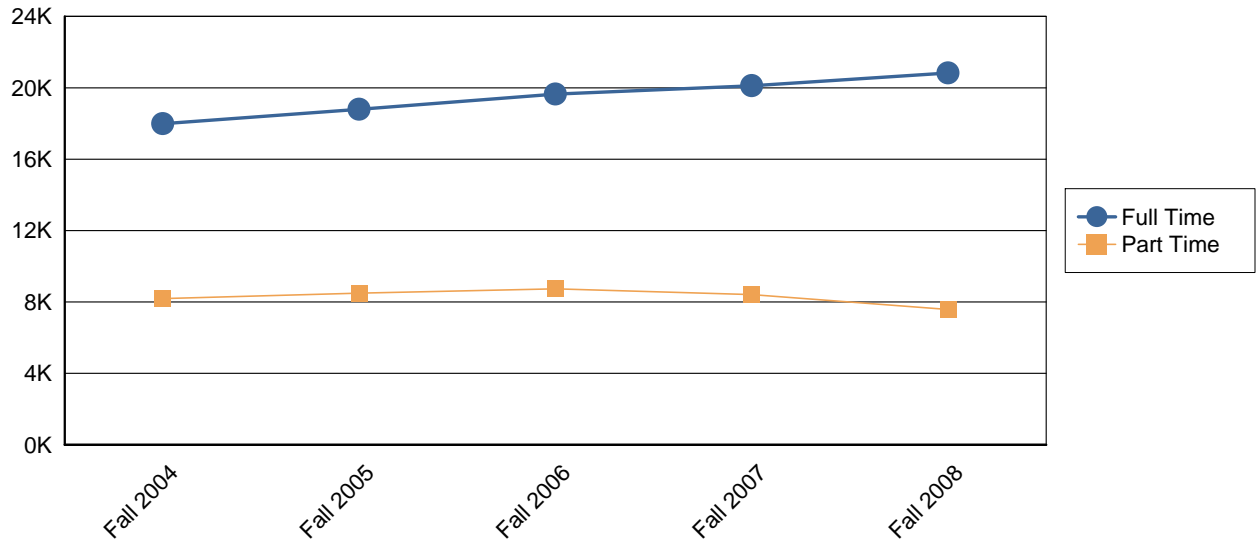

Enrollment by Course Load



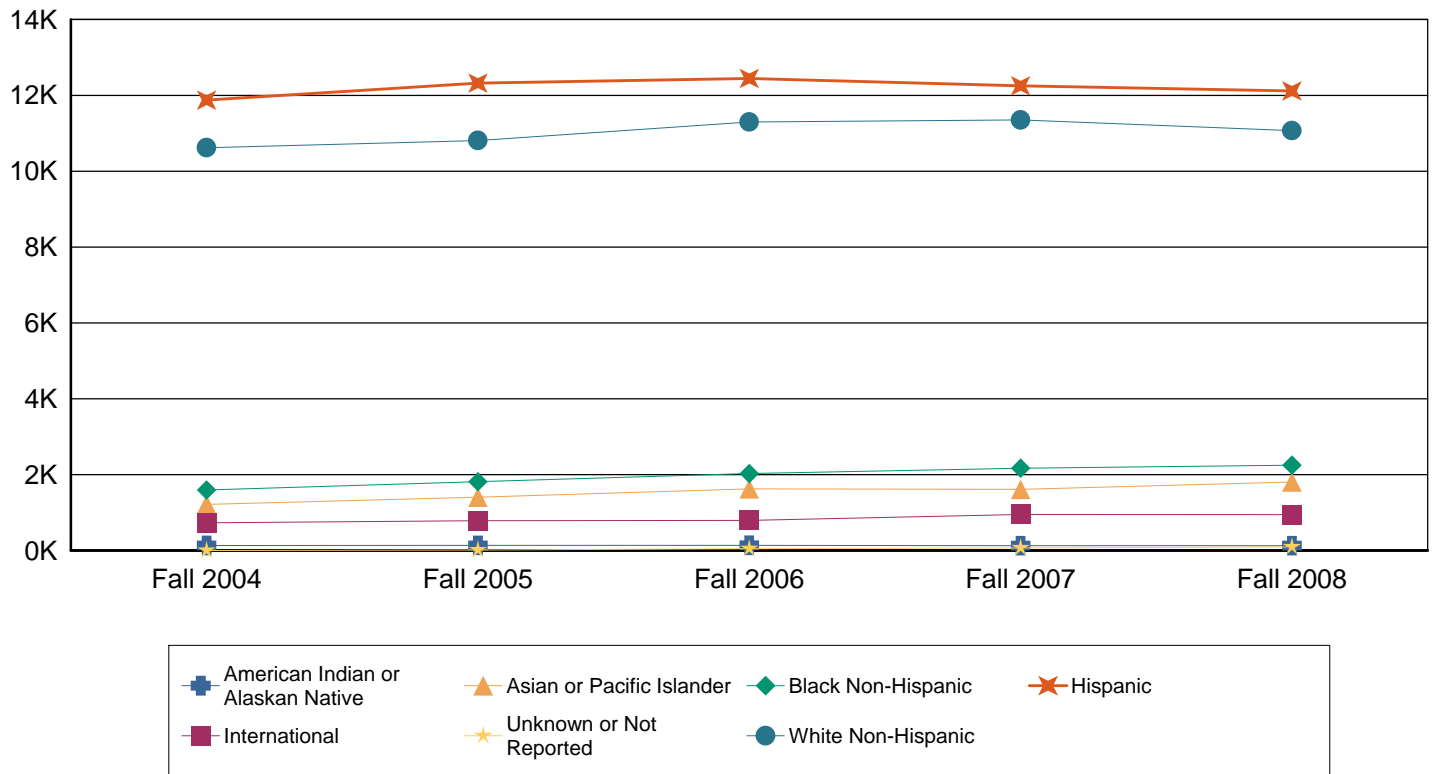

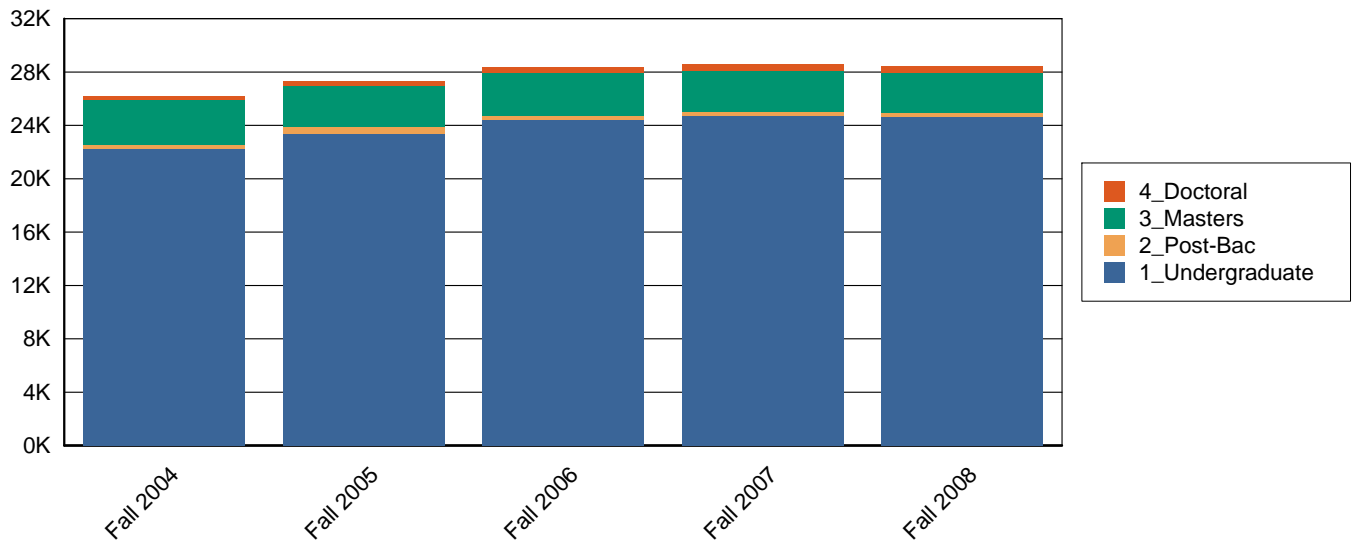

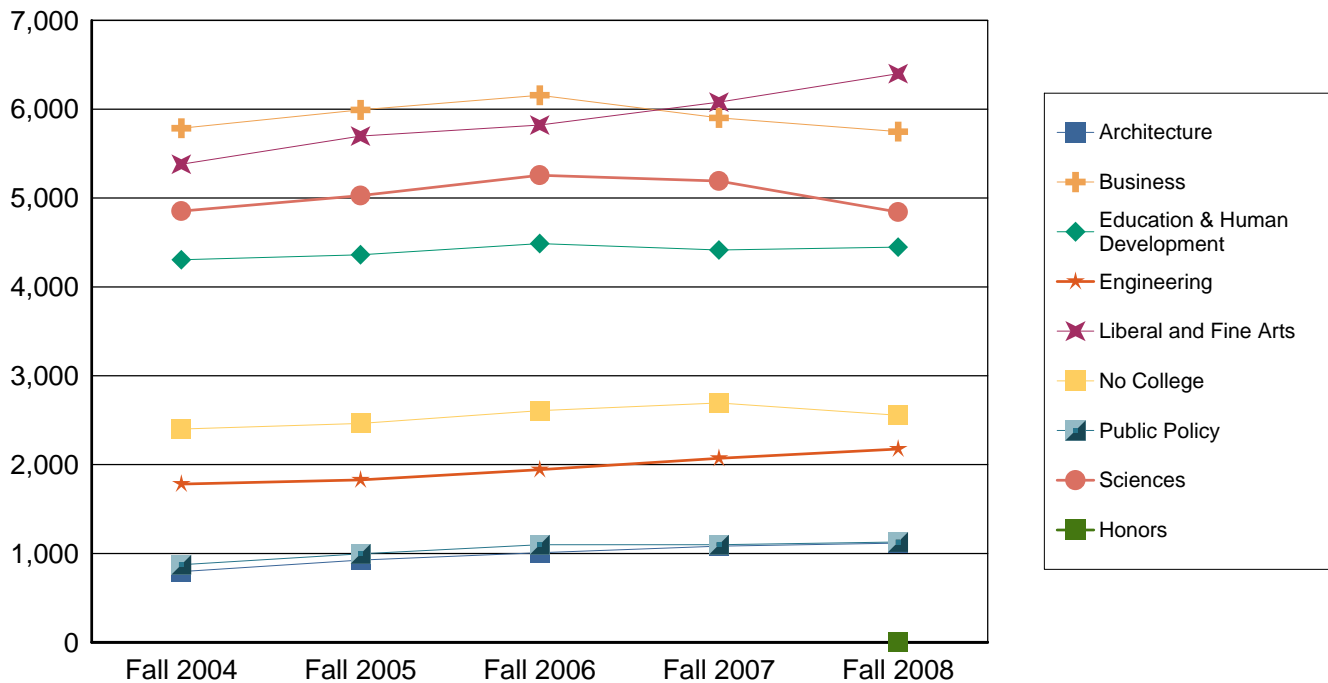

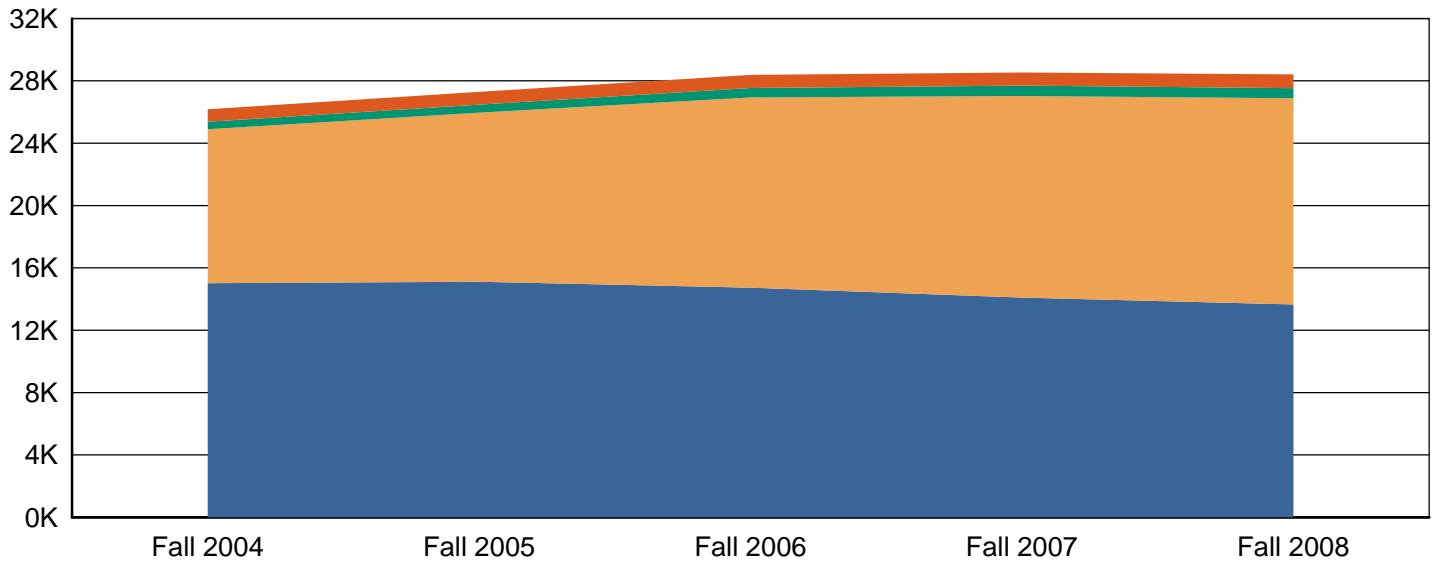
Enrollment by College

