Summary

• Function: To provide journeyman level skills performing carpentry work in a multi

trade environment.

• Scope: Coordinates work with end user. Responsible for using power and hand

tools in the construction, maintenance, and repair of structures,

equipment and different materials used on campus.

Duties

• Typical:

- 1. Performs general framing of walls and structures using metal and wood studs.
- 2. Installs and repairs suspended ceilings, gypsum board, and doors.
- 3. Installs door locks on manual doors.
- 4. Locates and repairs leaks on all roof surfaces.
- 5. Lays sub flooring; covers sub floor with building paper to keep out moisture and lays hardwood, parquet, wood-strip-blocks, brick and ceramic tile, and carpet by nailing floors to sub floor or cementing them to mastic or asphalt base.
- 6. Frame and install reinforcing bar, steel, and mix concrete appropriately for each application.
- 7. Assists with estimates of time and materials for required jobs.
- 8. Keeps records of material used.
- 9. Assist all trades, departments and zones with special events and assisted when needed.
- 10. Performs additional duties as assigned.
- Periodic:
- 1. Cabinet making and furniture repair for university spaces.
