

Payment Deadlines

Regular 16-week Term

- January 10 Payment deadline. All students (undergraduate and graduate) who have not paid, or made [payment arrangements](#), by 5 p.m. on this date will be charged a \$100 LATE fee.
- January 26 All students (undergraduate and graduate) who have not made payment arrangements by 5 p.m. on this date will be charged \$100 LATE fee.
- February 1 Students who are still unpaid at 5 p.m. on this date will be removed from their 16-week classes.

First 8-week Term (B5)

- January 10 Payment deadline for courses in the First 8-week term. All students (undergraduate and graduate) who have not made payment arrangements by 5 p.m. on this date will be charged \$100 LATE fee.

*Drop/Withdraw time frame rules

Students, both undergraduate and graduate, may drop an individual class through the Drop Deadline. The long term (16 weeks) and the 8-week terms have different drop deadlines, please see the dates listed above.

**Withdrawal procedures

After the *deadline to drop an individual course via ASAP*, students on financial aid who wish to withdraw (drop all classes) from the University must submit a [withdrawal form](#) to the One Stop Enrollment Center via the [Document Uploader](#). Except for student athletes and international students, only the student's signature is required on the form. Student athletes must submit a withdrawal form, signed by an advisor in the Collegiate Athletics department, to the One Stop Enrollment Center via the Document Uploader. International students must submit a withdrawal

form, signed by the Director, International Student Services or an International Student Advisor, to the One Stop Enrollment Center via the Document Uploader.

After the withdrawal deadline students may not drop courses, or withdraw, except with the approval of the course instructor and the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled.