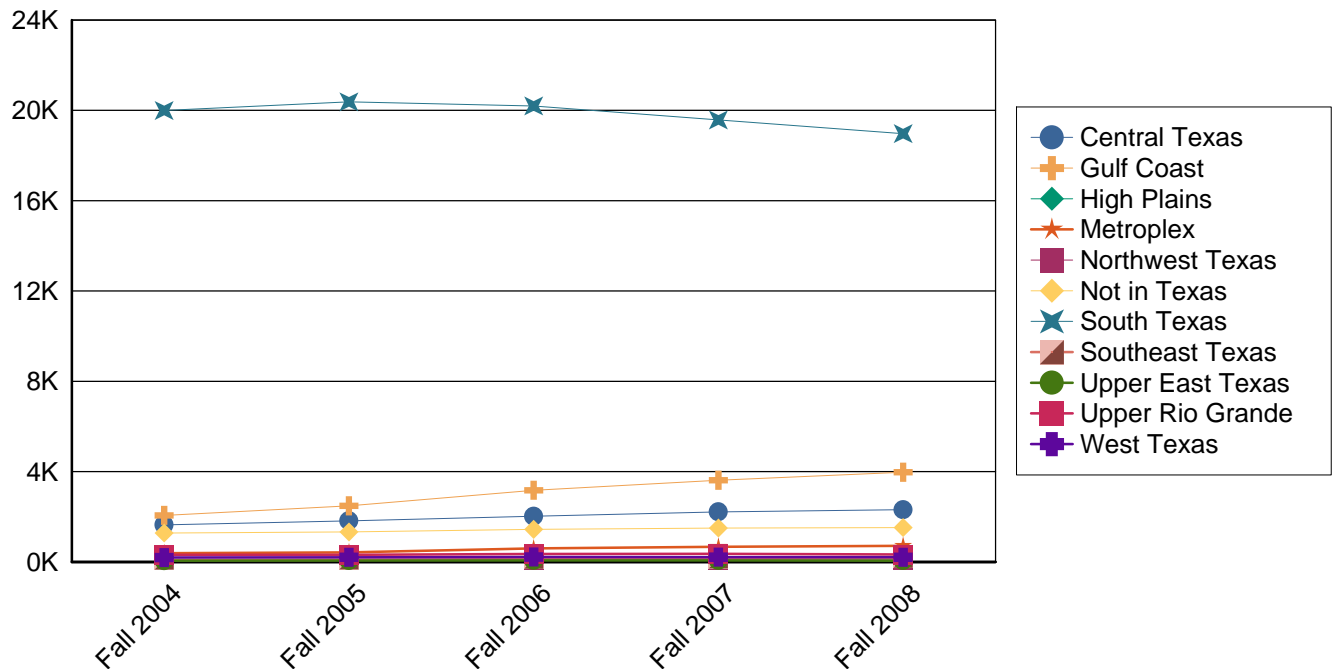
Enrollment by Residence

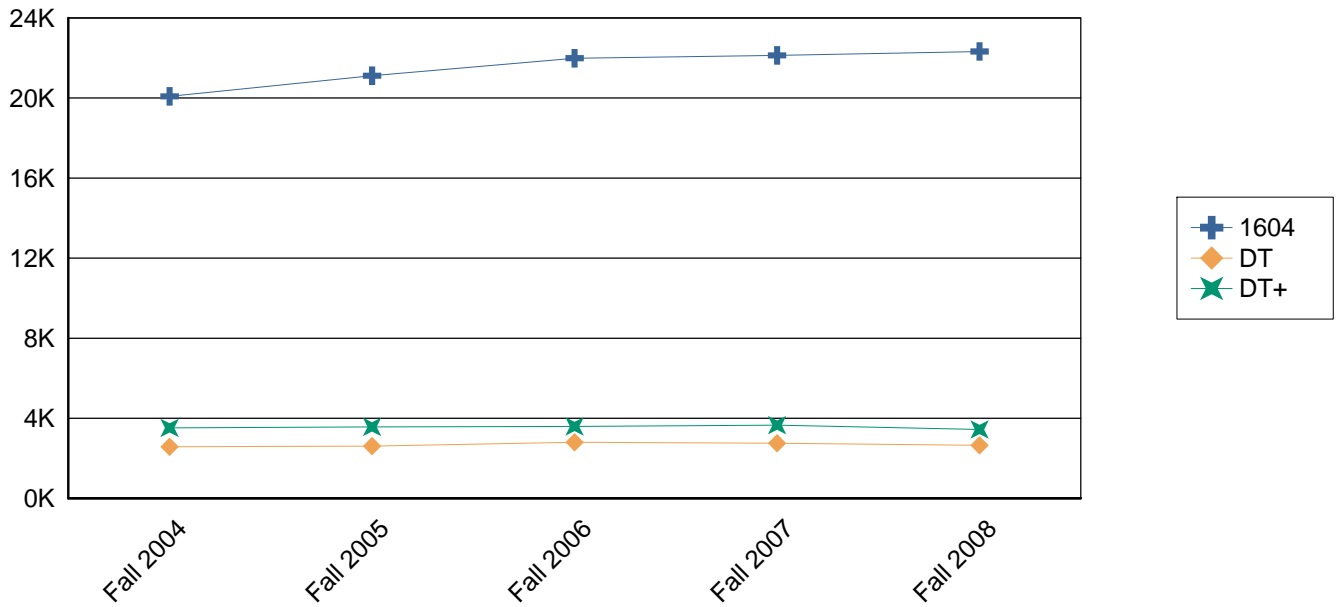
Enrollment by Economic Region

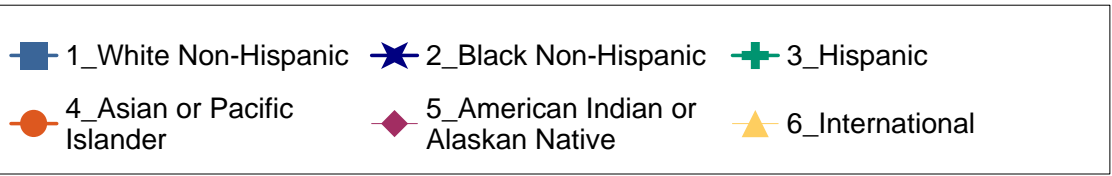
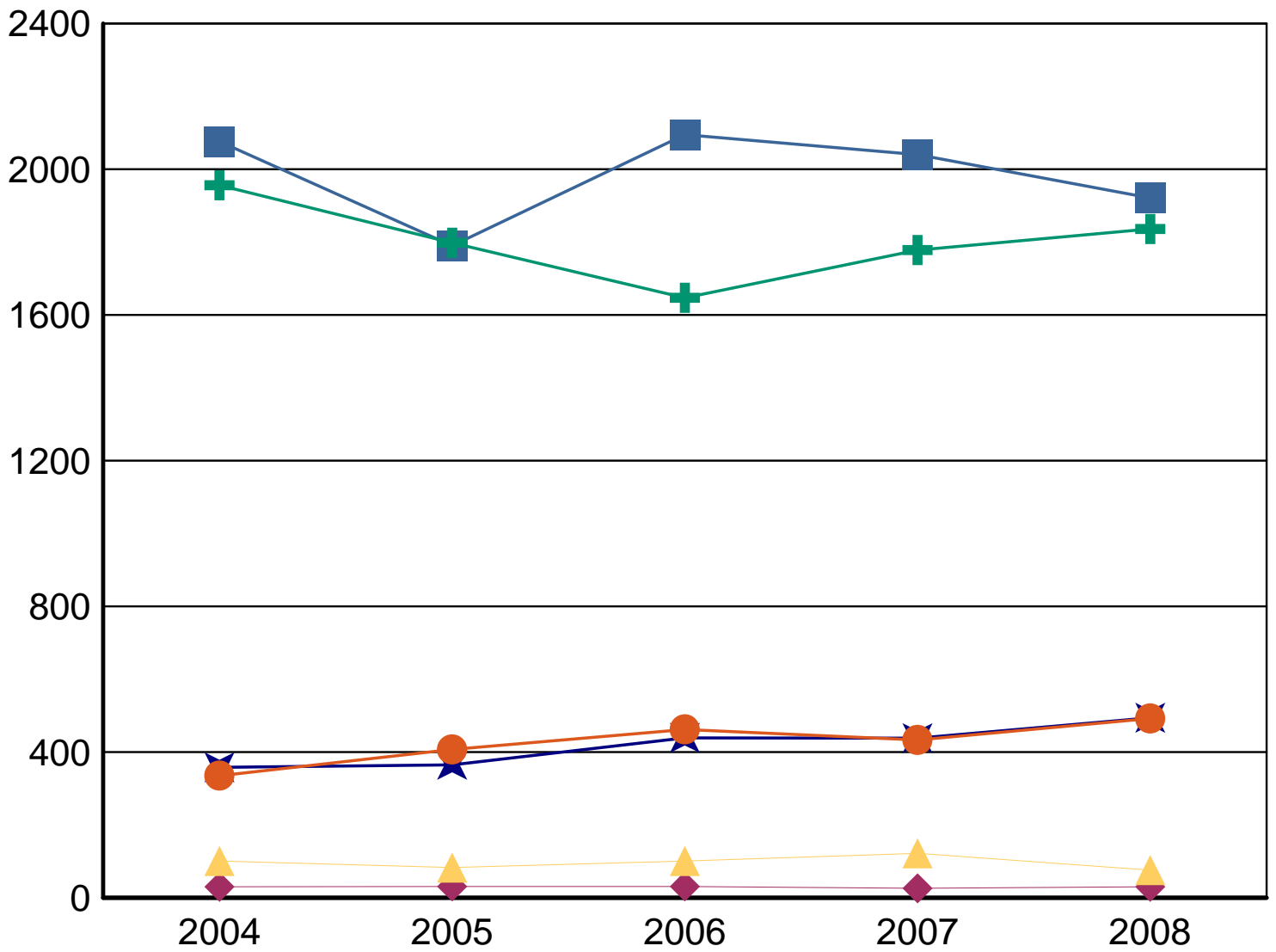
Number of New First Time Undergraduates Applied

