

Fall 2026 Registration Schedule

Fall registration starts March 30, 2026. Eligible students may register on *myUTSA* Account (formerly *ASAP*) as listed below. Eligible **students will have certain days and times to register** for their fall courses. See detailed instructions below.

* Priority registration will be granted for all [eligible veterans and service members](#) who are currently utilizing GI Bill benefits.

** Per Texas Senate Bill 459, priority registration will be granted to enrolled students who have [declared themselves a parent or legal guardian](#) of a child under 18 years of age by March 11, 2026.

Registration Instructions

1. Review the chart above to find your designated registration date and time.

Registration timeframes are based on student classification (your total earned credit hours).

- Each timeframe is a window of time students can register. It has a start date/time and close date/time for the indicated classifications.
- If you miss your first designated registration time period, there will be a second designated period for all students within your classification.
- If you miss the second designated registration time period, registration opens for all students on April 13.
- Waitlisting will be available starting April 13 at 7am. During early registration, March 30 to April 12, students will be allowed to add themselves to the waitlist, but notifications will NOT be sent out.
- Waitlist notifications will be sent out beginning April 13 at 7am. While it may seem there are open seats in courses when students drop, if there is a waitlist, those seats will be reserved for the students on the waitlist. Other students will not be able to register for those open seats. Once open registration begins, notifications will be sent out and the waitlist will resume as in previous semesters.

2. Prepare ahead of time prior to registration.

- **Check your registration status** → Log into your *myUTSA* Account to check your current classification and earned credit hours (*click on “Student Profile” then “Registration Notices” in the top right corner.*)
- **Check your holds and prerequisites** → Certain holds and prerequisites can prevent registration, so it is highly recommended that students address any holds or prerequisite overrides they have or need prior to their registration timeframe.

3. Register during your designated timeframe.

- **Login to *myUTSA* Account** → Students must log onto their *myUTSA* Account student portal to register for, add or drop up to 19 semester credit hours. Please note students on probation or academic warning are limited to 13 credits. Please see the [Registration Instructions page](#) for more information on how to register.

Additionally, please note classroom (location) assignments may change during registration. Please check your classroom locations the week before the scheduled start of the semester. Lastly, this registration schedule is subject to change.
