

# Fall 2020 Academic Calendar

## Payment Deadlines

August 18 (Tues)	Payment deadline for undergraduate students who registered March 23-August 14, 2020.
September 9 (Wed) (Census)	Payment deadline for all graduate and undergraduate students who registered August 17-September 9, 2020. <i>All students (undergraduate and graduate) who have not paid, or made payment arrangements by this date, will be charged a \$100 LATE fee.</i>
September 21 (Mon)	Students who are still unpaid by September 21 will be removed from their classes.

August 14-16 Registration closed (registration will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 14 and reopen at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 17).

August 17 (Mon) **Late registration and add/drop**  
All admitted students may register or add/drop classes via *ASAP* with appropriate approvals.

August 18 (Tues) **Payment deadline** for students who registered March 23-August 14.

August 23 (Sun) **100% Refund Date**  
Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a 100% refund of tuition and fees.\*

August 24 (Mon) **First day of Fall 2020 classes**

August 28 (Fri) **80% Refund Date**  
Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive an 80% refund of tuition and fees.\*

August 31 (Mon) **Waitlisting ends**

August 31 (Mon) **Challenge Examination Requests**  
Last day to request challenge examination from the instructor. Challenge Examination form must be turned into the One Stop Enrollment Center and the test administered by September 14.

### September 2020

September 1 (Tues) **Deadline to add a class or late register on ASAP**

September 4 (Fri) **70% Refund Date**  
Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a 70% refund of tuition and fees\*

September 7 (Mon) **Labor Day holiday.** University closed.

September 9 (Wed) **Census Date and Payment Deadline, 5 p.m.**

**All Students who have not made payment, or made payment arrangements, will be charged a \$100 LATE fee.**

**Last day to drop or withdraw without a grade.** Last day to drop an individual course and receive a 100% refund. NOTE: If you are enrolled in only one class, or are dropping your last class, this is considered a withdrawal and you will be refunded according to the prorated withdrawal refund percentages on the academic calendar.

**No refunds are given for dropping an individual course after this date.**

September 10 – October 26 **Drop Time Frame** (Automatic "W")  
All students (undergraduate & graduate) may drop an individual course via *ASAP*, or withdraw (drop all classes) and receive a grade(s) of "W." Students must see advisor to drop developmental classes.

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September 14 (Mon)	<b>50% Refund Date</b> Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a 50% refund of tuition and fees. *
September 14 (Mon)	<b>Challenge Examination Requests Due</b> Last day to submit an approved Request to Challenge Examination form to the One Stop Enrollment Center. Challenge examinations should be administered by this date.
September 21 (Mon)	<b>25% Refund Date</b> Last day to withdraw from all classes and receive a 25% refund of tuition and fees. *
September 21 (Mon)	<b>Students Dropped for Non-Payment</b> Students who do not make payment or payment arrangements will be dropped from their classes.
September 28 (Mon)	Second installment payment is due for students who select the three payment plan.

October 21 (Wed)	Last day to withdraw from all classes in the 8-week (B6) term and receive an <b>80% refund</b> of tuition & fees.
October 23 (Fri)	Deadline for students to bring an approved <b>Challenge Examination</b> form to the One-Stop and take the exam.
October 26 (Mon)	<b>Census Date, 5 p.m., for the 8-week (B6) term</b>  <b>Last day to drop or withdraw without a grade.</b> Last day to drop an individual course and receive a 100% refund. December 10 (Thurs)	Last day of classes for the 8-week (B6) term. No Study Days in 8-week terms.
December 11 (Fri)	<b>Final Exams for the 8-week (B6) term</b>
December 14 (Mon)	Final Grades Due; 2 p.m. Deadline for faculty to enter final grades for the 8-week (B6) term.

## \*Drop/Withdrawal timeframe rules

Students, both undergraduate and graduate, may drop an individual class via *ASAP* through the Drop Deadline.

## \*\*Withdrawal procedures

After the *deadline to drop an individual course via ASAP*, students on financial aid who wish to withdraw (drop all classes) from the University must submit a paper withdrawal form to the One Stop Enrollment Center for processing. Except for student athletes and international students, only the student's signature is required on the form.

Student athletes must submit a withdrawal form, signed by an advisor in the Collegiate Athletics Department, to the One Stop Enrollment Center for processing. International students must submit a withdrawal form, signed by the Director, International Student Services or an International Student Advisor, to the One Stop Enrollment Center for processing.

After the Withdrawal/Automatic "W" deadline, students may not drop courses, or withdraw, except with the approval of the course instructor and the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled.