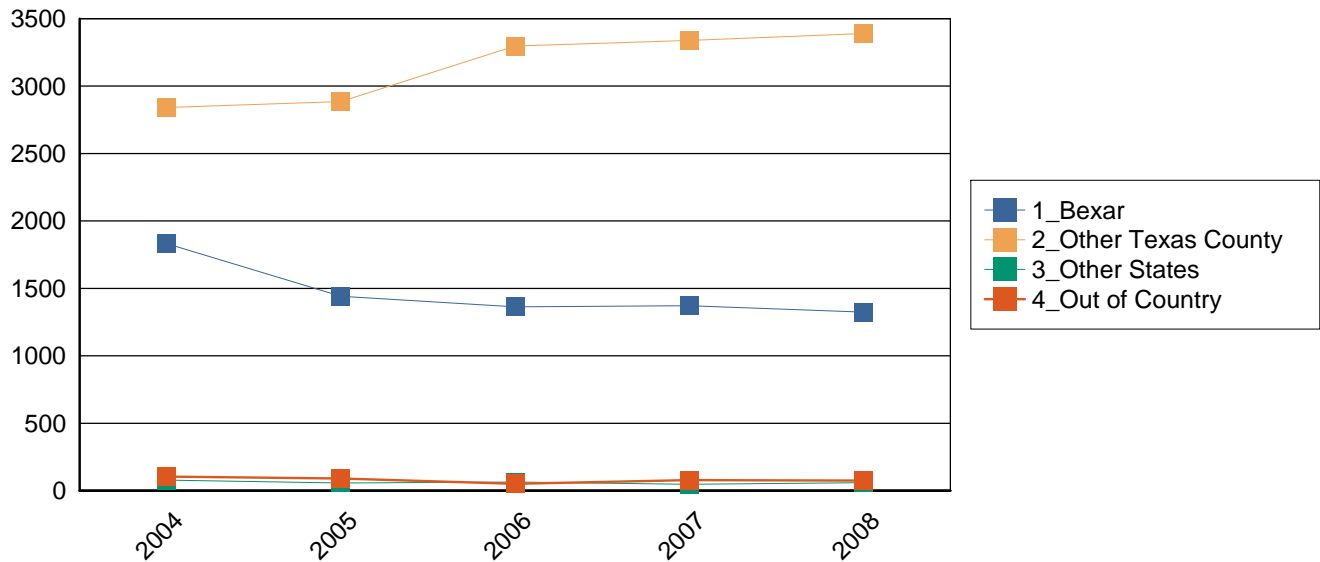

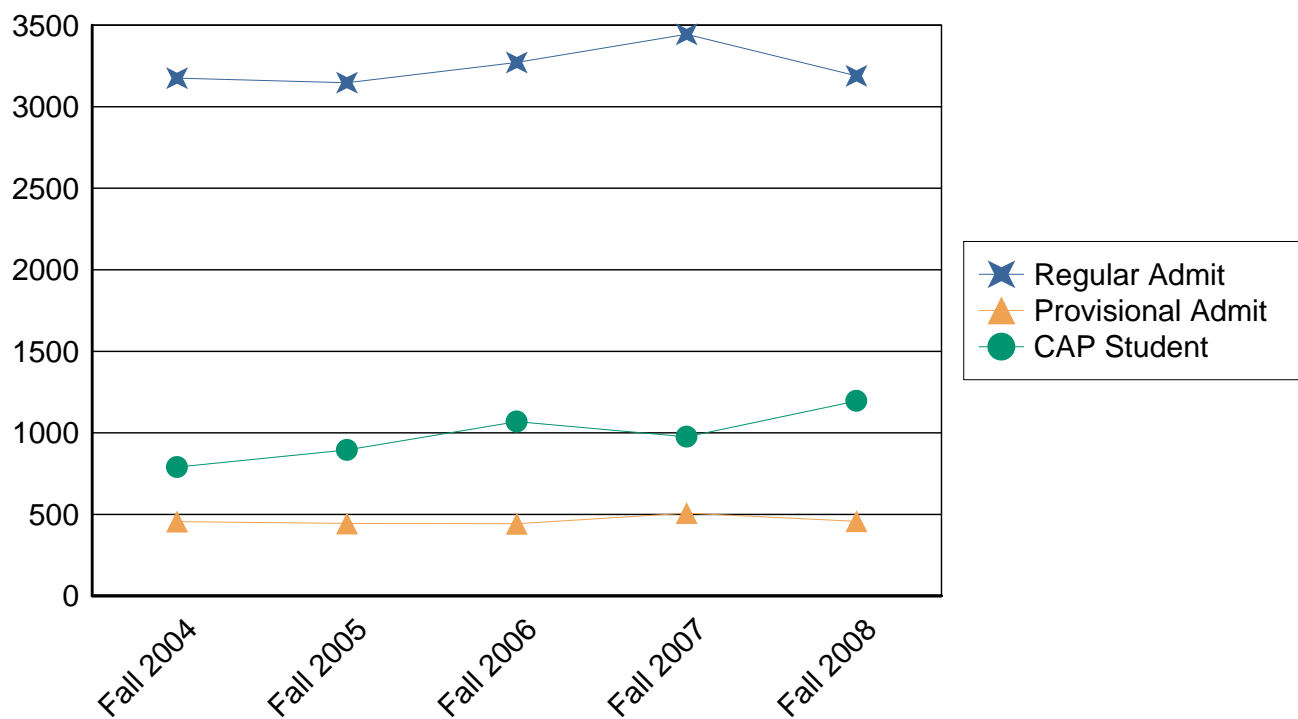

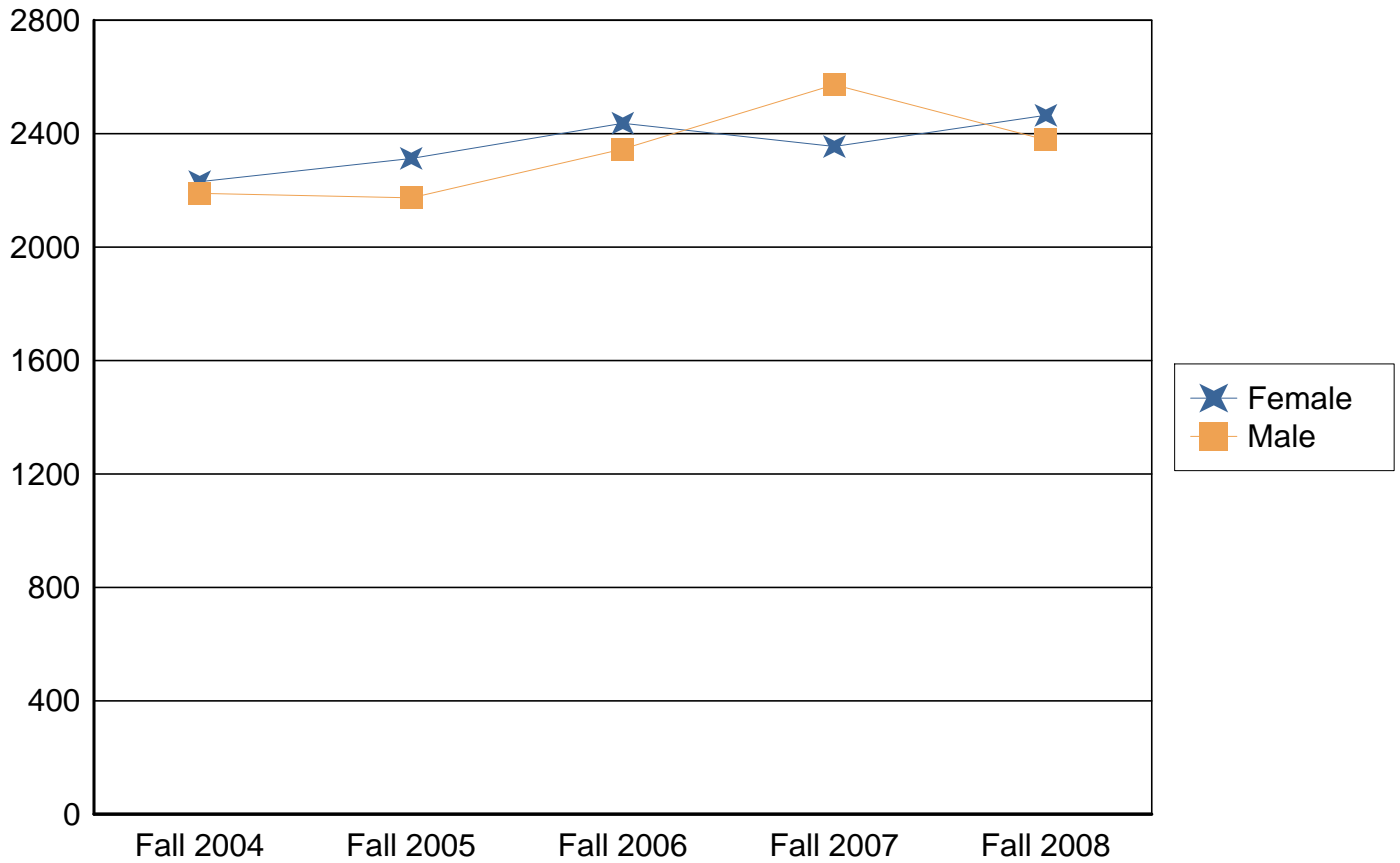
New Students by Admission Type

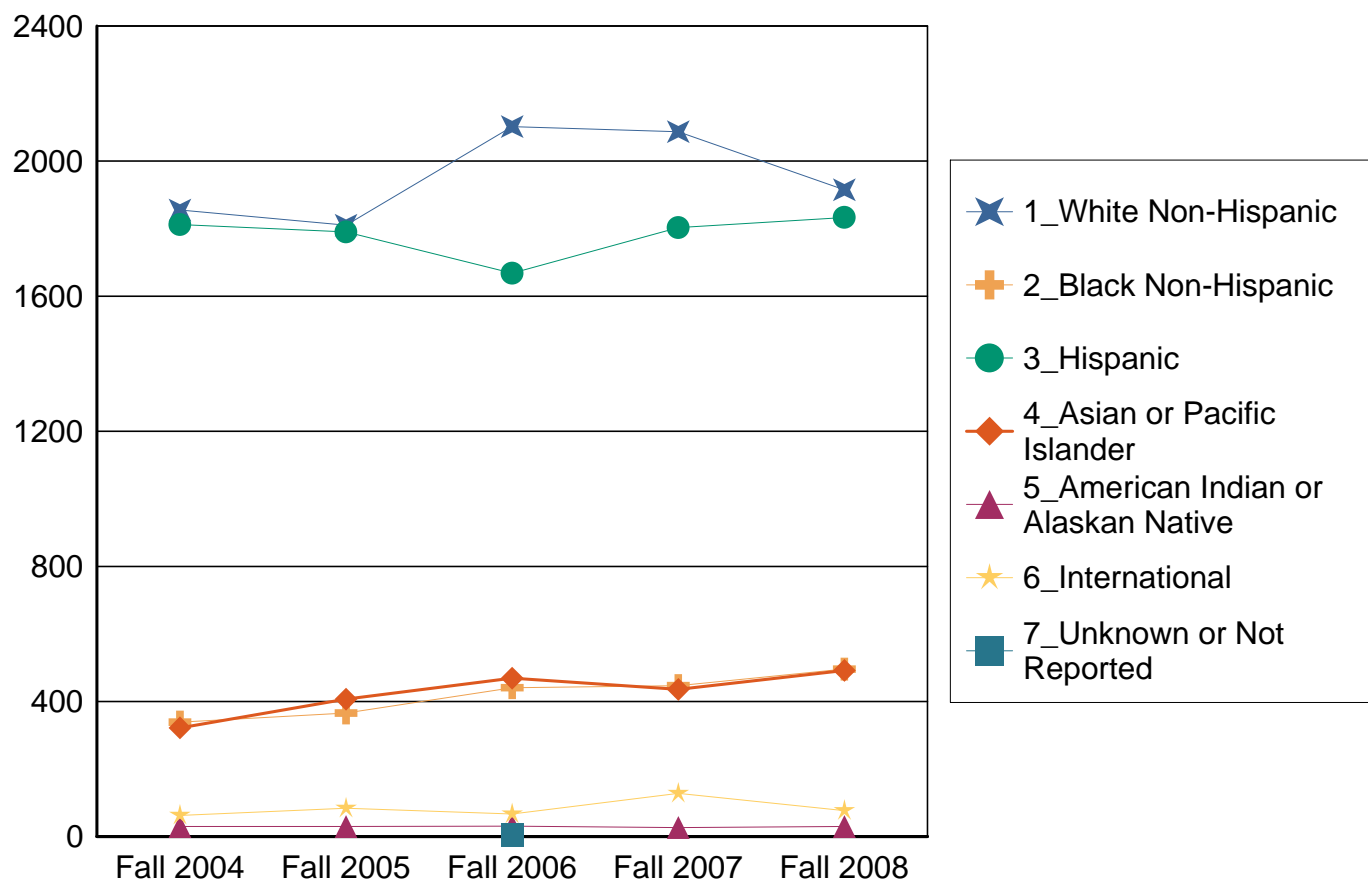
UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Gender

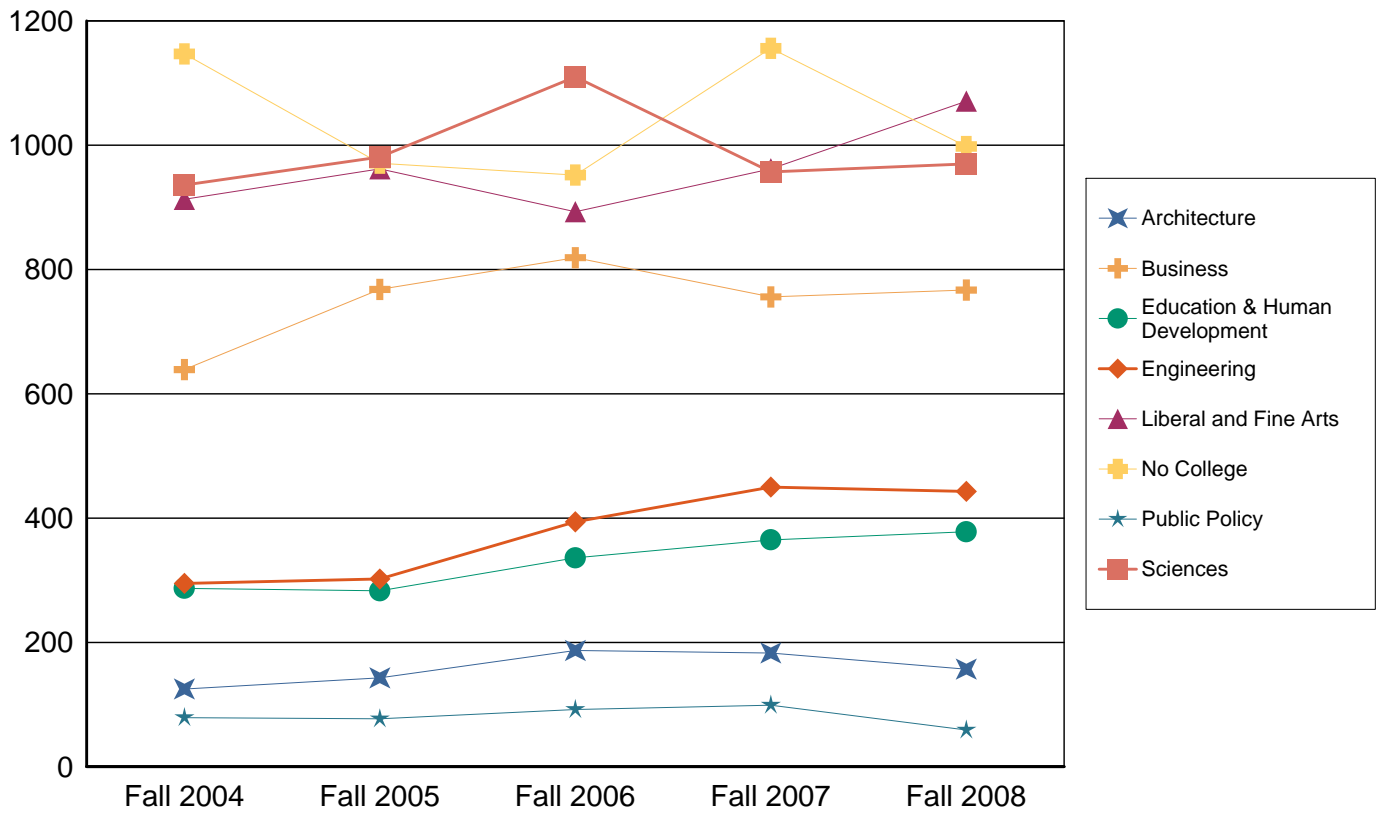
UTSA First Time Undergraduates by Ethnicity

