Summary

• <u>Function</u>: To provide advanced technical skills and abilities in the performance of voice and data telecommunications work.

• Scope: Responsible for communications systems of the tri-campus are by

installing, operating, and maintaining voice and data telecommunication

circuits and equipment.

Duties

Typical:

- 1. Establishes voice networks by running, pulling, terminating and splicing cables following industry standards.
- 2. Performs required switch programming to support the establishment of voice networks as necessary.
- 3. Verifies service by testing circuits, equipment and alarms
- 4. Monitors departmental work order system and performs daily work order updates and maintenance.
- 5. Documents voice network by labeling and routing equipment and cables; Records configuration diagrams and specifications.
- 6. Identifies and corrects reported voice network service degradations, escalating problems and outages.
- 7. Assists with phone switch monitoring and alarm response as required.
- 8. Keeps supplies ready by inventorying stock and assisting with inventory reconciliation.
- 9. Maintains a safe work environment by following codes, standards, and legal regulations.
- 10. Maintains customer rapport by listening to and resolving concerns as well as educating the customer in the use and function of telephone handsets.
- 11. Coordinates departmental vehicle's registration, documents usage and coordinates required maintenance with Facilities.

- 12. Performs site surveys for requested cable installation to ascertain customer needs, including port availability and desired location.
- 13. Plans cable installations by studying customer orders, plans and manuals; Works with cabling contractor to create cost estimates for customer and deliver installation schedules to the customer.
- 14. Assists with voice/data port conversions as required.
- 15. Maintains cable infrastructure records in departmental database.
- 16. Performs maintenance and ensures cleanliness of all communications closets.
- 17. Updates job knowledge by participating in educational opportunities and reading technical publications.
- 18. Enhances department and organization reputation by accepting ownership for accomplishing new and different requests while also exploring opportunities to add value to job accomplishments.
- 19. Performs other duties as assigned.
