- 2. Assist researchers as needed with specialized procedures with research animals.
- 3. Oversee the completion of animal care and husbandry assignments in compliance with federal regulations as directed by the attending veterinarian or facility manager.
- 4. May perform responsibilities of subordinates, including animal care.
- 5. Responsible for maintaining equipment, preparation of reports, and maintaining inventory as assigned by the facility manager.
- 6. Familiarity with federal laws and policies governing the care and use of laboratory animals.