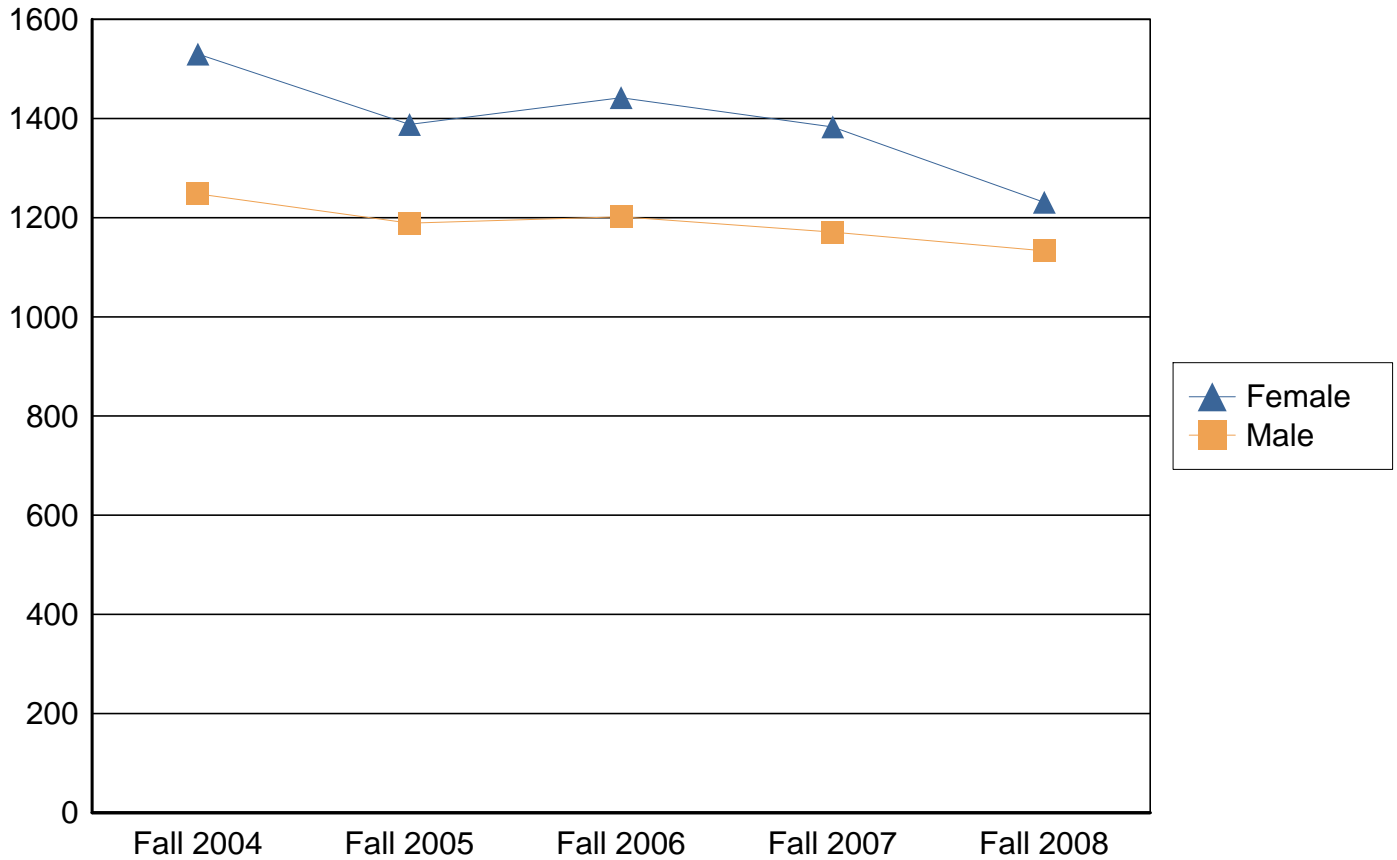

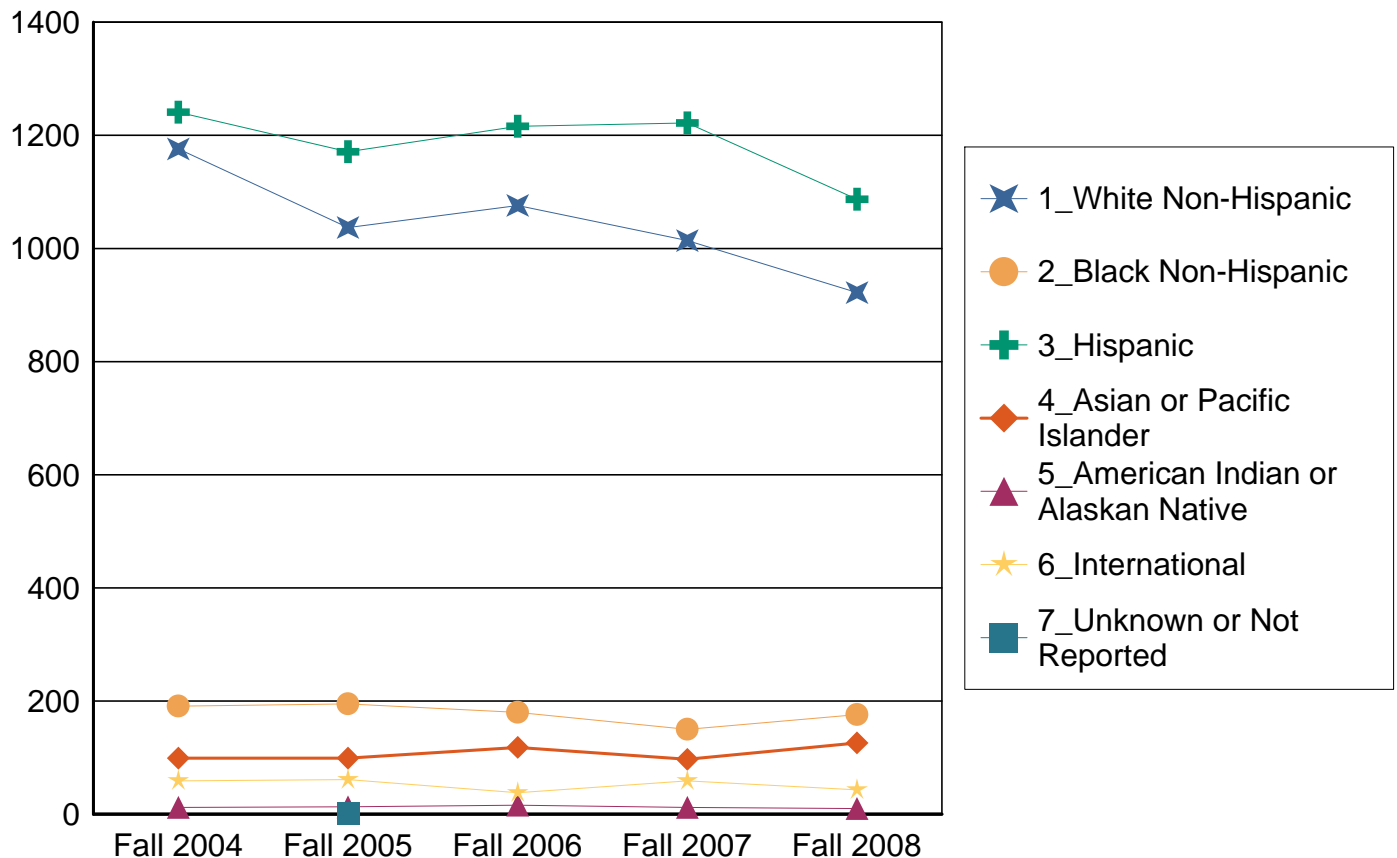
UTSA New Transfer Students by Gender

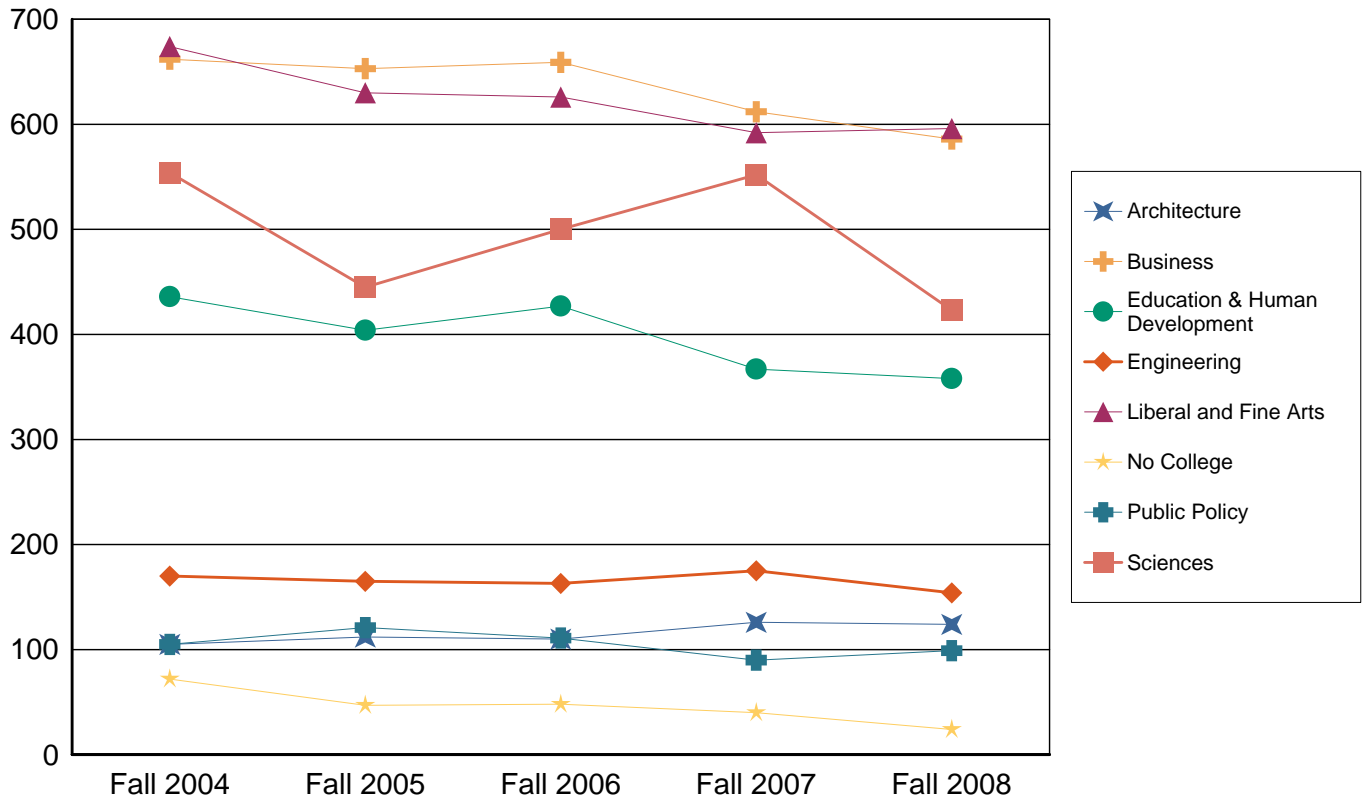
UTSA Transfer Students by Ethnicity

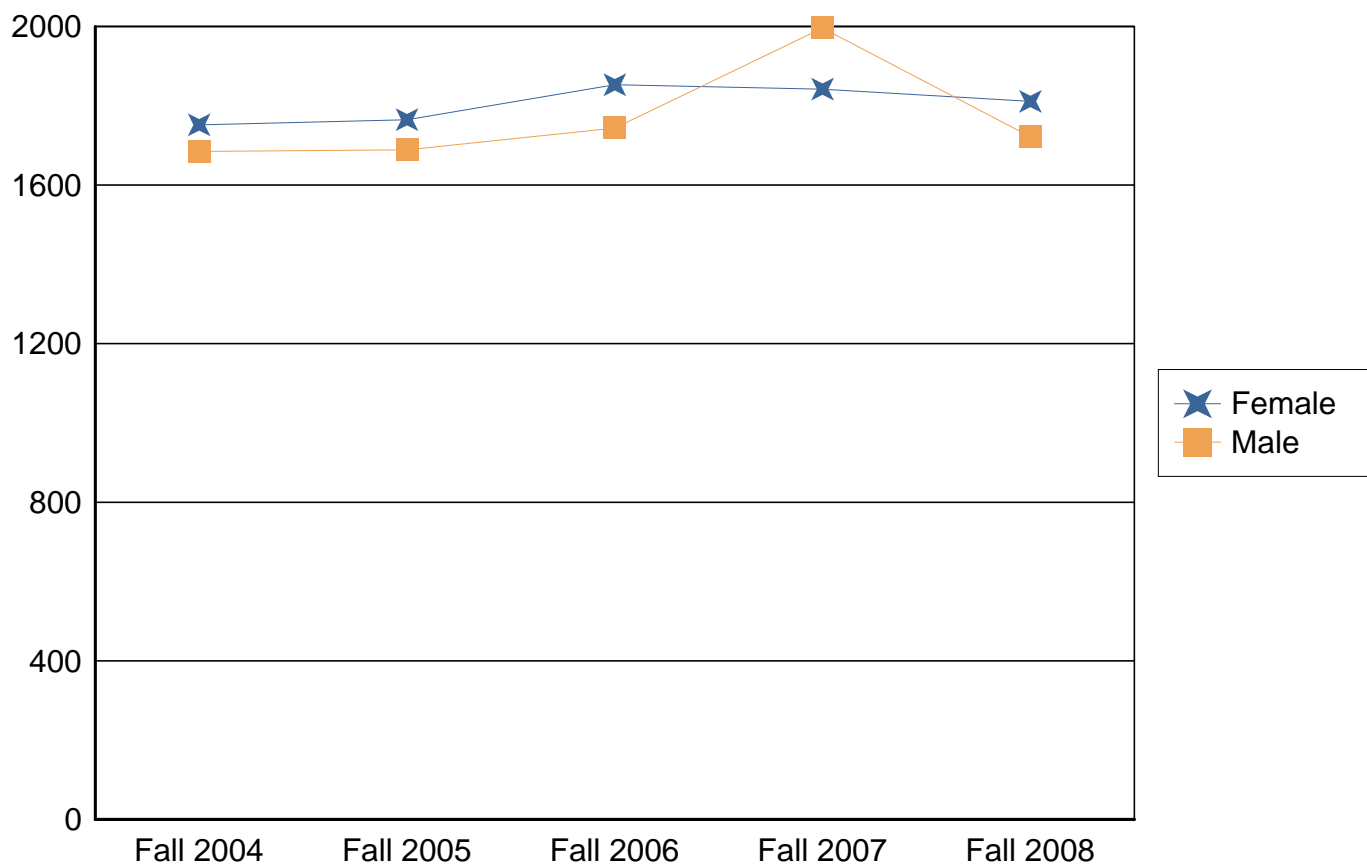

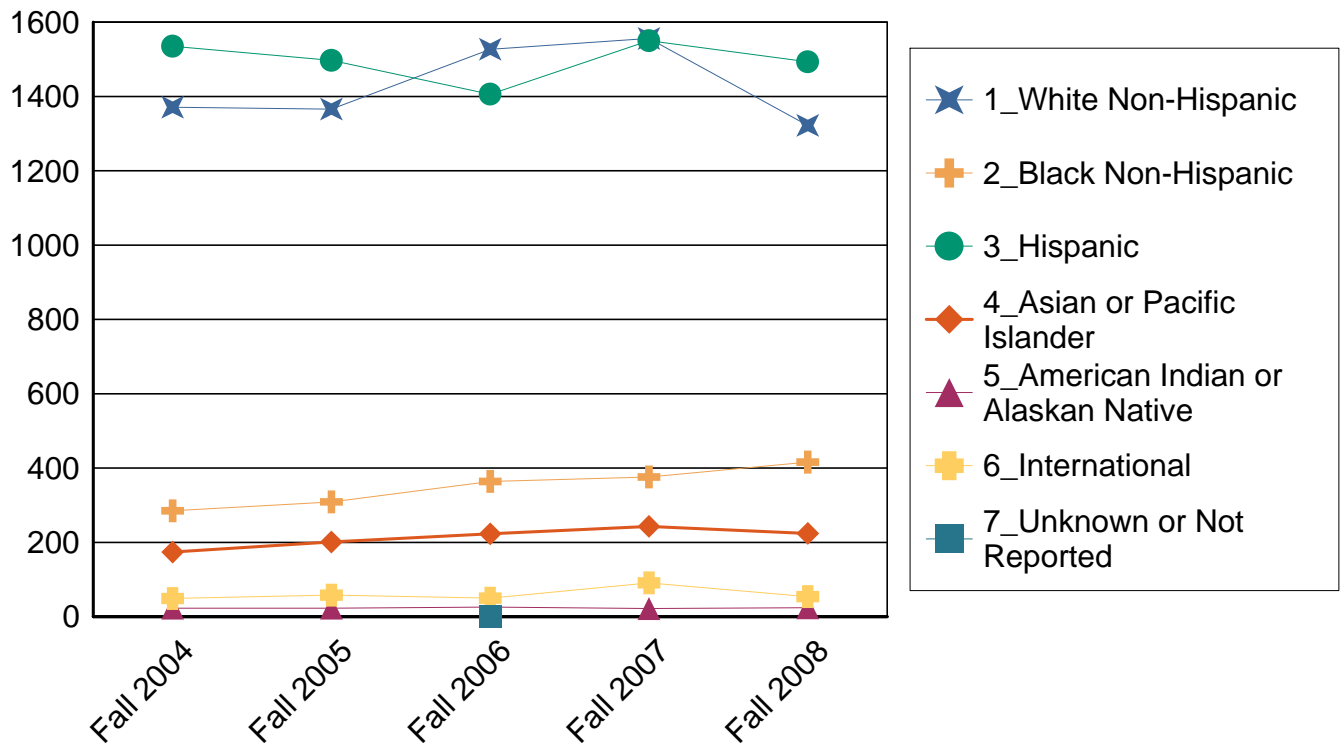
UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Gender

