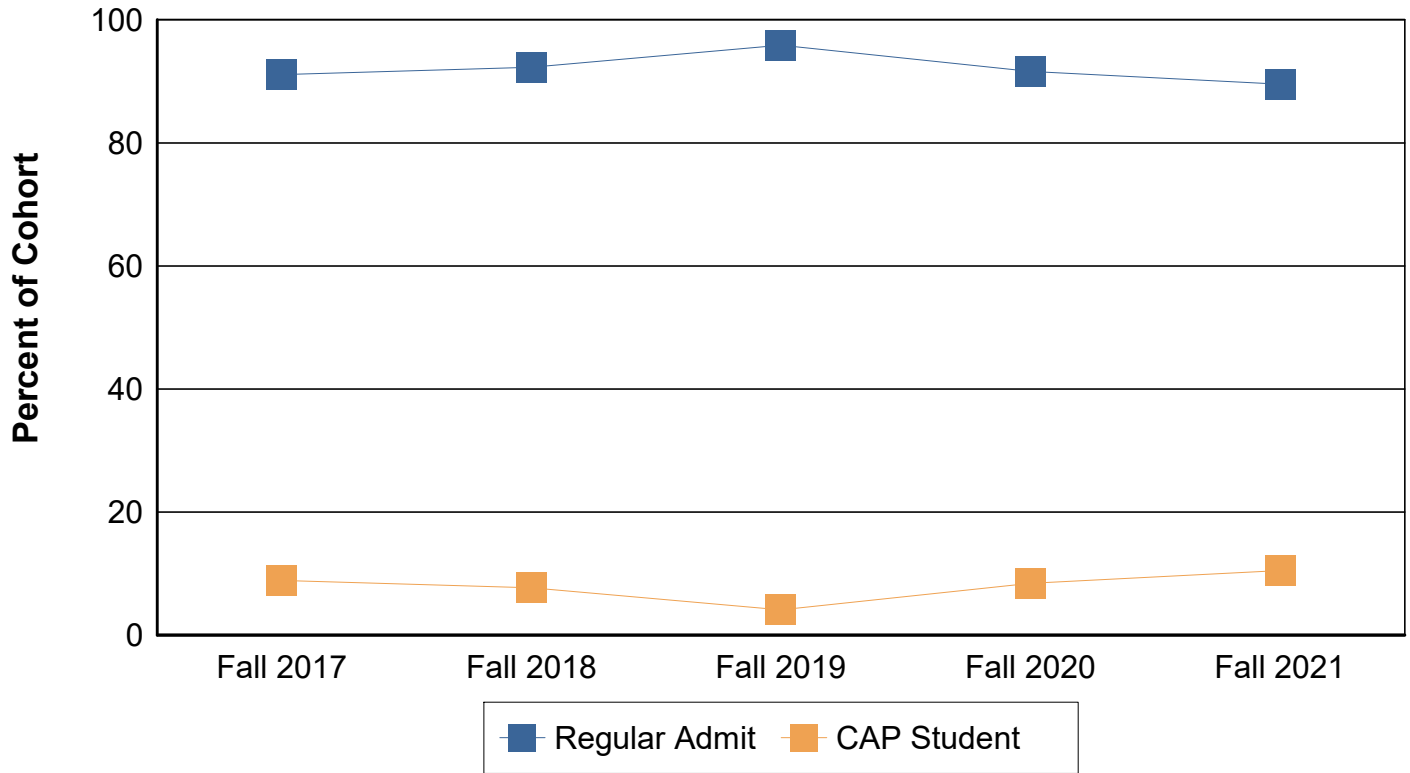

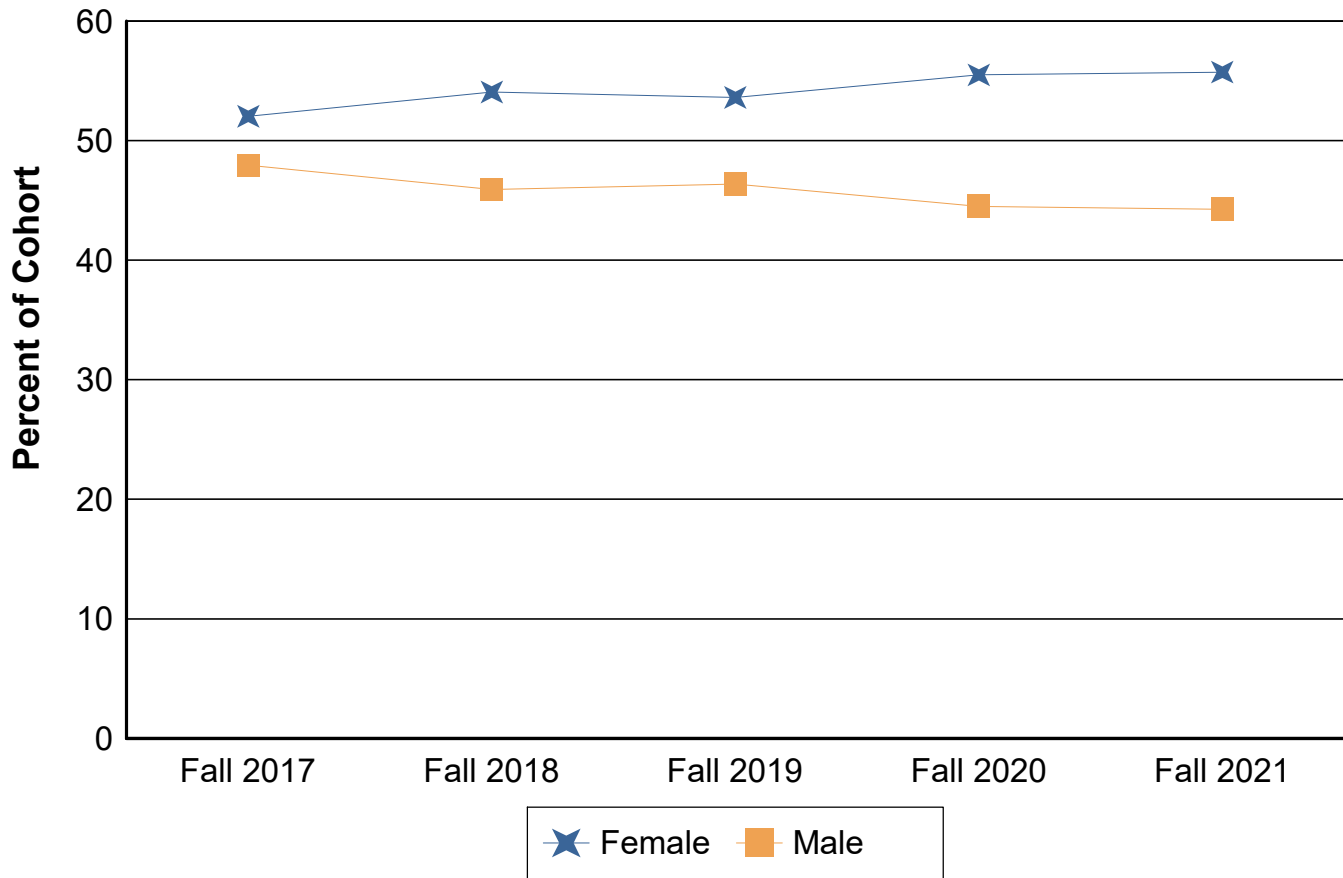
## UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Admission Type

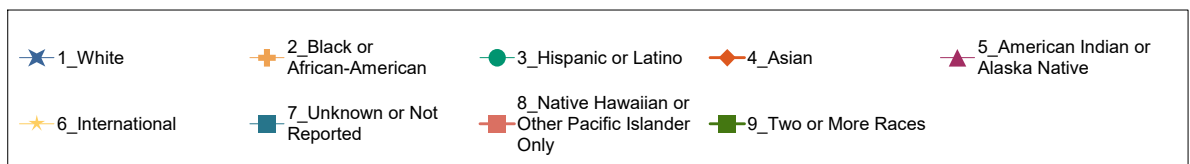

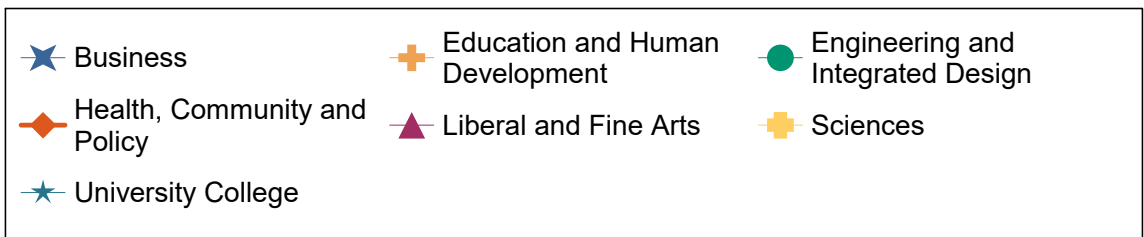
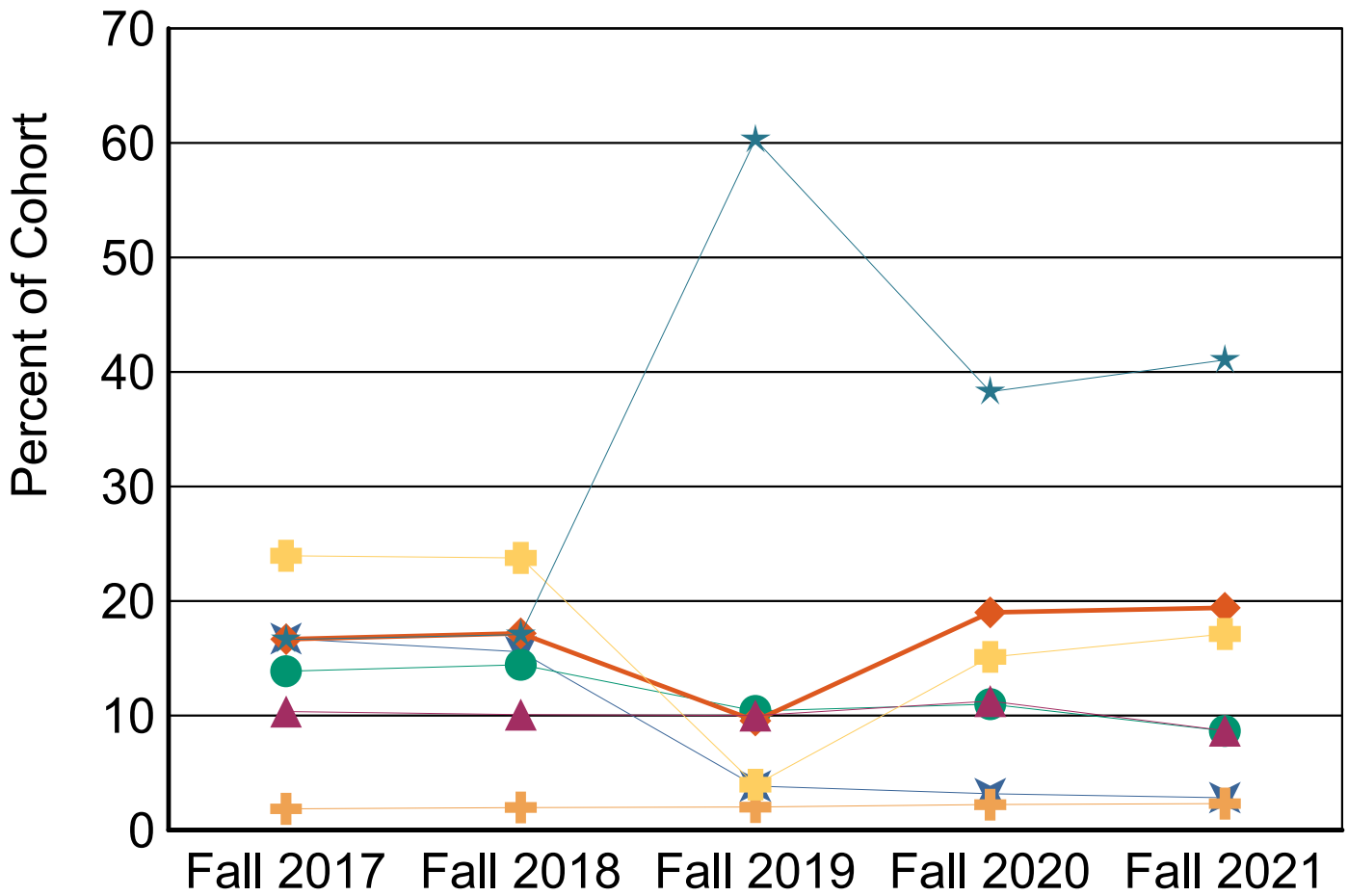

