Regarding Payments

Viewing your Bill: Tuition & fee charges for Spring 2026 registration will begin posting to your account **Dec 1, 2025**.

Financial Aid: The earliest Financial Aid and Scholarships can begin disbursing federal, state, and institutional aid is 10 days prior to the first day of class.

Payment Deadlines & Late Fee: A \$100 LATE fee will be charged for students who have not made payment arrangements by 5 p.m. CT on the date of the relevant payment deadline (*excluding the final deadline for the full 16-week term*).

Removal from Classes: Students who are still unpaid by the final payment deadline (Census) will be removed from their classes.

***Drop/Withdrawal timeframe rules**

Students, both undergraduate and graduate, may drop an individual class via *myJTSA* Account through the Drop Deadline.

****Withdrawal procedures**

After the *deadline to drop an individual course via myJTSA Account*, students on financial aid who wish to withdraw (drop all classes) from the University must submit a withdrawal form via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing. Except for student athletes and international students, only the student's signature is required on the form.

Student athletes must submit a withdrawal form, signed by an advisor in the Collegiate Athletics Department, via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing. International students must submit a withdrawal form, signed by the Director, International Student Services or an International Student Advisor, via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing.

After the Withdrawal/Automatic "W" deadline, students may not drop courses, or withdraw, except with the approval of the course instructor and the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled.
