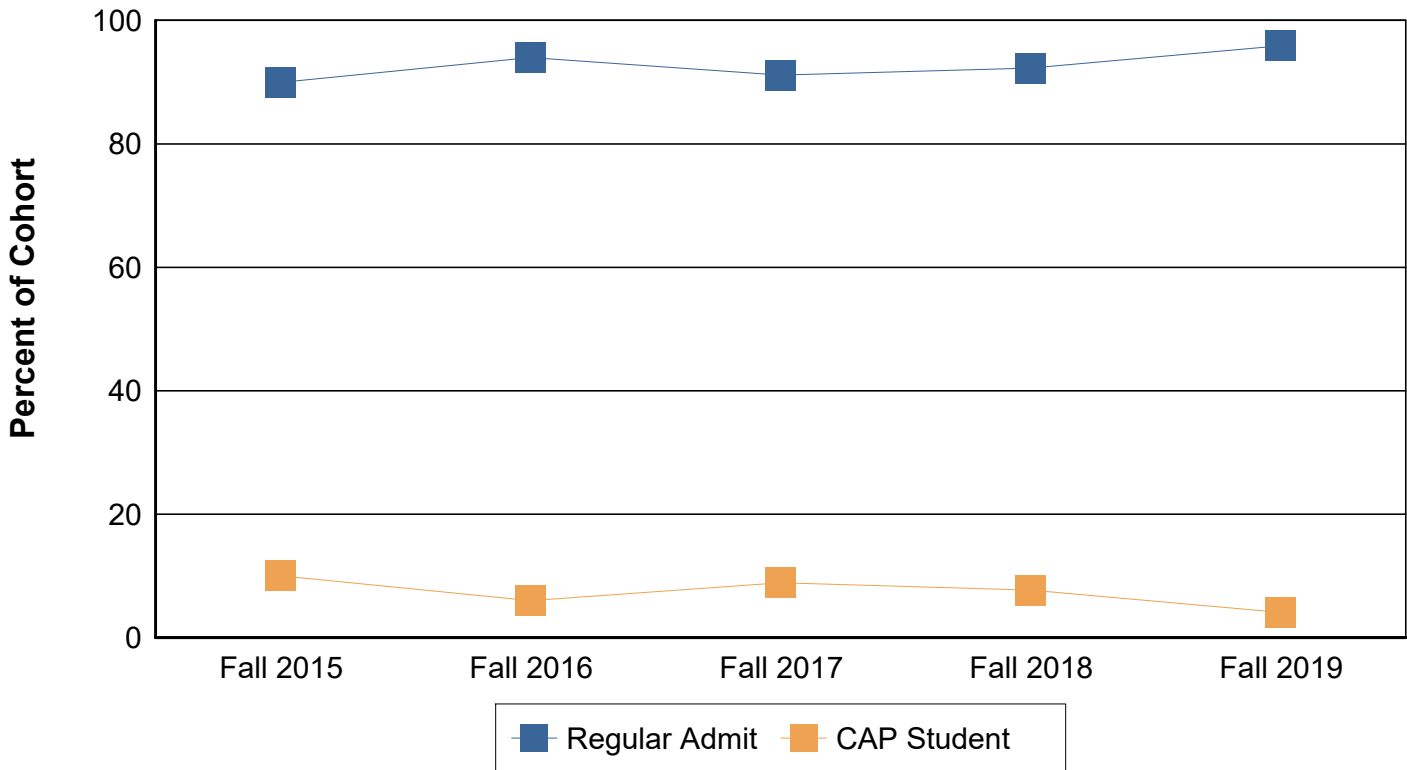

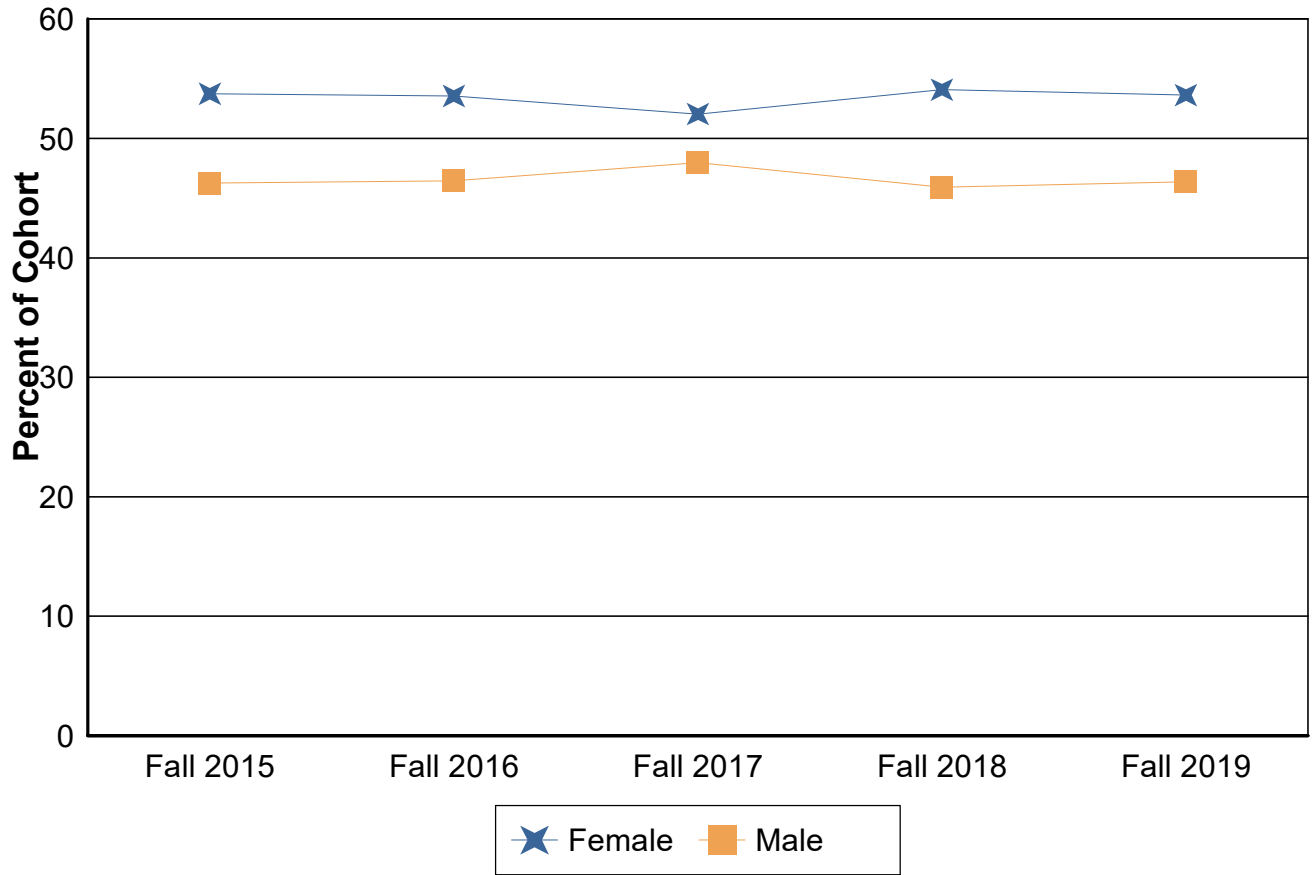
UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Admission Type

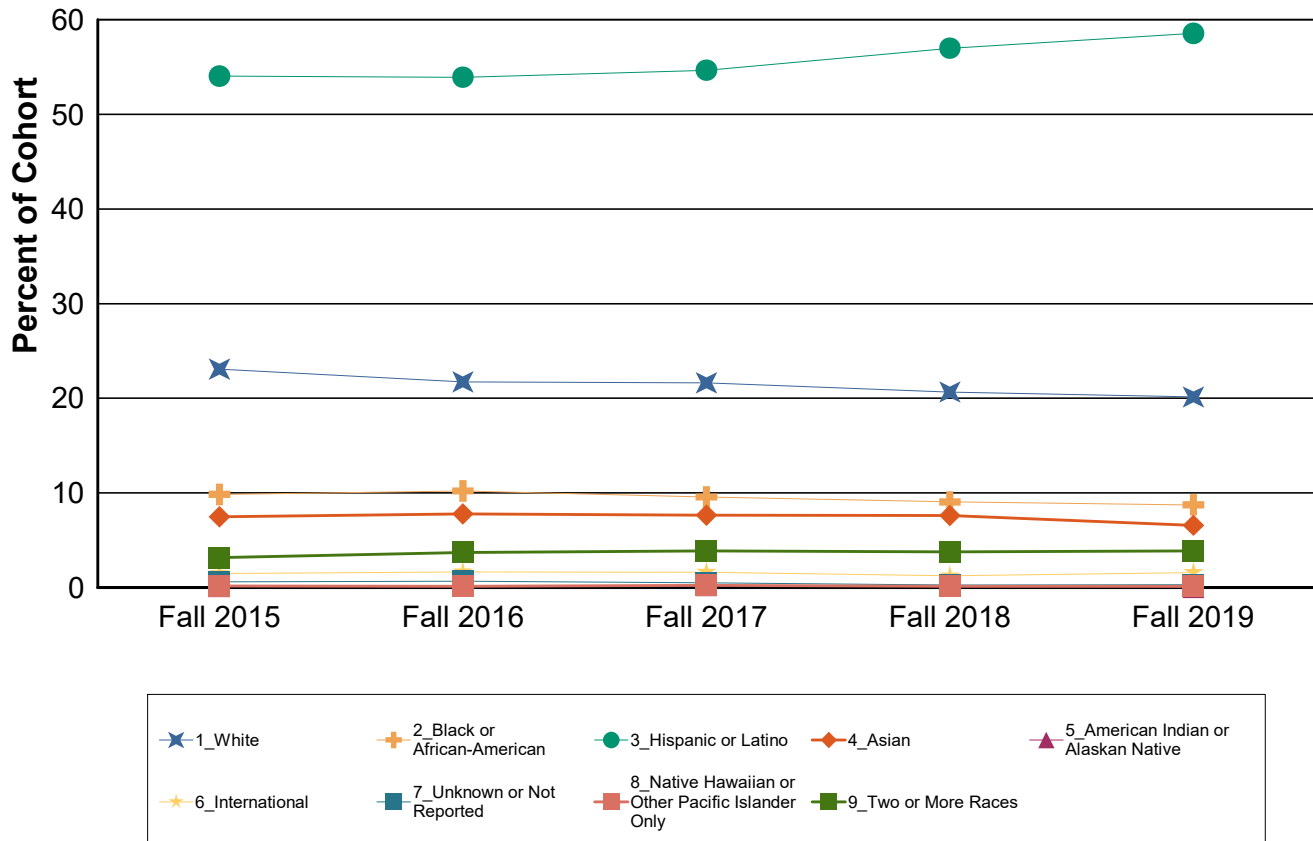