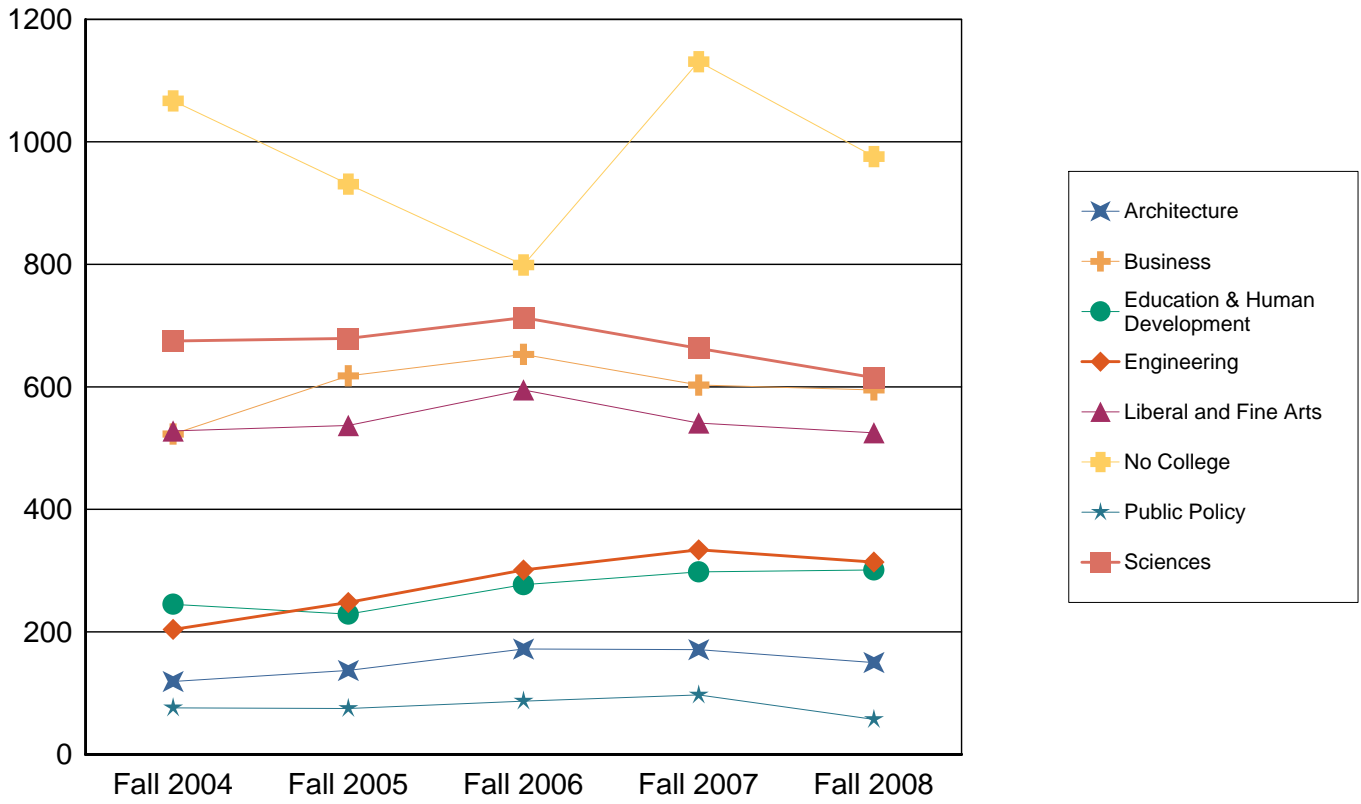
UTSA Degree Seeking Cohort by Ethnicity

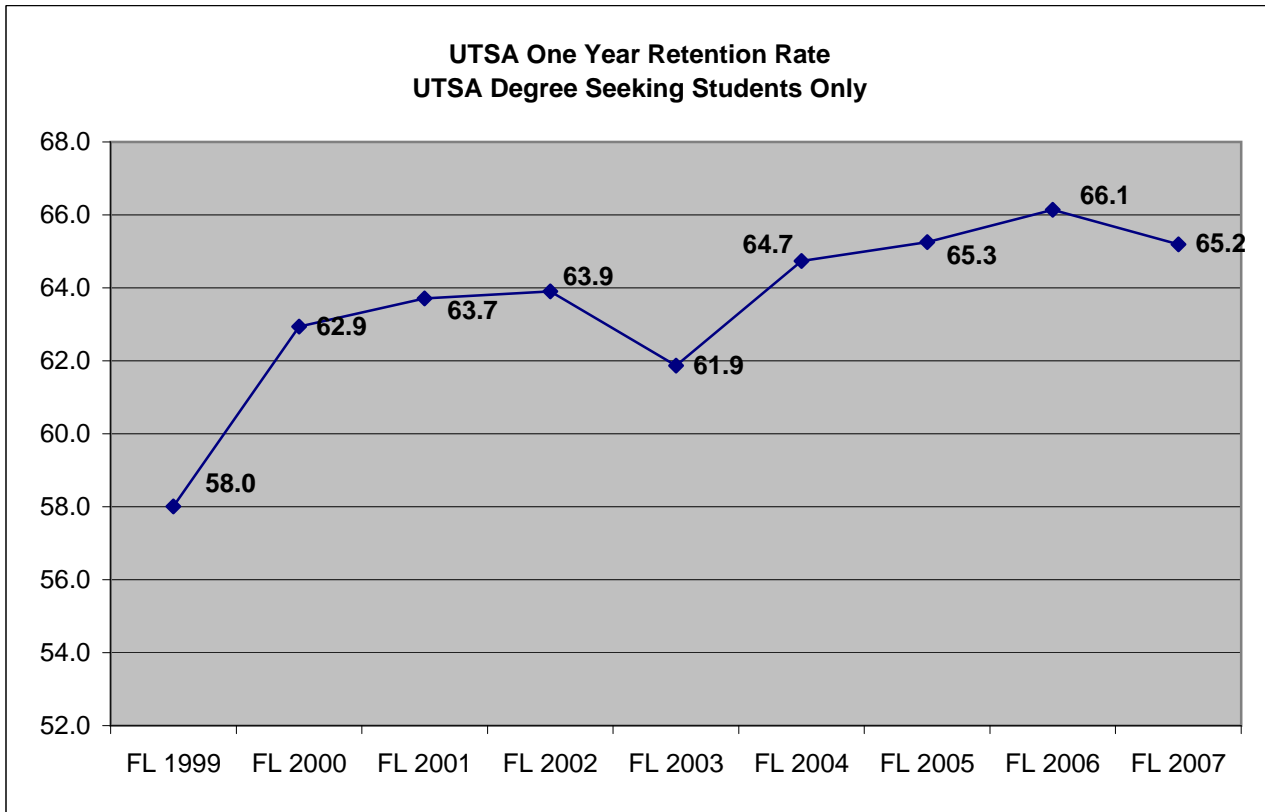

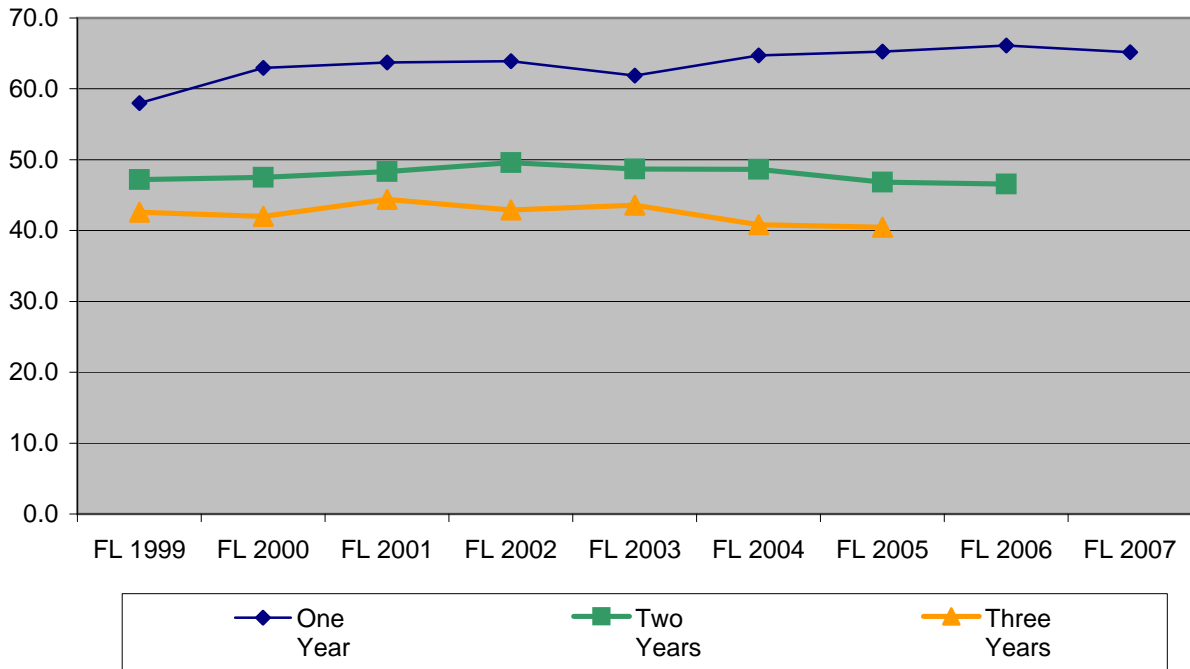

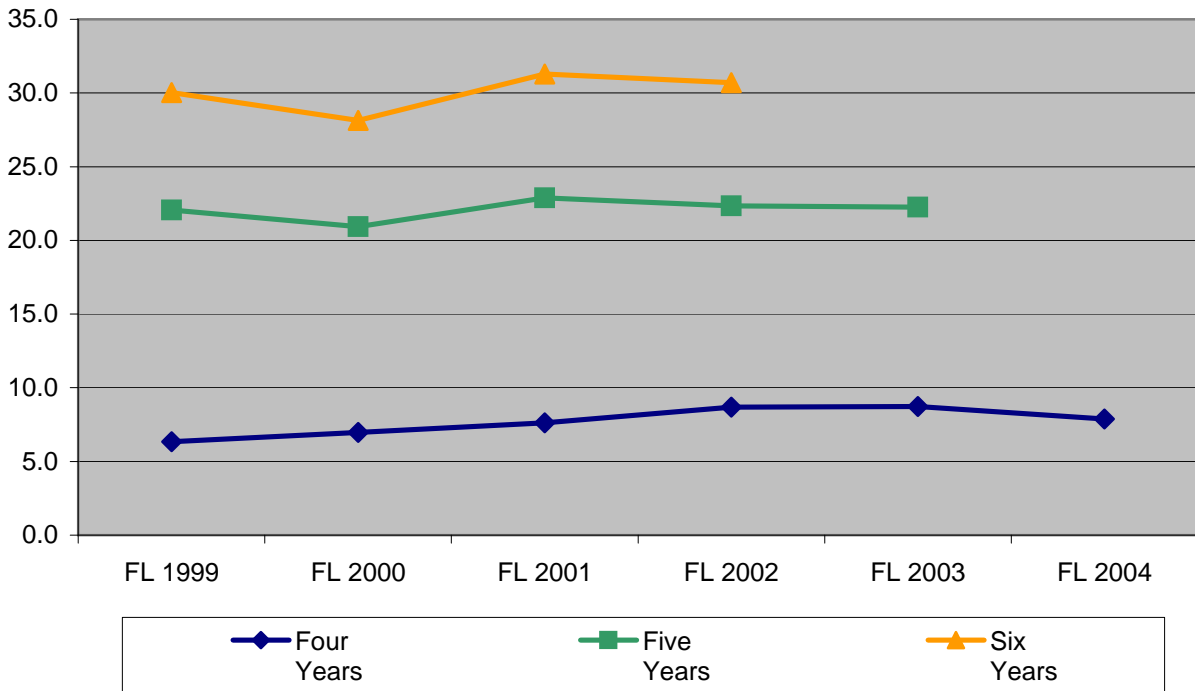

Graduation Rates (Four, Five and Six Year) by Cohort



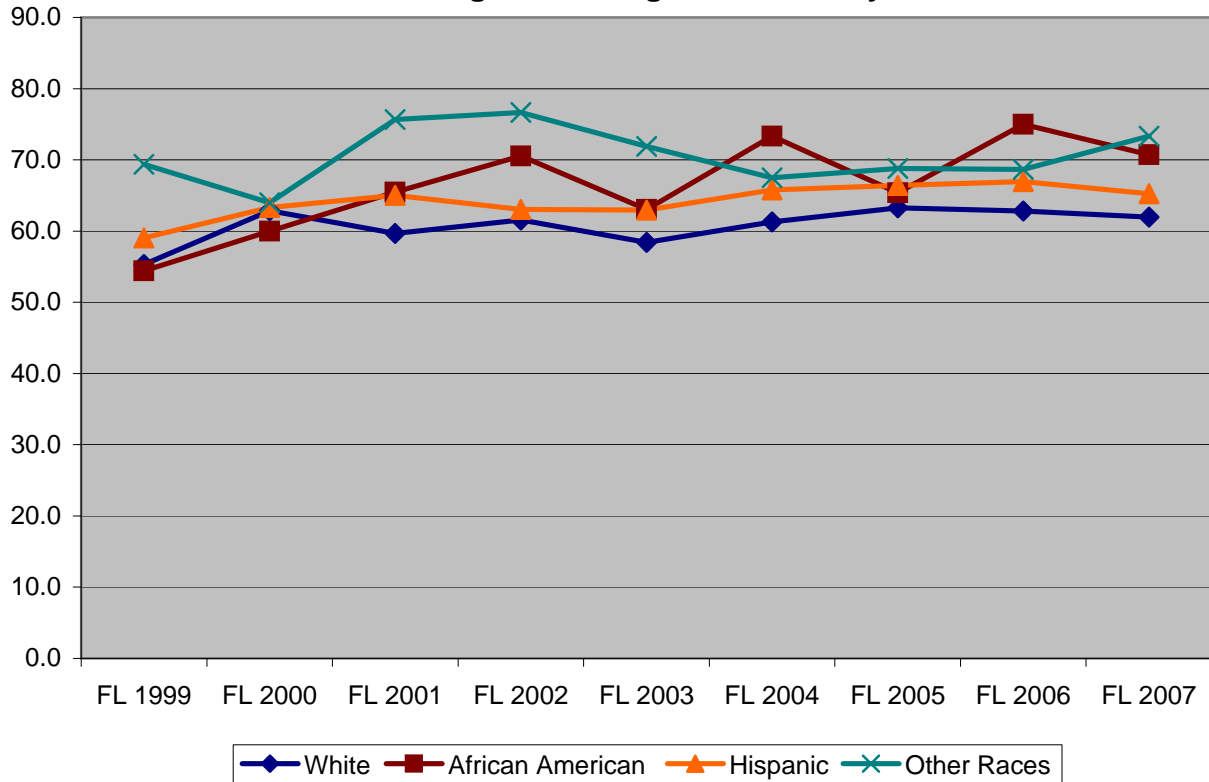

