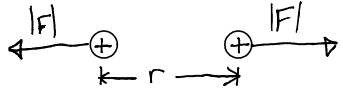

$|F| = k \frac{|q_1 q_2|}{r^2}$ ~ COULOMB'S LAW

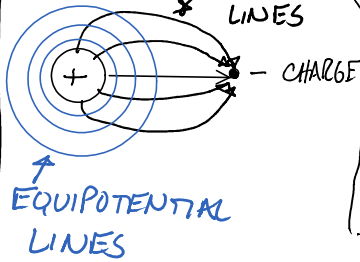
ELECTRIC FIELD = MAG. DIRECTION

$E = \frac{F}{q} = k \frac{q}{r^2}$ (V/m)

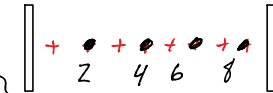
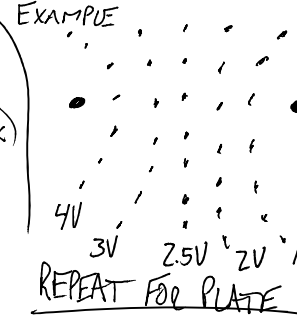