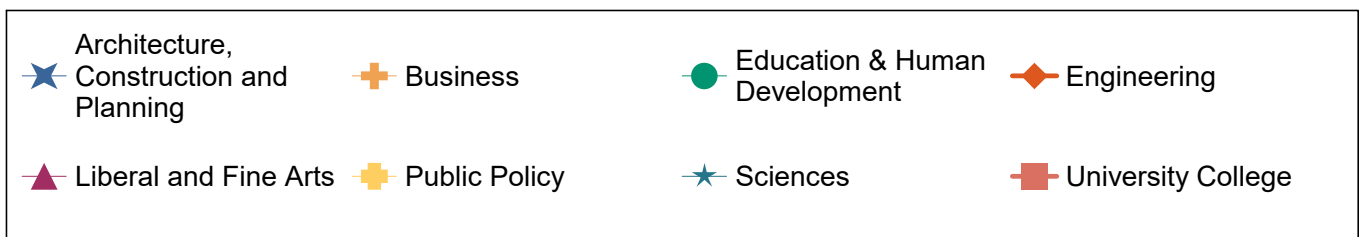

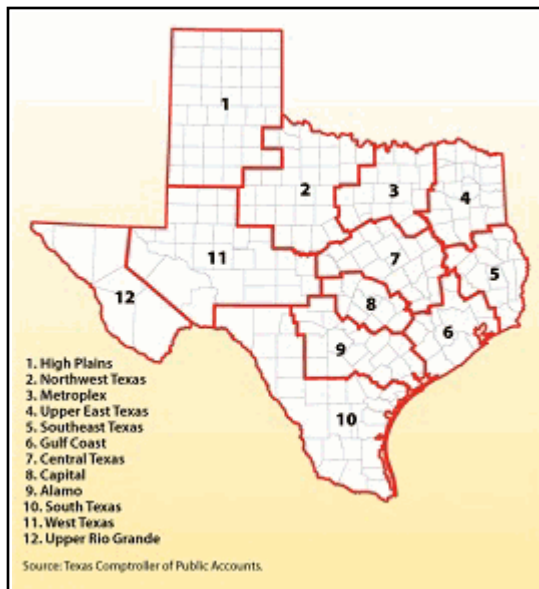

