## *Summary*

- Function: Programming using applicable software to process internal and external data requests. Perform data maintenance tasks as needed. Assist staff as technical issues arise.
- Scope: Performs programming analysis of moderate complexity, utilizing programming languages and platforms varying across assignments.

## *Duties*

- Typical:
  1. Performs programming and analysis of data.
  2. Maintains data repository and databases.
  3. Assists in the analysis of problems as defined by the supervisor and expands definition suitable to programmer's requirements.
  4. Designs test files.
  5. Performs moderately complex programming and debugging.
  6. Develops efficient, fast programming techniques.
  7. Performs documentation.
  8. Assists in implementation of systems and job streams.
  9. Assists in equipment selections and evaluation studies.
  10. Performs additional duties as assigned.
- Periodic:
  1. Evaluates and modifies existing programs.
