Summary

• <u>Function</u>: To provide patient care assistance in a clinical setting under the direction of a primary care physician in adult health and/or adolescent health.

• <u>Scope</u>: Responsible for the performance of routine and standardized tasks

requiring considerable training, but not constituting the practice of

medicine.

Duties

• Typical:

- 1. Obtain complete medical history data from patients.
- 2. Perform routine and specialized physical examinations with assessment of normal and abnormal findings.
- 3. Determine tentative diagnosis and order appropriate laboratory tests.
- 4. Formulate and present patient plan of care to staff physician based on examination findings and diagnostic test results.
- 5. Execute patient plan of care as determined by staff physician.
- 6. Provide follow-up and health maintenance care to patients in accordance with established protocols or specific instructions of the staff physician.
- 7. Counsel and educate patients regarding health maintenance and disease prevention.
- 8. Maintain complete and accurate records of contacts with patients.
- 9. Participate in quality assurance reviews.
- 10. Perform related duties as assigned.

• Periodic:

- 1. Initiates, designs, and presents educational programs for patients, clinic staff and other audiences.
- 2. Develop standards of care and patient education materials.
- 3. Coordinate and supervise work of volunteers.