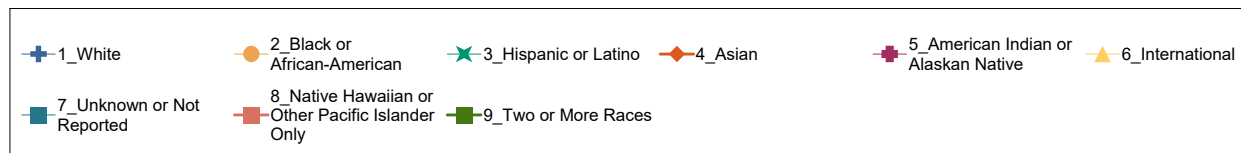

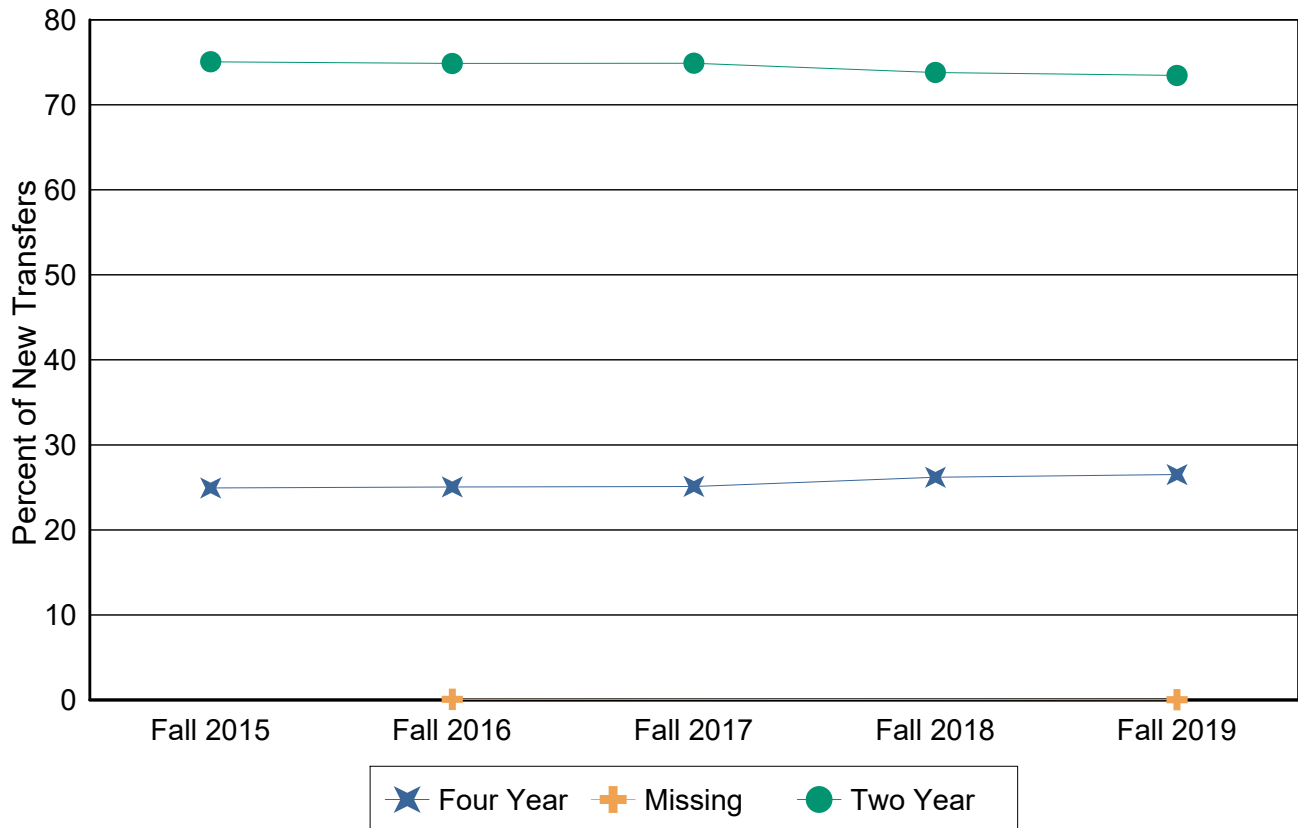
