Duties

• <u>Typical</u>:

- 1. Provides sub-journeyman work in the performance of a variety of maintenance and repair tasks to include rough concrete laying and patch plastering; assisting in the installation of locks and doors; rough painting; assisting carpenter's in maintenance of wood structures; performing less skilled electrical work; ceiling installation; repairing lines, faucets, and pipe fittings; fabricates and welds; and sink replacements.
- 2. May train new employees in the above duties.
- 3. Performs other duties as assigned.

• <u>Periodic</u>:

1. Perform general mechanical emergencies until journeyman or supervisory personnel arrive.