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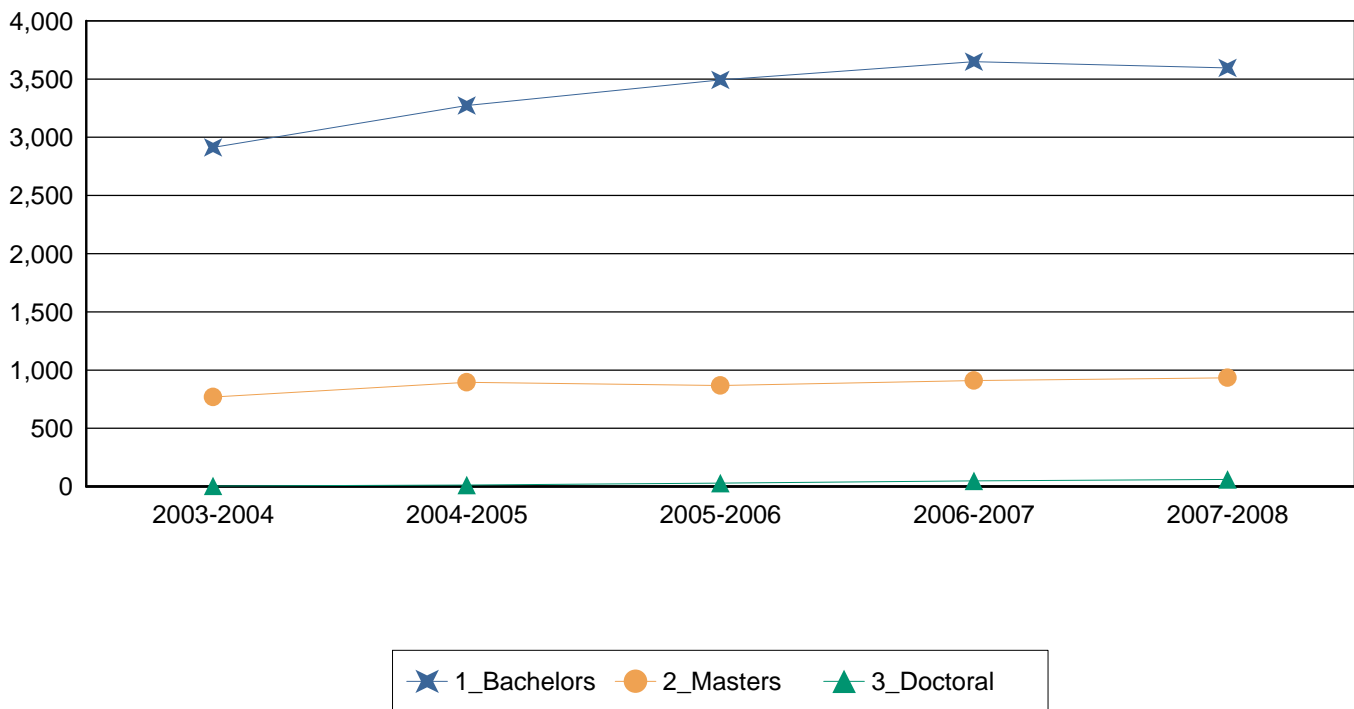

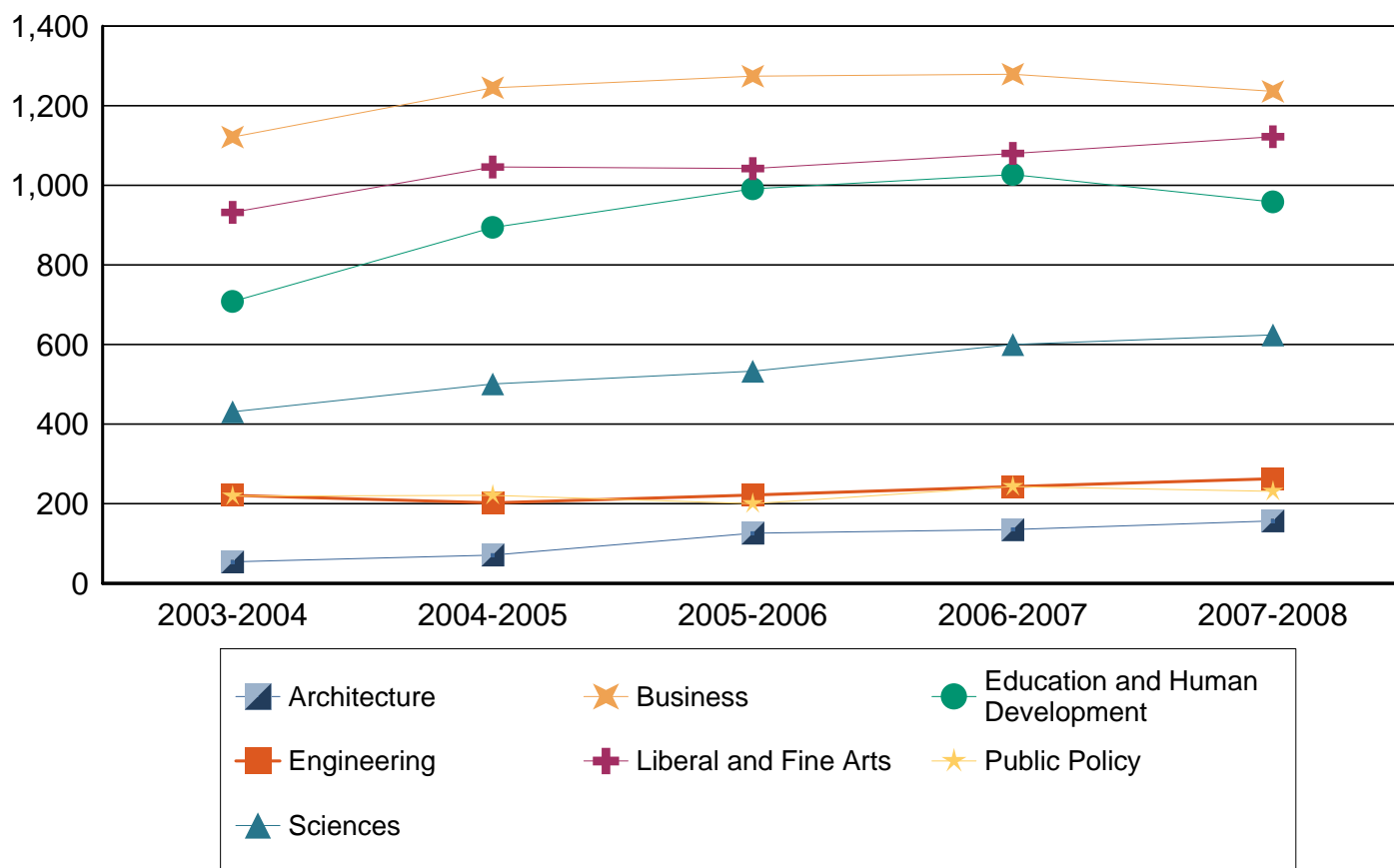
Degrees Awarded by Level

Degrees Awarded by College Based on the Fall 2008 College Structure

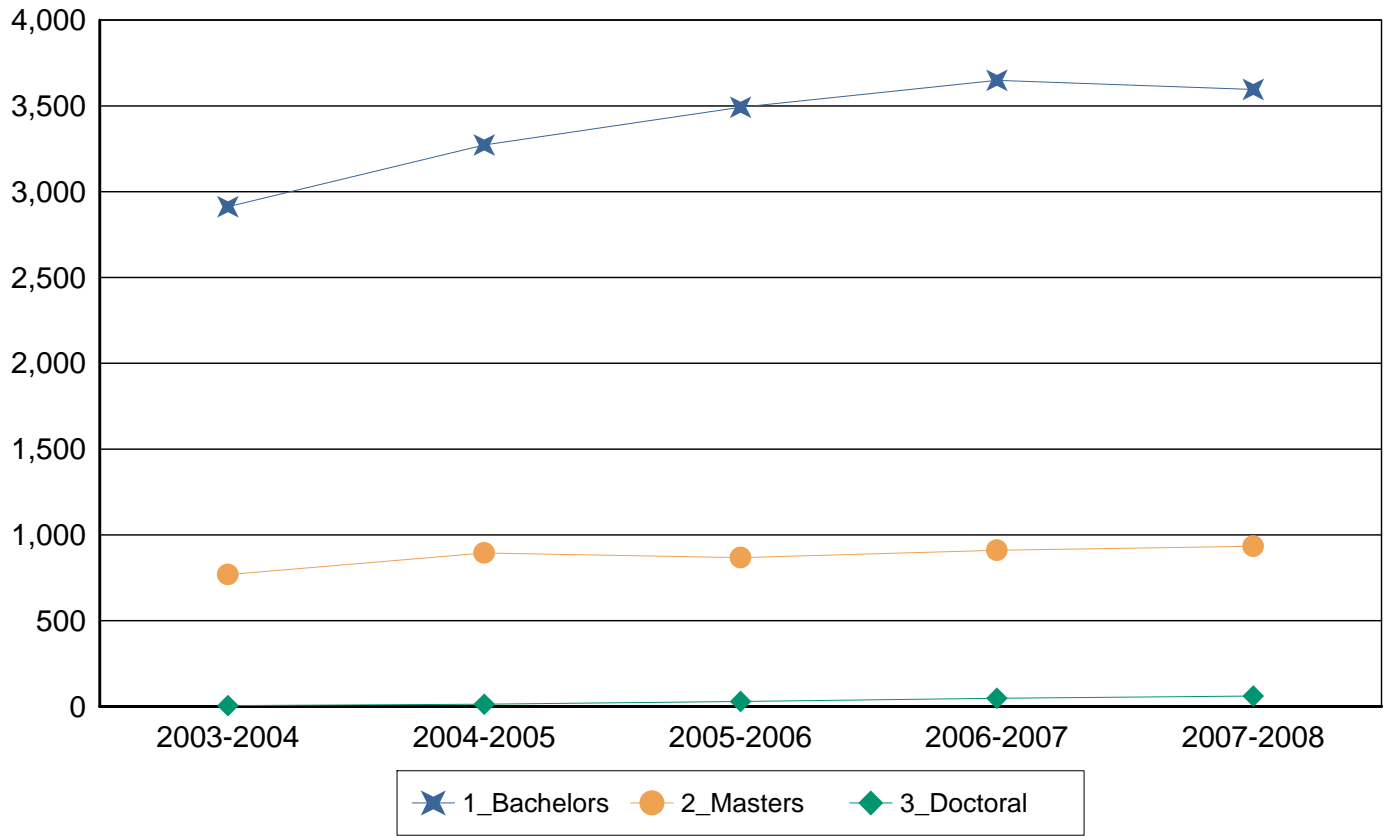

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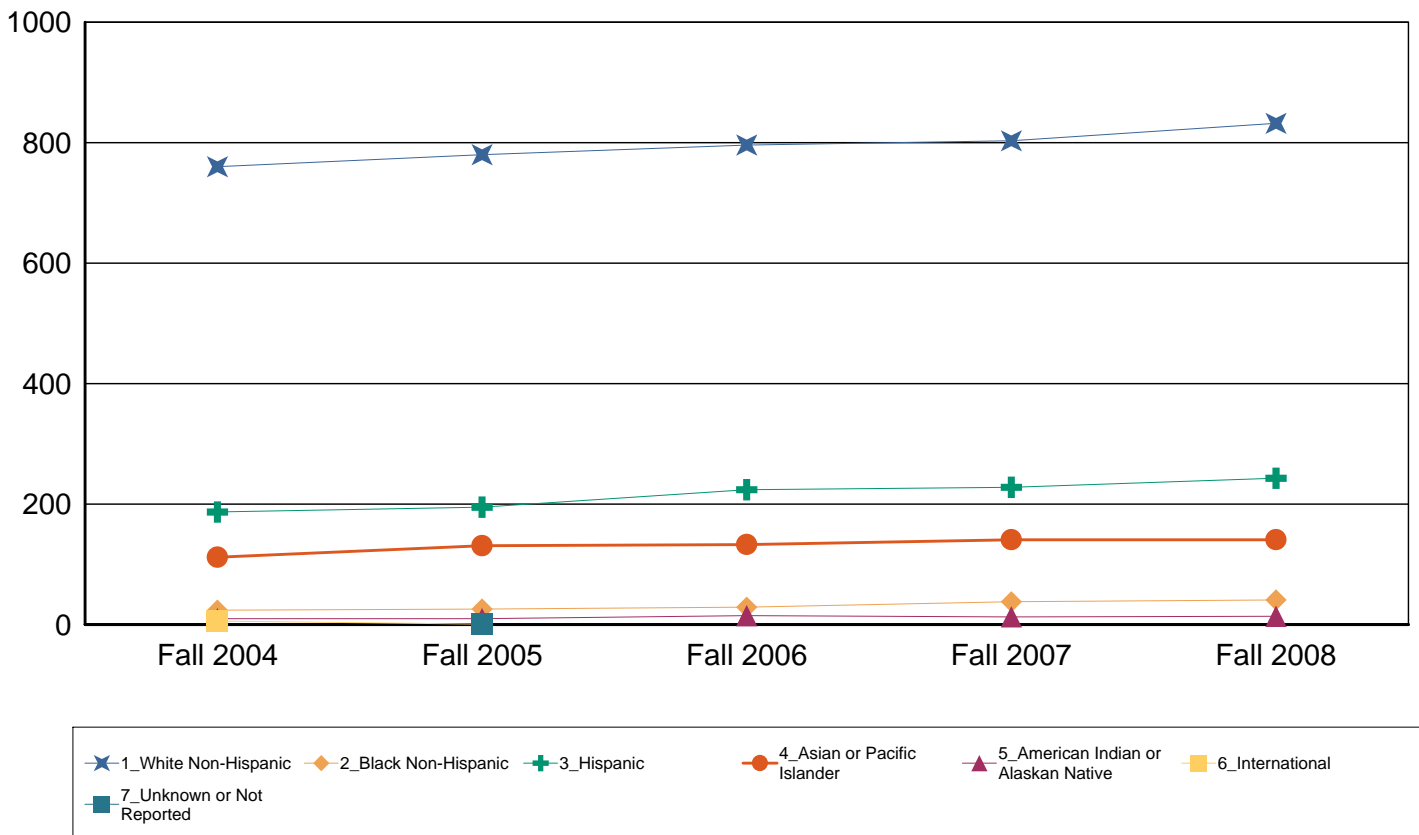