UTSA Transfer Students by Ethnicity

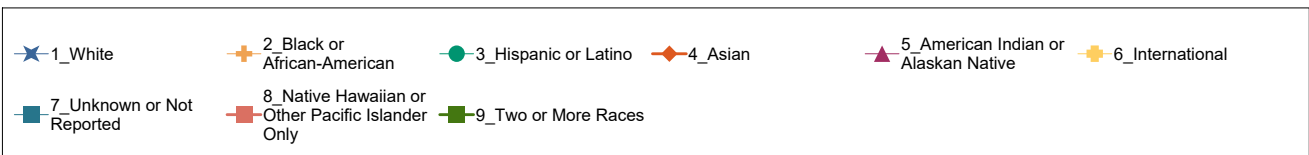

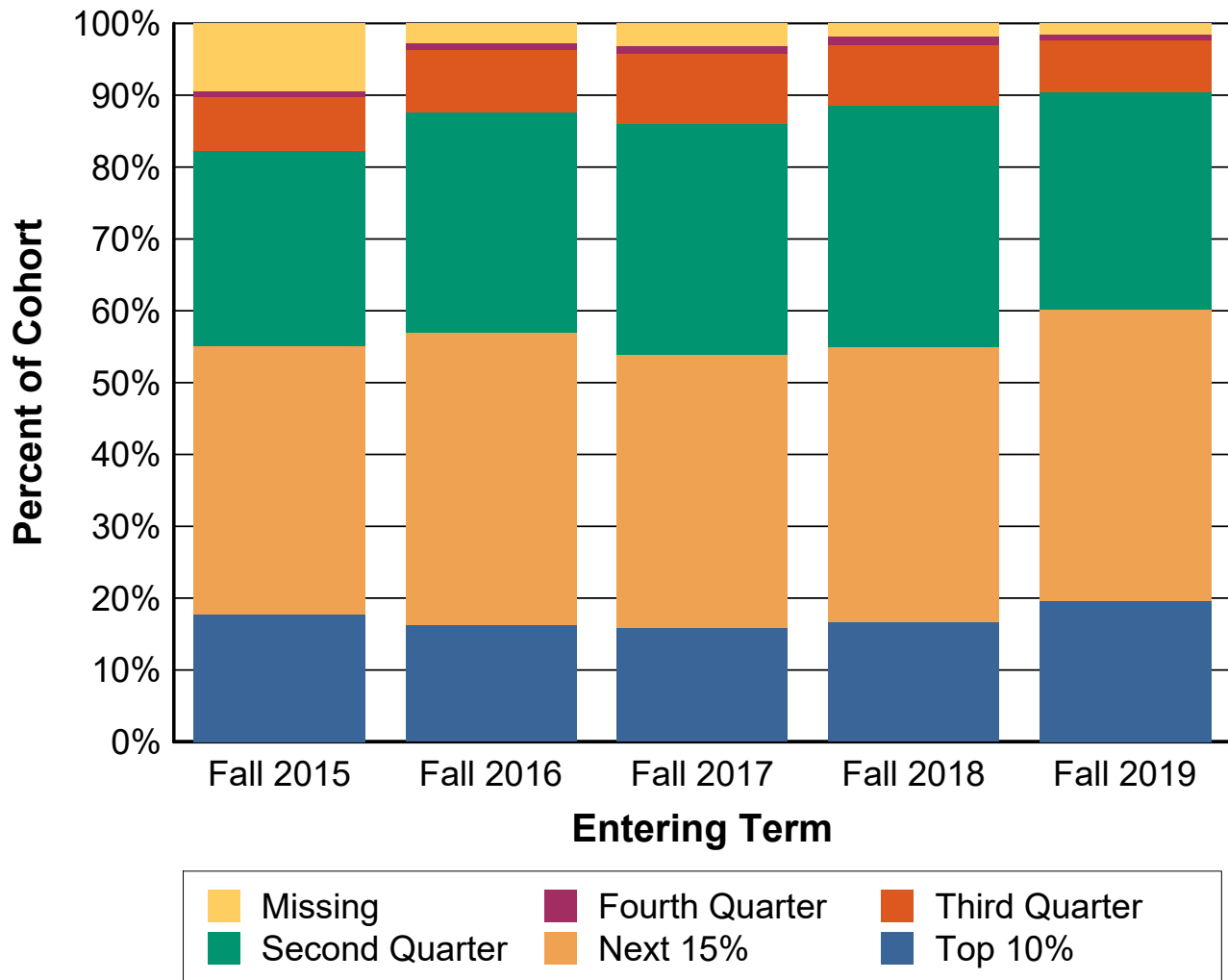

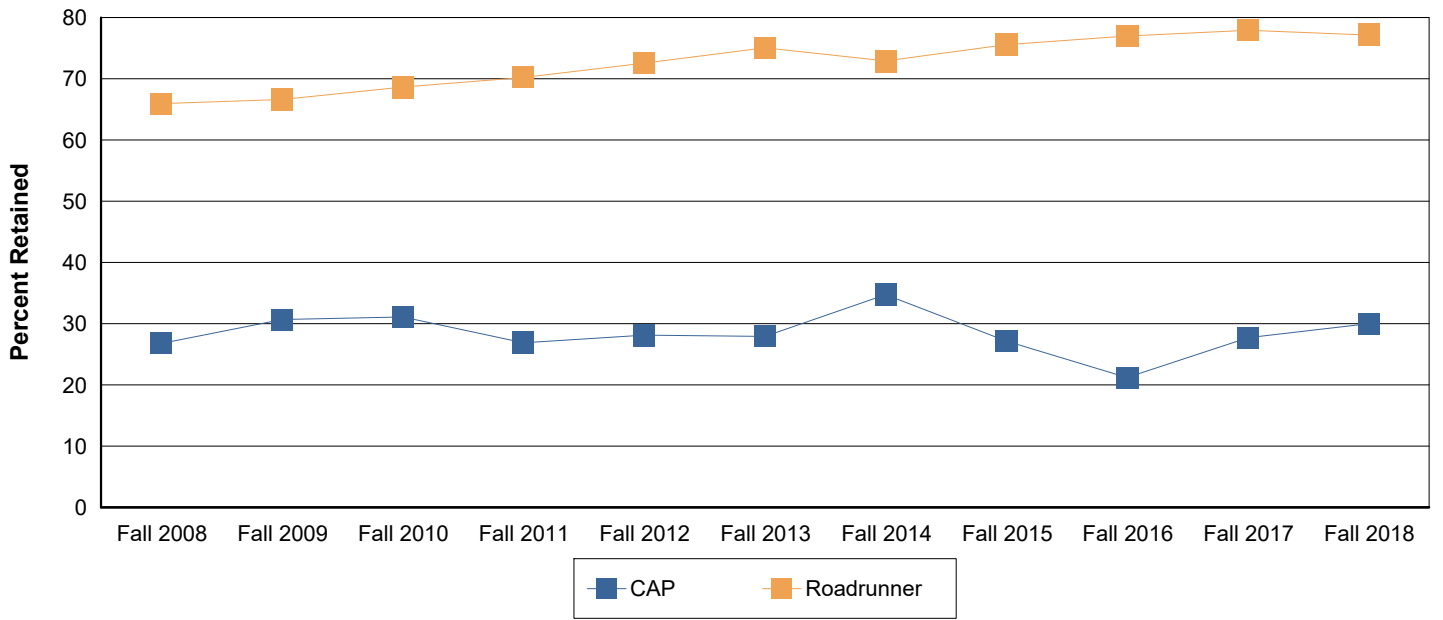
