2017-2018 Orientation Leader Job Description -updated 8/31/17

Orientation Leaders are highly trained student staff members of the Orientation and Family Programs Office. Their primary job responsibilities are to facilitate undergraduate orientation programs, Roadrunner Camp, Family Weekend and other related special events. Orientation Leaders must meet all of the job requirements in order to be eligible for hire.

ORIENTATION

- Facilitate Freshman, Transfer, and Family Orientation programs (spring, summer and fall)
- Lead groups of students and/or family members in various discussions and activities throughout each Orientation program
- Conduct various information sessions: Campus Tour, UTSA 101, College Life skit, Team Time, Roadrunner Walk, etc.
- Facilitate various orientation processes: check-in, course registration/ASAP, attendance, name tag lab, etc.
- Trouble shoot for administrators, faculty and staff during presentations
- Other Orientation duties as assigned

ORIENTATION LEADER TRAINING

- Participate in team building, and team challenge
- Register, attend/pass EDL 4953 and all other staff development activities: OL Retreat, Leadership Team Retreats, Intensive Training, etc.
- Other Orientation Training duties as assigned

ROADRUNNER CAMP

- Attendance at Roadrunner Camp Training and the 2018 Camp
- Other Camp duties as assigned

FAMILY PROGRAMS

- Assist with the overall facilitation of Family Programs as assigned
- Other Family Program duties as assigned

GENERAL

- Attend all special programs-Family Weekend, Admissions Events, etc.
- Assist with OFP marketing events
- Serve in the Convocation Program during Roadrunner Days
- Other OFP duties as assigned: this position requires walking long distances, standing, walking up and down stairs, and some light lifting

REQUIREMENTS: Must have been an OL; maintain at least a 2.0 GPA in **BOTH the UTSA cumulative & semester**; be enrolled full time for Fall '17, Spring '18 and must be enrolled for Fall '18 classes by May 2018. All OLs MUST live in Orientation Housing that is provided from May-August in order to manage/assist with all orientation programming (provided that on-campus housing is available for orientation). An OL may not take summer courses online or in-person (at this time). Must be eligible for hire by the university.