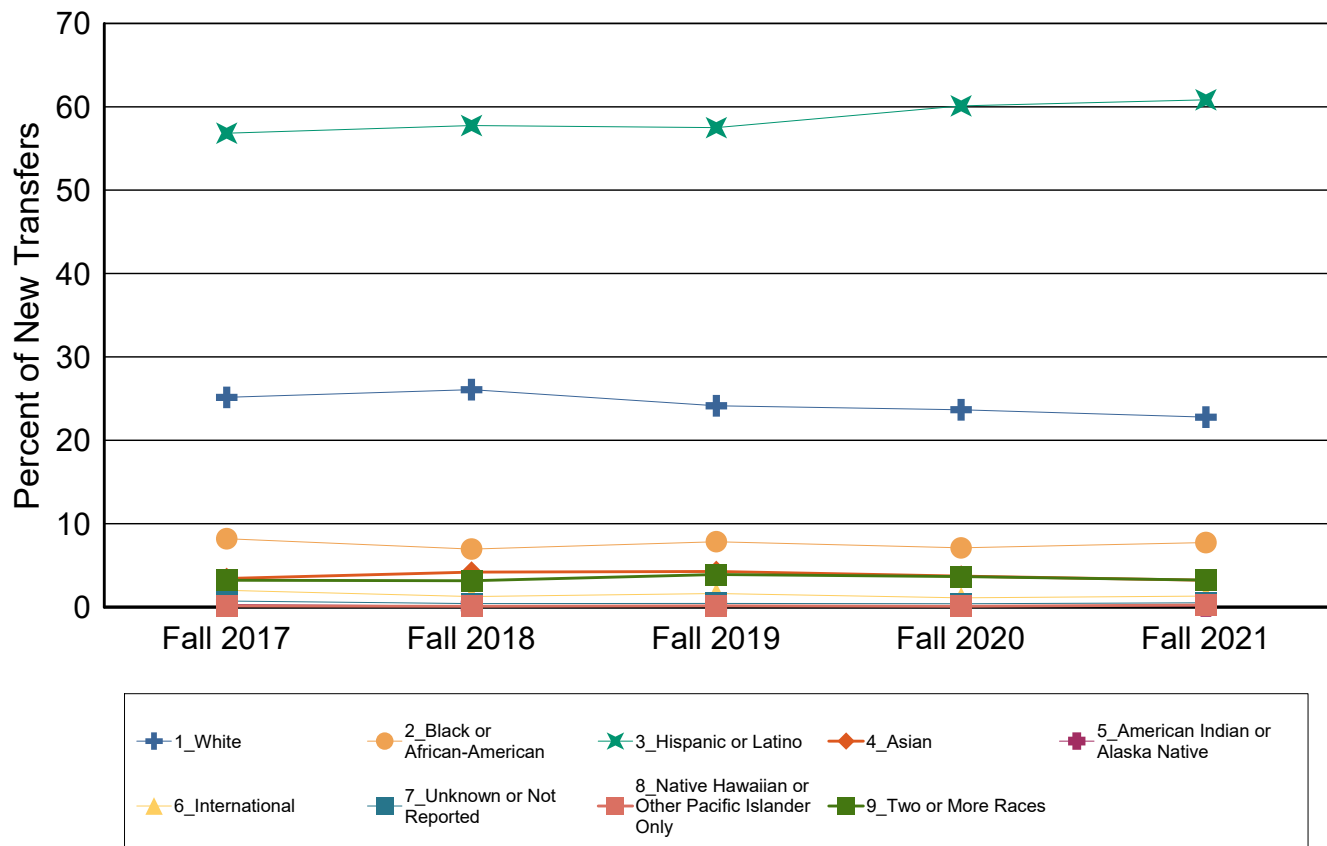

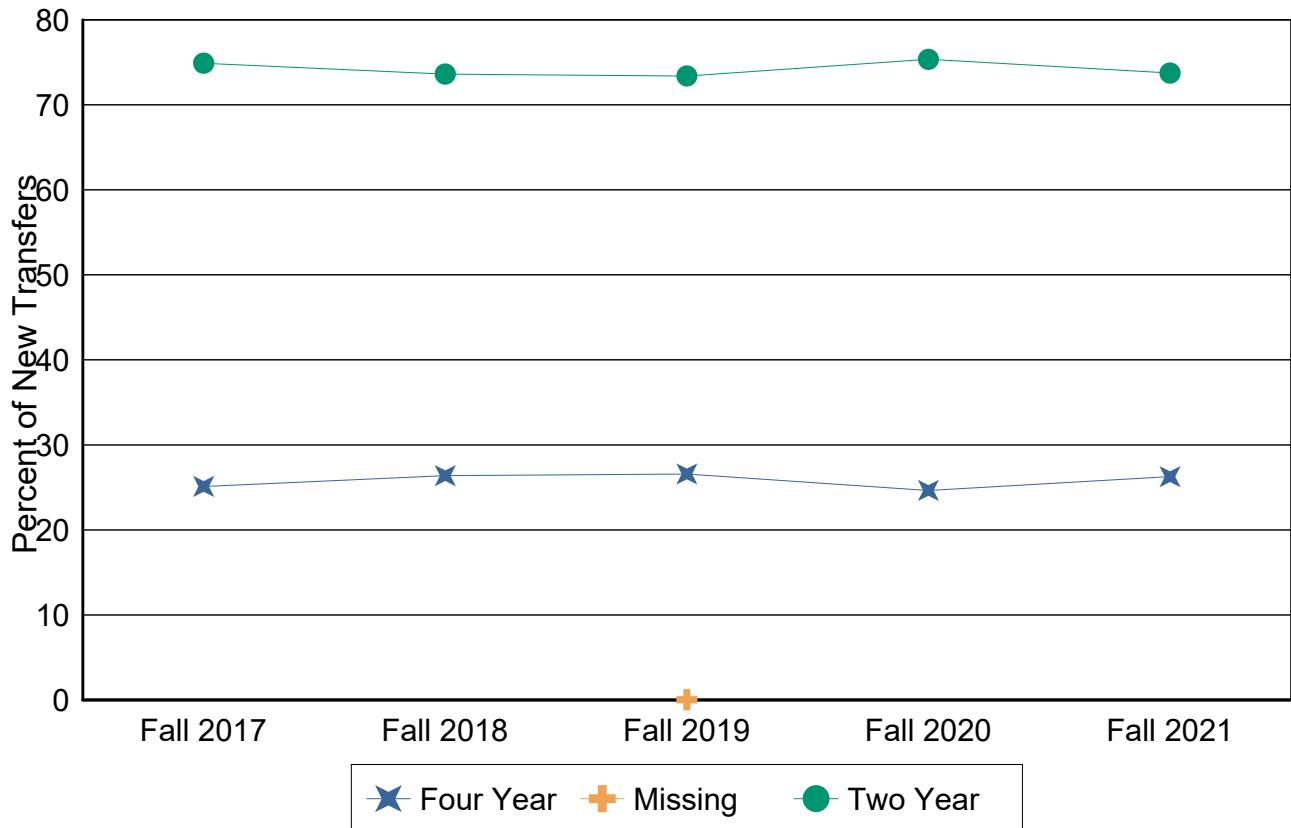

