- 6. Provide quality assurance assessments to verify compliance with medical records, equipment certification & program of surveillance, diagnosis & diagnostic resources.
- 7. Coordinate research collaborations/agreements with internal & external customers and prepare cost estimates for the same.
- 8. Track institution's animal care & use training, & OHSP & provide training as needed
- 9. Performs other duties as assigned
