Summary

- Function: Analyze science, engineering, business, and all other data processing problems for application to electronic data processing systems. Analyze user requirements, procedures, and problems to automate or improve existing systems and review computer system capabilities, workflow, and scheduling limitations.
- Scope: Responsible for basic systems analysis duties.

Duties

- Typical:
 1. Train faculty, staff, and students on use of hardware and software.
 2. Maintain computer workstations and departmental server(s) by troubleshooting and recommending new hardware and software.
 3. Develop and implement website to include designing of web-based material for on-line learning and train-the-trainer modules.
 4. Perform network, system, and domain level administration, installation and support of software, maximizing production time for servers, and perform data backups.
 5. Support the Universities' web-based course system and shell.
 6. Coordinate technical issues with application vendors.
 7. Perform duties as a manager for a computer lab.
 8. Perform other duties as assigned.

 1. Assist in machine logic charting.