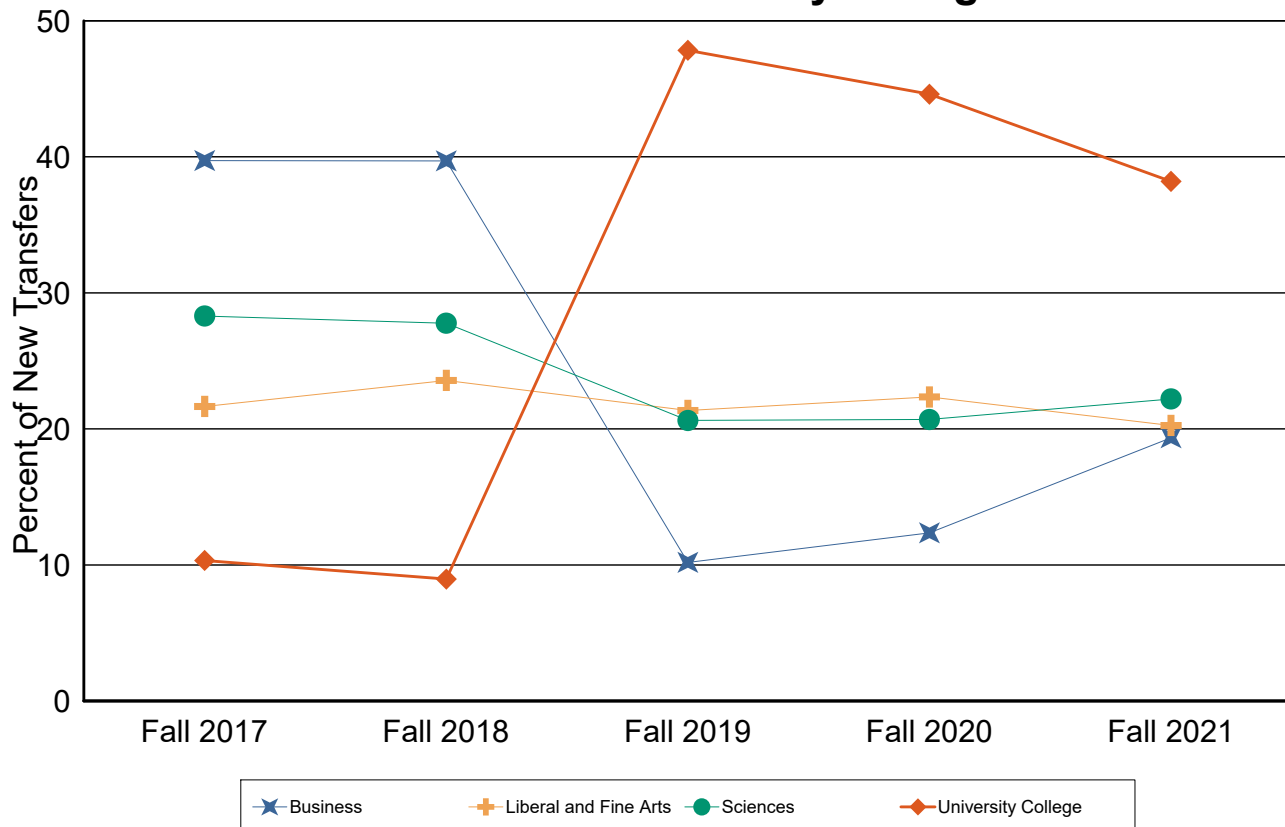

