Summary

• <u>Function</u>: Perform highly technical skills in the care of animals within research facilities.

• <u>Scope</u>: Responsible for performing duties in the documentation and triage of all

laboratory animal health cases.

Duties

• <u>Typical</u>:

- 1. Performs medical surveillance, diagnostic support and treatment of clinical cases, which include identification of sick animals, contacting investigators, following veterinary orders and documentation of cases.
- 2. Performs Sentinel testing program and animal health monitoring.
- 3. Assists QA/Training Coordinator with various aspects of the training program, including conducting classes and setting up for various hands-on workshops.
- 4. Assists QA/Training Coordinator with environment monitoring, including: water purity and chlorine levels at all facilities; microbial testing of cages, racks, wire tops, water bottles, autoclaves, cage washers and anything that comes in contact with animals; and room sanitation.
- 5. Assists QA/Training Coordinator with equipment monitoring, including: hoods certification; validation of LARC instrumentation; and Edstrom watering system.
- 6. Coordinates and performs anesthesia equipment training, scheduling, maintenance and set up for PI use. Maintains gas anesthesia equipment certification of all PI and LARC systems.
- 7. Monitors surgeries in PI labs.
- 8. Assists with the pick and delivery of animals to and from other institutions.
- 9. Oversees the maintenance and restock of LARC diagnostic/veterinary supplies, equipment and procedural rooms.

- 10. Keeps detailed and accurate records of health evaluations and surgical procedures.
- 11. Performs routine veterinary technical skills including: administration of various therapeutic measures by IV,IM,SQ, topical oral routes, etc; proficient animal restraint techniques; tissue sampling; other routine animal manipulations.
- 12. Develop and implement lab animal enrichment programs.
- 13. Communicate efficiently and effectively both verbally and in written form with co-workers and research investigators.
- 14. Assists QA/Training Coordinator with implementation of Occupational Health and Safety Program.
- 15. Assists in providing leadership, animal health training and guidance to other laboratory personnel
- 16. Performs other duties as assigned.
