- 3. Reconcile student wages account on a monthly basis.
- 4. Responsible for security of UTSA Recreation Center or Athletic Department.
- 5. Provides for the development, planning, coordination and management of informal recreation opportunities for Recreation Center/Athletics participants.
- 6. Maintains Campus Recreation/Athletics relations with on- and off-campus departments and service providers.
- 7. Assist with repair of equipment and some facility maintenance. Manage locker rentals and clean-outs.
- 8. Performs other duties as assigned.
