### Job Description

#### Summary

• <u>Function</u>: To provide master level skills in the repair, replacement and maintenance of locks, hardware, and access control security systems.

<u>Scope</u>: Responsible for overseeing project management, training and performing activities related to installing, repairing, maintaining and inspecting physical and technical access control equipment and systems.

#### **Duties**

<u>Typical</u> :
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- 1. Assists the lead in the management and maintenance of the structure of the electronic access control and door alarm systems.
- 2. Responsible for the Access Control Training program and training lower level coworkers; serves as the project manager for projects and assignments. Provides guidance and advice on physical security to customers.
- 3. Troubleshoots problems and recommends and implements solutions.
- 4. Directs team in the absence of the supervisor. Assigns work orders and assignments
- 5. Responsible for managing department inventory and tracking of equipment.
- 6. Assists in university wide key and electronic access inventories. Ensures correct access levels are issued.
- 7. Inspects, installs, adjusts, repairs and maintains mechanical and electronic door locks and supporting systems; rekeys locks; duplicates and generates original keys by code; establishes keying schedules.
- 8. Responsible for writing door hardware schedules, updating construction documents and other project planning documents to include physical security standards.
- 9. Researches and implements access control and physical security best practices, industry standards and procedures and implements them to the training program.
- 10. Perform other duties as assigned.
