• <u>Function</u>: To provide advanced skills in carpentry, cabinetmaking, and plastics fabrication in the construction, mounting, installation, maintenance and

repair of museum exhibits.

• Scope: Responsible for exacting use of a full range of hand and power tools,

specialized equipment, and techniques to build and maintain exhibits.

Duties

• Typical:

- 1. Reads and interprets blueprints and drawings. Performs wood and plastic fabrication, hand and spray painting, photo mounting, artifact handling and mounting. Uses special knowledge for problem solving.
- 2. Inspects and repairs permanent and traveling exhibits.
- 3. Docks and receives traveling exhibits and materials, and handles and stores heavy exhibit components and construction materials.
- 4. Selects materials and accurately records and reports materials and time used on jobs.
- 5. Maintains hand tools, shop machines, and spray equipment.
- 6. Advises designers and assists in training entry-level employees.
- 7. Performs other duties as assigned.

- 1. Drives trucks and vans to pick up and deliver exhibits and materials.
- 2. Participates in committee work as departmental representative and attends workshops and seminars.