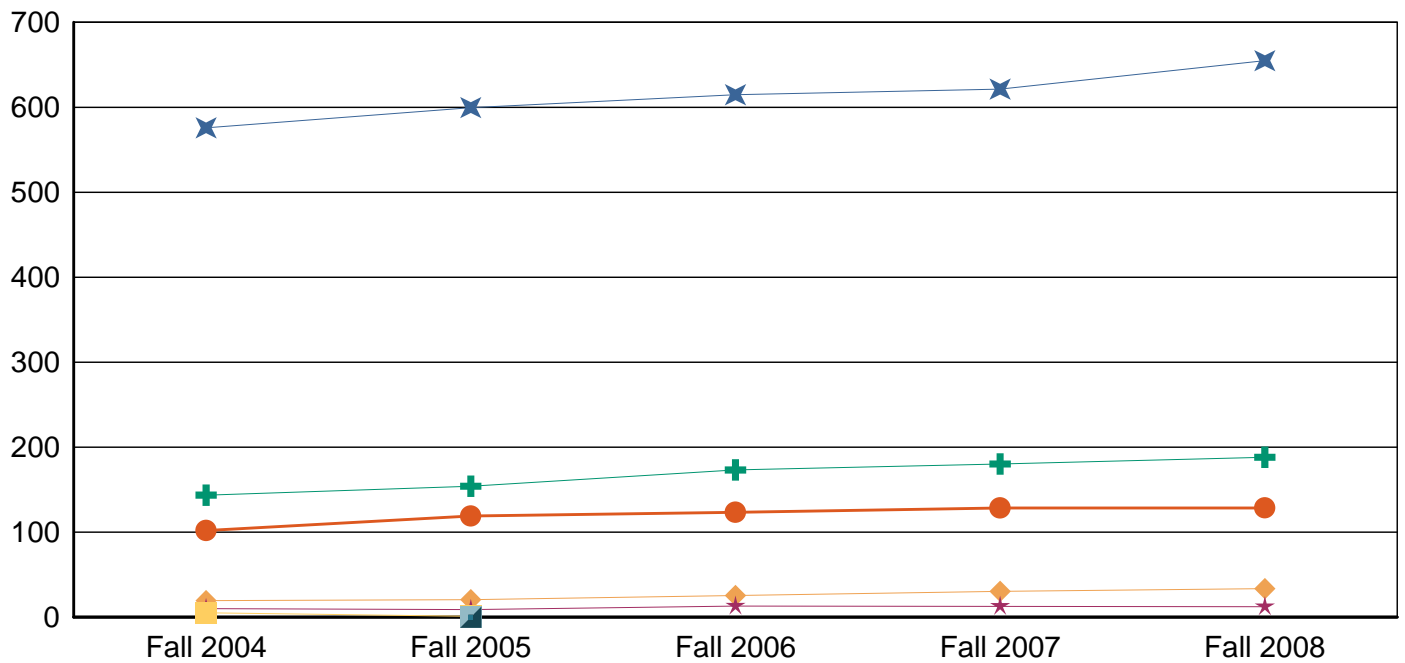

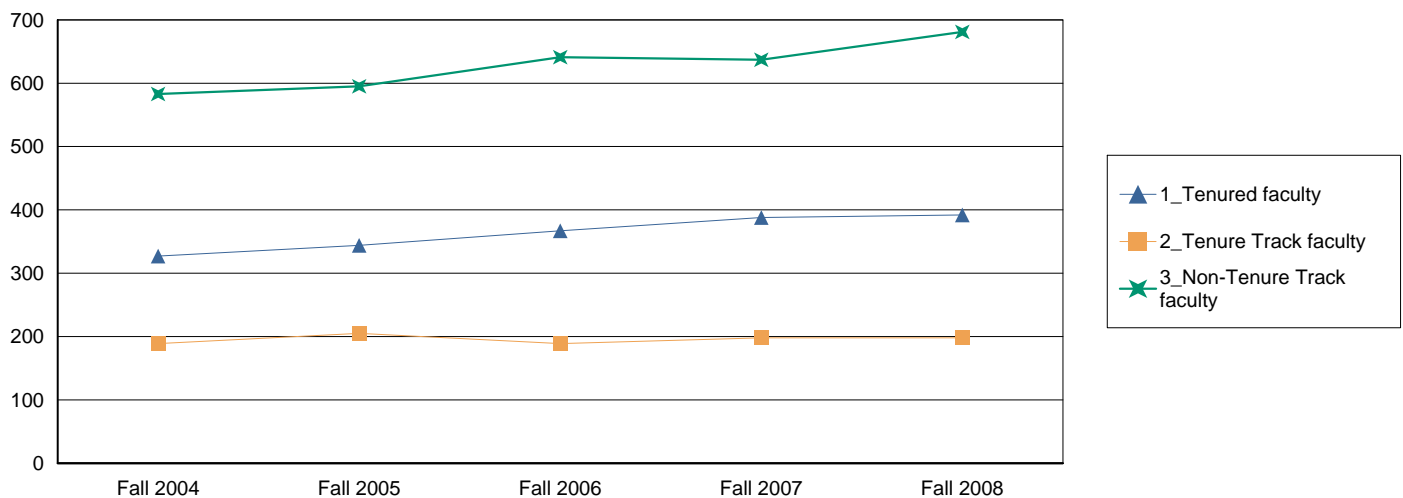

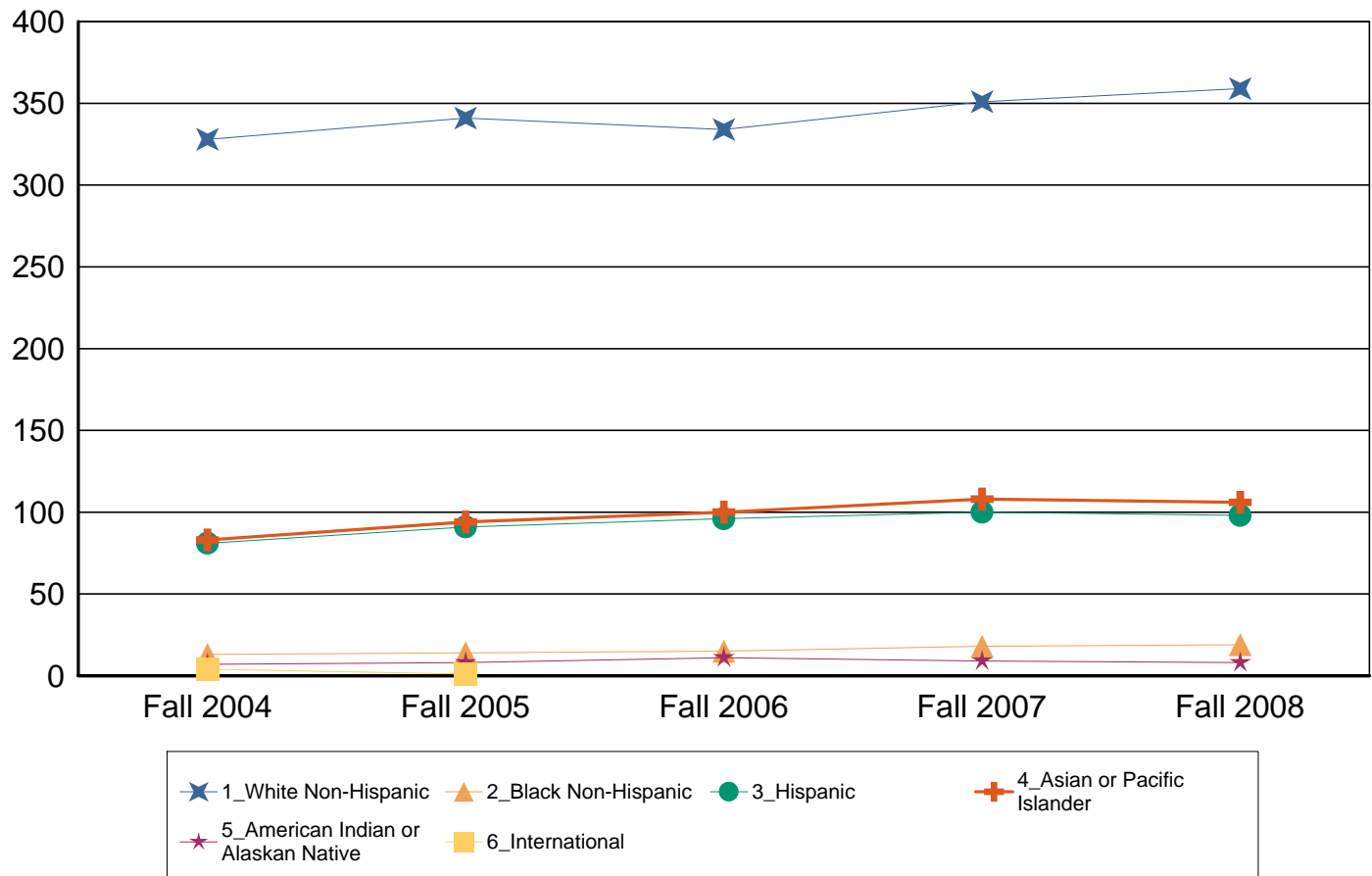

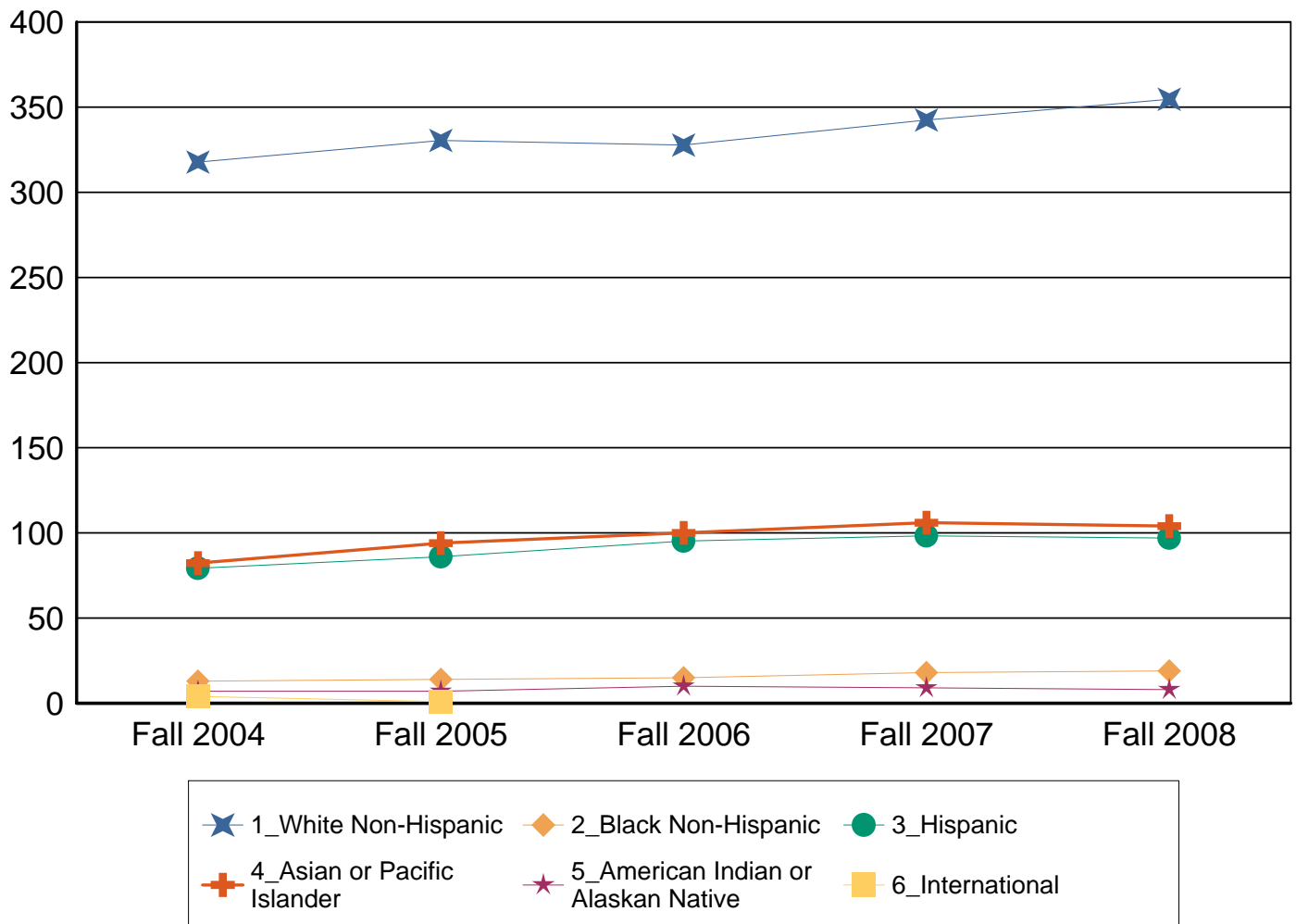

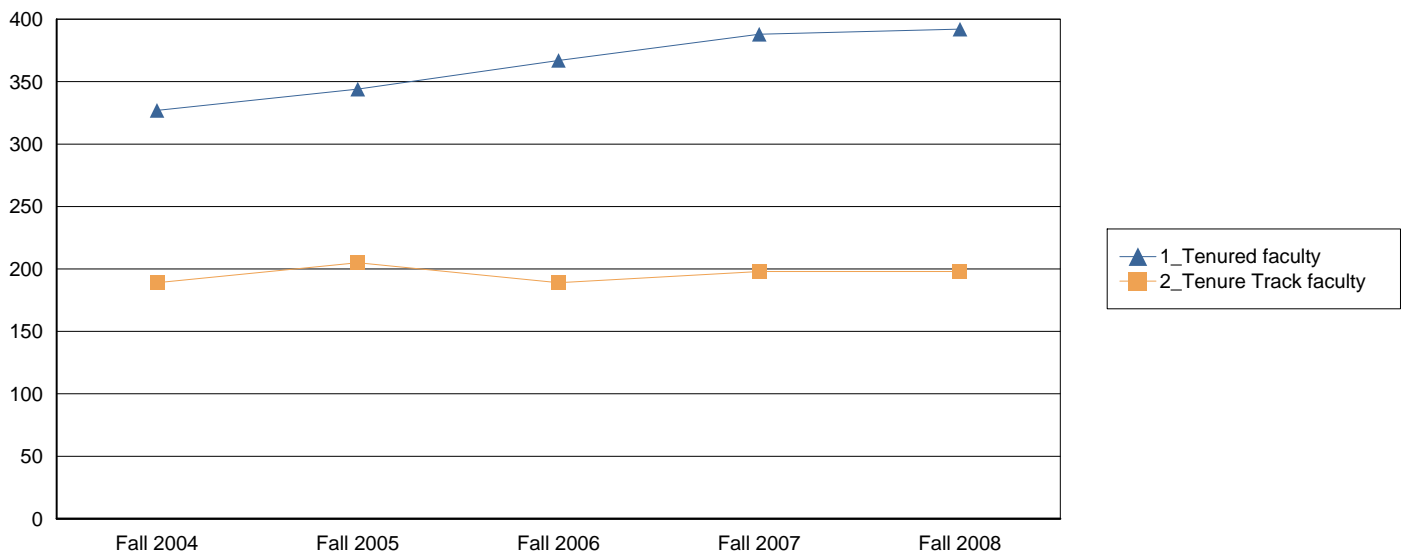

