Regarding Payment

Viewing your Bill: Tuition & fee charges for Summer 2026 registration will begin posting to your account **April 1, 2026**.

Financial Aid: The earliest Financial Aid and Scholarships can begin disbursing federal, state, and institutional aid is 10 days prior to the first day of class.

Payment Deadlines & Late Fee: A \$100 LATE fee will be charged for students who have not made payment arrangements by 5 p.m. CT on the date of the relevant payment deadline (*excluding the final deadline for the full 10-week term*).

Removal from Classes: Students who are still unpaid by census will be removed from their classes.

*Withdrawal procedures

After the *deadline to drop an individual course*, students on financial aid who wish to withdraw (drop all classes) from the University must submit a withdrawal form (<https://onestop.utsa.edu/forms/registrar/>) via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing. Except for student athletes and international students, only the student's signature is required on the form.

Student athletes must submit a withdrawal form, signed by an advisor in the Collegiate Athletics Department, via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing. International students must submit a withdrawal form, signed by the Director of International Student Services or an International Student Advisor, via the [Document Uploader](#) for processing.

Students must see their advisor to drop developmental classes.

After the withdrawal deadline, students may not drop courses or withdraw, except with the approval of the course instructor and the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled.