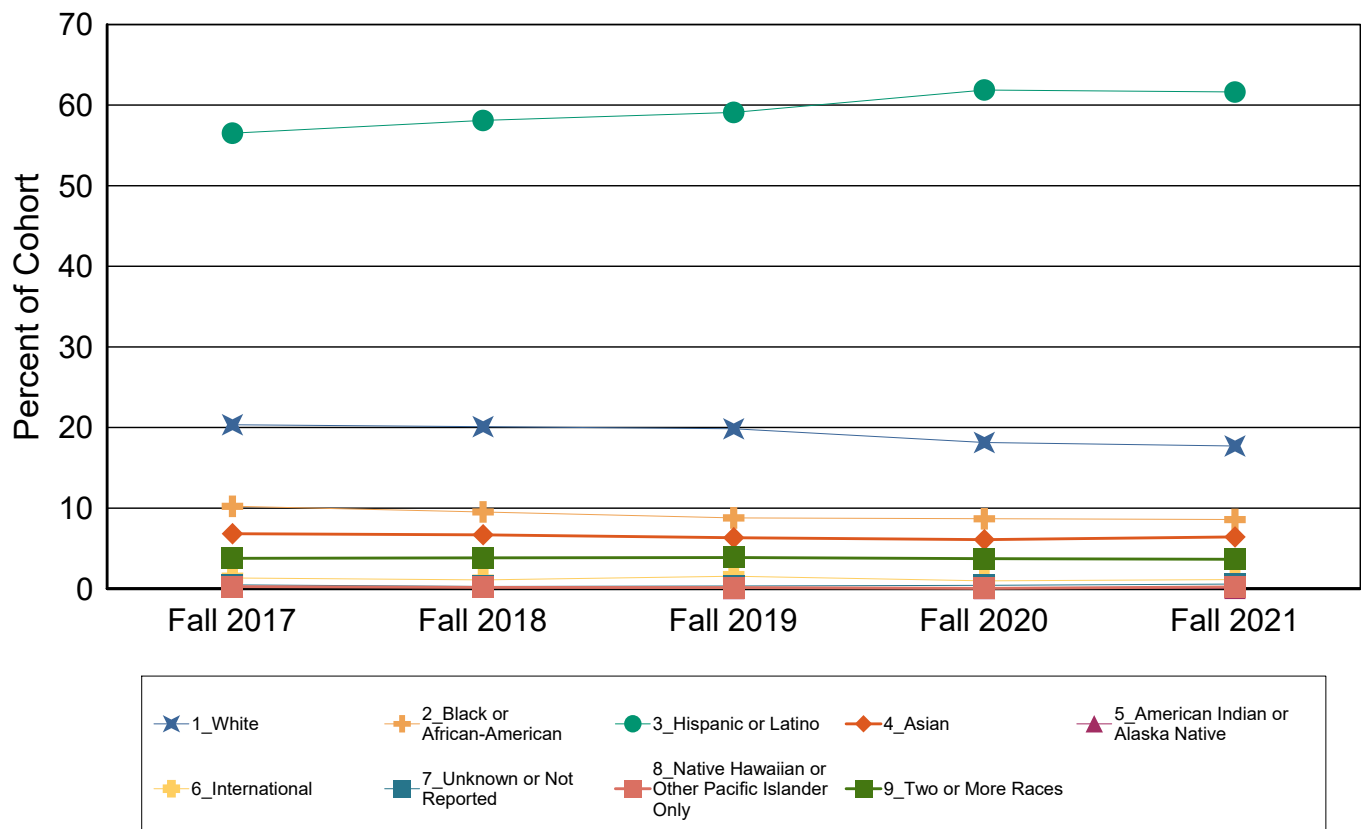

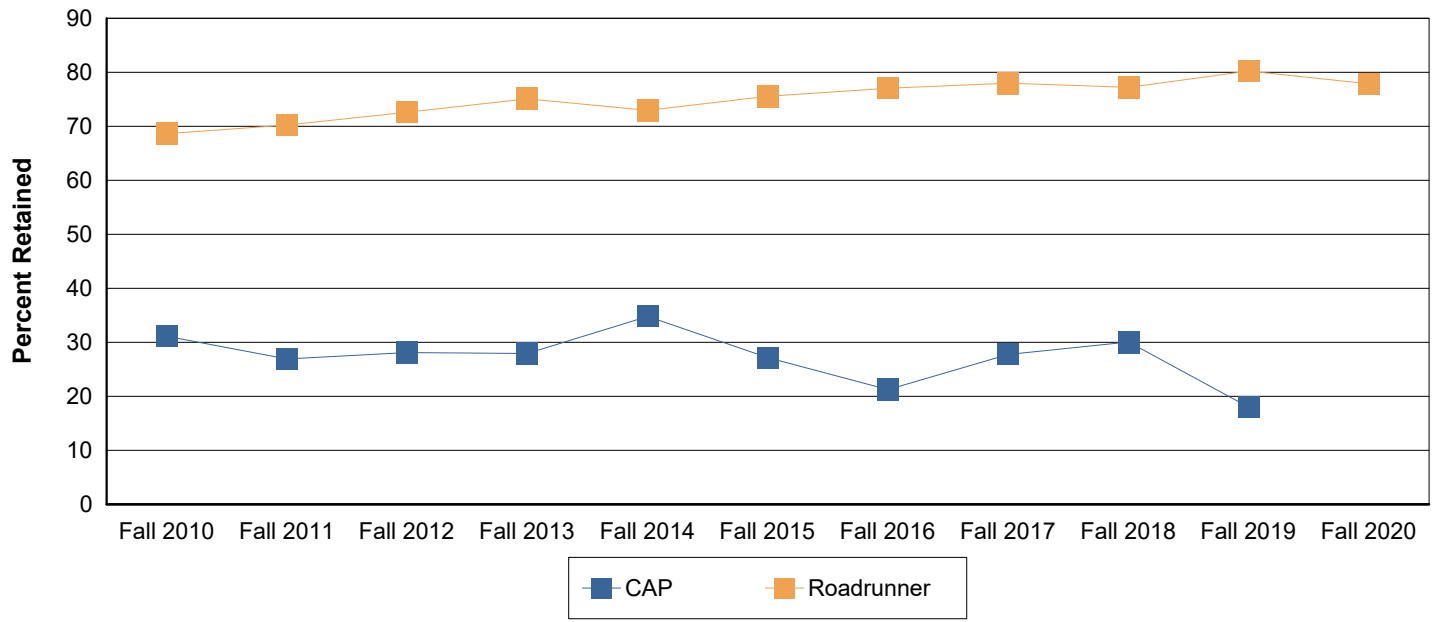