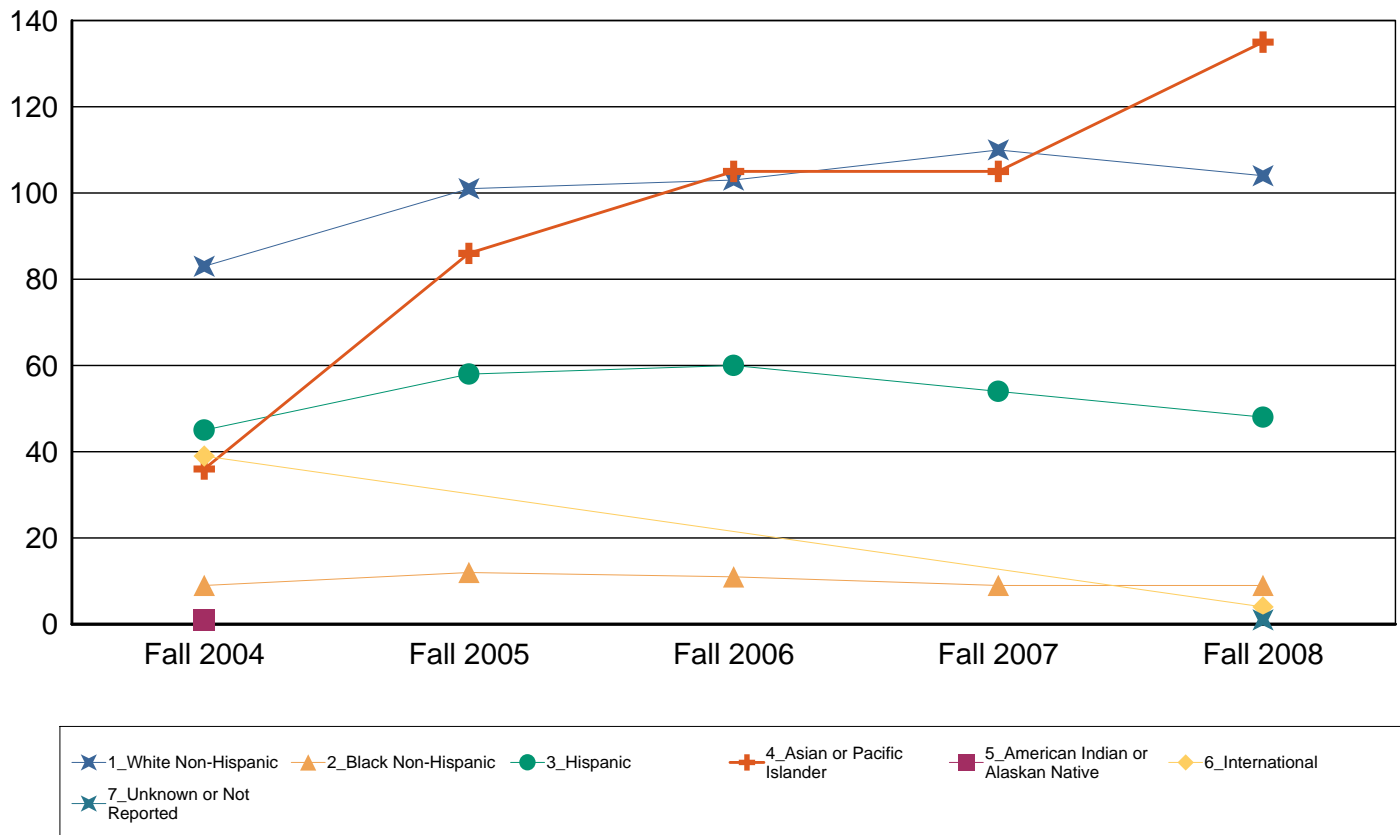

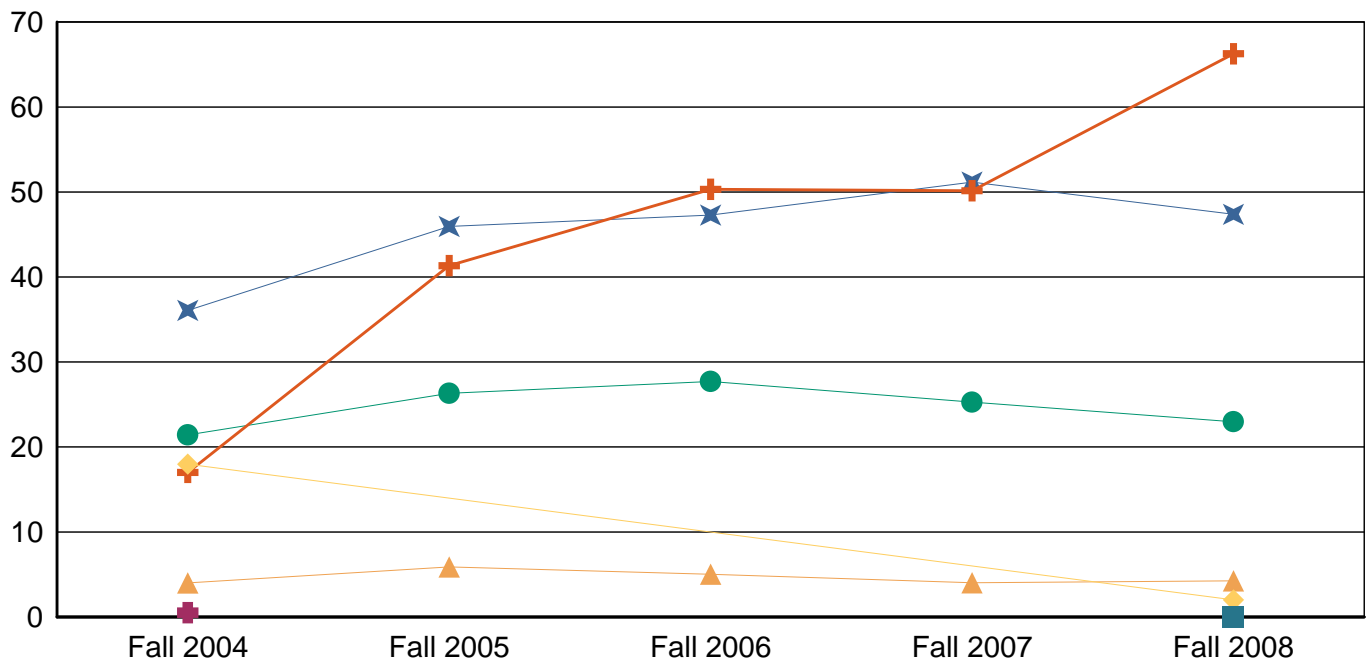

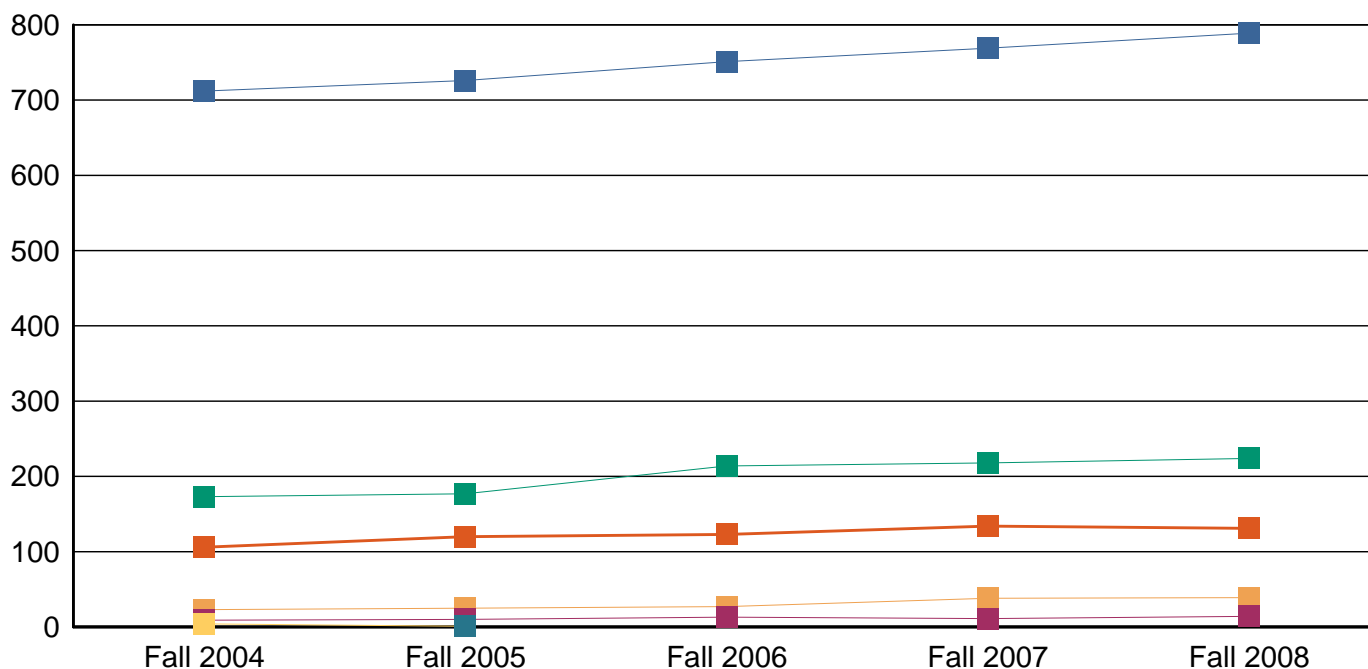

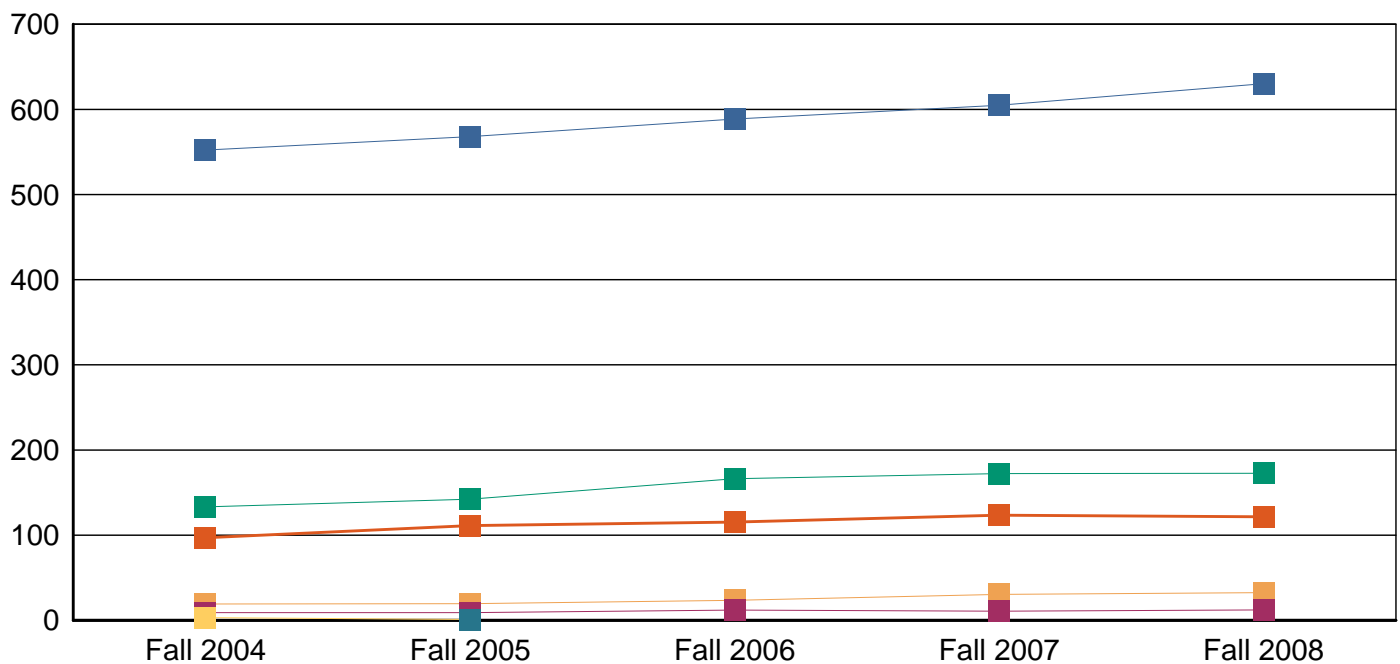

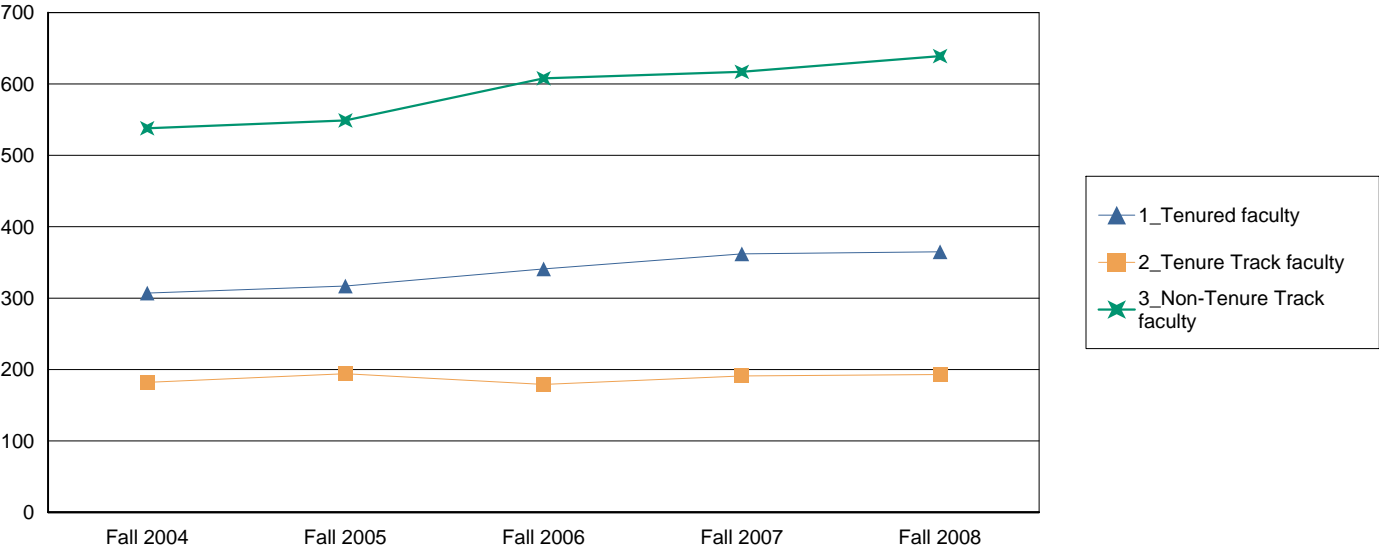
